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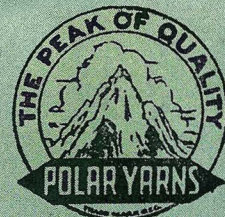

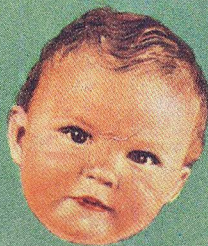

# BLOCKING A KNITTED GARMENT

Always turn wrong side out. Stretch to shape on flat pressing board along the exact lines and size you wish garment to remain. Use a slightly hot iron and a damp cloth and press lightly without any weight or pressure on the garment and allow steam to thoroughly penetrate the wool. Leave garment as pressed until thoroughly dry. This same procedure can be used for blocking a knitted garment after it has been washed.

Your handknits will give full satisfaction if they are given attention.

## KNITTING TEST FOR INTERCHANGEABLE YARNS

The same garment can be made of various yarns of approximately the same thickness whether the yarn is 2 ply, 3 ply or 4 ply. As a suggestion and to avoid trouble we suggest that you always knit a swatch approximately 6" x 4", using the needles called for in the instructions for the individual garment. You can alter the size of the needles until you have a gauge that is in agreement with the stitches per inch instructions and the rows per inch instructions given for the specific garment you are knitting.

Slip Stitch—Insert hook in next stitch. Yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.  
Pull stitches together—Break yarn and leave about 10 inches. Thread a tapestry needle and pull this needle through the remaining stitches.  
When using colors—In changing colors, always have right side facing you.  
Bind off—Take two stitches together and work off as one. Put the stitch back on the needle and take it together with the next st., etc., until the required amount of stitches are bound off.  
Block—Pin garment on wrong side out, and place on pressing board to the measurements desired. Place a damp cloth over the garment and with a moderately hot iron press lightly, allowing steam to go through. Keep it on a flat surface until thoroughly dry.  
When sewing seams—When sewing seams always split four-fold yarn in two parts. This will make a neater seam when blocked.  
3-ply Fingering Yarn interchangeable with Crochet Zephyr or Fleur de Laine.  
Knitting Worsted interchangeable with Germantown.

**LEG BANDS:**—With right side of work toward you, with No. 1 needles, pick up 116 sts. (start at seam edge). Continue along leg edge of front, along crotch edge and along leg edge of back. Work ribbing of K2, P2 for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Bind off loosely in ribbing.

**FINISHING:**—Sew side seams. Fold hem in half at top of pants. Make a loose chain with double yarn and draw through top hem.

### 607K—SOAKER

(Size 1)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
2— $1\frac{1}{8}$  oz. skeins knitting worsted (4-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 4  
1 small pearl button

**GAUGE:**—5 sts. make 1 inch. 12 rows make 1 inch.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 4 needles cast on 124 sts. K2, P2 for 1". Then work as follows:

Row 1—Knit across entire row.

Row 2—Same as row 1.

Row 3—K2, K2 together, knit to within the last 4 sts., K2 together, K2.

Row 4—Knit entire row.

Repeat these 4 rows till 6 sts. remain on needle. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Fold soaker so that 6 bound off sts. come to center front of ribbing. Sew side seams leaving a 4" opening for each leg. Crochet buttonhole. Sew button in place.

### 619D—BABY BOOTIES

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
1 1 oz. skein Fingering Yarn (3-ply)  
Small amount of contrasting yarn  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
No. 1 or No. 2 bone crochet hook  
2 small pearl buttons

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Starting at the sole, cast on 18 sts. Knit 2 rows. (Work entire slipper in garter st.) Increase 1 st. at beginning of each row until there are 36 sts. on needle. K3 rows straight, then decrease 1 st. at the end of every row until 18 sts. remain. This completes the sole. Do not bind off. For the side of slipper work across row then pick up 12 sts. (This is the heel.)

Row 2—Knit to last 2 sts. Increase 1 st. in the next st. K1. (This is the toe.)

Row 3—K1. Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 39 sts. on the needle, ending at the heel end.

Now shape the heel as follows:

Row 1—Knit 12, turn.

Row 2—Knit all even rows.

Row 3—Knit 9, turn.

Row 5—Knit 6, turn.

Row 7 (Heel edge)—Bind off 21 sts. Knit 18. (This completes the side of slipper.) Now knit these 18 sts. for 14 rows. (This makes the top of toe.) To work the other side of the slipper, knit 18, cast on 21 sts.

Row 1—Knit 6, turn.

Row 2—Knit all even rows.

Row 3—Knit 9, turn.

Row 5—Knit 12, turn.

Row 7—Knit across to the last 3 sts., then K2 together, K1.

Row 8—Knit. Repeat 7th and 8th rows until 30 sts. remain. K1 row. Bind off.

**STRAP:**—Cast on 44 sts. K2 rows. On next row make buttonhole as follows: K3, yarn over, K2 together, knit across row. Knit 2 rows. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew back seam. Crochet 1 row s.c. around side of slipper and straps in c. c. yarn. Sew button in place. Embroider as illustrated.

### 625—BUNTING AND HOOD

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
5  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " oz. hanks Germantown (4-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 14" No. 7  
1 20" zipper  
4 yds. satin ribbon  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

**GAUGE:**—5 sts. make 1 inch. 7 rows make 1 inch.

#### 625B BUNTING

**PATTERN STITCH:**—Multiple of 4 plus 2 sts.

Row 1—\*K2, P2, repeat from \* across row, ending K2.

Row 2—Repeat first row.

Row 3—Knit across entire row.

These three rows constitute the pattern.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 7 needles, cast on 158 sts. Work in pattern st. for 28". Bind off.

**GUSSET FOR BOTTOM:**—Cast on 10 sts. Work in pattern st., increasing 1 st. on each end of work every 3rd row, 12 times (34 sts.). Work even for 7". Decrease 1 st. on each end of work every 3rd row till 10 sts. remain on needle. Bind off.

#### 625H HOOD

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Cast on 94 sts. and work in pattern for  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Bind off 16 sts. at beginning of each of next 2 rows (62 sts.). Work even for  $7\frac{3}{4}$ ". Decrease 1 st. at beginning and end of every row till all sts. are bound off.

**FINISHING:**—Fold bunting in half and sew the gusset in bottom, having opening of bunting in center front. Sew zipper in place. Then bind with satin ribbon as illustrated. Sew hood together and bind same as bunting. Pull ribbon through neck part of hood to fit neck.

### 613—THREE-PIECE SET—SACQUE CARRIAGE COVER AND CAP

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
8—1 oz. balls Baby Zephyr (2-ply)  
2 yards of 1" satin ribbon  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
Gauge: 8 sts. make 1 inch

Note:—If made separately—Sacque, 2 balls; Carriage Cover, 5 balls; Cap, 1 ball.

#### PATTERN:—

Row 1—K2, P2, across row.

Row 2—P2, K2, across row.

Row 3—Same as 1st row.

Row 4—Same as 2nd row.

Row 5—Same as 3rd row.

Row 6—(Right side of work) P2\* skip next 6 sts. insert right hand needle between the 6th and 7th sts., making a loop, draw the loop through to the front and place at the end of the needle, then K2 sts. together (the loop st. and the first st. of the K2 group) K1-P2-K2-P2 and repeat from \* across row ending P2.

Rows 7-8-9-10-11—same as Rows 1-5 inclusive

Row 12 (Right side of work) P2-K2-P2, \* skip next 6 sts., insert right hand needle be-



tween the 6th and 7th sts., making a loop, draw the loop through to the front and place at the end of the needle, then K2 sts. together (the loop st. and the first st. of the K2 group) K1-P2-K2-P2 and repeat from \* across row ending P2.

Work these 12 rows for pattern.

### 613S—SACQUE

**BACK:**—Cast on 90 sts. Work in garter st. for 1". Change to stockinette st., and work till piece measures 6" from start. Holding wrong side of work toward you work pattern st. till piece measures 10" from start. Bind off.

**LEFT FRONT:**—Cast on 52 sts. Work in garter st. for 1 inch. Change to stockinette st. keeping the first 4 sts. at center front edge in garter st. and continue to 6" from start. Change to yoke pattern and at the same time beyond the K4 border work 2 sts. together every knit row until 32 sts. are left on needle. Work to back shoulder and bind off all but the 4 border sts. Work these 4 sts. in garter st. for 2" and bind off.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond to left front, reversing shape.

**SLEEVES:**—Cast on 60 sts. Work garter st. for 1". Work stockinette st. till piece measures 7" from start. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams to yoke. Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place. Sew ribbon in place.

### 613C—CARRIAGE COVER

Measurement of Finished Garment:—31" x 33".

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Cast on 228 sts. Work in garter st. for 3". Then work as follows:

Keep the first 33 sts. and last 33 sts. in garter st. and the center 162 sts. in pattern till piece measures 30" from start. Work last 3" in garter st. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Block to size.

### 613B—CAP

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Cast on 98 sts. Work in garter st. for 1½". Then work pattern 6 times, ending with 5th row of pattern. Work garter st. for 1½". Then work as follows:

1st decrease row:—K2 together, \*K10-K2 together repeat from \* across row. Purl across row.

2nd decrease row:—K2 together, \*K9-K2 together repeat from \* across row. Purl across row.

3rd decrease row:—K2 together, \*K8-K2 together repeat from \* across row. Purl across row.

Continue to decrease in this manner, having 1 st. less between decreases every knit row and a purl row between decrease rows until 6 sts. are left on needle, break yarn, draw through sts. and fasten.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seam down back. Pick up 61 sts. around the neck. Work garter st. for 5 rows. Bind off. Sew ribbon in place.

### 612—SACQUE AND BOOTIE SET

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

3—1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)

1 yd. narrow satin ribbon

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

1 bone crochet hook No. 2

If made separately, Sacque—2½ skeins

Booties—½ skein

**GAUGE:**—2 patterns make 1 inch.

### 612S—SACQUE

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—**PATTERN STITCH:**—Row 1—Purl. Row 2—\*K1, Yarn over, K3 together, Yarn over, Repeat from \* across row, ending K1. Repeat these 2 rows for entire garment.

**BACK:**—Cast on 89 stitches. Work in garter stitch for 4 rows. Then work pattern till piece measures 10 inches from start. Bind off.

**LEFT FRONT:**—Cast on 45 stitches. Work garter stitch for 4 rows. Work pattern till piece measures 8½ inches from start. Bind off 15 stitches at inside edge and then decrease 1 stitch at same edge every other row till piece measures 10 inches from start. Bind off.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond with left front.

**SLEEVES:**—Cast on 69 stitches. Work garter stitch for 4 rows. Work pattern till piece measures 7 inches from start. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew shoulder seams together. Sew side seams together, allowing enough of an armhole for sleeve to fit properly. Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place. Crochet edging around fronts and neck as follows:

Work 2 s. c. starting from lower right front edge \* chain 3, work s. c. in base of chain three, work 1 s. c. in next stitch. Continue from \* around to lower left front edge. Draw ribbon around neck.

### 612D—BOOTIES

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Cast on 76 stitches. K1, P1 for 1 inch. Next row K17, bind off next 14 stitches, work across 28 stitches. Turn. Bind off 4 sts. Work across center 14 stitches for 1¾ inches. Turn. Work next 31 sts. Turn and work over all (48) sts. Then start pattern. Add 1 stitch to make 49 sts. Work till 3¾ inches from cast on stitches. Bind off loosely. Sew sole seam and side instep seams. Draw ribbon through top.

### 610—HAT AND SWEATER SET

(Size 2-3)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

5—1⅞ oz. skeins Germantown (4-ply)

1 pair knitting needles 10", No. 4

1 pair knitting needles, No. 2

1 yard ¾" satin ribbon

7 pearl buttons

Note: If made separately, hat 2 skeins  
sweater 3 skeins

**GAUGE:**—6 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.

### 610S—SWEATER

Measurements of finished garment:

Across chest—14"

From shoulder to shoulder—13½"

Underarm seam—7½"

Sleeve seam—8"

**BACK:**—With No. 2 needles, cast on 88 sts. Work as follows:

Row 1—K4, P2, repeat across row ending K4.

Row 2—Purl back entire row.

Repeat these 2 rows for entire garment. Work till piece measure 7½".

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 5 sts. beginning of next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st. on each end every other row 4 times (70 sts.). Work even till piece measures 4¾" from armhole shaping. Bind off 5 sts. beginning of each of next 8 rows (30 sts.). Bind off these sts. for back of neck.



**LEFT FRONT:**—Cast on 42 sts. on No. 2 needles. Work pattern till piece measures 7½".

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 5 sts., on one side only. Decrease 1 st. on same side every other row 4 times (33 sts.). Work even till armhole measures 3¼", straight up.

**NECK SHAPING:**—At inside center edge, bind off 8 sts. at one time. At same edge decrease 1 st. every other row 5 times (20 sts.). When armhole measures same as back bind off 5 sts. from armhole edge every other row 4 times.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond with left front.

**SLEEVES:**—With No. 2 needles cast on 44 sts. K2, P2, for 2¼". Change to No. 4 needles and increase across next row to 46 sts. Work till sleeve measures 7½" straight up. Bind off 2 sts. beginning of every row till 10 sts. remain. Bind off.

**COLLAR:**—Sew shoulder seams together and with wrong side of work toward you pick up 76 sts. around neck. Work in garter st. for 3". Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seams together. Sew sleeves in place. Crochet 2 rows s. c. on left front. On right front one row s. c. On second row make 1 buttonhole at top by \*chaining 3, skip the next 2 st., 1 s. c. in third st., work 3 more s. c., repeat from \* to bottom of garment. Work 1 row s. c. over buttonholes. Work 2 rows s. c. around bottom.

#### 610C DOPEY HAT

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Cast on 40 sts. on No. 4 needles. Work pattern for 14". Bind off. Fold piece in half lengthwise. Work 2 rows s. c. around front of band and two rows around bottom holding in to fit neck. Turn back piece in front for flap. Sew ribbon in place.

#### 605—CARRIAGE SHAWL

##### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
4—1 oz. balls Baby Zephyr, M.C. (2-ply)  
4—1 oz. balls Baby Zephyr, C.C. (2-ply)  
1 pair wooden knitting needles No. 10  
1 bone crochet hook No. 3 or 4

Measurements of finished garment:  
36" x 48"

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 10 knitting needles, cast on 119 sts. with M.C. yarn. Work in pattern as follows:

Row 1—K1, P1, across row, ending K1

Row 2—K1, P1, across row, ending K1

Repeat these 2 rows till you have completed 3 balls of one color. Bind off. Make another piece exactly the same, using contrasting color. Bind off.

**CROCHETED FRINGE:**—Put one piece on top of the other and starting at corner, with crochet hook work as follows:

Using both colors of yarn, work 1 s. c. in first mesh, draw loop up about 3", repeat 2 more times in same mesh. Repeat around entire shawl. Cut and trim all fringe. Block to size.

#### 615—CARRIAGE COVER

##### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
5 1⅞ oz. skeins Germantown (4-ply)  
1 bone crochet hook No. 5  
6 yds. 3" satin ribbon  
1 skein each pink and blue Babysheen  
1 embroidery needle  
Measurements of finished garment:—26" x 31".

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Make a chain 26" long. Work as follows:

Row 1—One s. c. in second st., then 1 s. c. in each of the remaining stitches.

Row 2—\*Skip 2 sts., work 1 s.c. and 2 d.c. in the 3rd st. (shell st.), repeat from \* across row ending with a shell st. Repeat row 2, working a shell st. in each s. c. of the previous row, until piece measures 31" long.

**FINISHING:**—Bind with satin ribbon and make bow as illustrated and embroider with Babysheen in corners and center of bow.

#### 600C—CARRIAGE COVER

##### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

8—1 oz. balls Fleur de Laine (3-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

GAUGE:—11 sts. make 1 inch. 16 rows make 1 inch.  
Measurements of finished garment:  
32" x 35"

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 2 needles, cast on 239 sts. Work in garter st. (Knit every row) for 4½". Then work as follows:

Row 1—K32, \*K2, P2, for 34 sts. K13, repeat from \* 2 more times, K2, P2, for next 34 sts., Knit last 32 sts.

Row 2—K32, \*P2, K2 for 34 sts. K13, repeat from \* 2 more times, P2, K2, for next 34 sts., knit last 32 sts.

Repeat these 2 rows for 28". Work last 4½" in garter st. Bind off.

#### 600S—BABY CARDIGAN

(Size 1-2)

##### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

3—1 oz. balls Fleur de Laine (3-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
7 pearl buttons

GAUGE:—8 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.  
Measurements of finished garment:  
18"—across chest  
11¾"—from shoulder to bottom of garment  
7¼"—Underarm seam  
7"—Sleeve seam

**BACK:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 84 sts. K2-P2 for 2½". Change to No. 2 needles and work stockinette st. and increase across one row at even intervals to 88 sts. Work until back measures 7½".

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 6 sts. at the beginning of the next 2 rows, bind off 1 st. at the beginning of every row until 70 sts. are left on needle and change to yoke pattern.

**YOKE:**—Row 1—(Right side of work) K2-P2 across row ending K2

Row 2—P2-K2 across row ending P2

Repeat these 2 rows until armhole measures 4½" above cast off sts.

Bind off 5 sts. at the beginning of the next 8 rows, bind off remaining sts. at one time.

**LEFT FRONT:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 44 sts.

Row 1—P2-K6-P2 \*K2-P2 repeat from \* across row  
Row 2—P2-K2 across to last 10 sts., P10

Repeat these 2 rows for 2½", then change to stockinette st. and No. 2 needles and continue working front border as follows:—

Row 1—P2-K6-P2, Knit across row

Row 2—Purl across entire row.

Repeat these 2 rows to back armhole



**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—At armhole edge bind off 6 sts. at one time, bind off 1 st. at a time at armhole every other row 4 times. Work even until armhole measures 3¼" above cast off sts.

**NECK SHAPING:**—At neck edge bind off 10 sts. at one time, K2 sts. together at neckedge every knit row until 20 sts. are left on needle. Work to back shoulder and from outside edge bind off 5 sts. 4 times.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond with left front, working a button hole on center edge ½" from lower edge in following way: Work first 3 sts., bind off next 4 sts., work across remaining sts. On next row cast on 4 sts. directly over those bound off on previous row. Work button holes in this manner every 1½" to neck line.

**SLEEVES:**—On No. 1 needles cast on 56 sts. K2, P2 for 2½". Change to No. 2 needles and increase across row to 66 sts. Work in stockinette stitch till piece measures 7" from start. Bind off 3 sts. at beginning of every row till 12 sts. remain. Bind off these stitches.

**FINISHING:**—Sew shoulder seams together. Sew underarm seams. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in place. With No. 1 needles pick up 80 sts. around collar and with right side of work towards you work K2, P2 ribbing for 1". Bind off loosely. Sew buttons in place.

### 600B—BABY CAP

(Size 1-2)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
1—1 oz. ball Fleur de Laine (3-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
1 yd. satin ribbon ¾" wide

**GAUGE:**—8 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 2 needles, cast on 88 sts. K2, P2 for 1½". Work in stockinette st. for 4½" (6" from start). On next row bind off first 29 sts. and work across remaining sts. (59). On next row bind off first 29 sts., and work on center 30 sts. in K2, P2, ribbing till piece measures same as bound off sts. Bind off these sts.

**FINISHING:**—Sew center piece at back to side to form square back. Turn back ribbing at front of cap. Pick up 80 sts. around neck and work in K2, P2, ribbing for 1¼". Bind off loosely. Sew ribbon in place at each side of cap.

### 611—HAT, SWEATER, MITTEN AND LEGGING SET

(Size 2-4)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
9—1⅞ oz. skeins Knitting Worsted (4-ply)  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 3  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 4  
1 yard ¾" satin ribbon  
7 small pearl buttons  
No. 2 bone crochet hook  
2 stitch holders

Note: If made separately, hat—2 skeins  
sweater—3 skeins  
leggings—3 skeins  
mittens—1 skein

### 611L—LEGGINGS

**Left Leg:**—On No. 3 needles, cast on 42 sts. K2, P2, for 3". Change to No. 4 needles and increase across next row to 48 sts. Work in stockinette st. for 1". Increase 1 st. on each side, then increase 1 st. each side every 2", 3 more times (56 sts.). Increase 1 st. each side every ½" 3 times (62 sts.). Then every other row 5 times (72 sts.). Purl back. Increase 1 st. at beginning of next row (73 sts.). Place these 73 sts. on a st. holder and work right leg to correspond. Join (146 sts. on needle) and work ½" even. Decrease 1 st. each side every inch 5 more times (128 sts.). About 7½" from crotch. Next row, work across 33 sts. and put them on a st. holder. Bind off next 62 sts. once, then bind off 8 sts. from the same edge, every other row 3 times. Put the stitches from the st. holder on the needle and work in same way. Pick up 120 sts. around top of legging with right side of work facing you and work K1, P1, ribbing for 2". Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seams, having seam in center back.

### 611C—STOCKING CAP

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 140 sts., K2, P2 for 4". Change to No. 4 needles and work in stockinette st. for 3 rows, continue stockinette st. and decrease as follows:—

First decrease row—K6, K2 together \*K5, K2 together repeat from \* across row ending K6. Work even for 1".

Next decrease row—K6, K2 together \*K4, K2 together repeat from \* across row ending K6. Work even for 1".

Next decrease row—K6, K2 together \*K3, K2 together repeat from \* across row ending K6. Work even for 1".

Next decrease row—K6, K2 together, \*K2, K2 together, repeat from \* across row ending K6. Work even for 1".

Next decrease row—K4, K2 together, \*K1, K2 together, repeat from \* across row. Work even for ½".

Next decrease row—K3, K2 together, \*K1, K2 together, repeat from \* across row.

Next decrease row—P2 together across entire row.

Next decrease row—K2 together across entire row. Break yarn and draw through remaining stitches.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seam in back. Make pom-pom as illustrated.

### 611M—MITTENS

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 36 sts. Work K2, P2 for 2". Change to stockinette st. and increase across the row at even intervals to 50 sts. Work for thumb as follows:—

Row 1—Work across 24 sts., increase in each of the next 2 sts. Knit across row

Row 2—Purl across

Row 3—Work 24 sts., increase in next st., K2, increase in next st. knit across row

Row 4—Purl across

Continue to increase in this manner moving over 2 sts. between increases every knit row until 12 sts. are increased in thumb. Work even until mitten measures 1½" above ribbing, ending with a purl row. Working only on 12 thumb sts., work stockinette st. for 1¼", K1, K2 together across row, P2 together across row. Break yarn and draw through remaining sts.



Cast on 2 sts. on right hand needle (over the thumb sts.). Knit across the left hand needle. Work even for  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " for hand, then decrease by knitting 2 together, K1, across row. Purl next row. K2 together across next row. Break yarn. Draw through sts. and fasten. Sew seams. With double yarn crochet a chain 22" long. Sew to inside of mitten.

### 611S—SWEATER

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Starting at bottom of back, with No. 3 needles, cast on 66 sts. K2, P2, for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Change to No. 4 needles and increase across next row to 77 sts. Work in stockinette st. till piece measures 8" from bottom. Decrease 1 st. each side every other row 5 times (67 sts.). Work even for 3". On the first 22 sts. work even for 1" for right shoulder. Put remaining 45 sts. on a st. holder. Increase 1 st. at neck edge every row 7 times (29 sts.). Cast on 4 sts. for front of neck (33 sts. on needle). Work even for 1". At the armhole edge increase 1 st. every other row 5 times (38 sts.). Work to correspond with the back. Bind off 22 sts. on the st. holder for back of neck. On the remaining 23 sts. work the left shoulder and front to correspond with right. Bind off.

**SLEEVES:**—On No. 3 needles cast on 40 sts. K2, P2 for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Change to No. 4 needles and increase 1 st. on each side every  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 10 times (60 sts.). Work even for  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ". Decrease 1 st. on each end every row 8 times (44 sts.). Bind off these 44 sts.

**FINISHING:**—Pick up 70 sts. around neck with wrong side of work toward you and on No. 3 needles work K2, P2, for  $2\frac{3}{4}$ ". Bind off in ribbing. Sew underarm seams to armhole and sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place. Crochet 2 rows s. c. with 7 buttonholes on other edge of front. Sew buttons in place.

### 622—TWO-PIECE DRESS

(Size 3)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
6 2 oz. balls Sport Yarn (4-ply)  
1 circular needle 29" No. 3  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 3  
1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1  
No. 2 or No. 3 crochet hook  
3 small pearl buttons  
Small amount of contrasting yarn  
Embroidery needle  
1 st. holder

Note:—If made separately—

Sweater—3 balls.  
Skirt—3 balls.

**GAUGE:**—7 sts. make 1 inch. 10 rows make 1 inch.

### 622D DRESS

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—On circular needle, cast on 273 sts. Work in pattern as follows:

#### PATTERN:—

Round 1—\*K14, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for 1 round (13 panels). Join round making sure to keep sts. straight. Repeat this round for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Next Round—Decrease 1 st. in every K14 panel, in this manner \*K6, K2 together, K6, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for 1 round.

Next Round—\*K13, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Next Round—Decrease in this manner \*K5, K2 together, K6, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for 1 round.

Next Round—\*K12, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for  $1\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Continue to decrease 1 st. in the center of every large Knit Panel every inch 4 times. Work in K8, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2 (195 sts. in round) until piece measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " from the start.

Next Round—\*K2 together, K1 twice, K2 together, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2. Repeat from \* for 1 round (156 sts. in round).

Divide work in half. Change to No. 1 needles and work K1, P1 ribbing for 2". Bind off in ribbing.

**STRAPS:**—On No. 1 needles, cast on 12 sts. K1, P1, for 13". Make another strap.

**FINISHING:**—Sew side seams together at top. Sew straps in place, crossing them in the back. Embroider as illustrated.

### 622S SWEATER

**BACK:**—On No. 1 needles, cast on 84 sts. K1, P1, for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Change to No. 3 needles and increase across next row to 86 sts. Work as follows:

Row 1—K20, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K32, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K20.

Row 2—P20, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P32, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P20.

Repeat these 2 rows for entire garment. Work till piece measures 8" from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 6 sts. at beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st. at each end every other row 4 times (66 sts.). Work even till armhole measures  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " straight up.

**SHOULDER AND NECK SHAPING:**—Bind off 5 sts. at beginning of every row 8 times (26 sts.). Bind off remaining 26 sts. for back of neck.

**FRONT:**—On No. 1 needles, cast on 84 sts. Work same as back to underarm. Work armhole shaping same as back. Work till armhole measures  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " straight up, ending with right side of work facing you.

**NECK AND SHOULDER SHAPING:**—Work across first 24 sts. and put them on a st. holder. Bind off the next 18 sts.. Work across remaining 24 sts., decreasing 1 st. at the center neck edge every other row 4 times. Work even till armhole measures same as back. Bind off 5 sts. from armhole edge every other row 4 times. Work other shoulder to correspond.

**SLEEVES:**—On No. 1 needles, cast on 48 sts. K1, P1, for 2". Change to No. 3 needles and increase across the next row to 56 sts.

#### PATTERN:—

Row 1—K16, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K10, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K16.

Row 2—P16, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P10, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P16.

Repeat these 2 rows keeping panels straight throughout work. Work in pattern increasing 1 st. on each end, every  $1\frac{1}{4}$ ", till piece measures  $7\frac{3}{4}$ " from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 5 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st. at each end every other row 4 times. Work even till armhole measures  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " straight up. ending purl row.

Next Row—Knit every 2 sts. together.

Next Row—Purl back.

Repeat these 2 rows 2 more times. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew underarm seams together. Sew sleeve seams together. Sew left shoulder only  $\frac{1}{2}$ " in from armhole edge. Sew sleeves in place. Work 1 row s.c. around neck and shoulder opening, making 3 buttonholes. Sew buttons in place.



**616—GIRL'S SUN SUIT**  
(Size 1-2)**MATERIALS:**

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
 2 1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)  
 Small amount of contrasting yarn  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1  
 No. 1 or No. 2 bone crochet hook  
 GAUGE:—8 sts. make 1 inch. 10 rows make 1 inch.  
 Measurements:—Waist: 17". Waist to Crotch: 8½".  
 PATTERN:—Row 1—K2, P2, repeat across row.  
 Row 2—Purl across row.  
 Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

**BACK:**—Starting at top, with No. 1 needles, cast on 78 sts. K1, P1 for 1¼". Change to No. 2 needles and work in pattern st. for 6½". Bind off 3 sts. at the beginning of every row for 14 rows. Bind off 2 sts. at the beginning of every row until 18 sts. remain. Bind off these 18 sts.

**FRONT:**—Work same as back.

**BIB:**—Cast on 38 sts. Work in pattern st., decreasing 1 st. on each end, every other row till 14 sts. remain. Bind off.

**STRAPS:**—On No. 1 needle cast on 13 sts. Work garter st. till piece measures 8". Bind off. Make another strap to correspond.

**FINISHING:**—Sew side seams. Sew crotch. With c. c. yarn, crochet 1 row of s. c. around top of waist around leg openings, around bib and around straps. Sew bib and straps in place as illustrated, crossing straps at back.

**617—BOY'S SUN SUIT**  
(Size 1-2)**MATERIALS:**

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
 2 1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)  
 Small amount of contrasting yarn  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

 GAUGE:—8 sts. make 1 inch. 10 rows make 1 inch.  
 Measurements:—Waist: 17". Waist to Crotch: 8½".  
 PATTERN:—Row 1—K2, P2, repeat across row.  
 Row 2—Purl across row.  
 Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

**BACK:**—Starting at top, with No. 1 needles, cast on 78 sts. K1, P1, for 1¼". Change to No. 2 needles, and work in pattern st. for 6½". Bind off 3 sts. at beginning of every row for 14 rows. Bind off 2 sts. at the beginning of every row until 18 sts. remain. Bind off these 18 sts.

**FRONT:**—Work same as back.

**STRAPS:**—On No. 1 needle, cast on 13 sts. Work in garter st. till piece measures 13". Bind off. Make another strap to correspond.

**FINISHING:**—Sew side seams together. Sew crotch together. With c. c. yarn work one row of s.c. around top of waist, around leg opening, and around straps. Sew straps in place crossing them in the back.

**618—SURPLICE SWEATER**  
(Size 2-3)**MATERIALS:**

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
 4 1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)  
 1 skein Babysheen

1 skein contrasting Babysheen  
 4 small pearl buttons  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 3  
 No. 1 or No. 2 bone crochet hook

GAUGE:—8 sts. make 1 inch. 10 rows make 1 inch.

**BACK:**—With No. 1 needles starting at bottom of back, cast on 90 sts. K2, P2, for 1¼". Change to No. 3 needles and work in stockinette st. till piece measures 8" from start. At beginning of each of next 10 rows, cast on 12 sts. (210 sts.). Work till back measures 12½" from start, ending with a purl row. On next row, knit across 91 sts. Put these sts. on a stitch holder. Bind off the next 28 sts. for back of neck. Knit across remaining 91 stitches.

**BACK:**—Work on these 91 sts., increasing 1 st. at center front edge only every other row until work measures 4½" from back of neck at arm edge. Bind off 12 sts. from arm edge 6 times. Continue the front, increasing 1 st. at the inside edge until the work measures same as back to the front border, measuring from underarm. Change to No. 1 needles and work border same as back. Bind off. Work left front to correspond.

**CUFF:**—With No. 1 needles, and right side of work facing you, pick up 54 sts. across the bottom of sleeves. K2, P2, for 1½". Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seams together. Work 4 rows of s.c. around fronts and neck, making 2 buttonholes as illustrated. Embroider as illustrated.

**602A—V-NECK CARDIGAN**  
(Size 1-2)**MATERIALS:**

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns  
 3—1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2  
 1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1  
 7 small pearl buttons  
 1 crochet hook No. 1

GAUGE:—8 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.

**BACK:**—Starting at bottom of back with No. 1 needles cast on 84 sts. K1, P1 for 2". Across next row, increase at even intervals to 88 sts. Change to No. 2 needles and work in stockinette st. till piece measures 7½" from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 6 sts. at beginning of each of next 2 rows (76 sts.). Working garter stitch, decrease 1 st. on each end, every other row 4 times (68 sts.). Work even till armhole measures 4½" straight up. Bind off 5 sts. at beginning of each next 8 rows. Bind off remaining center 28 sts. for back of neck.

**LEFT FRONT:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 44 sts. K1, P1 for 2". Change to No. 2 needles and increase across row to 48 sts. Work in stockinette st. until front measures 7½" from beginning.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—At armhole bind off 6 sts. at one time, change to garter st. (all knitting) and at armhole continue to bind off 1 st. at a time 4 times.

**NECK AND SHOULDER SHAPING:**—On next row work 2 sts. together at neck edge and continue to decrease at neck edge every other row until 20 sts. are left on needle. Work even to back shoulder and at armhole bind off 5 sts. 4 times.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond with left front.



**SLEEVES:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 54 sts. K1, P1, for 2". Increase to 64 sts. at even intervals and change to No. 2 needles. Work in stockinette stitch till piece measures 7½" from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Working in garter stitch, bind off 3 sts. at beginning of every row till 10 sts. remain. Bind off these 10 sts. loosely.

**FINISHING:**—Sew shoulder seams together. Sew underarm seams. Then sew sleeves into armhole. Then starting at left front bottom, with No. 1 bone crochet hook, work single crochet around both fronts. Turn. On second row, work back to end of neck shaping on left front, \*chain 3, skip next 3 sts., 4 s.c. over next 4 sts. of previous row, repeat from \* till you finish entire row. Turn. On third row work s.c. around to bottom of right front. Turn. Work 1 row slip sts. Sew buttons in place.

### 602S—CREW-NECK SLIPOVER

(Size 1-2)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

3—1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

1 bone crochet hook No. 1 or 2

6 small pearl buttons

Small amount of white yarn

**GAUGE:**—8 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.

**Measurements of finished garment:**

Across chest—16 inches

Underarm seam—7½ inches

From shoulder to bottom—12 inches

Sleeve—7½ inches

**BACK:**—With No. 1 needles, cast on 80 sts. K1, P1 for 2". Increase across next row to 84 sts. and change to No. 2 needles. Work in stockinette stitch till piece measures 7½" from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 6 sts. at beginning of each of next 2 rows (72 sts.). Decrease 1 st. on each end every other row 5 times (62 sts.). Start yoke by working garter stitch till entire armhole measures 4½" straight up. Bind off.

**FRONT:**—Work to correspond with back.

**SLEEVES:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 54 sts. K1, P1 for 2". Increase across next row to 64 sts. Change to No. 2 needles and work in stockinette stitch till piece measures 7½" from start.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Working garter stitch, bind off 3 sts. at beginning of every row till 10 sts. remain. Bind off these 10 sts.

**FINISHING:**—Sew underarm seams together. Sew sleeve seams. Sew shoulder together ½ inch on each side. Sew sleeves into place. Crochet three button holes on each shoulder. Sew buttons in place. Monogram as illustrated.

### 602C—BABY CAP

(Size 1)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

1—1 oz. skein Fingering Yarn (3-ply)

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

1 bone crochet hook No. 1 or 2

1 yard satin ribbon ¾" wide

**GAUGE:**—8 sts. make 1 inch. 9 rows make 1 inch.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Starting at front with No. 2 needles cast on 84 sts. Work 1¼" in garter st. Then work 4¼" in stockinette stitch (5½" from start). On next row bind off first 28 sts. and work across row. On next row bind off first 28 sts. leaving 28 center

sts. Work on these center sts. in stockinette stitch till piece measures same as bound off sts. Bind off all sts.

**FINISHING:**—Crochet center piece to each side of back with crochet hook. Work 1" single crochet around entire neck of cap. Sew ribbon in place. Turn back 1¼" of garter st. for front of cap and tack in place.

### 621—CREEPER

(Size 2-3)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

5 1 oz. skeins Fingering Yarn (3-ply)

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 2

4 small pearl buttons

No. 1 or No. 2 crochet hook

1 st. holder

**GAUGE:**—8 sts. make 1 inch. 10 rows make 1 inch.

**PATTERN STITCH:**—Row 1—K3, P1 across row.

Row 2—K2, \*P1, K3 repeat from \* across row.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

**BACK:**—Starting at crotch with No. 1 needles, cast on 14 sts. Work in ribbing K2, P2 and increase 1 st. each end of needle for 10 rows. Cast on 2 sts. at the end of every row until 54 sts. are on the needle, then cast on 33 sts. at the end of the next 2 rows. (120 sts.) Work even in pattern until piece measures 9¼" from center of crotch. Change to No. 2 needles and decrease across row to 112 sts. K2, P2 for 1½". Change to No. 1 needles and work pattern to 2½" above ribbing.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—Bind off 6 sts. at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Change to K2, P2 and bind off 1 st. at the beginning of every row 4 times each side. Work even to armhole measures 4½" above cast off sts.

**SHOULDER AND NECK SHAPING:**—Bind off 9 sts. at the beginning of the next 6 rows and bind off remaining sts.

**FRONT:**—Work same as back until armhole measures 3" above cast off sts. on armhole shaping.

**NECK SHAPING:**—Work across 32 sts. bind off center 28 sts. loosely, work across 32 sts. Slip first 32 sts. on stitch-holder to be worked later. Working on other 32 sts. work 2 sts. together at neck edge every other row to 27 sts. left on shoulder, work to back shoulder and bind off from the outside edge 9 sts. 3 times. Slip other 32 sts. back on needle and work in same manner.

**SLEEVES:**—With No. 1 needles cast on 56 sts. K2, P2 for 2". Change to No. 2 needles and increase to 68 sts. Work in pattern until sleeve measures 7½" altogether. Bind off 3 sts. at the beginning of every row until 12 sts. are left and bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew side seams together. Sew right shoulder seam together. Sew left shoulder only ½" from armhole edge. With No. 1 needles and right side of work toward you, pick up 106 sts. around leg and K2, P2 for 6 rows. Bind off loosely. Work 1 row s.c. along crotch piece. With No. 1 needles and right side of work toward you pick up 72 sts. around neck. K2, P2 for 6 rows. Bind off. Crochet 4 buttonholes along left shoulder. Sew buttons in place. Sew sleeves seams together. Sew sleeves in place.

### 624—TWO-PIECE SNOW SUIT—CAP, BONNET AND MITTENS

(Size 3-4)

#### MATERIALS:

Rembrandt or Polar Yarns

5 3¾ oz. hanks Knitting Worsted (4-ply)

1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 1



1 pair knitting needles 10" No. 3  
 1 circular needle 29" No. 3  
 1 14" slide fastener for sweater  
 1 6" slide fastener for leggings  
 1 bone crochet hook No. 3 or 4  
 2 yds. 1" ribbon for binding straps  
 2 buttons  
 2 st. holders  
 1 yd. hatwire  
 GAUGE:—5 sts. make 1 inch. 7 rows make 1 inch.

### 624L LEGGINGS

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 1 needles, cast on 55 sts. for cuff of legging. K1, P1, on center 49 sts. working the first 3 sts. of every row in garter st. Work till piece measures 3½" straight up. Change to No. 3 needles and work in stockinette st. for 2½" (this is the side opening on outside of leg). Work in stockinette st., increasing 1 st. on each end of needle every inch till piece measures 13" from start or required length. Put sts. on a st. holder. Work another piece to correspond for other leg. Place both pieces on circular needles by slipping the sts. from st. holder and knitting the other sts. on to needle, making sure you have underseams facing each other. Mark the center front and center back with white thread. Work on circular needle making 2 center front decreases every inch 3 times. (To make decreases, knit the 2 sts. on each side of front marking together.) Then, every 1½", 3 times, then at the same time increase 2 sts. on center back every inch 7 times. Piece should measure 8" from crotch. Work in following manner:

Work K1, P1, including front 55 sts. on No. 1 needles for 1½". Bind off all but the 55 front sts. which are used for bib. Work on these sts., keeping 7 sts. on each end in garter st. and working the center 45 sts. in stockinette st. till piece is 3½" from top of legging. Now K1, P1 for 1". Bind off center 45 sts., leaving 7 sts. on each end to be worked for suspenders. Work till required length. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew inside legs seams together. Sew fasteners in place. Bind suspenders with ribbon and cut a buttonhole at end of each suspender. Sew around buttonhole so as not to tear. Sew buttons in place.

### 624M MITTENS

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 36 sts. and work in K1, P1, ribbing for 2". Change to stockinette st. and increase across next row to 40 sts. Work even for 1½". Work increase for thumb as follows: Work across first 19 sts. increasing 1 st. in each of next 2 sts. work across row. Purl back.

Next Row—Work across first 19 sts., increase 1 st. in next st., K2 sts., increase 1 st. in next st., knit last 19 sts. Purl back. Continue to increase every other row until there are 12 thumb sts. on right hand needle. Work these 12 sts. for ¾", on next row K1, K2 together across. Purl back, K2 together across and fasten off. Work 2¼" for hand. Decrease by knitting 2 together, K1 across row. Purl next row. K2 together across entire row. Break yarn and draw through all sts. Fasten and sew seams together.

### 624S SWEATER

**BACK:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 64 sts. K1, P1 for 2½". Change to No. 5 needles and work in stockinette st. until back measures 9 inches long altogether.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—With right side to you, work as follows:

Row 1—K1, slip 1, K1 pass slipped st. over K1, knit across to last 3 sts. K2 together K1.

Row 2—Purl across.

Repeat these 2 rows until 24 sts. are left on needle and bind off.

**LEFT FRONT:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 35 sts. and work as follows:—

Row 1—K1, P1 for 32 sts., K3.

Row 2—K3, \*K1, P1 repeat from \* across row.

Repeat these 2 rows for 2½". Change to No. 5 needles and work in stockinette st. continuing the 3 sts. at front edge all knit and continue until 9" long.

**ARMHOLE SHAPING:**—At armhole edge decrease as follows:

Row 1—K1, slip 1, K1 pass slipped st. over K1, Knit across row.

Row 2—K3, Purl across row.

Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 2" shorter than back.

**NECK SHAPING:**—At neck edge bind off 10 sts. at one time. K2 sts. together at neck edge every knit row and at the same time continue armhole shaping until all sts. are off needle.

**RIGHT FRONT:**—Work to correspond with left front reversing shape.

**SLEEVES:**—With No. 3 needles cast on 40 sts. K1, P1 for 2". Change to stockinette st. and No. 5 needles and increase 1 st. each end of needle every 6th row until 56 sts. on needle. Work even until sleeve measures 9" long. Now decrease the sleeve using the same directions as the back armhole shaping until all sts. are off the needle.

**COLLAR:**—With No. 3 needles, pick up 64 sts. around neck. Work stockinette st. keeping first 4 and last 4 sts. of each row in garter st. till piece measures 3" from start. Now work 8 rows in all garter st. Bind off.

**FINISHING:**—Sew seams together. Sew fastener in place.

### 624BC PEAK CAP

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 3 needles, cast on 72 sts. Work K1, P1 for 1". Work in stockinette st. for 4½" (5½" from start). Bind off 24 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, leaving 24 sts. on center of work. Work these center 24 sts. in K1, P1 for 5½". Bind off. Sew sides of hat to center back piece. Pick up sts. across neck line, skipping every 5th st. Work K1, P1, for 1". Bind off.

**PEAK:**—Pick up the center 36 sts. along front of hat. K1, P1 for 2". Bind off first 3 sts. at beginning of each row till 12 sts. remain. Bind off. Wire front peak by holding wire along edge of peak and working 1 row s.c. over wire.

### 624GC BONNET

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—With No. 3 needles, cast on 72 sts. Work K1, P1, for 1". Work in stockinette st. for 4½" (5½" from start). Bind off 24 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, leaving 24 sts. on center of work. Work these center 24 sts. in K1, P1, for 5½". Bind off. Sew sides of hat to center back piece. Pick up sts. across neck line, skipping every 5th st. Work K1, P1 for 1". Bind off.

**BRIM:**—Pick up 72 sts. across front of bonnet. Work in K1, P1, ribbing, binding off 3 sts. at beginning of every row till 36 sts. remain. Bind off. Wire front brim by working 1 row s.c. over wire. Sew ribbon to each side of hat.



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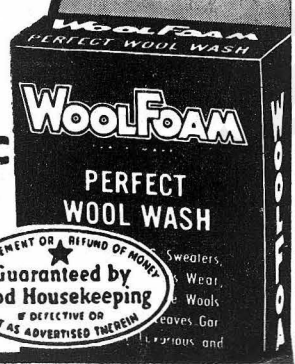
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
