ANY goods purchased from us that are not entirely satisfactory may be returned within ten days, and we will at once return the purchase price or exchange for other goods, as preferred. We want customers ordering by mail to be satisfied, and to have as many privileges as when buying at a store.

#### HOW TO ORDER

Write your name in full, giving name of street and number, or post-office box, or rural delivery, and write plainly. Also state how much money you enclose. If goods are to be sent to other than permanent address, please give the home address as well. Also state name of article, the number and price, and color when necessary.

#### ABOUT DELAYS

Wait a reasonable time before writing us about a shipment. ## Suggestions for Working

Where scallops appear in the illustrations the edges are to be buttonholed, the eyelets for ribbon are to be worked, and all the embroidery is to be done in either Eyelet or French work as the design requires. If a lace edge is preferred to the buttonholed scallops, the stamped scallops may be easily trimmed off, the edge hemmed and lace whipped in place, as shown in Gown No. 125, on page 11.



Design A. Princess Knickerbocker, No. 509 Made of fine nainsook. Sizes, 36, 38, 40, and 42. Stamped with any design shown on the underwear pages, and 12 skeins of embroidery cotton, \$1.35.







In making up sofa-pillows, it is well to have the inside pillow measure at least two inches larger each way than the cover. This insures a snug fit, and keeps the cover in good shape.

## **Embroidery Stitches**



Simple Outline is made from left to right, putting the needle forward a short distance along the line of stamping and bringing it up at the end of the last stitch. Always keep the


thread on the same side of the line.

Satin Outline is made over a single run thread, or over simple outlining, if a more cordlike effect is desired. After running the padding thread, work over and over with very short, close stitches, keeping these stitches at right angles to the stamped line.



close stitches, keeping these stitches at right angles to the stamped line.

This stitch is used in French embroidery.







Running Outline is made by running a row of short stitches along the line of stamping and then going back, putting the needle under every stitch and always putting in under from the same side

French Knots. Bring the thread out on the right side, then, holding it with the left hand, wrap once, twice, or several times around the needle; insert the needle near where it was brought up and hold the thread taut while the needle is carried through.



Sec. Sec.

German Knot is made from left to right. Take a short tight stitch at right angles to the stamped line, put a loose simple stitch and a loose buttonhole stitch into the first stitch. Repeat at intervals.

Couching consists of sewing down a cord or several strands of thread by taking short stitches across at regular intervals.





Satin Stitch may be padded or not. It consists of regular smooth stitches taken close together side by side across a space, either straight across or on a slant. This is the most important stitch in French Embroidery.


Kensington is the long and short stitch used for covering a surface and which is usually employed when shading is to be done. The illustration shows how the stitches dovetail together.





Buttonholing may be padded or not and is worked from left to right. Holding the thread down with the left thumb, a stitch is taken across the space to be covered, and the loop formed when the thread is drawn up makes a purling on the edge of the space.

Long and Short Buttonholing is made like simple buttonholing except that the stitches are of unequal length. This stitch is used when an irregular effect is desired.






Wallachian is a form of buttonholing used for working flowers, leaves, etc. The stitches are worked from left to right, taking them from the mid-vein or centre and bringing the needle out on the edge, always keeping the purling on the edge.

Balkan Stitch is made by bringing the thread up on the left of the line, then inserting the needle on the right and taking a slanting stitch, bringing it up on the line above the thread. The thread is caught down with a short stitch and the needle is again brought up on the left.






Cross Stitch consists of two short stitches crossing at right angles. The top threads should all run in the same direction.

Darning consists of parallel rows of short, regular stitches; the stitches of each row alternate with those of the last. It is used for filling large spaces or backgrounds.

## Embroidery Stitches



Briar Stitch and Feather Stitch are both forms of buttonholing made towards the worker. The first is made along two lines by taking a short buttonhole stitch first on one line and then on the other. Feather stitch is made with short, slanting buttonhole stitches taken alternately on the left and right of a single


Shadow Embroidery consists of cat stitch worked on the wrong side and showing on the right as two continuous lines of short stitches. The work pro-gresses from left to right, and the needle always points to the left.






Honeycomb Stitch, which is used for filling irregular spaces or backgrounds, is a simple loose button-hole stitch worked into the preceding row and the fabric beneath. The illustration shows the method of working very plainly.

Fagoting, usually employed for joining two edges, consists of buttonhole stitches taken on first one edge and then the other, letting the work progress towards one. When two bands are fagoted together, they are first basted on stiff paper and then the stitches




Lazy Daisy or Bird's-Eye Stitch is another form of buttonholing. Long loop stitches, beginning and ending at the same place, are caught down with a short stitch in the end of the loop.

Long Eyelet. Run a thread around the stamped line, slit the space, roll back the edges on the wrong side and whip over and over with short close stitches.






Round and Shaded Eyelets are made in the same way that long ones are made except that in the shaded eyelet longer stitches are taken on one side to give the heavy edge. Some padding may be used.



Italian Cut Work consists of long parrow spaces buttonholed on the sides, with buttonhole bars across and the material cut away be-neath. The bars are put in before the edges are buttonholed.

Roman Cut Work. Run the edges and put in the twisted bars and woven wheels, then buttonhole all the edges very nar-lowly and cut away the linen from beneath the lace stitches or bars.




Bullion Stitch. Bring the thread up at the base of the petal, insert the needle at the apex and bring the point out at the base again; wrap the thread a number of times around the needle and draw through, then carry down at the apex.

Relief Embroidery is made sep-arate from the linen except at the starting point and at the finish. It consists of fine, close buttonholing worked back and






to conform to the desired shape.



Filet. Parallel threads are carried across the space, then, at right angles, other threads are knotted to the first as illustrated. The edges are buttonholed and the linen beneath cut away.


Rambler Rose. This stitch should be worked with several shades. A knob is built for the centre, then the stitches taken around and around as illustrated, keeping the flower raised three-sixteenths of an inch above the material.





Punched Work is done with fine thread and a large needle, the thread being drawn tightly. The illustration shows the method of working, after the space has been gone over in one direction and the work has been turned.


