## Handkerchief edging No. 1

**Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET**

**2 balls White**

**1 1/4 inch handkerchief**

**Steel crochet hook No. 13**

Attach thread in corner space, and work a row of s c around entire handkerchief working 3 s c in each corner, join in 1st s c.

**2nd Row**—S c in next s c, ch 6, s c in same space, ch 6, s c in same space, \* ch 6, skip 1/4 inch space, s c in next st, repeat from \* 38 times (about 1/4 inch from next corner), ch 6, s c in corner st, ch 6, s c in same space, ch 6, s c in same space, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c.

**3rd Row**—Sl st to 2nd st of next loop, s c in same loop, ch 3, s c in same loop, ch 9, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, \* ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times \*\* ch 7, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, \* ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times, repeat from \*\* 5 times, ch 9, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from 1st \* twice, \* ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 7, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 5 times, \* ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 2, d c in 1st s c (this brings thread in position for next row).

**4th Row**—Ch 3, cluster st in next large loop (cluster st: 3 tr c in same space keeping last loop of each st on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time), \* ch 3, cluster st in same space, repeat from \* 3 times, \*\* ch 3, s c in next large loop, \* ch 6, s c in next large loop, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 3, 3 cluster sts with ch 5 between each

cluster st in next ch 7 loop, repeat from \*\* 5 times, ch 3, s c in next large loop, \* ch 6, s c in next large loop, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 3, 5 cluster sts with ch 5 between each cluster st in next corner loop, repeat from 1st \*\* twice, \* ch 3, s c in next large loop, ch 6, s c in next large loop, ch 6, s c in next large loop, ch 6, s c in next large loop, ch 3, 3 cluster sts with ch 5 between each cluster st in next ch 7 loop, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 3, s c in next large loop, \* ch 6, s c in next large loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, tr c in d c.

**5th Row**—Ch 3, s c over tr c, \*\* ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, \* ch 5, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from \* twice, \* ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 6, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, ch 5, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 6, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \*\* twice, ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, \* ch 5, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from \* twice, \* ch 4, skip 1 loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 6, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, ch 5, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 4, skip 1 large loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 6, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 2, d c in tr c.

**6th Row**—Ch 3, s c over d c, ch 7, skip 1 large loop, \* cluster st in next loop, ch 4, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, ch 6, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 6, repeat from \* twice, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, \* ch 7, skip 1 large loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next large loop, ch 3, cluster st in next large loop, ch 4 picot, ch 5, cluster st in same loop, ch 4 picot, ch 5, cluster st in same loop, ch 4 picot, ch 3, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next large loop, ch 7, skip 1 large loop, cluster st in next large loop, ch 4 picot, ch 7, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, ch 7, cluster st in next loop, ch 4 picot, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 7, skip 1 large loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next large loop, ch 3, cluster st in next large loop, ch 4 picot, ch 5, cluster st in same loop, ch 4 picot, ch 5, cluster st in same loop, ch 4 picot, ch 3, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next large loop, ch 7, skip 1 large loop, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, join in the d c, cut thread.

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## *Knot Stitch Handkerchief edging No. 4*

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET  
3 balls Tinted White, Yellows and Blues or any color  
desired  
11 1/4 inch handkerchief  
Steel crochet hook No. 13

Attach thread at corner and work 3 s c in same space, 1 s c in each hemstitched space on each side and 3 s c in each remaining corner, join in 1st s c.

**2nd Row**—Sl st into next st, ch 5, d c in same space, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, skip 1 s c, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in next s c, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, skip 3 s c (about 1/4 inch), 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c (shell) in next s c, repeat from \* across side working last shell in st before the 3 corner sts, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, shell in center st at corner, repeat from \* all around ending to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch.

**3rd Row**—Sl st into corner loop, \* draw up a 3/16 inch loop on hook, thread over hook and pull through loop forming a ch st, s c over single loop of st, repeat from \* once (double knot st made), s c in same space (corner), \* work a double knot st, s c in next shell, repeat from \* all around working all corners same as 1st corner.

**4th Row**—Sl st to center of double knot st at corner, \* work a double knot st, s c in center of next double knot st, repeat from \* all around.

## *Hairpin Lace Handkerchief edging No. 5*

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET  
2 balls each White and Chartreuse or colors desired.  
3/4 inch hairpin staple  
11 1/4 inch handkerchief  
Steel crochet hook No. 13

With White work a strip of hairpin lace same as below having 720 loops on each side of staple, tie lace together being sure not to twist lace.

**1st Row**—Attach Chartreuse in corner of handkerchief and work 3 s c in same space, 1 s c in each hemstitched space all around working 3 s c in each corner, join.

**2nd Row**—Sl st to next st, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 2 and keeping the twist in the loops, s c through 1st 10 loops of hairpin lace inserting hook through all loops at one time, \*\* ch 2, 2 d c in same space on handkerchief, \* ch 2, s c through next 5 loops of hairpin lace, ch 2, skip 1/4 inch space on handkerchief, 2 d c in next st, repeat from \* 33 times having last 2 d c in center st at corner (34 groups of 5 loops on side), ch 2, s c through next 10 loops of hairpin lace (corner), repeat from \*\* all around ending with the 34 groups of 5 loops on last side, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

**3rd Row**—Keeping the twist in the loops attach Chartreuse in 1st loop of corner group on opposite side of hairpin lace, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 8 times, \*\* ch 2,

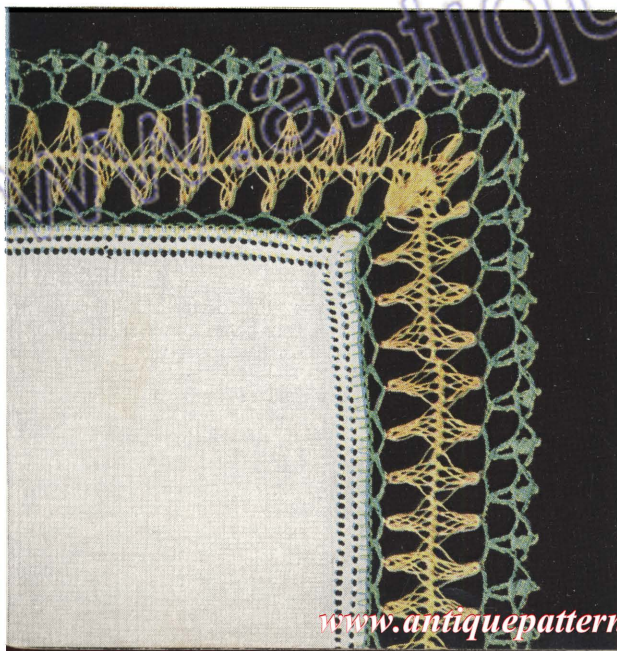
## *Hairpin Lace edging No. 6*

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET  
1 ball Yellow  
2 balls Nile Green or colors desired  
3/4 inch hairpin staple  
10 1/4 inch Yellow Handkerchief  
Steel crochet hook No. 13

**HAIRPIN LACE:** Make a loop at end of thread and place 1 prong of staple in loop just made, insert hook in loop, wind thread around right prong of staple, thread over hook and draw through loop keeping work at center, \* drop loop from hook, turn staple 1/2 turn to the left, pick up the dropped loop at center, thread over hook and pull through, insert hook through top part of loop on left hand prong, thread over and pull through (2 loops on hook), thread over and pull through both loops completing the single crochet, repeat from \* for desired length.

With Yellow work a length of hairpin lace having about 592 loops on each side of staple. For a larger handkerchief work more loops.

### Handkerchief edging No. 7

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET

1 ball each Nile Green and White or colors desired  
11 1/4 inch handkerchief  
Steel crochet hook No. 13

**MOTIF**—With Green ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c in ring, join in 1st s c, cut Green.

**2nd Round**—Attach White and pull loop up about 1/4 inch, leave on hook, s c in same space, pull loop up same length, leave on hook, \* s c in next s c, pull loop up 1/4 inch, leave on hook, s c in same space, pull loop up same length, remove loops from hook, pick up the last 2 loops made, repeat from \* 6 times, sl st in same space with 1st loops, cut thread.

**3rd Round**—Attach White in any loop, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join, cut thread.

**4th Round**—Attach Green in any loop, \* ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending with ch 2, d c in same space where thread was attached (this brings thread in position for next round).

**5th Round**—\* Ch 6, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 2, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, join in d c, cut thread.

### Handkerchief edging No. 9

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET

1 ball each White and Lavender or colors desired.  
3/4 inch hairpin staple  
11 1/4 inch handkerchief  
Steel crochet hook No. 13

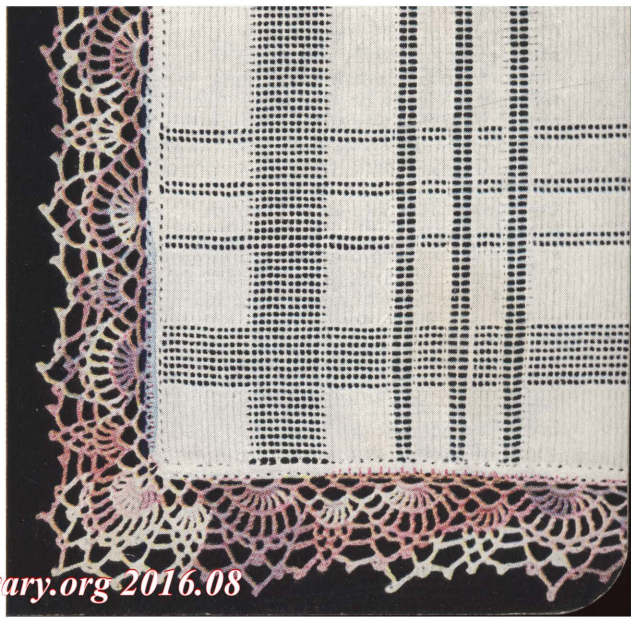
With White work a length of hairpin lace same as on page 4 having 720 loops on each side of staple.

With Lavender work 1st, 2nd and 3rd rows same as handkerchief edging No. 5 on page 4 but do not drop thread at end of 3rd row.

**Next Row**—Sl st into loop, s c in same space, ch 3, s c in same space, \* ch 2, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, s c in next loop, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, repeat from \* twice, ch 1, s c in same space (corner), \* ch 2, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 3 times, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 6 loops, s c in next loop, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, repeat from \* twice, ch 1, s c in same space, \* 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 10 loops, s c in next loop, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, repeat from \* twice, ch 1, s c in same space, repeat from \* 6 times, \* 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 7 loops, repeat from first \* all around ending to correspond, join, cut thread.

### Knot Stitch Handkerchief edging No. 4

**5th Row**—Ch 7, tr c in same space (corner), \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in center of next double knot st, repeat from \* all around working 1 tr c, ch 3, 1 tr c in s c over the center of double knot st of previous row at each corner. Repeat the 3rd, 4th and 5th rows once, then repeat the 3rd row once.

**10th Row**—Sl st to center of double knot st, work a double knot st, s c in same space, \* double knot st, s c in center of next double knot st, repeat from \* all around working all corners same as 1st corner.

**11th Row**—Sl st to center of double knot st, \* ch 6, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 3, sl st in same space, ch 3, sl st in same space (3 picot cluster), ch 3, s c in center of next double knot st, repeat from \* all around, cut thread.

### Hairpin Lace Handkerchief edging No. 5

continued from page 4

s c through next 10 loops of hairpin lace inserting hook through all loops at one time, \* ch 2, s c in next loop of hairpin lace, repeat from \* 9 times, repeat from \*\* 7 times, ch 2, s c through next 10 loops of hairpin lace, ch 2, s c in next loop, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, ch 2, join, drop Chartreuse.

With White work another strip of hairpin lace in same manner having 776 loops on each side of staple.

**4th Row**—Pick up Chartreuse and sl st in next loop, ch 4, s c through 1st loop of 2nd strip of hairpin lace, ch 1, d c in next loop of 3rd row, \* ch 1, s c in next loop of hairpin lace, ch 1, d c in next loop of 3rd row, repeat from \* twice, \*\* ch 3, s c through next 16 loops of hairpin lace inserting hook through all loops at one time, ch 3, d c in same space of 3rd row (corner), \* ch 1, s c in next loop of hairpin lace, ch 1, d c in next loop of 3rd row, repeat from \* 10 times, \*\* ch 2, 1 s c through next 10 loops of hairpin lace, ch 2, d c in same space of 3rd row, \* ch 1, s c in next loop of hairpin lace, ch 1, d c in next loop of 3rd row, repeat from \* 10 times, repeat from 1st \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch, cut Chartreuse.

**5th Row**—Working on opposite side of hairpin lace attach Chartreuse in 1st loop of the 16 loops at corner, s c in same space, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 14 times, \*\* ch 3, s c through next 11 loops inserting hook through all loops at one time, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 9 times, repeat from \*\* 7 times, ch 3, 1 s c through next 11 loops, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 15 times, repeat from first \*\* all around ending to correspond, ch 3, join in 1st s c.

**6th Row**—Sl st into next loop, ch 7, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, d c in next loop, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, d c in next loop, repeat from \* 12 times, \*\* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 1 d c in each of the next 2 loops keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, d c in next loop, repeat from \* 8 times, repeat from \*\* 7 times, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 1 d c in each of the next 2 loops keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, d c in next loop, repeat from \* 14 times, repeat from first \*\* all around ending to correspond, join, cut thread.

### Hairpin Lace edging No. 6

continued from page 4

Starting at corner of handkerchief with Green work a row of s c all around working 3 s c in each corner and 1 s c in each hemstitched space, join (multiple of 4 plus 1 s c including the 2 corner s c on each side).

**2nd Row**—Sl st into center st at corner, ch 3, and keeping the twist in the loops, s c through 1st 16 loops of hairpin lace inserting hook through all loops at one time, ch 3, s c in same space, \* ch 3, 1 s c through next 4 loops of hairpin lace, ch 3, skip 3 s c on handkerchief, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around working all corners same as 1st corner, join in 1st s c, cut thread, tie hairpin lace together.

**Next Row**—Working on opposite side of hairpin lace, attach Green through 1st 4 loops of the 16 loops at corner, s c in same space, \* ch 7, 1 s c through next 4 loops of hairpin lace, repeat from \* all around, ch 7, join.

**Next Row**—Sl st into center st of loop, ch 5, tr c in same space, \* ch 7, tr c in center st of next loop, ch 1, tr c in same space, repeat from \* twice, \* ch 5, 1 tr c, ch 1, 1 tr c (shell) in center st of next loop, repeat from \* all around working 7 chs between the 5 shells around each corner, ch 7, join in 4th st of ch.

**Next Row**—Sl st into the ch 1, ch 3, 2 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, \* ch 3, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, ch 4, sl st in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next ch 1 between the 2 tr c (cluster st: 3 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time), repeat from \* all around ending to correspond, ch 4, join, cut thread.

### Handkerchief edging No. 7

continued from page 5

Work a 2nd motif in same manner joining it to 1st motif in last round as follows: ch 4, slip loop off hook, insert in any picot of 1st motif, pull loop through, ch 1, sl st in 3rd st of the ch 4, ch 2, s c in next loop of 2nd motif, ch 4, join to next picot of 1st motif, ch 1, sl st in 3rd st of ch 4, ch 2, s c in next loop of 2nd motif and complete round same as 1st motif. Work a 3rd motif joining it to 2nd motif in same manner leaving 3 picots free on inside edge of 2nd motif and 9 picots free on outside edge.

Applique motifs to corner of handkerchief having 4 picots of each side motif extend over edge. Cut away extra material from underneath leaving about 1/8 inch to turn under.

**EDGE:** Attach White in hem next to motif to left of corner, \* ch 4, skip 1/8 inch space, s c in next space, repeat from \* to next corner, ch 4, s c in same space at corner, repeat from 1st \* all around to next motif at opposite side, cut thread.

**Next Row**—Attach Green in space before the space where White was joined, ch 6, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 1, s c in 1st loop, \* ch 5, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 1, s c in next loop, repeat from \* to loop before corner loop, ch 5, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 1, s c in corner loop, ch 5, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 1, s c in same loop, repeat from 1st \* all around to the loop before opposite motif ending in loop to correspond, ch 5, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, ch 2, sl st in space before the space where White ended, cut thread.

## Handkerchief edging No. 8

### Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET

2 balls Tinted White, Greens and Lavenders

11¼ inch handkerchief

Steel crochet hook No. 13

Attach thread in space before corner, s c in same space, \*\* work a double knot st (single knot st: \* draw up a 3/16 inch loop on hook, thread over hook and pull through loop forming a ch st, s c over single loop of st, repeat from \* once for double knot st), s c in corner space, ch 7, s c in same space, work a double knot st, s c in next space, ch 5, skip about ¾ inch space, s c in next space, \* work a double knot st, skip about ¾ inch space, s c in next space, ch 5, skip about ¾ inch space, s c in next space, repeat from \* to space before corner, repeat from \*\* all around ending with ch 2, d c in 1st s c (this brings thread in position for next row).

**2nd Row**—Ch 3, 1 d c, ch 3, 2 d c over d c, \* work a single knot st, s c in center s c of next double knot st, work a single knot st, 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c (shell) in next loop, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch.

**3rd Row**—Sl st to loop of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, work a double knot st, \* shell in next shell, work a double knot st, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch.

**4th Row**—Sl st to loop of shell, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 2 d c in same loop, \*\* work a single knot st, s c in center s c of next double knot st, work a single knot st, 2 d c in center of corner shell, \* ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 2 d c in same loop, repeat from \* once, \* work a single knot st, s c in center s c of next double knot st, work a single knot st, 2 d c in loop of next shell, ch 4, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 1, 2 d c in same loop, repeat from \* to shell before corner shell, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join, cut thread.

## Handkerchief edging No. 10

### Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET

2 balls Tinted Pink and Lavender

11¼ inch handkerchief

Steel crochet hook No. 13

Attach thread in corner and work a row of s c all around working 3 s c in each corner space, join in 1st s c.

**2nd Row**—S c in same space, ch 4, s c in corner s c, ch 4, s c in same space, ch 4, s c in next s c, \* ch 4, skip about ¼ inch space, s c in next s c, repeat from \* across row having last s c in s c before corner s c, ch 4, s c in corner s c, ch 3, s c in same space, ch 4, s c in next s c, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c (51 loops on each side including the 2 corner loops).

**3rd Row**—Sl st in next loop, s c in same space, ch 1, 9 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in next loop, \* ch 1, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 1, 7 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in next loop, repeat from \* 8 times, ch 1, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 1, 9 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in corner loop, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c.

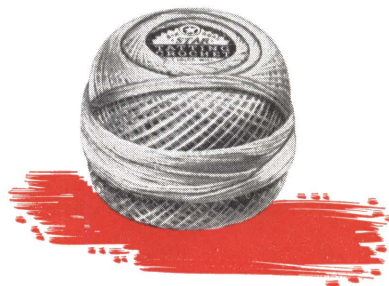
**4th Row**—Sl st in next tr c, ch 6, tr c in next tr c, \* ch 2, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* 6 times, ch 3, s c in next large loop, \*\* ch 1, 5 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in next loop, ch 1, s c in next loop, ch 1, tr c in next tr c, \* ch 2, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 1, s c in next large loop, repeat from \*\* 8 times, ch 1, 5 tr c with ch 1 between each tr c in next loop, ch 1, s c in next loop,

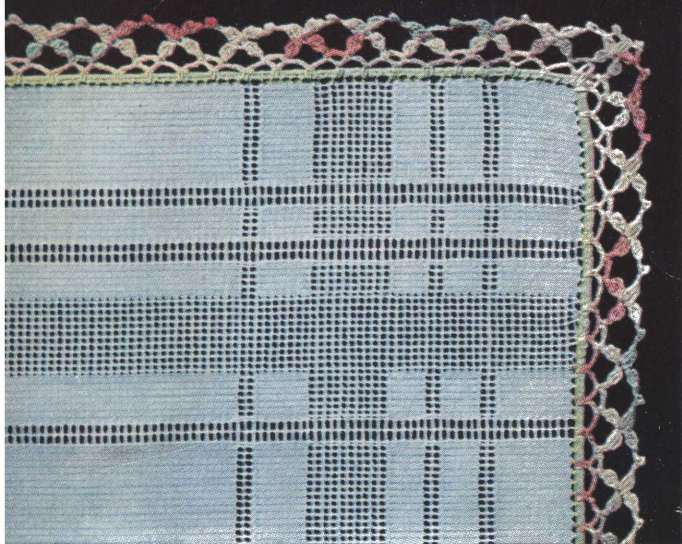
ch 3, tr c in next tr c, \* ch 2, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* 7 times, ch 3, s c in next large loop, repeat from \*\* all around ending to correspond, ch 3, join in 4th st of ch.

**5th Row**—Sl st into next loop, s c in same space, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 7 times, ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, \*\* ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, skip 2 loops, s c in next loop, repeat from \*\* 8 times, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 3, skip 2 loops, s c in next loop, repeat from \*\* 8 times, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 8 times, ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, repeat from 1st \*\* all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c.

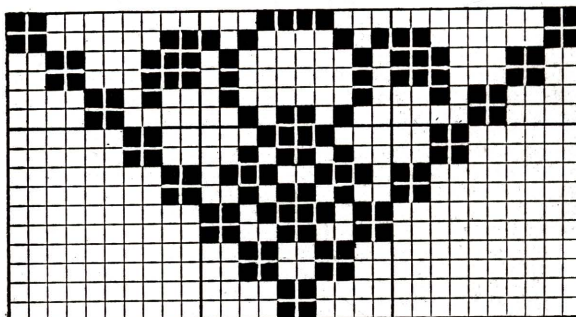

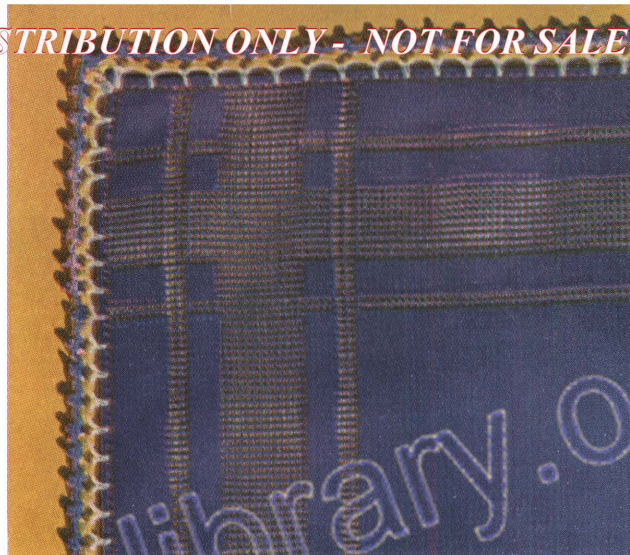

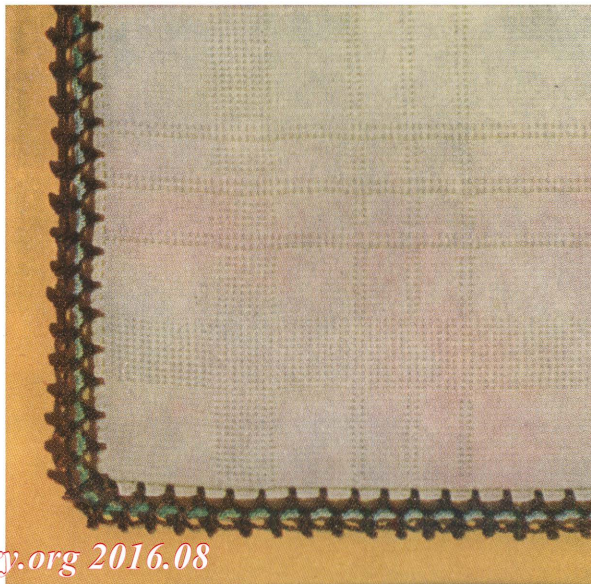

**3rd Row**—Attach Brown over any 2 loops of previous rows, ch 6, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, d c over same 2 loops, ch 4, \* d c over next 2 loops of previous rows, ch 4, sl st in top of d c for picot, d c over same 2 loops, ch 4, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch at beginning, cut thread.





## Handkerchief edging No. 22

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET**

**1 ball Aqua or color desired.**

**1 1/4 inch handkerchief**

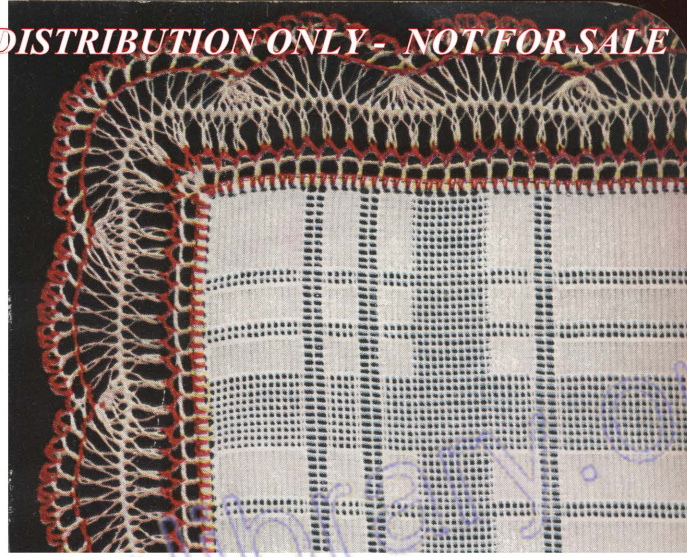
**Steel crochet hook No. 13**

Attach thread at corner and work 3 s c in same space, work 1 s c in each hemstitched space on each side and 3 s c in each corner having a multiple of 10 sts plus 5 on each side not counting center st at each corner, join.

**2nd Row**—Ch 6, s c in next s c, ch 6, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, \* ch 6, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, ch 6, skip 2 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from \* across side ending last s c in 1st s c at corner, repeat from beginning all around.

**3rd Row**—\* 3 s c in next loop, ch 7, 3 s c in next loop, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from \* all around.

**4th Row**—Sl st into loop at corner, ch 3, 2 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, ch 3, sl st in top of cluster st just made for picot, \* ch 5, cluster st in same space (cluster st: 3 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time), ch 3, sl st in top of last cluster st for picot, repeat from \* once, ch 6, skip 4 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, ch 3, sl st in top of s c just made for picot, s c in next s c, \* ch 6, cluster st in next loop, picot, ch 4, cluster st in same loop, picot, ch 6, skip 4 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, picot, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around working all corners same as 1st corner, ch 6, join, cut thread.



## Hairpin Lace Handkerchief edging No. 24

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" TATTING CROCHET**

**2 balls White**

**1 ball Bright Red or any contrasting color**

**3/4 inch hairpin staple**

**1 1/4 inch handkerchief**

**Steel crochet hook No. 13**

With White work a length of hairpin lace same as on page 4 having a length long enough to fit loosely around entire handkerchief.

With Red work a row of s c around handkerchief, working 3 s c in each corner and 133 s c on each side not counting the 3 s c at each corner, join, cut Red.

**2nd Row**—Attach White in center st at corner, ch 6, d c in same space, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 3, d c in same space, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, repeat from \* all around working 4 d c with ch 3 between each d c in center st at each corner and having a multiple of 8 meshes plus 4 on each side not counting corners, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

**3rd Row**—Attach Red in 1st d c to left hand side of the 4 d c at corner, ch 2, s c through 1st 2 loops of hairpin lace keeping the twist in the loops, ch 2, s c in next d c, \* ch 2, s c through next 2 loops of hairpin lace, ch 2, s c in next d c, repeat from \* to 1st d c at corner, \* ch 2, s c through next 4 loops of hairpin lace, ch 2, s c in next d c, repeat from \* twice, repeat from 1st \* all around, join, cut thread.

**3 balls Tinted White, Pinks and Greens**

**1 shuttle**

**8 inch square of handkerchief linen.**

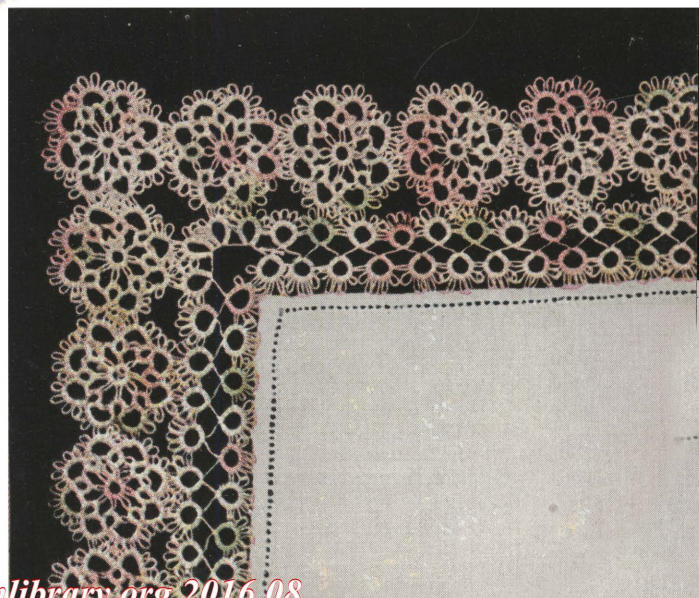

Ch, 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, turn. \* R, 3 ds, join to last p of last r, 3 ds, join to next p of center, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, turn. Repeat from \* 6 times, joining last p of last r to 1st p of 1st r, tie and cut.

**2nd Motif**—Work center same as 1st motif.

**1st Row**—R, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to any picot of center, 3 ds,

**4th Row**—Working on opposite side of hairpin lace, attach Red in 1st loop of the 12 loops of corner always keeping the twist in the loops, \* ch 3, s c through next loop of hairpin lace, repeat from \* 10 times, \*\* ch 3, s c through next 8 loops of hairpin lace inserting hook through all 8 loops at one time, \* ch 3, s c through next loop, repeat from \* 7 times, repeat from \*\* across each side having 1 s c in each of the 12 loops around each corner with ch 3 between each s c, join, cut thread.

**5th Row**—Attach White in s c over the 2nd loop of corner scallop, ch 7, d c in next s c, \* ch 4, d c in next s c, repeat from \* twice, ch 4, d c in next loop (center of corner), \* ch 4, d c in next s c, repeat from \* 4 times, \*\* ch 4, thread over hook, insert in next s c, pull through and work off 2 loops, thread over hook, insert in 1st s c of next scallop, pull through and work off 2 loops, thread over and work off all loops at one time (2 d c cluster), \* ch 4, d c in next s c, repeat from \* twice, ch 4, d c in next loop, \* ch 4, d c in next s c, repeat from \* twice, repeat from \*\* to next to last s c of scallop before corner scallop, ch 4, work a 2 d c cluster same as at base of previous scallops, ch 4, d c in next s c of corner scallop, ch 4, d c in next s c, then repeat from first \* all around ending row to correspond and joining last ch 4 in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

**6th Row**—Attach Red in 1st d c of corner scallop after the 2 d c cluster, ch 6, s c in next loop, \* ch 3, d c in next d c, ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 9 times, \*\* ch 3, skip the 2 d c cluster, s c in next loop, \* ch 3, d c in next d c, ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 6 times, repeat from \*\* all around working all corners same as 1st corner, ending to correspond, join, cut thread.

### Round Tatted Motif Handkerchief edging No. 23

p, 3 d, cl r, turn. Ch, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of ch of 1st motif, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, turn. R, 3 ds, join to last p of last r, 3 ds, join to next p of center, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of next ch of 1st motif, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, turn. Finish motif same as 1st motif. Work 8 more motifs joining in same manner leaving 2 chs free at top and lower edge between joinings.

Last motif is corner motif. There are 10 motifs across each side counting corner motifs.

Work next motif in same manner but join to corner motif leaving 4 chs free on outside edge of motif. Work other 3 sides in same manner joining last motif to 1st motif.

Using shuttle only, R, 5 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p at inside edge of 2nd free ch to left hand side of corner motif, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of next ch of same motif, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r. R, 5 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of 1st free ch of motif to right hand side from corner, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of next free ch of same motif, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 2nd p of 1st r, 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. \* R, 5 ds, join to last p of opposite r, 2 ds, 6 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of opposite r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of next free ch of next motif, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of opposite r, 2 ds, 6 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of opposite r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to center p of next free ch of same motif, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. R, 5 ds, join to last p of opposite r, 2 ds, 6 p sep by

2 ds, 5 ds, cl r, turn. ¼ inch space. Repeat from \* all around, working all corners same as 1st corner, tie and cut. Cut linen about ¼ inch larger on each side than opening.

**To Hemstitch**—Draw 3 threads from linen ¾ inch from edge. Baste a very narrow hem to the edge of drawn threads. Attach "STAR" Mercerized Sewing Thread in hem to left of work, \* pick up about 4 or 5 threads from right to left and draw threads together, take a stitch straight down into the hem to the right of group picked up, repeat from \* all around. Sew edging to linen as illustrated.

**MOTIF:** Using shuttle only R, 5 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 5 ds, cl r. \* R, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 3 ds, 4 p sep by 3 ds, 5 ds, cl r. Repeat from \* twice joining last p of last r to 1st p of 1st r, tie and cut.

**2nd MOTIF:** R, 5 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to corresponding p of side of 1st motif, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl r. R, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 3 ds, join to 1st free p on side of next r of 1st motif, 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 5 ds, cl r. \* R, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 3 ds, 4 p sep by 3 ds, 5 ds, cl r. Repeat from \* once but joining last p to 1st p of 1st r, tie and cut. Work 2 more motifs joining in same manner joining 3rd motif to 2nd motif and 4th motif to 3rd and 1st motifs.

**1st Round**—Using shuttle and ball, \* R, 6 ds, join to 1st p to right of corner p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 5 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn. R, 6 ds, join to last p of last r, 6 ds, skip 1 p of same r, join to next p, 6 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn. R, 6 ds, p, 3 ds, skip 1 p of next r, join to next p, 1 d, join to next p of next r, 3 ds, p, 6 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn. Repeat from \* 3 times, tie and cut. This completes one large motif. Work a 2nd large motif in same manner joining center p of 2 center chs on side to center p of 2 center chs of 1st motif and joining 6th p of corner ch to 6th p of corner ch of 1st motif and 2nd p of next corner ch to 2nd p of next corner ch of 1st motif. Work a 3rd large motif joining in same manner to side of 2nd motif. Sew to one corner of handkerchief as illustrated.

Cut out extra material from underneath motifs leaving about ¼ inch to turn under.

**EDGE:** R, 4 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 4 ds, cl r. \* R, 4 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 4 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn. R, 4 ds, p, 3 ds, join to center p of last r, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl r. Repeat from \* until edge is long enough to reach around handkerchief to the motif inset. Sew in position on handkerchief as illustrated.

## *Handkerchief with Tatted edging No. 25*

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET**

**2 balls White or color desired**

**1 Shuttle**

**11¼ inch handkerchief**

Using shuttle and ball, R, 4 ds, 3 p sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl r, turn. \* Ch, 7 ds, p, 7 ds, turn. R, 7 ds, join to last p of last r, 6 ds, p, 1 d, cl r. R, 1 d, join to last p of last r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 1 d, cl r. R, 1 d, join to last p of last r, 6 ds, p, 7 ds, cl r, turn. Ch, 7 ds, p, 7 ds, turn. R, 4 ds, join to last p of last r, 4 ds, 2 p sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl r, turn. Repeat from \* until edging is long enough to go around entire handkerchief.

Sew around handkerchief as illustrated.
