Working Instructions.



ABBREVIATIONS.—Cb. chain, S.S. Slip Stitch, D.C. Double Crochet, Tr. Treble, Dbl. Tr. Double Treble, Trip. Tr. Triple Treble, Quad. Tr. Quadruple Treble, Quint. Tr. Quintruple Treble, St. Stitch



- 1st Row.** Commence with 20 ch., join with s.s.—s.s. round right—2 ch. and work 24 d.c. over the s.s, join with a s.s., 5 ch.
- 2nd Row.** Group 3 quad. tr. (keep one loop from each st. on hook until there are 4, then pull thread through all at once), 6 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 trip. tr. grouped, 8 ch., miss 2 d.c., 2 quad. tr., 1 quint. tr., 2 quad. tr. grouped, 8 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 trip. tr. grouped, 6 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 quad. tr. grouped, 5 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 tr. grouped, 5 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 dbl. tr. grouped, 5 ch., miss 2 d.c., 4 tr. grouped, 5 ch., join with s.s.
- 3rd Row.** 2 ch., 1 d.c into every st.
- 4th Row.** 4 ch., 2 dbl. tr. into same place, 1 dbl. tr. into every d.c., increasing at the 1st and 2nd corner with 5 dbl. tr. (3rd side), 7 tr., 4 d.c., 3 d.c. into same st., 4 d.c. 7 tr., 2 dbl. tr. in starting place of this row, 2 ch.
- 5th Row.** 1 d.c. into every st., increasing at the corners by 8 d.c.
- 6th Row.** To be worked same as Row 4.
- 7th Row.** 5 ch., 3 trip. tr. grouped, 6 ch., 5 trip. tr. grouped, 6 ch. Divide 1st and 2nd sides into 4 divisions and 3rd and 4th into 3. Work at each point 4 dbl. tr. grouped with 6 ch. between, at 2nd corner 4 quad. tr. grouped, 6 ch., 4 quad. tr. grouped, 6 ch., 4 quad. tr. grouped, 6 ch.—same as 1st side. At 3rd corner 4 trip. tr. grouped, 5 ch., 4 trip. tr. grouped, 5 ch., 4 trip. tr. grouped, 5 ch., 4 tr. grouped in 1st div., 5 ch., 4 trs. groupd in 2nd div., 5 ch. at 4th corner, 4 tr. grouped, 4 ch., 4 tr. grouped, 4 ch., 4 tr. grouped 5 ch. same as 3rd side. 4 trip. tr. grouped into 1st corner, 6 ch., join with a s.s., 4 ch.
- 8th Row.** 2 dbl. tr. into same st., 1 dbl. tr. into every st., increasing by 5 at each corner, 2 ch.

- 9th Row.** 1 d.c. into every dbl. tr., join with s.s., 4 ch.
- 10th Row.** *Miss 1 d.c., 1 tr. into next, 1 ch., repeat from * all round, working 1 tr. 1 ch. into 3 consecutive d.c at each corner—s.s., 84 chain.
- 11th Row.** Miss 21 ch., 1 trip. tr. in next, *8 ch., miss 8 ch., 1 trip. tr. in next, repeat from * 5 times. Divide 1st and 2nd side into 5 div., s.s. in to 1st div., 1 ch., turn, s.s back to the 8th ch. after the 1st trip. tr., 13 ch., turn. 1 trip. tr. in last trip. tr. and so on, always s.s into each div. at the end of the lines.

Heading. 4 ch., *miss 1 ch., 1 tr. into next, 1 ch., repeat from * along the top of bag. 9 ch., turn. Work groups of 3 dbl. tr. above each vertical line with 4 ch. between, thus forming the heading for the cord. Miss 1 ch., 1 tr. into next, 1 ch., repeat to the end of line. ** 1 dbl. tr. into every st., 4 ch., miss 1 ch., 1 tr., 4 ch. in next, 1 ch., repeat from ** to end of row. S.S. down the right side of satchel round to the 3rd corner. Join the two sides by s.s.

Cord. Make a ro of ch. 3/4 yard long, and work 3 rows of s.s on it. Run the cord through the heading before putting on the tassel

Tassel. Wind croceht round a piece of cardboard 2 inches wide 40 times, remove from card, twist thread round 2 or 3 times, tying it securely to the end of cord. To make the head tie a thread very tightly round the strands near to the joing of the cord. Cut the strands evenly and fray out each a litte at the ends. Knot the cord separately twice about 4 inches from tassel and then together 1 inch below. Line bag throughout with 1/2 yard of white ribbon silk.
