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EXPLICIT INSTRUCTIONS



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No. 1—BABY SET—Bonnet, Jacket And Socks — "Hit Parade" (SIZE—1 TO 4 MONTHS)

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—6-balls Blue or Pink and 1-ball White. Size 2 Knitting Needles. Crochet hook size 5. 3-yds. White ribbon.

BONNET—In color, cast on 2 sts on each of 3 needle (6 sts in all). K 1 row. **ROW 3**—(K 2, K st in back of 2d st) repeated around. K 1 row. Repeat Row 3. K 2 rows. Repeat Row 3. K 3 rows. Repeat Row 3. K 5 rows (to measure 1½" from center). For larger size repeat Row 3 and K 4 rows. **ROW 18**—K 2, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) repeated across, ending with Y O, K 2. K 3 rows. Repeat these 4 rows once. Bind off 25 sts and repeat Row 18 across remaining sts, ending with K 2. P back. K across, P back. Repeat these last 4 rows until front measures about 3" from solid circle. Bind off loosely. **CROCHETED EDGE**—Join color to a front corner, ch 3, dc in same corner, ch 2, a 2-dc-Cluster in same corner, ch 2, a 2-dc Cluster in next 2d st) repeated around, widening at other corner, and spacing Clusters farther apart around neck. Ch 2, sl st in 1st dc. **ROW 2**—(Sc, ch 3, sc) in next 2-ch. (ch 3, sc in next sp) around, widening at 2d corner. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join White to 1st loop before corner loop, * (ch 2, dc) 3 times in next loop, ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across front. Make 3-ch loops around neck edge. **ROW 4**—* Sc in 1st 2-ch sp on next shell, (ch 3, sc in next 2-ch sp) 3 times. Repeat from * to corner, make 3-ch loops around neck. Fasten off. Press on inside. Sew ribbon ties to each corner with loop bows.

JACKET—2 long needles size 2 or circular needle. **YOKE**—In color, cast on 68 sts. P across. **ROW 3**—K 8, (Y O, K 1, Y O, K 16) 3 times, Y O K 1, Y O, K 8. **ROW 4**—P across. (Each even no. row is purled). From here inc. 1 st before (Y O, K 1, Y O) in each uneven no. row, until there are 20 sts before corner widening on 1st side, 40 sts between corners on next 3 sides, and 20 sts on last side. P back for alternate rows. (Yoke 3" deep). **Arm Hole**—K 21, take off on st holder 44 sts, cast on 20 sts for underarm, K 42 sts, take off next 44 sts on st holder, cast on 20 sts,

K 21. P back. **ROW 3**—K 2, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) repeated across, ending with Y O, K 2. P back. K across and P back. These 4 rows make pattern. Repeat until jacket measures 10" from neck. Bind off. **SLEEVE**—Use 4 needles. Put sts from st holder on needles, and pick up 20 sts that were cast on under arm. (64 sts on 3 needles). * Repeat Row 3. K around 3 times. Repeat from * until sleeve measures 7" from neck. Bind off loosely. Repeat for other sleeve. **EDGE**—Repeat Bonnet Edge around sleeves, neck, fronts and bottom edge, except make only 3-ch loops in Rows 3 and 4 around neck. Press on back. Tie with ribbon at neck.

SOCKS—Four No. 2 needles. In color, cast on 35 sts on 3 needles. K around twice. **ROW 3**—K 2, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) repeated, ending with Y O, K 2. K around 3 times. Repeat these last 4 pattern rows until piece measures 2" (5 rows of design). For back of heel, (K 11 sts and P back) 5 times to measure 1". K 1, K 2 tog, K 2, K 2 tog, K 1, K 2 tog, K 1 (8 sts on needle). Pick up 7 sts on side of heel, K 3, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) 4 times ending with Y O, K 3 instead of K 2. Pick up 7 sts on other side of heel, K 4 to center of heel. K 1 row. K 9, K 2 tog, K 23, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 9. K 1 row, K 8, K 2 tog, K 23, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 8, K 12 (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) 4 times, ending with Y O, K 12. K 7, K 2 tog, K 23, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 7. K 1 row. K 6, K 2 tog, K 23, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 6, K 10, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) 4 times, ending with Y O, K 10. K 5, K 2 tog, K 23, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 5. K 2 rows (35 sts in each). K 8, (Y O, sl st, K 2 tog, P. S. S. O., Y O, K 2) 4 times, ending with Y O, K 8. K 3 rows. Repeat these last 4 rows 4 times until foot measures 3" from back of heel. **KITCHENER TOE**—Have 19 sts on 1 needle across top of sock, 8 sts on each of other 2 needles. **ROW 1**—Starting at bottom of sole (1st needle), K 5, K 2 tog, K 1. On 2d needle, K 1, sl st, K 1, P. S. S. O., K 13, K 2 tog, K 1 (17 sts on needle). On 3d needle, K 1, K 2 tog, K 5. K 1 row. Repeat Row 1, using K 4 on 1st needle,

K 11 on 2d, and K 4 on 3d (instead of K 5 on 1st, K 13 on 2d and K 5 on 3d). K 1 row. Continue similarly until there are 4 sts on 1st needle, 7 on 2d and 4 on 3d. Put 2 groups of 4 sts onto 1 needle. **TO BIND OFF**—Break thread, leaving about 12". Thread to a darning needle. Holding sock so thread is to your right, run thread towards the back thru 1st st, and then toward the front thru the 2d st. Slip off 1st st. Now from the back needle, run thread towards the front thru 1st st and away from you thru 2d st. Slip off 1st st. Repeat from front to back until all sts are off the knitting needles. Fasten off end. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 of Bonnet Edge around top, then in White make 2 rows of 3-ch loops. Fasten off and press.

No. 2—BABY SET—Bonnet And Mitts — "Baby Talk"

(Size 3 to 6 Months)

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5—2-balls White or Ivory and a partial ball Blue or Pink, 1 pair Bone Knitting Needle size 3. Crochet hook size 5. 2 yards ribbon.
BONNET—Back—Beginning at back of neck, in White or Ivory, cast on 28 sts. K 1 row and P 1 row for 8 rows. ** Row 9—K 2 tog, * Y O, K 2 tog. Repeat from *, ending with K 2 tog. K next 4 rows, P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row, K 4 rows. Repeat from ** thru P Row 40. **FRONT**—Cast on 28 sts. **ROW 41**—K across last row and cast on 28 sts at end. P 1 row. **ROW 43**—Repeat Row 9. Continue pattern rows until there are 3 across top of Bonnet. On last K row add 18 sts at even intervals, making 102 sts across

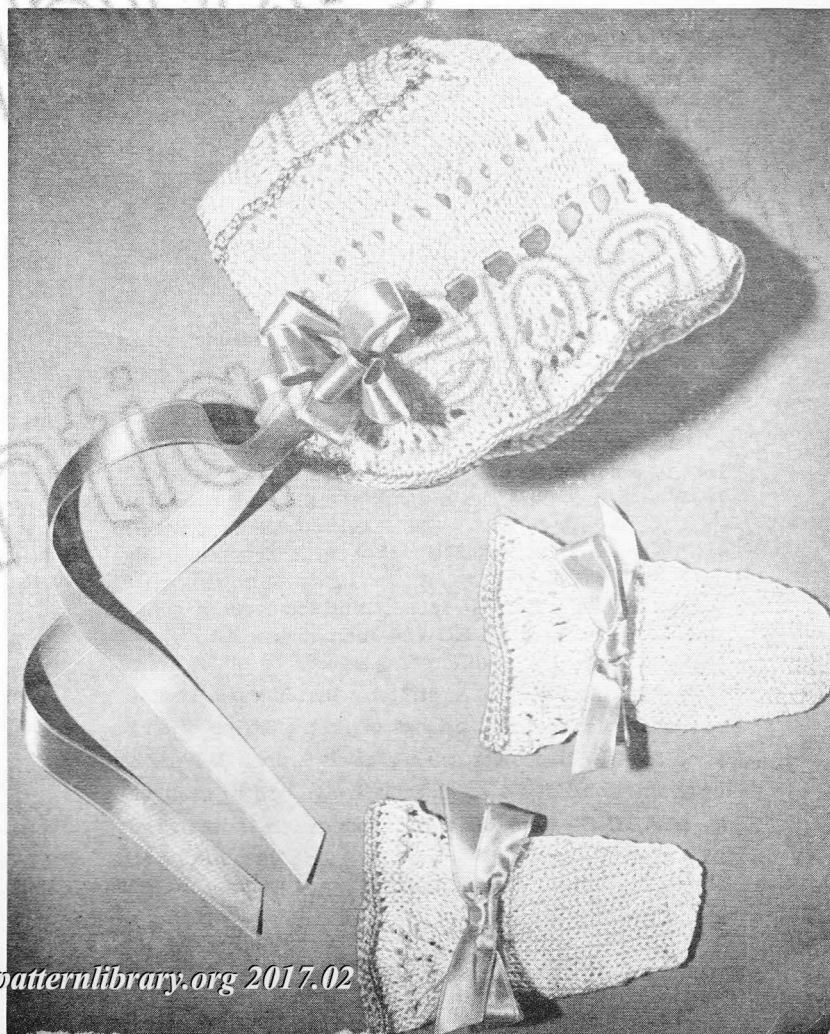
front. **BRIM**—P across. **ROW 2**—(K 2 tog.) 3 times, * (Y O, K 1) 5 times, Y O, (K 2 tog.) 6 times. Repeat from * across, ending with (K 2 tog.) 3 times. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. Repeat from Row 2. **ROW 10**—Bind off. Working on right side, crochet Front and Back together with a row of sc around sides and top of Back in color. **EDGE**—Join color to corner of Brim and work sc around bonnet. Across neck edge, sk every other st to gather it to fit. Run ribbon thru last pattern row on Front, leaving 12" ends. Make rosettes and sew in place on corners.

MITTS—Cast on 23 sts. (K 1 row, P 1 row) twice. **ROW 5**—Inc. 1 st in 1st st, K 10 sts, inc. in next st, K 10 sts, inc. in last st. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. **ROW 9**—Inc. in 1st st, K 12, inc. in next st, K 11 sts, inc. in last st. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. **ROW 13**—K across, inc. in 1st and last sts and in center of row. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. Repeat Row 13. P 1 row. **ROW 19**—K across, inc. in 1st and last sts. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. **ROW 23**—Repeat Row 19. P 1 row, K 4 rows. **ROW 29**—K 1, * Y O, K 2 tog. Repeat from * across, ending with Y O, K 1. P 1 row, K 2 rows. **ROW 33**—Inc. in 1st st, K 4, inc. in next st and in every 3d st across, ending with K 4, inc. in last st (51 sts across). P 1 row. **ROW 35**—(K 2 tog.) 3 times, * (Y O, K 1) 5 times, Y O, (K 2 tog.) 6 times. Repeat from * ending with (Y O, K 1) 5 times, Y O, (K 2 tog.) 3 times. P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. Repeat these last 4 rows and bind off. Fold and sew together across narrow end and up side. Work sc in color around cuff. Run ribbon in beading row around wrist and tie.



No. 2 Baby Set Bonnet and Mitts "Baby Talk"

An exquisite cap and mitten set for the tiny babe. Especially fetching for a little girl. A gift the young mother will appreciate.



No. 3—Child's Dress and Bonnet— "Dress-Up Stuff"

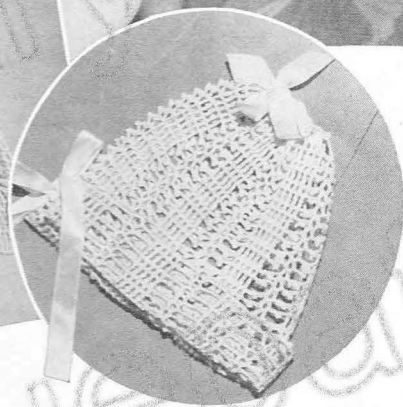
(Size 3 to 5 Years)

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5—14-balls Salmon Rose (or other color). Crochet hook size 5. 3½-yds. ribbon ¾" size. 9-buttons ⅝" size.

Ch 267 for waistline, (add or subtract sts in units of 18 for larger or smaller sizes). Tr in 9th st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) 3 times, * ch 5, sc in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next 5th st, ch 5, p, ch 1, tr in next 5th st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) 4 times. Repeat from * to end of ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 4, turn, dc in next tr, (ch 1, dc in next tr) 3 times, * ch 5, p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next 3-ch shell, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc in next tr, (ch 1, dc in next tr) 4 times. Repeat from * across. **ROW 3**—Ch 6, turn, tr

in next dc, (ch 1, tr in next dc) 3 times, * ch 5, p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next shell, ch 5, p, ch 1, tr in next dc, (ch 1, tr in next dc) 4 times. Repeat from * across. Repeat Row 2. Continue to alternate tr and dc rows in the lattice stripes, as in Rows 3 and 2. In the p-strips, increase the p-loops to ch 5, p, ch 2 in the next 4 rows; inc. to ch 6, p, ch 2 in next 4 rows; then 4 rows of ch 6, p, ch 3; 3 rows of ch 7, p, ch 3 loops; 3 rows of ch 7, p, ch 4 loops; **NEXT ROW**—Ch 6,

p, ch 3, dc in shell, (ch 2, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) in same shell, ch 6, p, ch 3; **NEXT 2 ROWS**—Ch 6, p, ch 3, dc dc in 1st sp of shell, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next sp, ch 3, dc in next, ch 6, p, ch 3. Make the p-loops in bal. of rows the same, but in 1st and last sps of enter shell:—Inc. to 4-ch for 2 rows; inc. to 5-ch for 2 rows. **NEXT ROW**—Ch 6, p, ch 3, dc in next sp, (ch 3, dc) 4 times in next sp, ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 6, p, ch 3. **NEXT 3 ROWS**—Ch 6, p, ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 3, dc in next, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, dc) in center sp, (ch 3, dc in next sp) twice, ch 6, p, ch 3. **NEXT 2 ROWS**—Inc. 1st and 5th loops of center shell to 4-chs. **NEXT 2 ROWS**—Inc. 1st and 5th loops of shell to 5-chs. For a different size, add or omit several rows, allowing for 1" to 2" stretch when blocked. In final row, make 1st and last p-loops of each p-stripe of ch 6, p, ch 3, with 5 loops across shell of ch 5, p, ch 2. Work sc up front to waist,—4 sc in each tr-sp, 3 sc in each dc-sp. **BEADING**—Ch 8, dtr above next tr, (ch 1, dtr in next 2d st) 3 times, * (ch 4, dtr in next 5th st) twice, (ch 1, dtr in next 2d st) 4 times. Repeat



from * across. Work sc down to bottom corner. Fasten off. Join to corner of beading, ch 6, tr in next dtr, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 3 times, * ch 4, p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dtr, ch 4, p, ch 1, tr in next dtr, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 4 times. * Repeat from * to * twice. (Tr in next dtr) twice, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 4 times. Repeat from * to * 6 times. (Tr in next dtr) twice, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 4 times. Repeat from * to * 3 times. **LEFT FRONT**—Ch 4, turn, dc in next tr, (ch 1, dc in next tr) 3 times, * ch 4, p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next shell, ch 4, p, ch 1, dc in next tr, (ch 1, dc in next tr) 4 times. Repeat from * twice. Continue to alternate tr and dc rows in lattice stripes. Make 1 more row of ch 4, p, ch 1 p-loops in all 3 p-strips. Then keep the 2 p-strips next front an even width, with (ch 4, p, ch 1) loops, but widen p-stripe on sleeve side with 2 rows of ch 5, p, ch 1 loops; 2 rows of ch 5, p, ch 2 loops; 2 rows ch 6, p, ch 2 loops; 2 rows ch 6, p, ch 3 loops; 2 rows ch 7, p, ch 3 loops; and 5 rows ch 7, p, ch 4 loops. Add or omit several rows for a different size. **FINAL ROW**—Across wide p-stripe, make ch 7, (dc, ch 3, dc) in shell, ch 7. In other 2 p-strips, make ch 2, (dc,

ch 3, dc) in shell, ch 2. Repeat for Right Front. **BACK**—Join, ch 4, dc in next tr and work across back as in ROW 1 of Fronts. Continue as for Fronts thru Row 15, widening the 1st and 6th p-stripes (on sleeves) **ROW 16**—In 2 center p-stripes, make ch 2, (dc, ch 3, dc) in shell, ch 2. **ROW 17**—Work across thru 2d p-stripe, tr in 1st dc of next lattice stripe, (ch 1, tr in next dc) twice, dtr in next 2 dc. **ROW 18**—Ch 2, turn, sl st in next 3d tr, ch 6, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next shell, ch 2, dc in next tr, and complete as in Final Row of Fronts. Fasten off. Repeat last 2 rows on other shoulder. Work sc around neck and fronts to waist. **SLEEVE EDGE**—Join at shoulder, (ch 5, p, ch 2, sc in next row) repeated around sleeves. Stretch and pin skirt right-side-down in a curve. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Remove and pin fronts and back out to full width in a reverse curve. Steam and press. Sew shoulders together from sleeve across to center of 2d p-stripe. Run ribbon thru wide p-stripe 4 rows below shoulder on front and back, and tie in bow on shoulder. Turn back neck corners, press and tack. Run ribbon thru waist beading and tie in front. Lap front Lattice Stripes, sew buttons on under stripe and button thru top stripe.

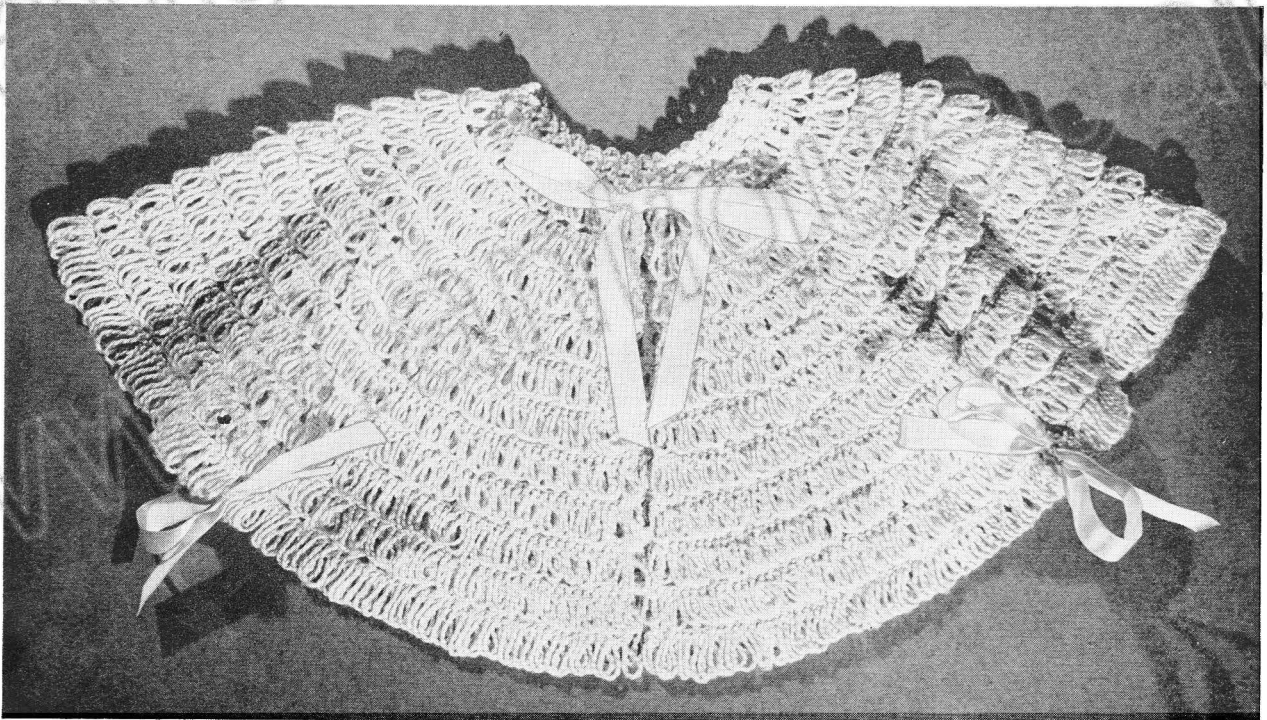
DUTCH BONNET—Ch 101, dtr in 11th st, (ch 1, dtr in next 2d st) 3 times, * (ch 3, dtr in next 3d st) twice, (ch 1, dtr in next 2d st) 4 times. Repeat from * 5 times. **ROW 2**—Ch 6, turn, tr in next dtr, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 3 times, * ch 4, sc in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dtr, ch 4, p, ch 1, tr in next dtr, (ch 1, tr in next dtr) 4 times. Repeat from * across. **ROW 3**—Repeat Row 2 of Dress. Continue, alternating tr and dc rows in Lattice Stripes. Make p-loops in p-stripes the same in next row. Then widen p-stripes:—2 rows of ch 5, p, ch 2 loops; 2 rows ch 6, p, ch 2 loops; and 18 rows ch 6, p, ch 3 loops. **ROW 27**—Make (dc, ch 5, p, ch 2, dc) in center shell of each p-stripe. Repeat "Sleeve Edge" on both ends of Bonnet. Across back, make (ch 3, sc in next sp) repeated. Fasten off. Stretch and pin down, wet with hot starch and press thru a cloth. When dry, run ribbon thru Row 1, gather and tie. Turn front edge back 2". Sew a ribbon tie to each front corner.

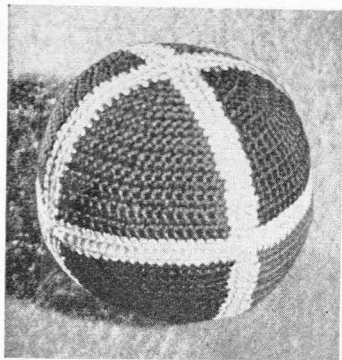
No. 4—Baby Nap-Sacque— "Pleasant Dreams"

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3: 8-balls Lt. Pink or Blue. Crochet hook size 1. 2-yds. ribbon. Size—4 months to 1 year.

Make a ch 1-yd. and 20" long. Sk last st, a short loop st (see instructions) in each remaining st. **ROW 2**—Ch 6, turn, sk last 2 sc, tr in next, * (ch 1, tr in next 2d sc) 4 times, ch 1, tr in next 3d sc. Repeat from * across. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, turn, a lp st in last tr, a lp st in 1 loop of next 1-ch, lp st in next tr) repeated across. 2 lp sts in end 6-ch. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 three times. **ROW 10**—Like Row 2 to *. * (Ch 1, tr in next 2d sc) 3 times, ch 1, tr in next 3d sc. Repeat from * across. Repeat Rows 3, 10 and 3. **ROW 14**—Like Row 2 to *. * (Ch 1, tr in next 2d sc) twice, ch 1, tr in next 3d sc. Repeat from * across. Repeat Rows 3, 14 and 3. **ROW 18**—Like Row 2 to *. (Ch 1, tr in next 2d sc, ch 1, tr in next 3d sc) repeated across. Repeat Row 3. **ROW 20**—Like Row 2 to *. (Ch 1, tr in next 3d sc) across. Repeat Row 3. **ROW 22**—Ch 4, turn, sk last 2 sc, dc in next sc, (ch 1, dc in next 2d sc, ch 1, dc in next 3d sc) across. Fasten off. Join to other end of last row, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp) across. Fasten off. Stretch and pin right-side-down in a true circle. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Run 1-yd. ribbon thru Row 22 and tie. Tie 18" ribbon thru front and back 6" below each shoulder point.

An irresistible "best" Nap-Sacque. For the very young baby it would be sweet made in either white, pink, or blue.



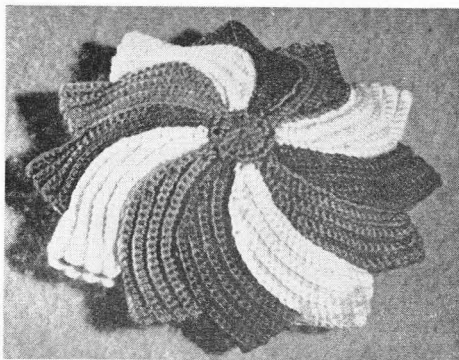


NO. 5—BALL

No. 5—Ball

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3:—1-ball each Scarlet and Royal Blue; ½-ball White. Crochet hook size 3.

SECTION—In Scarlet, ch 21, 20 sc on ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, sk last sc, sc in each remaining st. Repeat once. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across, but decrease 1 st in center by working 2 sc off together into 1 st. Make 2 rows even. Repeat Row 2 twice; Row 4; 1 row even; Row 2 twice; Rows 4 and 2. **ROW 15**—Repeat Row 2, except dec. 1 st in center, too. Repeat Rows 2, 15 and 2. Ch 1, turn, sk last sc, sc in next 2 sc worked off together, sc in next sc. Ch 1, turn, sk last sc, sc in next. Fasten off. Make 4 each in Red and Blue. Make White sc around each,—3 sc in each side corner, 5 sc in top corner. Sew sides of 4 together, alternating colors, matching corners exactly. Repeat for other half. Sew halves together, leave a small opening, stuff hard with rag strips and close opening.



NO. 6—BEAN BAG

No. 6—Bean Bag

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton size 3:—1-ball each White and Royal Blue, 1½-balls Scarlet. Crochet hook size 3.

CENTER—In Scarlet, ch 4 with 1st st twice usual size. 15 dc in long st, sl st in 3-ch. Ch 1, sc in same st, (1 sc in next dc, 2 sc in next) repeated around, sl st in 1-ch. Fasten off. In Scarlet, ch 17, sl st in 1 sc on center. Ch 1, turn, 22 sc over ch, 1 sc in end st. * (Ch 1, turn and in back loops, sc in last 22 sc) twice. (Ch 1, turn, sc in last 19 sc) twice. (Ch 1, turn, sc in 16 sc) 3 times. (1 hdc and 1 sc down in 1st sc on next rib, sc in next 2 sc) twice, hdc down in next rib, sl st in next sc on Center. Cut 2" long. Turn, sl st in White in next sc on Center. Working over Scarlet end into last row, (sc in 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 5 times, 1 sc in ext, 2 sc in next. Repeat from * around center. (12 Sections). Make 3d Section Blue, then repeat Red, White and Blue 3 times. Sew 1st and last together. Make a 2d piece. Steam and press on back, sew together, fastening end of one section with 2 dress snaps, thru which fill with beans. Remove beans for laundering.

Children up to six years love balls and beanbags—and these are so easy to make with Lily's Mercerized Pearl Cotton. The ball is stuffed with rag strips, and the bean bag is made so that the beans can be removed for laundering the bag. Make and keep several each of these for those unexpected gifts you need.

No. 7—Sunsuit—"Sun-Day Best"

(Size 2 to 3 Years)

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton size 5:—2-balls each White and Scarlet (or other colors). ½-yd. cloth. 12"-elastic ¼" wide. Crochet hook size 5. Make shorts first. **BIB**—In Red, ch 13" long, a 3-tr-Cluster in 6th st, (ch 3, a 4-tr-Cluster in next 4th st) repeated to fit front. Fasten off. Cut off bal. of ch. **ROW 2**—Turn, join White to last 3-ch sp, ch 6, a 3-tr-Cluster in same sp, (ch 3, a 4-tr-Cluster in next sp) repeated across. Fasten off. Use the right side of this row as right side of bib. Repeat Row 2 alternately in Red and White thru Row 11, each row one Cluster shorter. **EDGE**—Turn, in White, (2 sc, ch 3, sl st in last sc for a p, 2 sc) in each 3ch sp on top and bottom edges. **STRAPS**—In Red, ch 14" long and work as Row 1 for desired length. Repeat Edge in White on both sides. Make 2. **TRIMMING BANDS**—In Red, ch 10" long and work as for Straps to fit length of side seams. Make 2. **FLOWER**—In White, (ch 6, a 3-tr-Cluster in 6th st from hook, a 3-ch p, ch 6, sl st at base of Cluster) 4 times, sl st in 1st st. Fasten off. Make 12. Stretch and pin crochet right-side-down to fit. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Sew bib to front. Tack straps to top corners, cross and button to back. Sew trimming bands on side seams. Sew 6 flowers on each leg at top of hem.



No. 8—Crocheted Flower Picture

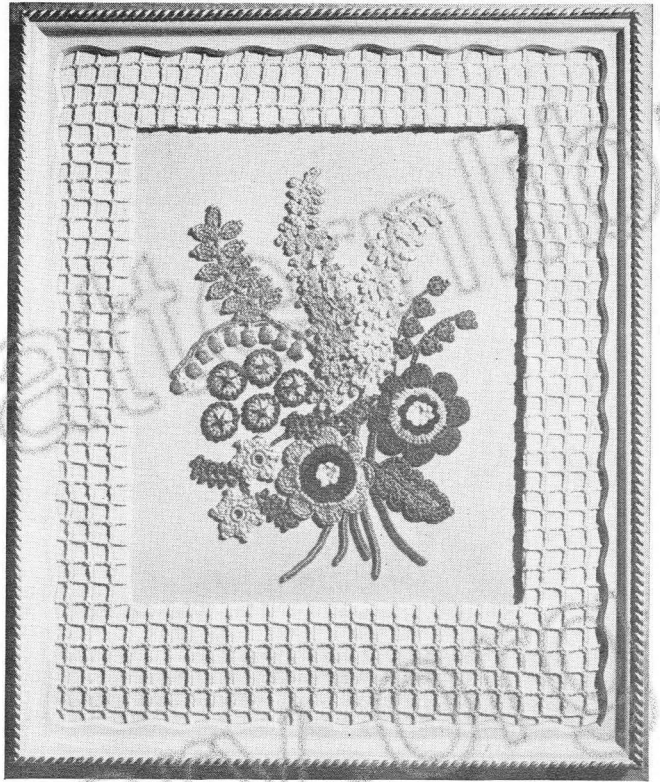
MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—2-balls Lt. Ecu, and a partial ball each Blue, Lt. Steel Blue, Salmon Rose and Mid Apple Green. Lily Six Strand Floss:—2-skeins each Maroon and Dk. Green, 1-skein each Dp. Peach, Black, Med. Green, Dusty Rose and Dk. Salmon Rose (or other colors). ½-yd. Oyster White linen. ½-yd. Lt. Green muslin. A picture frame 13"x16" glass size. Crochet hook size 5.

MAT—Cut cardboard for a loose fit in frame. Cut out center 3" from bottom, 2" from other 3 sides. Cut linen 1" outside edges, pull taut and fasten on back with gummed tape, slashing inside corners. In Lt. Ecu, make ch 2" longer than bottom width, tr in 15th st from hook, (ch 4, tr in next 5th st) repeated across for width (stretched). Cut off excess ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 9, turn, tr in next tr, (ch 4, tr in next tr) across to 5th st of end ch. Repeat 4 times to cover bottom. Then work up each side (4 sps wide). Connect top corners with a ch (5 ch for each sp, minus 1 st), and work 4 rows across top. Fasten off. Stretch and pin down in exact size. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Tack to edges of Mat. **1ST PEONY**—In 6 strands Black Floss, ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, 16 sc in ring. In back loops, sl st in 1st sc, (ch 1, 2 dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next) 8 times. Fasten off. Turn, in remaining loops of Row 1, join Dp. Peach, ch 4, 2 tr in same st, (2 tr in next st, 3 tr in next) around (40 sts). Fasten off. Join Maroon in both loops, (hdc and dc in next st, 2 tr in next, 3 tr in next, dc and hdc in next, sc in next) 8 times. Fasten off. **CENTER**—In Salmon Rose, ch 7, sl st in 1st st, (ch 6, sl st in same st) 7 times. Sew on center. **2ND PEONY**—Repeat Rows 1 and 2, make Row 3 in Maroon and Row 4 in Dk. Salmon Rose. Repeat Center. **1ST LARKSPUR**—In Salmon Rose, * ch 10, sl st in 4th st from hook, ch 2, sl st in next 2d st, (ch 6, sl st in 4th st from hook, ch 2, sl st in next 2d st) 4 times, sk these 5 petals, sl st in next ch st. Repeat from * 10 times. **TIP END**—(Ch 8, sl st in 4th st, ch 2, sl st in next 2d st) 4 times, sl st in next 2 sts, (ch 6, sl st in 4th st, ch 2, sl st in next 2d st, sl st in 2 sts between next 2 petals) 3 times. Fasten off. **2ND LARKSPUR**—Make 1st 7 flowers in Lt. Steel Blue. Join Blue and make 4 flowers and Tip End.

LILY—In Dp. Peach, ch 5, an 18-loop Clones Knot (see instructions) over ch, sl st in 1st st, (ch 8, a Knot over ch, sl st in 4th st from previous Knot) 8 times, ch 20. Fasten off. Join Mid Apple Green in last st, sc closely over ch, (sc at top of Knot, 5 sc between Knots) repeated to end. Fasten off. **LEAF**—In Apple Green, (ch 11, a 2-tr-Cluster in 6th st from hook, ch 3, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 5, sl st at base of Cluster, sl st in next st) 6 times, ch 8, a leaf in 6th st, sl st in next 2 sts, (ch 7, a leaf in 6th st, sl st in next st, sl st in 4 sts between leaves) repeated to end. Sew end to center-top of Lily.

PHLOX—In Dusty Rose, ch 4, with 1st st twice usual size, 14 dc in long st, join and fasten off. Join Maroon, (ch 2, sl st in next st) around. Fasten off. In Maroon, make 5 sts from center out to edge and a French Knot in center. Make 5 flowers.

BLUE FLOWER—In Lt. Steel Blue, ch 7, sl st in 1st st, ch 1, 12 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off. Join Blue, * ch 2, (dc, ch 3, sl st in 3d st from hook for a p, dc) in next sc, ch 2, sc in next sc. Repeat from * 5 times. Fasten off. Make a Peach French Knot on each petal, with a st down to center ring. Make 2 flowers. **LEAVES**—In Dk. Green, ch 6, * sl st in 4th st from hook for a p, (ch 5, p) 6 times, dc between 3d and 4th ps from hook, (ch 4, p, dc between next 2 ps) 3 times, ch 4, p, ch 1, sk next p, sl st in next 2d st, * ch 6. Repeat from * to *. Fasten off. **2d SPRAY**—Ch 25 and repeat from * to *, ch 12 and repeat from * to *. Fasten off. **SMALL LEAVES**—In Dk. Green, ch 12, (2 dc, a 3-ch p in last dc, 2 dc, ch 2 and sl st) all in 4th st from hook, sl st in next st, (ch 10, another leaf in 4th st from hook) 3 times. Fasten off. Make a 2d spray with 3 leaves.

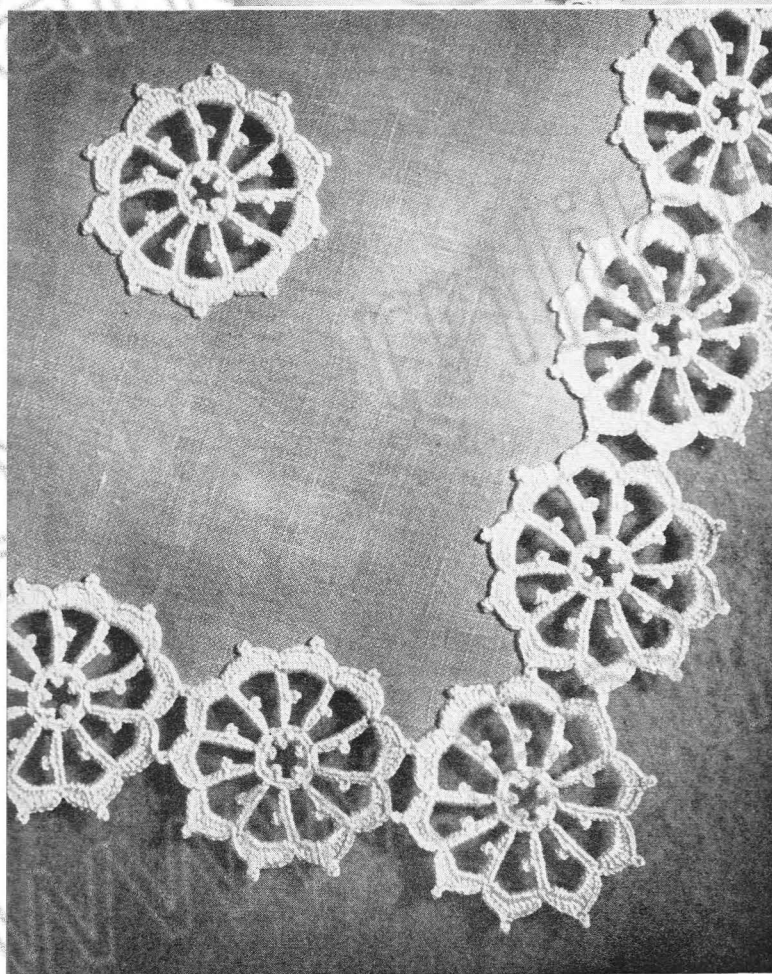
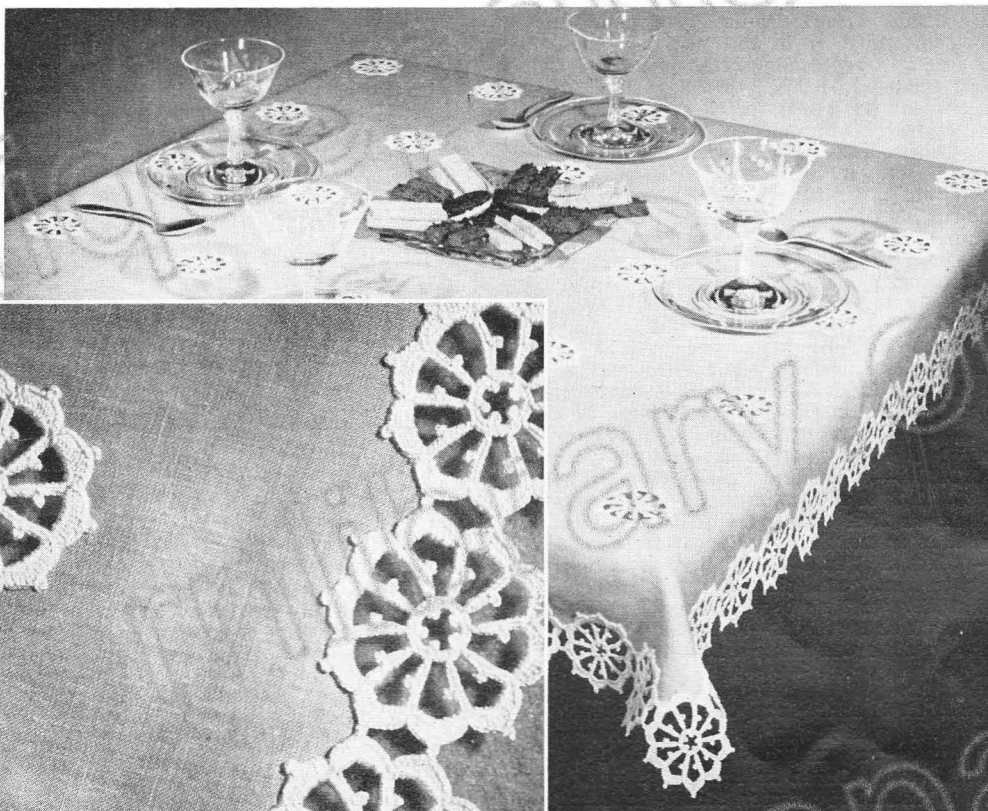
LARGE LEAF—In Med. Green, ch 15, sc in 2d st, * (hdc in next, 2 dc in next, hdc in next, sc in next) 3 times, * (hdc, 3 dc and hdc) in end st, sc in next on other side of ch. Repeat from * to *. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Join Dk. Green in same end st, ch 3 and in back loops, dc in next st, (2 dc in next, 1 dc in next) twice, hdc in sc between scallops, * (dc in next st, 2 dc in next, dc in 2 sts, hdc in sc) twice, * dc in next st, 2 dc in next, (2 dc, 3-ch p, 2 dc) in next st, 2 dc in next, 1 dc in next, hdc in sc. Repeat from * to *. 1 dc in next st, (2 dc in next) 3 times, 1 dc in next, sl st in 3-ch, ch 10, 9 sc on ch. Fasten off. **STEMS**—Starting at left. **1ST STEM**—In Apple Green, ch 25, cover ch with sc. **2D STEM**—In Med. Green, start with 20-ch. **3D STEM**—In Dk. Green, start with 17-ch. **4TH STEM**—In Med. Green, start with 44-ch. (Connect this up to Salmon Rose Larkspur). **5TH STEM**—In Dk. Green, start with 35-ch. Cut Green muslin 1" larger all around than mat opening. Pin motifs on muslin, following illustration, then tack lightly. Twist larkspur sprays so flowers are on alternate sides of ch stem. When finished, stretch and pin right-side-down, and steam and press dry thru a cloth. Fasten with gummed tape on a 2d piece of cardboard cut ¼" smaller than outside of frame. Place glass and mat in frame, then tack 2d cardboard on back of frame, with very short nails or tacks.

No. 9—Card Table Cover— "Hospitality"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—14-balls White. 1-sq. yd. colored linen. Crochet hook size 10.

FLOWER—(Ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p) 5 times, remove hook, insert it in 1st st, catch loop and pull thru (a ring with ps on inside). Ch 1, sc at base of last p, (5 sc between ps, sc at base of next p) repeated around (30 sc). Sl st in 1st sc and cut 3" long. Ch 8 and with ring wrong-side-up, make a sl st in same st with last sl st, ch 1, turn, and working over 3" end, 4 sc on

8-ch, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, 4 sc on 8-ch, 1 sc in end st. * Ch 15, turn, sl st in next 3d sc on ring, ch 1, turn, (4 sc, p, 5 sc) on half of 15-ch. Repeat from * 8 times. Ch 7, turn, sl st in end of 1st bar. Turn, ** ch 1, (5 dc, p, 5 dc) in next sp, ch 1, sl st in end of next bar. Repeat from ** around. Fasten off. **MOTIF**—Repeat thru 8 scallops of final row. Omit ps on final 2 scallops, join with a sl st to 2 points on 1st motif. Make and join motifs to go around edge of linen. Pin in place. Whip edge to linen. On back, cut linen $\frac{1}{4}$ " from stitching, turn edge back next crochet and hem down on back of dc-row. Make 25 separate motifs. Arrange in 5 rows each way, cut out linen underneath and finish in same way. Stretch and pin right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



No. 11—Table Doily Set— "Old Colony"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—7-balls Cream and 4-balls Delft Blue (or other colors) for each Place Mat size 12" x 16"; 5-balls Cream and 3-balls Blue for Centerpiece size 12" square. Crochet hook size 10.

PLACE MAT—In Blue, ch 186, sk 4 sts, and working over Cream, 182 dc on ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, turn, sk last dc, dc in next 8 dc, pull up Cream taut and thru final 2 loops of last dc, working over Blue, make 6 Cream dc, pull up Blue taut thru last dc and make 21 dc. Continue, following chart with (12 Cream dc, 21 Blue dc) 4 times, 6 Cream dc and 9 Blue dc. Use the right side of this row as right side of doily. At end of rows always carry thread around on wrong side. Follow chart thru Row 31, repeat Rows 10 thru 31 twice, reverse chart and

No. 10 Doily Set — Place Mat And Glass Doily

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—3½-balls White and 1-Glass Doily. Colored linen. Crochet hook size 10.

PLACE MAT—Large Leaf—Center—Ch 4, with 1st twice usual size, dc in long st, ch 2, tr in same st, (ch 2, dtr) 8 times in same st, (ch 2, tr, ch 2, dc, ch 3, sl st in same st, 3 sc in next 3-ch, (1 sc and 4 hdc in next sp) 11 times, 3 sc in next, sl st in 1st sc, ch 30, sk 2 sts, (dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next) 7 times, dc to end, join and fasten off.

CENTER PETAL—Ch 12, dc in 6th st from hook, (ch 6, dc in 6th st from hook) 17 times, ch 8, sl st in 8th st from hook, (sc under bar of next dc, ch 4, sl st at base of same dc) 18 times, sl st in next 6 sts.

ROW 2—Ch 7, turn, sc in next loop, ch 4, hdc in next, (ch 4, dc in next) twice, (ch 4, tr in next) twice, (ch 4, dtr in next) 10 times, * (ch 4, tr in next) twice, ch 4, (tr, ch 7, tr) in end loop, (ch 4, tr in next) twice, * (ch 4, dtr in next) 10 times, (ch 4, tr in next) twice, (ch 4, dc in next) twice, ch 4, hdc in next, ch 4, sc in next, ch 7, sl st in end. **ROW 3—Ch 1**, turn, 8 sc in 7-ch, (1 sc and 5 hdc in next sp) across to end, (1 sc, 4 hdc, ch 5, sl st in last hdc for a p, 4 hdc and 1 sc) in end sp, (5 hdc and 1 sc in next sp) across to end, 7 sc in end 7-ch, join, fasten off and tack under center scallop of "Center". Make 2 more petals.

with 1st Row 2 loops shorter, and with 2 less dtr on each side. Tack to "Center" on each side of 1st petal.

(Make 2 petals with 1st Row 2 loops shorter than last petals and with 2 less dtr on each side) twice. **NO. 5—**

PETALS—Make Row 1 with 7 loops on each side. Ch 7, turn, sc in next loop, ch 4, dc in next, ch 4, tr in next, (ch 4, dtr in next) twice. Repeat from * to * in 1st Petal. (Ch 4, dtr in next) twice, ch 4, tr in next, ch 4, dc in next, ch 4, sc in next, ch 7, sl st in end and complete.

Make 2. Sew all to "Center", then sew petals together ½ to 2/3's of length. **SEPARATE LEAVES—Make 9 petals No. 4 size** (12 loops on each side of Row 1) putting 8 hdc instead of sc in 1st and last 7-ch sps on edge-row. Cut



linen about 13"x18". Pin leaves in place, following illustration, bending around corners. Whip edges to linen. On back, cut linen ¼" from stitching, turn back next crochet and hem down on back of edge-row.

GLASS DOILY—Center—Ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 7, tr in ring, ch 2, tr in ring) 10 times, ch 2, sl st in 5th ch st. Ch 1, (4 hdc and 1 sc in next sp) 12 times. Fasten off.

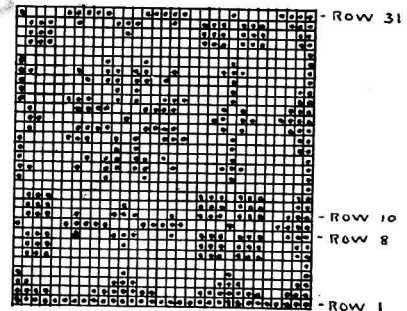
PETAL—Repeat 1st Row of Leaf Petals with 2 loops on each side. Ch 7, turn, dc in next loop, (ch 4, tr) twice in next loop, ch 4, (tr, ch 7, tr) in end loop, (ch 4, tr) twice in next loop, ch 4, dc in next, ch 7, sl st in end. Complete as for "Separate Leaves". Make 6. Tack together and under edge of "Center". Stretch doilies right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



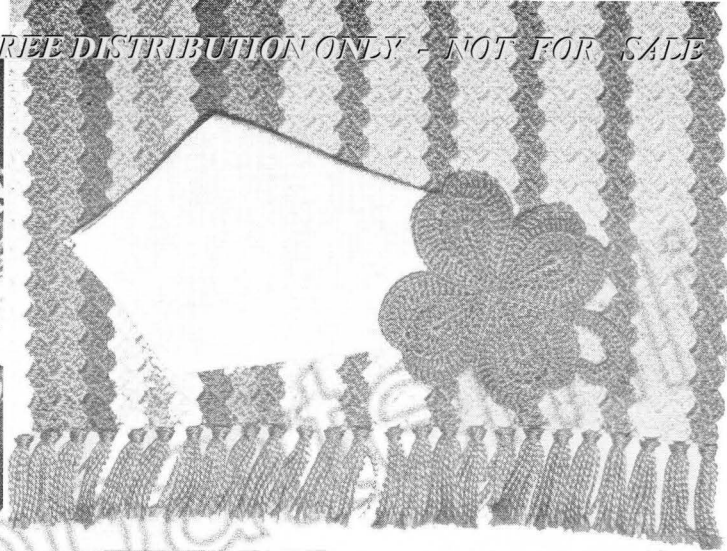

No. 12—"Brunch" Doily In Shell Stitch

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—3-balls each Ecu and Mid Apple Green, ½-ball each Golden Brown, Red and Yellow, and ¼-ball Blue (or other colors) for each doily. Crochet hook size 5.
 In Green, ch 209, a 2-dc-Cluster in 6th st from hook, a 2-dc-Cluster in next st, sc in next 4th st, * ch 3, (a 2-dc-Cluster in next st) twice, sc in next 4th st. Repeat from * to end (34 shells). **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, two 2dc-Clusters in last sc, sc in 3-ch of next shell, * ch 3, two 2-dc-Clusters in same 3-ch, sc in 3-ch of next shell. Repeat from * to end. Fasten off. Join Ecu to last sc and repeat Row 2 four times. Fasten off. Then 2 rows each in Green, Brown, Red, Yellow, Blue, Yellow, Red, Brown and Green. Next make (4 rows Ecu, 2 rows Green) 5 times. **FRINGE**—Wind Green around a 2" card. Cut at one edge. Tie 6 strands in each 5-ch loop on ends. Trim evenly. **POCKET**—In Green, ch 9 with 1st st twice usual size, sk 1 st, (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc and 1 tr) on ch, 11 tr in end st, (1 tr, 2 dc, 2 hdc and 2 sc) on other side of ch. Ch 1, turn, sc in 2 sts, hdc in 2 sts, dc in 2 sts, (2 tr in next st) 5 times, (2 tr, 2 dc and 1 hdc) in next st, 1 sc in next, (1 hdc, 2 dc and 2 tr) in next st, (2 tr in next) 5 times, dc in 2 sts, hdc in 2 sts, sc in 2 sts, hdc in 1st sc on other side. Fasten off. Make 4 and tack together into a square. **STEM**—Ch 22, sk 2 sts, (hdc in 2 sts, 2 hdc in next) 6 times, sc in 2 sts. Fasten off and tack ends to leaf. Tack leaf on lower left corner of doily for pocket for napkin. Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

No. 13—Breakfast Table Cloth

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—22-balls White, 2-balls Lt. Green, and 1-ball each Beauty Rose, Blue and Yellow (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5. Size—36" square.

In White, make a 36" chain, sc in 2d st, (ch 6, sk next 5 sts, sc in next 2 sts) for 34" stretched, ending with only 1 sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, sc in next 6-ch loop, (ch 2, dc in next 2 sc, ch 2, sc in next loop) across, ending with only 1 dc. **ROW 3**—Ch 6, turn, insert hook under 6-ch loop in Row 1 and make sc over sc in last row, (ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc over next sc) across, ending with only 1 dc. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, turn, sc in dc, (ch 5, sc in next 2 dc) across, ending with only 1 sc. **ROW 5**—Ch 1, turn, sc in sc, (ch 6, sc in next 2 sc) across, ending with only 1 sc. Repeat Rows 2, 3, 4 and 5 until work is square, ending with Row 4. Fasten off. Stretch until pattern is opened out and pin down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. **BRAID**—In Lt. Green, make a ch 6" longer than around cloth, sc in 2d sc, a loop st (see instructions) in each st. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Turn, join Beauty Rose, (ch 1, hdc in next 2d st) to end. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join Blue to last hdc, turn, (ch 1, hdc in next sp) to end. Fasten off. Repeat in Yellow. Sew on edge of cloth and press on back. Make a napkin in each color in braid.

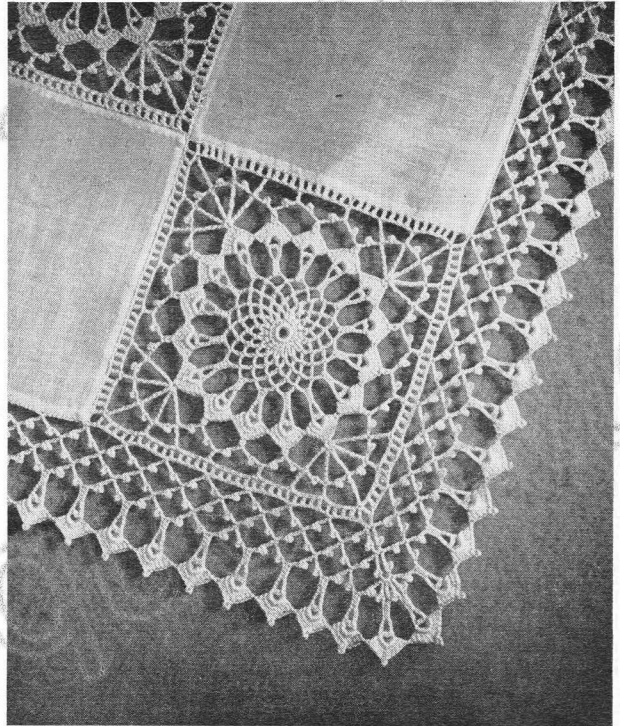
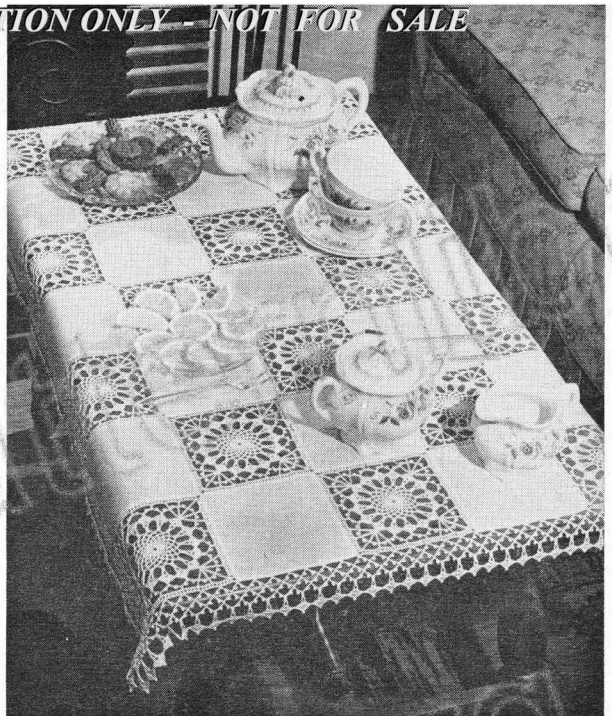


No. 14—Tea-Time Cloth

Whisk out your crochet hook and begin on this lovely Tea-Time Cloth immediately. It is one of the nicest designs we've offered, and we're sure you'll love it. It can be made to fit any size table, of course.

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—14-balls White. Crochet hook size 10. ½-yd. White handkerchief linen.

BLOCK—Wind 10 times around ends of 2 crochet hooks, slip off, 16 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—(Ch 5, sc in next sc) 15 times, ch 2, hdc in next sc. **ROW 3**—(Ch 4, sc in next loop) 15 times, ch 2, hdc in next hdc. Repeat once with 5-ch loops. **ROW 5**—(Ch 6, sc in next loop) 15 times, ch 3, dc in next hdc. **ROW 6**—(Ch 17, dc in 8th st from hook, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in 4 sts, ch 2, sc in next loop) 16 times. Fasten off. **ROW 7**—Join to end of 1 loop, ch 3, 4 dc in same loop, ch 4, sl st in last dc for a p, 5 dc in same loop, (5 dc, a p, 5 dc) in each loop around. Sl st to 1st p. **ROW 8**—* (Ch 7, sc in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 9, p, ch 3, sc in next p) twice, (ch 6, p, ch 2, dtr) 5 times in next p, ch 6, p, ch 2, sc in next p. Repeat from * 3 times. Fasten off. **ROW 9**—Join to next p-loop, ch 3 for a dc, * ch 9, dc in next loop, ch 7, tr in next dtr, ch 7, dc in next, ch 9, dtr in next, ch 9, dc in next, ch 7, tr in next, ch 7, dc in next p-loop. Repeat from * around. Join to 1st 3-ch. **ROW 10**—Ch 4, dc in next 2d st. (ch 1, dc in next 2d st) around, with ch 1. (dc, ch 5, dc) in corner dtr. Join to 1st 3-ch. Fasten off. As illustrated, cloth requires 18 lace blocks and 17 linen blocks. For a larger cloth, make and join blocks for desired size. Cut a true cardboard square ½" larger than Block. Mark around card on tissue paper. Stretch and pin Blocks right-side-down on patterns. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Cut and hem linen squares to fit. Whip lace and linen blocks together alternately into desired shape. Around edge, connect Blocks with ch 69 and sew to linen. **EDGE**—Join to one corner, * ch 7, p, ch 9, p, ch 3, sc



in next 4th sp, (ch 7, p, ch 9, p, ch 3, sc in next 5th sp) 5 times, a p-loop, sc in Block corner, (a p-loop, sc in next 10th ch st) 7 times to corner of next Block. Repeat from * around, with an extra p-loop at each corner. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Join to a corner loop, (a p-loop, sc in next loop) around, with an extra p-loop at each corner. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join to one corner, * ch 7, p, ch 16, dc in 8th st from hook, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next 4 sts, ch 6, p, ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, with 2 extra loops at each corner. Fasten off. **ROW 4**—Join to one loop, ch 3, (4 dc, a 4-ch p and 5 dc) in same loop, * ch 1, (5 dc, a p and 5 dc) in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and fasten off. Stretch and pin right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



No. 15—Small "Circles"— "Party Frills"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—2-balls White for 3 doilies. Crochet hook size 10. Size—6" to 6½".

NO. 1—Ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 15 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 14 times, ch 2, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, * (sc, ch 36, sc) in next sp, sc in dc. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. **ROW 4**—3 sc in 1 loop, (ch 8, 3 sc in next) around. **ROW 5**—Sl st in 1st 2 sc, * (ch 4, sc) 3 times in next 8-ch, ch 4, sc in center sc. Repeat from * around. **ROW 6**—Ch 1, sl st in 1st loop, ch 4, hdc in next, (ch 2, hdc in next) around. Join to 2d st of 4-ch. **ROW 7**—(3 sc in next sp) 3 times, * 2 sc in next, ch 12, 11 sc on ch, 2 sc in same sp, (3 sc in next sp) 7 times. Repeat from * around, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 8**—* Ch 5, dtr in 1st st on next bar, ch 5, tr in next 4th st, ch 5, sc in tip, ch 5, tr opposite last tr, ch 5, dtr opposite next dtr, ch 5, sk 10 sc, sc in next 5 sc. Repeat from * around. **ROW 9**—** (Sc, ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1, sc) in each of next 3 sps, * (sc, ch 6, sc) in end sc. Repeat from ** to *. 1 sc between points, (sc, ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1, sc) in next sp, (sc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next, ch 13, sl st back in 2d shell on previous point, (ch 4, sc) 6 times on 13-ch, ch 4, sl st in last dc, (2 dc, ch 1, sc) in bal. of same sp, (sc, ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1, sc) in next sp. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Make 13-ch loop between 1st and last points.

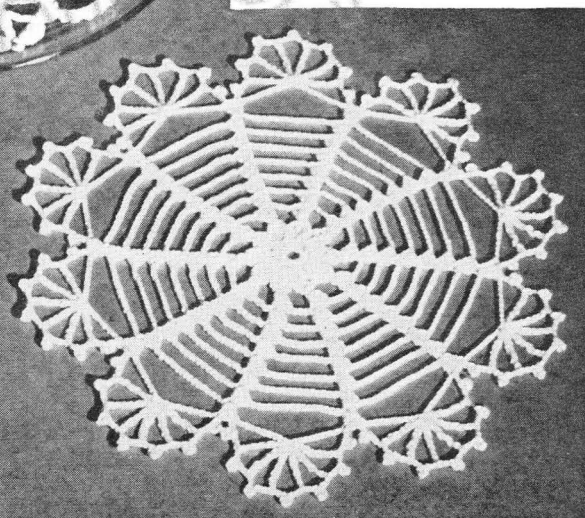
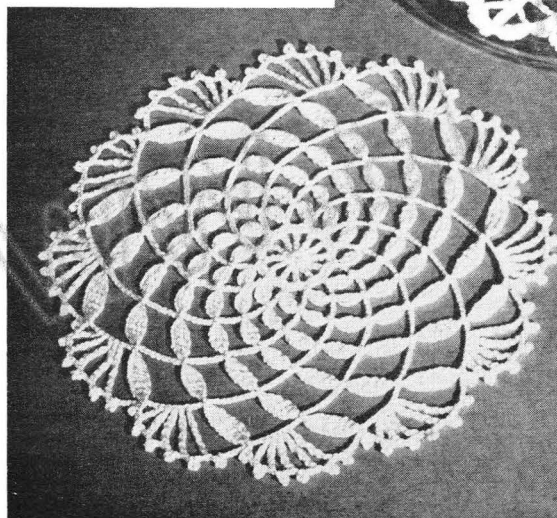
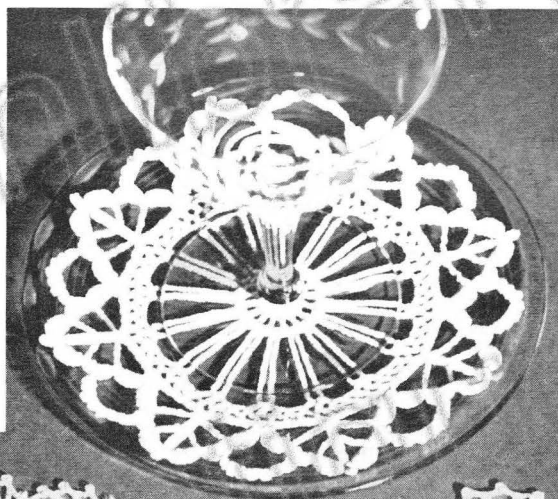
NO. 2—Ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in 1 loop of 1st sc. **ROW 2**—(Ch 5, 2-tr-Cluster in same sc, ch 4,

sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 6, sl st in next sc) 10 times. **ROW 3**—Ch 6, fasten up back to tip of next petal, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, (ch 4, 3 dc in next p) 9 times, ch 4, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 4**—Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, (ch 7, 3 dc in 1st dc of next group) around and join. **ROW 5**—As in Row 4, but with 9-chs. Make 5 more rows, 2 more sts in loops in each row (19-ch loops in last row). **ROW 11**—Sl st in next 2 dc, * (ch 6, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 2, dtr) 6 times in 10th st of next sp, ch 6, p, ch 2, sl st in 3 dc. Repeat from * around. Fasten off.

NO. 3—Ch 8 with 1st st twice usual size, tr in long st, (ch 2, tr in same st) 10 times, ch 2, sl st in 5th ch st. **ROW 2**—3 sc in each sp. Sl st in 1st 2 sc. **ROW 3**—(Ch 5, a 2-dc-Cluster in 5th st from hook, ch 4, sc in next 3d sc) 11 times, ch 5, a Cluster, tr in next 3d sc. **ROW 4**—(Ch 5, a 2-dc-Cluster, ch 5, sc in next loop) around, with tr in place of final 5-ch. **ROW 5**—(Ch 6, a 2-tr-Cluster in 6th st, ch 6, sc in next loop) around, with tr in place of final 6-ch. Repeat once. **ROW 7**—(Ch 8, a 2-dtr-Cluster in 8th st, ch 7, sc in next loop) around, with dtr in place of final 7-ch. **ROW 8**—(Ch 8, a 3-dtr-Cluster, ch 9, sc in next loop) around, with tr tr in place of final 9-ch. **ROW 9**—(Ch 10, a 3-tr tr-Cluster, ch 10, sc in next loop) around. Fasten off. Join to center of last loop. **ROW 10**—* Ch 5, sc in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 1, tr in next 3d st, (ch 5, p, ch 1, dtr in next st) twice, (ch 5, p, ch 1, tr

tr in next st) twice, ch 5, p, ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Stretch and pin right-side-down in true circles. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

ROW 2—Ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 5 times, (2 dc in next sp, 1 dc in dc) 3 times, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 11 times, (2 dc in next sp, 1 dc in dc) 3 times. Continue, following chart, with 10 sps, 1 bl, 5 sps, 1 bl, 10 sps, 3 bls, 11 sps, 3 bls, 6 sps. Work to top of chart (Row 37), then reverse chart and work from Row 36 back thru Row 1. **EDGE**—Make 3 sc in each sp around, with 7 sc in corner sps. Fasten off. **SIDES**—Mark center sc on 1 side. Wrong-side-up, join to 42d sc to right of center, ch 6, tr in 12th sc, (ch 6, dtr in next 6th sc) 4 times, ch 6, (dtr, ch 6, dtr) in next 6th (center) sc, (ch 6, dtr in next 6th sc) 4 times, ch 3, tr in next 6th sc, ch 6, sc in next 12th sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, (3 sc, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, and 3 sc) in each 6-ch, 1 sc in each tr and dtr. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join to next 18th sc, turn, ch 7, dtr at end of last row, (ch 7, dtr in center sc between next 2 rs) 12 times, ch 7, dtr at end of last row, ch 7, sc in next 18th sc. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, turn, (4 sc, p, 4 sc) in each sp, 1 sc in each dtr. **ROW 5**—Like Row 3, except make 8-chs. **ROW 6**—Like Row 4, except make (5 sc, p, 5 sc) in each sp. **ROW 7**—Join to next 15th sc, turn, 9-chs and dtr across, ending in next 15th sc. Repeat Row 6. Repeat on other 3 sides. **ROW 9**—Join to 1 corner, ch 10, dtr at end of last row, 10-chs and dtr around entire piece. **ROW 10**—(6 sc, p, 6 sc) in each sp, 1 sc in each dtr. Fasten off. Stretch and pin right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

No. 16—"Darned Filet" Centerpiece

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—9-balls Ecreu, Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3:—3-balls Cream. (Note—This design may also be made in regular Filet Crochet, requiring 12-balls Sil-Tone). Crochet hook size 10. Size—14"x24".

In Ecreu, ch 177, dc in 9th st from hook, (ch 2, dc in next 3d st) across (57 sps). **ROW 2**—Ch 8, turn, dc in last dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) across to 3d st of end ch, ch 2, tr in same st. Repeat 8 times (75 sps in Row 10). **ROW 11**—Ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) across to end ch. Repeat thru Row 116. Ch 1, turn, sl st to 2d dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) across to last dc (decreasing 1 sp at each end). Repeat 8 times (57 sps in final row). **EDGE**—Ch 11, turn, tr in last sp, (ch 5, tr in next 2d sp) around, with an extra 5-ch and tr in each corner. Join to 1st 6-ch. **ROW 2**—(4 sc, ch 5, sl st in last sc, 3 sc) in each sp. Fasten off. Stretch and pin right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Tack right-side-down on a cardboard and darn in the design, following chart. Use 1 strand Pearl Cotton and dull-pointed needle. (Run darning lengthwise, over-and-under bars, then back over-and-under opposite bars) twice (4 strands) to each row. To fasten ends of darning strands, make 2 back sts on darning, then tie a tight knot down close to work and cut close. Steam and press dry thru a cloth, and remove from card.

No. 17—Filet Centerpiece

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—10-balls White or Cream. Crochet hook size 10. Size—21".

DIAGRAM FOR "DARNED FILET" CENTERPIECE — No. 16

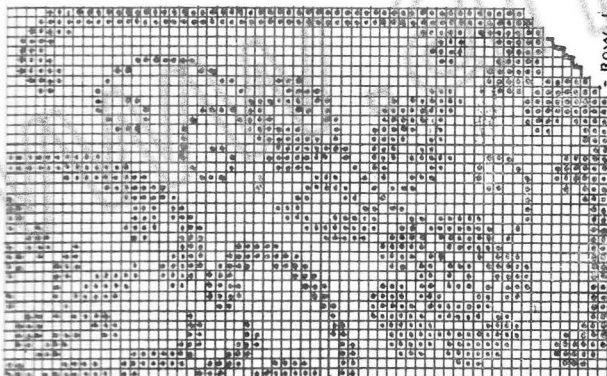
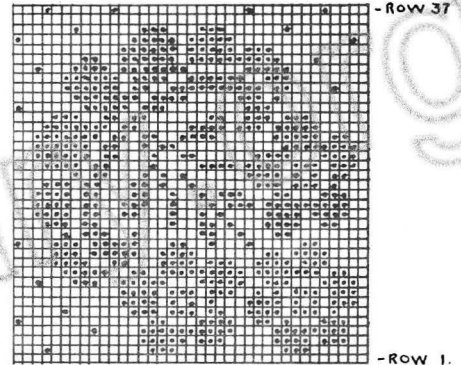


DIAGRAM FOR No. 17 FILET CENTERPIECE



No. 18—Chair Set—"Latticed Garden"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—12-balls White or Ecu or Cream. Crochet hook size 9.

LATTICE MOTIF—Ch 8, dc in starting st. Ch 7, turn, (sc, ch 4, dc) in 1st loop. Ch 7, turn, sc in last loop, ch 4, (sc, ch 4, dc) in next loop. Continue for 2 more rows, 1 more loop in each row. Ch 6, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times, ch 2, dc in same end loop. * Turn, sk last half-loop, (ch 4, sc in next loop) 5 times. Ch 6, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times, ch 2, dc down in half-loop at end of previous row. Repeat from * 3 times. Turn, (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times, ch 2, dc in end loop. Continue for 3 more rows, 1 loop less in each row. Ch 2, turn, dc in next loop. **EDGE**—Ch 1, 3 sc over bar of last dc, * (3 sc in next sp) 3 times, ch 7, turn, sk 5 sc, (tr, ch 6, tr) in next sc, ch 4, sl st in next 5th sc. Ch 1, turn, 5 sc in 4-ch, sc in tr, 3 sc in next sp, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, (2 sc, p, 2 sc) in same sp, sc in tr, 8 sc in next sp, (3 sc in next sp, 2 sc, a p and 1 sc in next sp) 3 times, (3 sc in next sp) 4 times, 2 sc in next, ch 4, turn, sk last 5 sc, (tr, ch 6, tr) in next sc, ch 7, sl st in next 5th sc. Ch 1, turn, 8 sc in 7-ch, sc in tr, (2 sc, p, 2 sc, p, 3 sc) in next sp, sc in tr, (5 sc in next sp) * twice. Repeat from * to *. 2 sc in next sp, sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off.

FLOWER—Wind thread around handles of 3 crochet hooks held together, slip off, 16 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. Ch 10, dc in next 2d sc, (ch 7, dc in next 2d sc) 6 times, ch 3, dc in 3d st of 1st 10-ch, (1 dc, 2 tr, a p, 2 tr, 1 dc) in same st, sc in next loop, * (1 dc, 2 tr, a p, 2 tr, 1 dc) in 1 loop of next dc, sc in next loop. Repeat from * 6 times. Fasten off.

CHAIR BACK DOILY—Make 18 Lattice Motifs and 27 Flowers. (Join 9 Lattice Motifs by 5 ps on each long side, into a straight row) twice. (Join 9 Flowers by 1 petal on each side, into a straight row) 3 times. Alternating Flower and Lattice Rows, join 3 petals of each Flower to 2 ps and center-end of each Lattice Motif. **BORDER**—Wrong-side-up, join to 1st flower on bottom, * (ch 13, sc in next petal) twice, ch 6, sc in 1st petal on next flower. Repeat from * across, ending with two 13-ch loops.

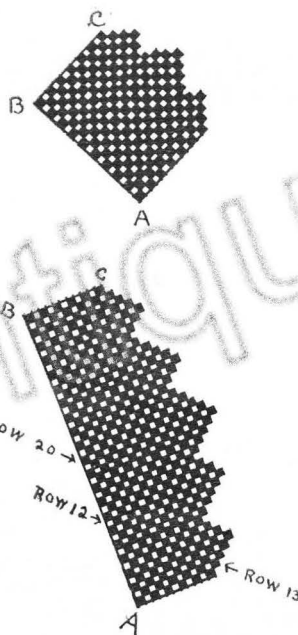
ROW 2—Ch 1, turn, * 15 sc in next loop, 6 sc in next, ch 15, turn, sk 11 sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, turn, (9 sc, p, 9 sc) in 15-ch, 9 sc in next loop, (3 sc, p, 3 sc) in 6-ch. Repeat from * across. Fasten off. **TASSELS**—Wind 25 times over a 2" card. Tie at one end, cut other end. Tie 1/4" down from top. Make 17 and hang one from each p on Border. **ARM REST DOILY**—Make 8 Lattice Motifs and join into 2 bands. Make 12 Flowers and join into 3 rows. Join alternately, work Border across one end, make 7 tassels and hang to Border ps. Make 2 dollies. Stretch and pin 3 pieces right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

No. 19—CHAIR SET "Checkered Charm"

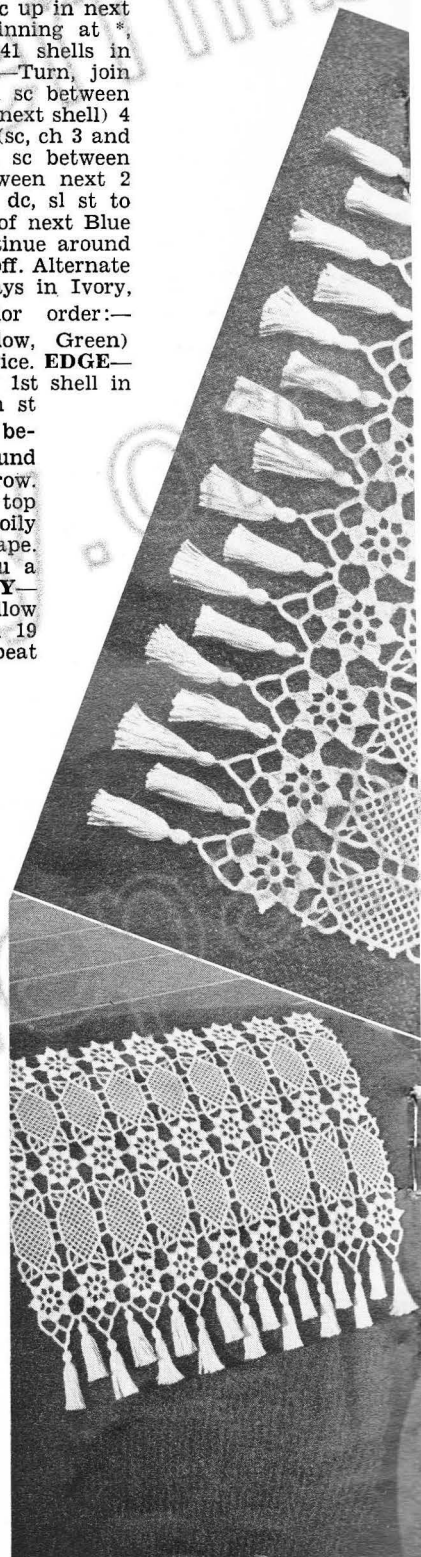
MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—6-balls Ivory, 4-balls Ecu, 2-balls each Yellow and Blue, and 1-ball Nile Green (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5.

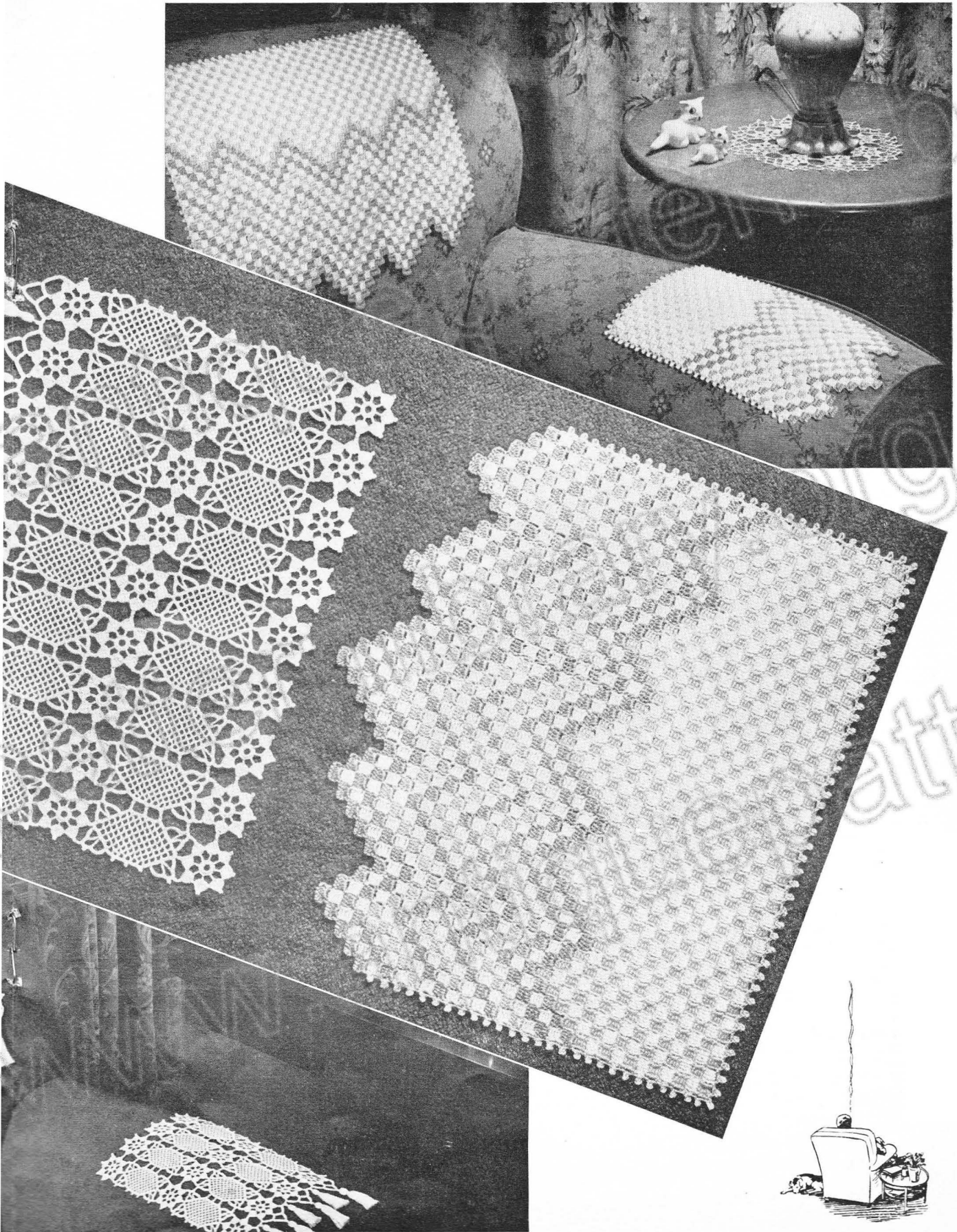
CHAIR BACK DOILY—Starting at corner "A" on Chart and working rows diagonally, ch 8 in Ecu, sk last 4 sts, dc in next 4 sts. Draw Ivory thru last 2 loops of end dc and drop Ecu on back. **ROW 2**—In Ivory, ch 8, turn, sk last 4 sts, dc in next 4 ch sts, (sc ch 3 and 4 dc) in 4-ch of next shell, working over Ecu. Join Ecu thru final dc. **ROW 3**—In Ecu, ch 8, turn, sk 4 sts, 4 dc on ch, and working over Ivory, (sc, ch 3 and 3 dc) in 3-ch of next shell, 1 dc in sc between shells, (sc, ch 3 and 4 dc) in end shell. Right side of Ecu rows is right side of Doily. Join Ivory in last dc. **ROW 4**—Ch 8, turn, a shell on ch, * (sc, ch 3 and 3 dc) in next shell, 1 dc in sc between shells.

repeat from * once. (Sc, ch 3 and 4 dc) in end shell, join Ecu. Make 7 more rows in same way, working over thread not in use, keeping it pulled up taut. **ROW 12**—Like Row 4 for 11 shells (start of 1st point). **ROW 13**—12 Ecu shells. Continue, following Chart to corner "B". Still with Ecu, ch 1, turn, sl st up to corner of last shell, join Ivory and make 14 shells. Join Ecu and starting as in Row 3, make 14 shells. Continue in same way to corner "C" on Chart. Fasten off. **BORDER—ROW 1**—Turn, join Blue to last shell and make 4 shells, * (ch 3, 4 dc, ch 3 and sc) in next shell, (dc in sc between shells, 3 dc, ch 3 and sc in next shell) twice, dc in sc between shells, 3 dc in next shell, sc up in next shell. Make 4 shells. Beginning at *, continue around points (41 shells in row). Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Turn, join Ivory to last dc, * (dc in sc between shells, 3 dc, ch 3 and sc in next shell) 4 times, ch 8, a shell on ch, (sc, ch 3 and 3 dc in next shell, dc in sc between shells) 3 times, sl st between next 2 shells, ch 1, turn, sk last dc, sl st to corner, turn, sc in corner of next Blue shell. Beginning at *, continue around points (41 shells). Fasten off. Alternate these 2 rows, Row 2 always in Ivory, and Row 1 in this color order:—another Blue row, (Yellow, Green) twice, Yellow, and Blue twice. **EDGE**—Turn, join Ecu at top of 1st shell in last row, (ch 4, sc in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 1, sc between next 2 shells) around to other end of last Blue row. Make an extra p-loop at top corners. Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. **ARM REST DOILY**—Start in same way and follow Chart. Make Border with 19 shells in each row. Repeat Edge, steam and press. Make 2.

No. 20—"Mother And Daughter Set" Handbags And Coin Purses

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—15-balls each White and Lt. Ecrú, or 29-balls of one color; ½-ball each Scarlet, Delft Blue, Orange and Mid Apple Green (or other colors). Crochet hooks sizes 1 and 5. Buckram and lining material.

LARGE BAG—In 1 strand each White and Lt. Ecrú or 2 strands color, and size 1 hook, ch 115, sk 2 sts, 113 hdc on ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 2, turn, 113 hdc in back loops. **ROW 3**—Ch 2, turn, 113 hdc in both loops. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 thru Row 10. Fasten off. Turn work over, 113 hdc on other side of starting ch, and repeat Rows 2 and 3 thru Row 11. 35 sc across end, 113 hdc on next side. **ROW 12**—With rows in both loops and back loops alternately, ch 2, turn, hdc across side, 2 hdc in end hdc, (2 hdc, 4 dc, 23 tr, 4 dc and 2 hdc) across end, 2 hdc in 1st hdc at corner, hdc across to end. **ROW 13**—Ch 2, turn, hdc around, widening with 2 hdc at corners of end, in line with base of 1st row across end. Widen evenly as neces-

sary around curved end. Repeat until band is 13" wide. Fasten off. **CORNER**—Ch 3, 7 hdc in 1st st. Alternate rows in back loops and both loops. Ch 3, turn, dc and hdc in last hdc, hdc in 2 sts, 5 hdc in next, hdc in 2 sts, hdc and dc in end st. **ROW 3**—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc and 1 hdc in last dc, hdc in each st around, with 1 hdc and 2 dc in end st. In center shell, 3 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in 3 hdc, 3 hdc in next. **ROW 4**—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc and 1 hdc in last dc, hdc around, with 5 hdc in center st, and 1 hdc and 2 dc in end st. Repeat Rows 3 and 4 twice. Fasten off. Join to other end of row, sl st in each st around. Make 2 and sew long side under edge of flap about 5" apart. Fold Bag. **GUSSET**—Ch 5, 15 dc in 1st st, join with sl st. Ch 3, dc in same st, (2 dc in next dc) 15 times and join. Ch 2, 1 hdc in same st, (1 hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next) repeated around and join. Ch 3, hdc in 3 sts, sc in 9 sts, hdc in 3 sts. Ch 2, turn, (3 hdc, 9 sc and 3 hdc) across. * (Ch 2, turn, hdc across) for 2 rows. Ch 2, turn, decrease by working 2 hdc in center of row together as 1 st. Repeat from * for length to fit end of Bag. Make sc all around. Fasten off. Make 2. **BUTTON**—Ch 2, 6 sc in 1st st. (2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (1 sc in next, 2 sc in next) 6 times. Sc in 18 sc. (Sc in next 2d sc) 9 times, stuff hard with cotton and close with sl sts. **RING**—Ch 18, join. Ch 1, 27 sc in ring. Working over last row into ring, make 30 sc around, join

and fasten off. Sew to center of flap. **FLOWER**—In 1 strand Red and size 5 hook, ch 1 twice usual size, (ch 2, 2 dc in long st, ch 2. sc in long st) 5 times. Fasten off. Make 2 each in Orange and Blue. **LEAVES**—In Green, ch 5, a 2-dc-Cluster in 5th st from hook, ch 3, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 4, sl st at base of Cluster, ch 10, a leaf in 5th st, sl st in next st, (ch 15, a leaf, sl st in next st) 5 times, ch 9, a leaf, sl st in next 4 sts, (ch 6, a leaf, sl st in next st, sl st in each st between leaves) repeated to end. Fasten off. Sew Leaves on flap 1¼" from edge. Sew Red flower in center sp, an Orange flower on each side, and a Blue flower in end sps.

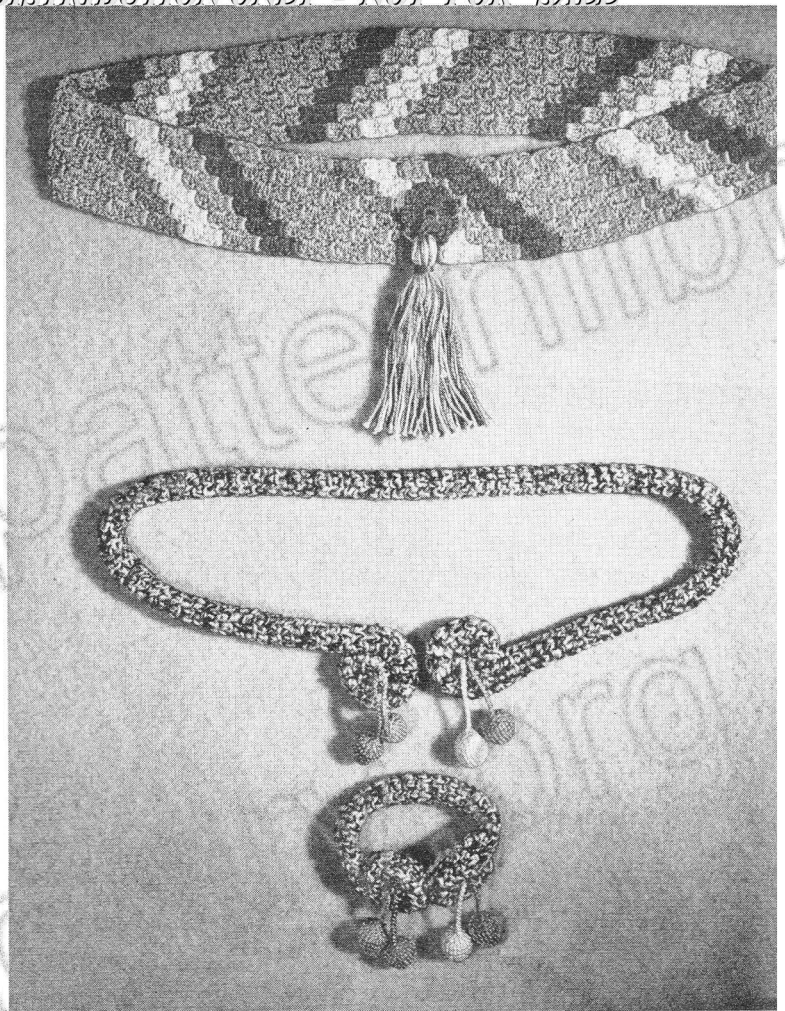
COIN PURSE—(Worked in both loops at all times). In 1 strand each White and Lt. Ecrú, or 2-strands color, ch 36, sk 2 sts, 33 hdc on ch, 5 hdc in end st, 33 hdc on other side of ch. Ch 2, turn, 33 hdc, (2 hdc in next st) 5 times, 33 hdc. Make 6 more rows of hdc, widening around curved end. Fasten off. Turn and make 1 row of sc each in 2 strands Blue, Orange, Green and Red. Stretch and pin Bag and Purse right-side-down in true shape. Wet with thick, hot starch and press thru a cloth. When dry, remove and fold. Sew sides of Purse together and fasten flap with a dress snap. Fold Gussets lengthwise, wrong-sides-out, and cover with lining material. Cut buckram to fit bag but ⅝" shorter, hold inside bag with ends even and fold bag. Cut lining 1" larger than buckram. Lay buckram on lining, folds raised up slightly, turning lining over and fasten with sticky tape. Place inside bag and hem to edges. Sew a gusset in each end. Sew button to crochet to match ring.

SMALL BAG—Start with 83 ch, sk 2, 81 hdc on ch. As for Large Bag, make 6 rows on one side, 7 on other. 2 sc in corner, 23 sc across end, 2 sc and 1 hdc in corner, hdc across side. Ch 2, turn, hdc across side, 2 hdc in corner, (1 hdc, 3 dc, 17 tr, 3 dc and 1 hdc) across end, 2 hdc in corner, hdc across side. Continue as for Large Bag until 9" wide. Fasten off. Repeat Corners thru Row 6. Finish with sl st row. Repeat 1st 2 rows of Gusset. Ch 2, 3 dc, 5 sc and 3 hdc across. Ch 2, turn, 3 hdc, 5 sc and 3 hdc across. Repeat Gusset from * to end. Make Ring and Button and flower trim. **COIN PURSE**—Start with 30-ch, 27 hdc on ch, 5 hdc in end st, 27 hdc on other side, make 5 more rows of hdc and 4 colored rows of sc. Finish Bag and Purse as for large set.

No. 21—Diagonal Belt in Shell Stitch

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—1-ball each Red, Delft Blue, Yellow, Mid Apple Green and Golden Brown (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5.

In Red, ch 41, a 2-dc-Cluster in 6th st from hook, a 2-dc-Cluster in next st, sc in next 4th st. * Ch 3, (a 2-dc-Cluster in next st) twice, sc in next 4th st. Repeat from * 4 times. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, two 2-dc-Clusters in last sc, sc in 3-ch of same shell, (ch 3, two 2-dc-Clusters in same 3-ch, sc in 3-ch of next shell) 5 times. Fasten off on back. **ROW 3**—Turn, in Blue, sc in last 3-ch, (ch 3, two Clusters in same 3-ch, sc in next shell) 6 times, making final st a dc instead of sc. **ROW 4**—Ch 5, turn, 2 Clusters in last dc, sc in 3-ch of same shell. Make 5 more shells and fasten off. Repeat Rows 3 and 4 in Yellow and Green, and 6 rows in Golden Brown. Repeat 2 rows each Red, Blue, Yellow and Green, and 6 rows Brown for desired length, plus 2 rows for lap. Fasten off. Steam and press on back. Fasten with dress snaps, with 1st end on



Change your belt and you have a different dress. These two designs are unusual—and easy to make.

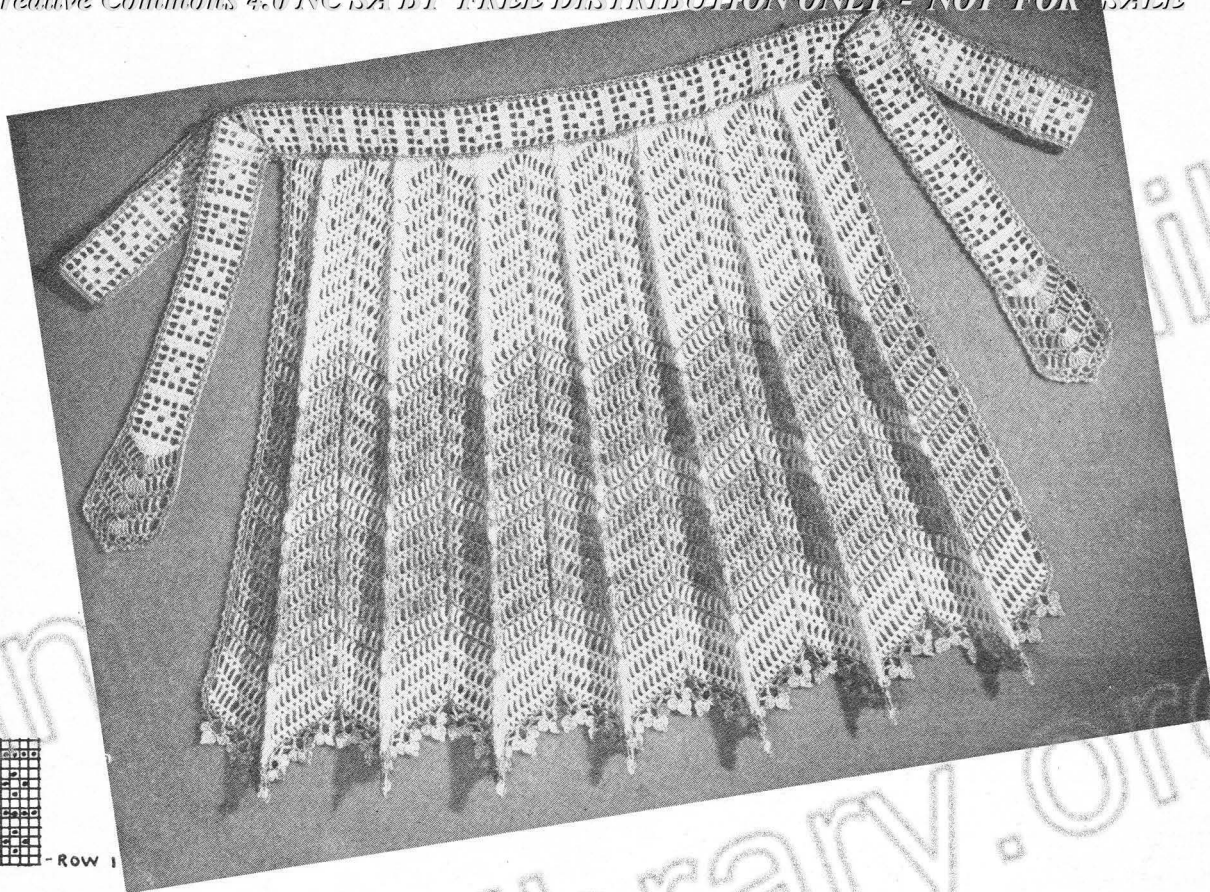
outside. **CIRCLE**—In Red, ch 6, sl st in 1st st, ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch, (ch 1 and in back loops, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, sc in next dc) 9 times. Fasten off and sew on end. **TASSEL**—Wind 5 colors 14 times around a 4" card, cut at one edge and tie a double Red strand around center, double and tie again ½" from top. Trim evenly. Hang by ½" string from Circle.

No. 22—Belt And Bracelet of "Crocheted Rope"

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—1-ball each Black, Yellow, Beauty Rose and Lt. Green (or other colors). Crochet hooks sizes 0 and 5.

BELT—In 1 strand of each color and size 0 hook, ch 2, 7 sc in 1st st. In back loops, sc in 7 sc around and around for 4½" more than desired length. Roll each end back in opposite direction for 2¼" into a coil, and tack. Fasten with hook and eye. **BALLS**—In 1 strand Rose and size 5 hook, ch 2, 6 sc in 1st st. In back loops, (2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) 6 times. (Sc in 5 sc, 2 sc in next) 3 times. Sc in 42 sc (2 rows). (Sc in next 2d sc) 11 times. Stuff with cotton, close top with sl sts, ch 15 and cut 6" long. Fasten in one coil. Make a Green ball, ch 18 and tack to same coil. Make a Yellow ball, ch 18, a Green ball, ch 15, and tack in other coil.

BRACELET—Make in same way to a snug fit over hand. Tack ends of coils together. Make 4 balls with chs of 10 and 13 sts, and tack to coils.



No. 23—Crocheted Apron

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5:—9-balls Cream, 3-balls Beauty Rose and 4-balls Sunset (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5.

SECTION—In Cream, ch 24, sk 1 st, (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 2 dtr and 1 tr tr) on ch, 3 tr tr in next st, (1 tr tr, 2 dtr, 2 tr, 2 dc, 2 hdc and 2 sc) on ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, sk 2 sc, tr in next st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) 4 times, ch 1, 7 tr in next 2d st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) 5 times, tr in end st. **ROW 3**—Turn, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp) 5 times, * ch 4, sc in next 3d tr, ch 4, sc in next 2d tr, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp) 5 times, ch 2, hdc in end ch. **ROW 4**—Ch 5, turn, tr in next loop, (ch 1, tr in next) 4 times, ch 1, 7 tr in next loop, (ch 1, tr in next loop) 5 times, tr in end loop. Repeat Rows 3 and 4. **ROW 7**—Repeat Row 3 to *. To widen, ch 4, sc in next 2d tr, ch 4, (sc, ch 4, sc) in next 2d tr, ch 4, sc in next 2d tr, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp) 5 times, ch 2, hdc in end ch. (Repeat Row 4 with 1 more ch 1 and tr on each side; Row 3 with 1 more loop on each side) for 5 rows; then a widening row with center loops as in Row 7. Continue in pattern, widening in every 6th row:—Make 5 more rows Cream, fasten off; * 1 row each Beauty Rose, Cream and Beauty Rose; 7 rows Sunset; 1 row each Beauty Rose and Cream. Repeat from *. 1 row Beauty Rose and 6 rows Cream. Fasten off. Make 7 Sections. With right sides together, crochet together on long sides with 2 sc in small sps and 5 sc in large sps. **EDGE**—In Beauty Rose, work sc down one side to corner loop, * (ch 2, sc in next loop) across to center loop, ch 4, sc in same loop, (ch 2, sc in next loop) across Section, sc in 1st loop on next Section. Repeat from * across bottom, with sc up side. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Join Sunset, (ch 3, sc in next 3d sc) down side to 2d loop at corner, ch 3, dc in next 2d loop, * ch 4, 2 dc in 4th ch st from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st, ** ch 4, 2 dc in 4th st, ch 3, sl st in last dc for a p, 2 dc in same st with last dc, ch 3, sl st in same st. Repeat from * to *. Dc in same loop on edge, ch 3, sc in next 2d loop, ch 3, dc in next 2d loop, ch 4, 1 dc in 4th st from hook, sl st back in last petal, complete petal with 1 dc, ch 3 and sl st. Repeat from ** across Section

(7 motifs), putting 4th motif in center loop. (Ch 1, sc in next loop) 3 times (to 2d loop on next Section). Complete across bottom and make 3-ch loops up side to top. Fasten off. **BAND**—In Cream, ch 21, dc in 9th st from hook, (ch 2, dc in next 3d st) 4 times. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, 1 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in dc, 2 tr in next sp, dtr in dc, 3 dtr in next sp, dtr in dc, 2 tr in sp, dc in dc, 2 hdc and 1 sc in end sp. Fasten off. Repeat on other end. **TAB**—Join Sunset to 1st sc, ch 5, tr in next 2d st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) twice, ch 1, 7 tr in next 2d st, (ch 1, tr in next 2d st) 3 times, tr in end st. Turn, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch) 3 times, ch 4, sc in next 3d tr, ch 4, sc in next 2d tr, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp) 3 times, ch 2, hdc in end ch. Repeat these 2 rows 3 times. Fasten off. Repeat Tab on other end. **EDGE**—In Beauty Rose, make (ch 2, sc) along each side of Band, sc on sides of Tabs, (ch 2, sc) around ends with a center 4-ch loop. **ROW 2**—In Sunset, make (ch 2, sc) around. Sew center of Band to top of apron. Stretch and pin right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth, then press into pleats.

No. 24—Crocheted Necklace— "Rose Chain"

MATERIALS—1-ball Lily Sil-Tone in Variegated Roses (or other color). Crochet hook size 10.

ROSE—Ch 15, sl st in 12th st from hook, ch 2, dc in starting st, ch 4, sl st in same st. Turn, (ch 7, sc) 5 times on bar of dc, (ch 7, sc) 5 times in 4-ch loop. Sc in 1st 7-ch loop. **ROW 2**—* (Ch 2, dc) 4 times in same loop, ch 2, sc in same loop, ch 1, sc in next loop. Repeat from * 9 times. **ROW 3**—* Ch 1, sc in next 2-ch, (ch 4, sc in next 2-ch) 4 times. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Make 7. **CORD**—Cut 3 lengths 5 yds. long, (double and twist tightly) twice. Tie loose end. Dip Roses in hot starch and set in even ripples. Push a crochet hook thru top loop. When dry, hang on cord, tying a knot in cord on each side of each rose. Tie cord at back.

No. 25—Necklace And Bracelet Set—"Match Play"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—1-ball Shaded Greens, and a partial ball each Scarlet and Emerald Green (or other colors). Crochet hook size 10. 14-buttons 9/16" size.

BRAID—In Red, ch 6, sc in 1st st, (ch 5, turn, sc in sc) repeated for 17". Fasten off. Make a 7" braid for Bracelet. **BUTTON**—In Shaded Greens, ch 6, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch. Ch 1, sc in same st, in back loops, 2 sc in each dc. 1 sc in each sc around. (Sk 1 sc, sc in 5 sc) repeated around. Slip on button, (sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) repeated for several rows, close with sl sts. Fasten off. Make 14. **FLOWER**—In Red, ch 6, 2 dc in 5th st from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st, sl st in starting st. (Ch 5, 2 dc in 5th st, ch 3, sl st in same st, sl st in starting st) 4 times. Fasten off. Make 15. Sew one on each button and one on one end of Necklace braid. **LEAVES**—In Green, (ch 11, a 4-dtr-Cluster in 8th st from hook, ch 5, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 8, sl st at base of Cluster) 3 times, sl st in 1st st. Fasten off. Make 14. Dip leaves in hot starch. Press flat. When dry sew 7 on Necklace braid 1" apart. Sew a button on each. Fasten at back with dress snap. Fasten Bracelet with snap and sew other 7 leaves and buttons on it.

No. 26—Hat Pin

MATERIALS—A partial ball Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5, in Orange; 1-skein Lily Six Strand Floss in Black (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5. 1-hat pin.

In Orange, ch 6, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch. Ch 1, sc in same st, in both loops, (2 sc in next dc, 1 sc in next) repeated around, sl st in 1-ch. Turn, (ch 3, in back loops, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sl st in next) repeated around. Fasten off. ** Turn, join Black to remaining loops of Row 2, * ch 3, thread over, (swing hook forward and down, thread over under ch, swing hook forward and up and thread over above ch) repeated until there are 13 loops on hook, thread over and pull thru all loops at once, 1 sc on ch at base of knot (a Clones Knot), sl st in next 3 sc. Repeat from * 5 times. Fasten off. Make 7 Black French Knots on center. Make a 2d circle but omit Clones Knots. Cut 2 cardboard circles inside Row 2, and glue one to back of each circle. Sew circles together back-to-back, inserting hat pin head between.

"FRANKLY FEMINE"

No. 27 Hat Pin

MATERIALS — A partial ball Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5, in Mid Apple Green. 1-yd. each of 8 colors Lily Six Strand Floss. Crochet hook size 5. 1-hat pin.

In Green, ch 2, 6 sc in 1st st. In back loops, (2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (1 sc in next, 2 sc in next) 6 times. (Sc in 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times.

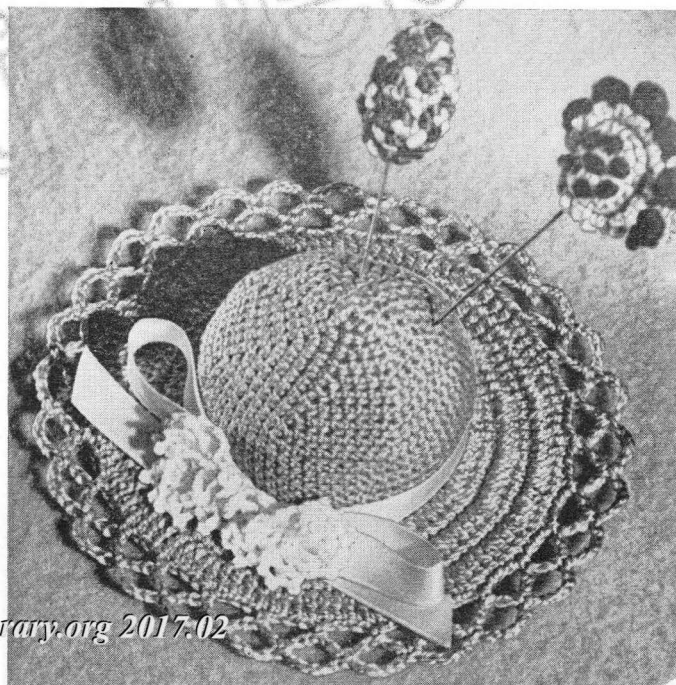
Sc in 72 sc (3 rows). (Sk 1 sc, sc in 6 sc) repeated until 11 sc are left, insert hat pin head and stuff hard with cotton. (Sk 1, sc in 2 sc) repeated until 6 sc are left, stuff and close with sl sts. Cover with French Knots, —12 to 15 knots in each color,—wound 6 times around needle.

No. 28—"Hat" Pincushion

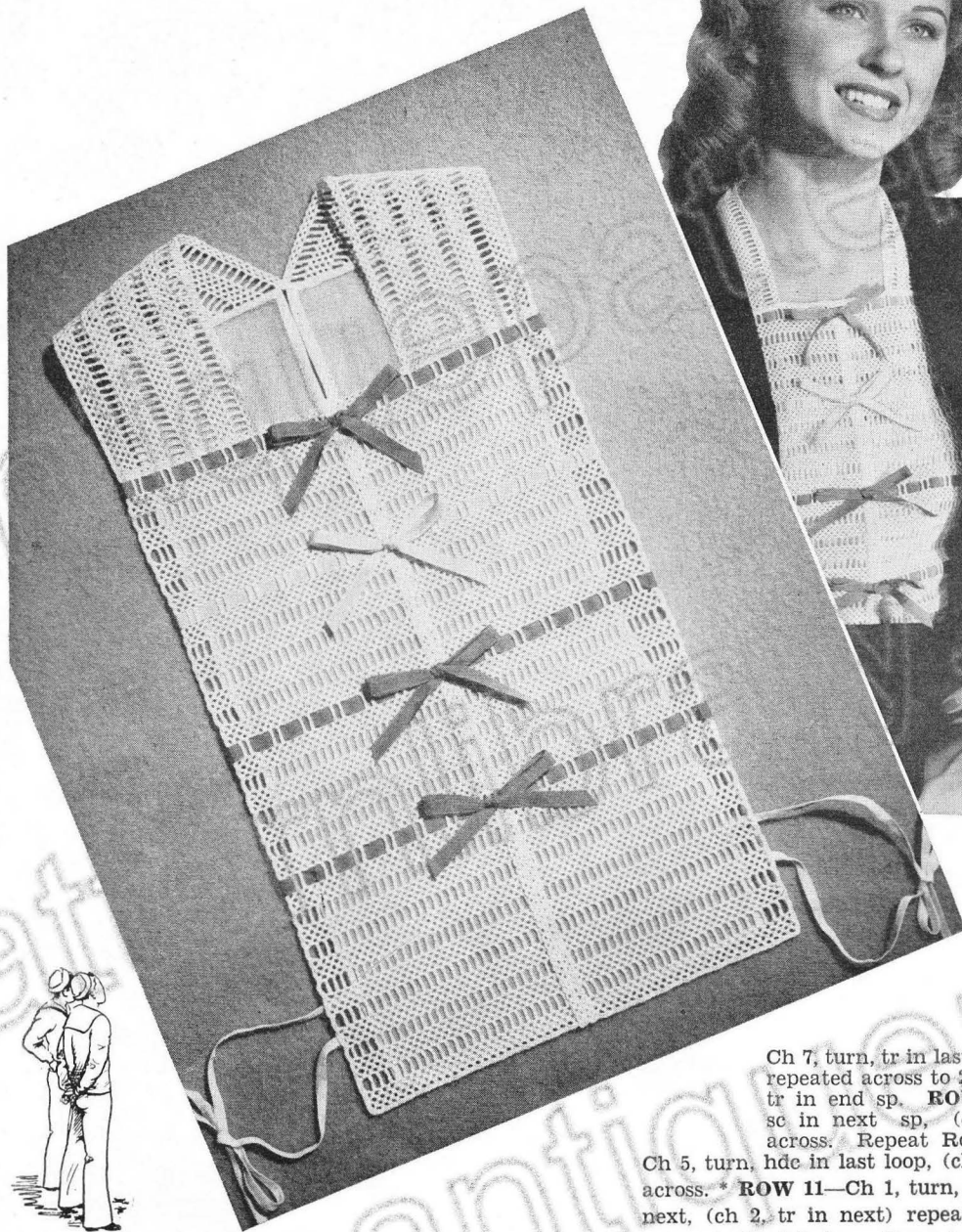
MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3:—2- balls Blue; ½-ball Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton in White (or other colors). Crochet hooks size 3 and 10. ½-yd. White ribbon ½" wide.

CROWN—In Blue and size 3 hook, ch 2, 7 sc in 1st st. In both loops, (2 sc in next sc) 7 times. (1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 2 sc in next) 7 times. (Sc in 2 sc, 2 sc in next) 7 times. Make 5 more rows with 1 more sc between widenings in each row (63 sc in final row). Make 8 rows even. Sl st in 6 sts. Fasten off. **BRIM**—In Blue, ch 2, 8 sc in 1st st. In back loops, (2 sc in next sc) 8 times. (1 sc in

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton: —7-balls White. Crochet hook size 10. 1½-yds. ¼" gros-grain ribbon in Shocking Pink, and ¾-yd. each Yellow and Turquoise.

FRONT—Ch 169, sc in 7th st, (ch 3, sc in next 3d st) 54 times. **ROW 2**—* Ch 5, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 3, sc in next) repeated across. Repeat once. **ROW 4**—Ch 5, turn, hdc in last loop, (ch 2, hdc in next loop) repeated across. **ROW 5**—Ch 7, turn, tr in last sp, (ch 2, tr in next) repeated across. **ROW 6**—Ch 5, turn, sc in last 2-ch sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) repeated across to end 7-ch. Repeat from * for 15", ending with Rows 6 and 2. Fasten off. **SHOULDER**—Ch 134, tr in 11th st, (ch 2, tr in next 3d st) repeated across. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, sc in next sp, (ch 3, sc in next) repeated across. **ROW 3**—* Ch 1, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 3, sc in next) repeated across. **ROW 4**—Ch 5, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 3, sc in

next) repeated across. **ROW 5**—Ch 1, turn, sc in last loop, ch 3, hdc in next loop, (ch 2, hdc in next loop) repeated across. **ROW 6**—

Ch 7, turn, tr in last 2-ch sp, (ch 2, tr in next) repeated across to 2d sp from end of last row, tr in end sp. **ROW 7**—Ch 1, turn, sk 2 tr, sc in next sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) across. Repeat Rows 4 and 3. **ROW 10**—Ch 5, turn, hdc in last loop, (ch 2, hdc in next) repeated across. * **ROW 11**—Ch 1, turn, sc in last loop, ch 5, tr in next, (ch 2, tr in next) repeated across. Repeat Row 2 across to final 2-ch sp. Repeat from * to *. Fasten off. On long side (neck edge), make 2 rows of 3-ch loops. Make 2 pieces. Sew straight ends under top edge of Front. Work sc around outside edges. **CENTER BAND**—Make ch 1" longer than Front, sc in 7th st, (ch 3, sc in next 3d st) repeated to end. Ch 5, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 3, sc in next) repeated across. Fasten off. Repeat 2 rows on other side of ch. Sew down center of Front. Stretch and pin right side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Cut net or cloth about 18" long and ¾" wider than ends of shoulder pieces. Cut a 3" slash down from center of one end. Bind slash. Hem edges and sew slashed end to shoulder pieces. Fasten with button and ch loop. Tack two 12" tapes on each side at waist line. Run half of Pink ribbon thru beading row at top of Front, tying in a bow in center. Run Yellow thru next 4th beading row below, Turquoise thru next 4th, and Pink thru next 4th.

No. 30—House Slippers— "Loafer Espadrilles"

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton size 3: 7-balls Lt. Blue; size 5:—1-ball Beauty Rose (or other colors). 2-prs. cork inner soles in men's size. Crochet hooks sizes 3 and 5.

Cut cork soles to fit,—2 lefts and 2 rights. Glue pairs, cloth sides together. In Blue and size 3 hook, make ch $2\frac{1}{4}$ " shorter than soles, 2 sc in 2d st, sc in 22 sts, hdc in 5 sts, dc to end with 7 dc in end st, dc, hdc and sc on other side to match 1st half, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, 3 dc in same st, in both loops, 2 dc in next sc, make dc around, widening with (2 dc in next st) 5 times around end. 2 dc in 2d sc from end of row, 3 dc in end st, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 3 and work dc around, widening as necessary, and join. Next make 2 rows around, starting with sc, using hdc and dc to shape sole to exactly fit cork soles. Fasten off. Make 2. Draw around cork soles on paper. Pin crocheted soles right-side-down on pattern. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Sew on cork soles with strong thread such as dental floss. **VAMP**—In Blue, ch 15, sk 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, (1 hdc, ch 2, 1 hdc) in next st, hdc in 6 sts. (For smaller size, ch 13 and make 5 hdc on each side of center shell). **ROW 2**—Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across, with (1 hdc, ch 2, 1 hdc) in center 2-ch. Repeat 12 times (less for smaller size), each row 1 hdc longer on each side of center. **ROW 15**—* Ch 2, turn, (hdc in 1st 2 hdc) worked off together into a Cluster (a decrease). Continue across in pattern with final 2 hdc made into a Cluster. Repeat Row 2. Repeat from * twice. Work sc down each side to front corners. **TRIM**—In Blue, ch 6, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch. (Ch 3, sl st in next dc) 18 times. Fasten off. In Beauty Rose and size 5 hook, ch 4, thread over, (swing hook forward and down and thread over under ch, bring hook forward and up and thread over above ch) repeated until there are 13 loops on hook, thread over and pull all loops at once, sc around ch at base of knot (a Clones Knot), sl st in starting st. (Ch 3, a Clones Knot on ch, sl st in same starting st) 3 times. Fasten off. Sew on circle. Make 4. Sew down center of vamp. Steam and press on back and sew to crocheted sole. **BACK**—In Blue,

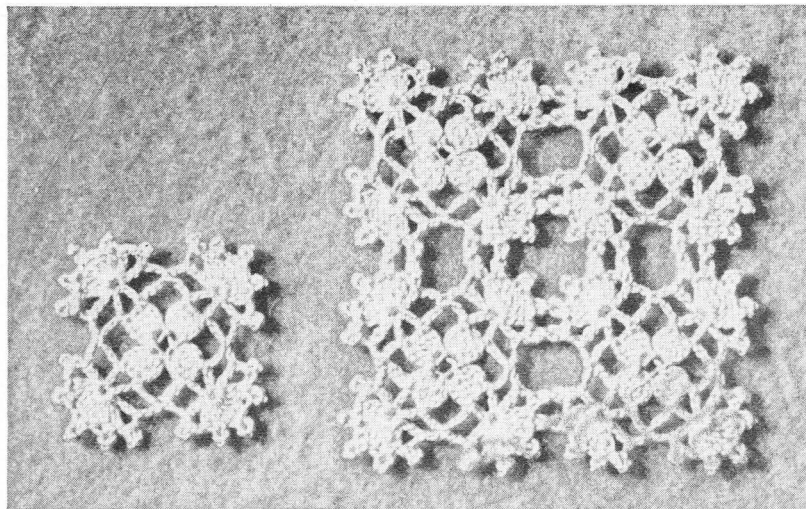
ch 12, sk 2 sts, 10 hdc on ch. (Ch 2, turn, 10 hdc) repeated for length around heel, with $\frac{1}{4}$ " lap under vamp. Make sc on bottom edge. On top work sc for about $2\frac{3}{4}$ ", ch 5, turn, sl st back in 5th sc, ch 1, turn, 6 sc in loop, sc around heel, holding it in taut to fit, make another loop opposite 1st loop, and work sc to end. Press on back and sew to sole and vamp. **TIE**—Cut 4 strands Blue and 10 strands Rose 44" long. Tie together 1" from one end. Divide Rose into 2 parts and braid with Blue. Tie end. Sew center to vamp, run thru side loops, cross in back and tie in front of ankle. Make 2d slipper.

No. 31—Collar—"Ruffle of Spring"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton: —3-balls White. Crochet hook size 10. 1-yd. $\frac{1}{4}$ "-grosgrain ribbon.

Ch 240, sc in 9th st, (ch 5, sc in next 3d st) 77 times. **ROW 2**—Ch 7, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 5, sc in next) repeated across. Repeat once. **ROW 4**—Ch 8 for turning loop, with 6-ch loops across. **ROW 5**—Ch 9 for turning loop, with 7-ch loops across. Repeat once. **ROW 7**—Ch 11, turn, a 3-tr-Cluster in center st of last loop, (ch 7, a Cluster in next loop) repeated across, ch 3, dtr in same end loop. **ROW 8**—Turn, (ch 9, sc in next loop) repeated across with ch 4 and tr for end loop. **ROW 9**—Turn, * ch 6, dc in center st of next loop, ch 10, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 2, dc in next 3d st of 10-ch, ch 6, p, ch 2, dc in same st with last dc, ch 6, p, ch 3, sl st in same st, ch 2, dc in same st of 9-ch loop with next dc, ch 6, sc in next loop, ch 8, sc in next. Repeat from * across. **ROW 10**—Turn, * ch 8, p, ch 7, p, ch 3, sc in dc between next 2 ps, (ch 7, p) 3 times, ch 3, sc in next dc, (ch 7, p) twice, ch 4, 3 sc in next 8-ch loop. Repeat from * across. Fasten off. **BEADING**—Join to end of Row 1, ch 7, tr at base of next sc, (ch 2, tr at base of next sc) repeated across. **ROW 2**—Turn, (ch 5, sc in next tr) repeated across. Repeat twice. **ROW 5**—Repeat Row 7, except make only 5-ch between Clusters. Repeat Row 9 except make 4-ch instead of 6-ch at start and end of each shell, and 6-ch between shells. Repeat Row 10. Fasten off. Starch and pull out in even ripples. Run ribbon thru beading row and tie in front.

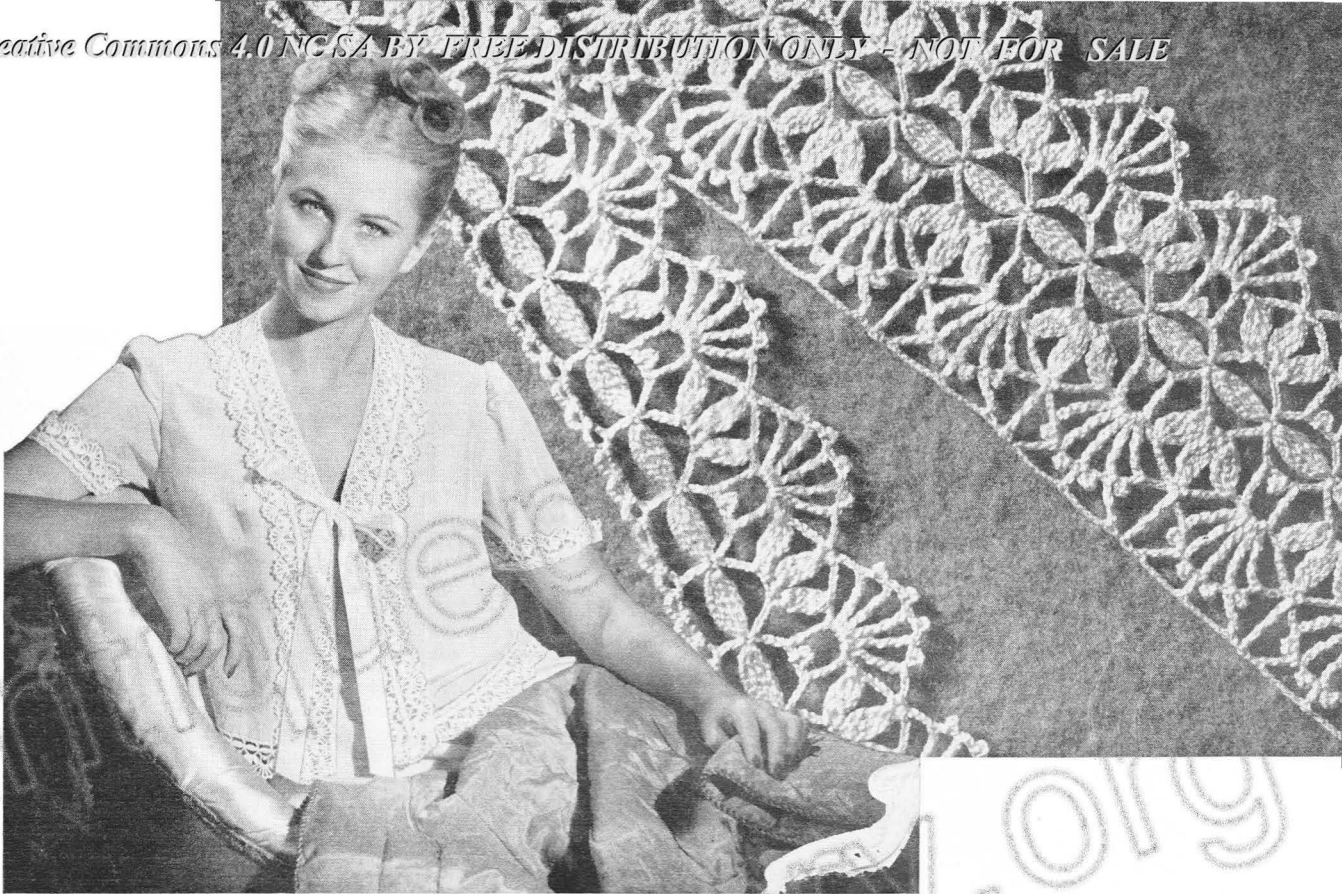
MOTIF—Ch 4, 2 dc in 4th st from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st, (ch 4, 3 dc in 4th st from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st) 3 times, sl st in starting st, ch 3, sl st in top of 1st 3-ch. **ROW 2**—(Ch 7 sc in next 2d dc, ch 7, sc in 1st dc on next petal) repeated around. Make 3-ch and dc in place of final 7-ch loop. **ROW 3**—* Ch 2, dc in 4th st of next loop, ch 5, sc in 5th ch st from hook for a p, ch 1, (2 dc in same st with last dc, ch 5, sl st in last dc for a p) 3 times, 1 dc in same st, ch 5, sc in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 1, 1 dc in same st with last dc, ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * 3 times. Fasten off. Make and join motifs by 4 center ps on each side, leaving p at each corner free. To join 1st and 4th ps on each side, ch 2, sl st in corresponding p on other motif, ch 2, sl st back in last dc. To join 2d and 3d ps, ch 3, sl st in corresponding p on other motif, ch 2, sk last 2 sts of 3-ch, sl st in next st, ch 1 and dc. Join motifs into a band 2 wide and 15 long to go from center front to center back over shoulder. **SLEEVE FRILL**—On one side, work across 7 center motifs with (ch 7, sc in next p) repeated. **ROW 2**—Ch 10, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 7, sc in next loop) repeated across. (Ch 12 turning loop, and 8-ch loops across) for 2 rows. Make 6 more rows, 1 more ch st in loops in each row, with turning loops 1½ times length of loops.

EDGE—Ch 5, turn, sc in last loop, * ch 5, sc in center of same loop, ch 4, 3 dc in 4th ch st from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st, (sc, ch 5, sc) in same 14-ch loop, ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across. Fasten off. Repeat for other side of gown. Make a single row of motifs to go around each armhole and around waist. Stretch and pin right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Sew on gown.

No. 33—"Bow-Getter"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton: 1½-balls White. Crochet hook size 10.

Ch 10, sl st in 1st st. Ch 5, dc in ring, (ch 2, dc in ring) 10 times, ch 2, sl st in 3d st of 1st 5-ch. **ROW 2**—Sc in next sp, (ch 7, sc in next) 11 times, Ch 3, dc in 1st sc. **ROW 3**—(Ch 7, sc in next loop) 11 times, ch 3, dc in next dc. **ROW 4**—(Ch 9, sc in next loop) 11 times, ch 4, tr in next dc. **ROW 5**—Ch 3 for a dc, * ch 8, (dc, ch 4, dc) in 5th st of next loop. Repeat from * around. Join end 4-ch to 1st 3-ch. **ROW 6**—Sl st to center of next loop, (ch 9, sc in next loop) 23 times, ch 4, tr in next. **ROW 7**—Make 23 10-ch loops, ch 5, tr in next tr. **ROW 8**—Make 11-ch loops. Repeat Row 5. **ROW 10**—Sl st to center of next loop, * (ch 3, tr) 4 times in next 4-ch loop, ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 5, dc in next, ch 5, sc in next. Repeat from * around, with a tr in place of final 5-ch. **ROW 11**—* (Ch 7, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 3, tr in next tr) 4 times, ch 7, p, ch 3, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 11 times. Fasten off. Make a 2d circle. **BAND**—Ch 13, sc in 7th st from hook, (ch 3, sc in next 3d st) twice. * Ch 5, turn, sc in last loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) twice. Repeat from * for 1¼". Fasten off. Stretch and pin circles right-side-down, wet with hot starch and press thru a cloth. When dry, fold each crosswise thru center, gather at center of straight side, tack together, with Band around joining.



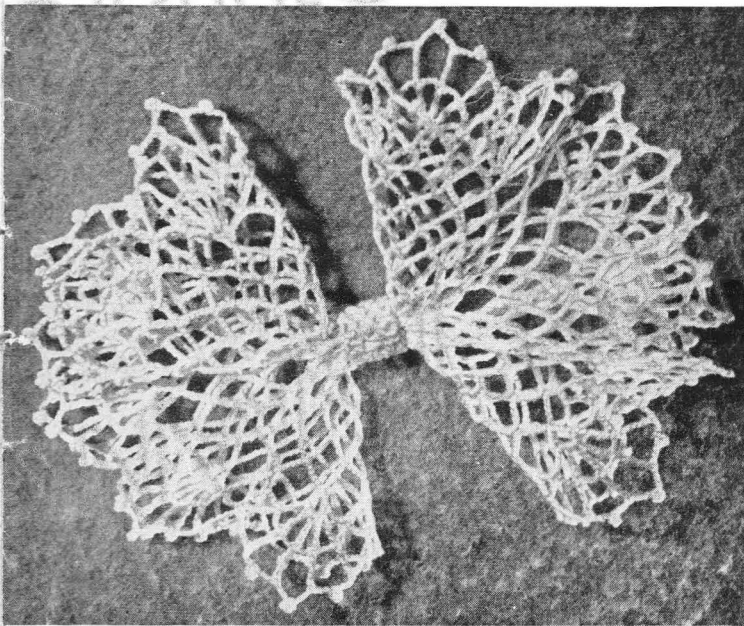
NO. 34—CROCHET-TRIMMED BED JACKET

No. 34—Crochet-Trimmed Bed Jacket

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—6-balls White. 1½-yds rayon crepe in color. Crochet hook size 10.

NO. 33—"BOW-GETTER"



NARROW EDGING—(Ch 9, a 3-dtr-Cluster in 8th st from hook) for length around sleeve, having an uneven number of Clusters. **ROW 2**—Ch 2, sc in 2d st, * ch 10, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 5, sl st between next 2 Clusters, ch 9, p, (ch 5, p) twice, ch 4, sl st between next 2 Clusters. Repeat from * to end. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join to sc at other end, ch 10, * tr in 2d st on right of next p, ch 3, tr in 2d ch st on left side of p, ch 1, a 3-tr-Cluster in next p, (ch 5, a Cluster in next p) twice, ch 1 and repeat from * across, ch 10, sc down in end. Fasten off. **ROW 4**—Join to 1st 10-ch, ch 5, dtr in next 3-ch sp, * (ch 4, sl st in 4th ch st from hook for a p, ch 1, dtr) 4 times in same sp, ch 2, sc in left side of next 5-ch, sc in next 5-ch, ch 2, dtr in 3-ch sp between next 2 tr. Repeat from * across. Ch 5, sc in end ch. Fasten off.

HEADING—Join to 1st st in Row 1, ch 3 for a dc, (ch 9, dc between next 2 Clusters) across. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Join to 1st 3-ch, (ch 4, sc) 3 times in next loop, * ch 3, sc in next loop, (ch 4, sc) twice in same loop. Repeat from * across. Fasten off. Make a length for each sleeve and around bottom edge. **WIDE EDGING**—Repeat Row 1 for length around neck and down fronts, then make Rows 2, 3 and 4 on both sides. In Row 4, make a shell of (ch 4, p, ch 1, dtr) 6 times in sc at center of each end. **HEADING**—Join to start of Row 4, ch 8, tr in next 2 dtr, * ch 6, dc in next dtr, ch 6, tr in next dtr, ch 1, dtr in sc between shells, ch 1, tr in next 2d dtr. Repeat from * across. Ch 8, sc between end shells. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Work 4-ch and sc loops across. Stretch and pin right-side-down in exact lengths. Pin center of Wide Edgings in a slight curve. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

No. 35—Fascinator—"Gay Mantilla"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—7-balls Orange and 6-balls White (or other colors). Crochet hook size 10.

In Orange, ch 9, sl st in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 1, dc in 1st st. **ROW 2**—Ch 14, p, ch 1, turn, sk last p, dc in next 5th st, ch 11, sk p in previous row, dtr in next 2d st, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc in dtr, inserting hook 1/3 of way down dtr. (Each row will end this way, so it will not be mentioned again.) **ROW 3**—Ch 14, p, ch 1, turn, sk last p, dc in next 5th st, ch 11, (dc, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc) in 6th st of next 11-ch loop, ch 11, dtr in 2d st past end p, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc in dtr. **ROW 4**—Ch 14, p, ch 1, turn, sk last p, dc in next 5th st, * ch 11, (dc, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc) in 6th st of next 11-ch loop. Repeat from * once, ch 11, dtr in 2d st past end p, ch 5, p, ch 1, dc in dtr. Continue

in same way, each row 1 sp longer, until there are 51 sps in row. Ch 12, turn,, dc in 7th st from hook, * ch 8, (dc, ch 3, dc) in 6th st of next 11-ch. Repeat from * across, ending with (ch 8, dtr, ch 3, dc). Fasten off. **EDGE**—Join to starting point, ch 5 for a tr, (ch 3, tr) 6 times in same sp, ch 3, sc in next sp, * (ch 3, tr) 3 times in next small sp, ch 3, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. At corners, make (ch 3, tr) 7 times, for shell. **ROW 2**—Make (ch 5, sc in next sp) around shells, ch 3 between shells. **FLOWER**—In White, ch 15, sl st in 1st st. * Ch 15, sk last 2 sts, (2 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 6 tr, 1 dc and 1 hdc) on ch, sc in ring. Repeat from * 9 times. Fasten off. **POM PON**—In Orange, * ch 12, sl st in first st, (ch 12, sl st in same st) 3 times. Repeat from * 3 times, sl st in 1st st. Fasten off. Sew on flower center. Make 41 flowers, dip in hot starch, pin right-side-down, press lightly thru a cloth, then leave until dry.

Gather long side in center (top of head) and sew on 3 flowers. Gather front edge of side points 8" from end and sew on 1 flower. Gather sides of back point crosswise 12" from end and sew 2 flowers on each side. Around points sew a flower every 2½". Sew balance of flowers on points.

No. 36—Crochet-Trimmed Sweater — "Gay-As-You-Go"

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3:—1-ball Emerald Green. Size 5—1-ball Beauty Rose and ½-ball White (or other colors). A short-sleeved pullover sweater. Crochet hooks sizes 3 and 5.

FLOWER—In White and size 5 hook, ch 2, making 1st st twice usual size, 12 sc in long st. Without joining, cut 3" long and pull thru loop tightly. **ROW 2**—In back loops, (sl st, ch 6, sl st) in Beauty Rose in next 3d sc, * (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in next sc, (sl st, ch 6, sl st) in next sc. Repeat from * around. Cut 3" long as before. Tie 2 ends together in a hard knot on back. **LEAF**—In Green and size 3 hook, ch 16, * sk last st, (2 sc, 2 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc and 1 sl st) on ch, * ch 10, sk last st, 9 sl sts on ch, ch 11, repeat from * to *. 5 sl sts on stem ch. Tack to flower. Make 20. Press on back. Sew 2 on each sleeve, bal. on front, following illustration.



No. 37—"Smart Tricks"

MATERIALS—Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton in White. Crochet hook size 10.

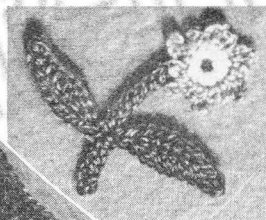
Ch 32, sk last 16 sts, sc in next 16 sts. Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 4, sc in next 3d sc) 5 times, (ch 4, sc) 6 times in next loop, ch 4, sc in next sc, (ch 4, sc in next 3d sc) 5 times. Ch 1, turn, sc in last loop, ch 3, dc in next, (ch 6, sl st in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 2, tr in next loop) twice, ch 6, p, ch 2, dtr in next loop, (ch 6, p, ch 2, tr tr in next loop) 3 times, (ch 6, p, ch 2, tr tr) 3 times in next loop, (ch 6, p, ch 2, tr tr in next loop) 3 times, ch 6, p, ch 2, dtr in next, (ch 6, p, ch 2, tr in next) twice, ch 6, p, ch 2, dc in next, ch 3, sc in next. Ch 1, turn, sc in sc, (ch 6, a 3-dc-Cluster in 6th st from hook, ch 1, for a scallop, dc between next 2 ps) twice, (a scallop, tr between next 2 ps) 3 times, (a scallop, dtr in next tr tr) 3 times, (a scallop, dtr) twice in next tr tr, (a scallop, dtr in next tr tr 3 times, (a scallop, tr in next tr) 3 times, a scallop, dc in next dc) twice, a scallop, sc across end, ch 10, turn, sl st at other end, ch 1, turn, 12 sc in 10-ch. Fasten off. Make a 2d piece. Stretch and pin right-side-down in true shape, wet with hot starch and press thru a cloth. **CORD**—Cut 3 strands 80" long, (double and twist tightly) twice. The loose end. Lace thru end loops and tie in bow knot.

No. 38—Trimming Edge

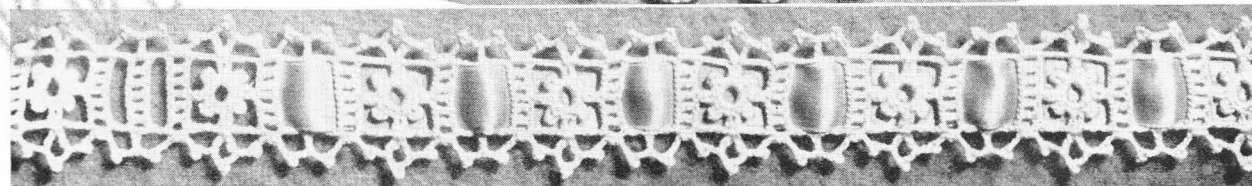
MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 5, in White and Royal Blue (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5.

In White, ch 6, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 3-ch. Fasten off. Make enough for desired length 1 16" apart. **TOP**—Join to 3d dc to right of end of row on 1 circle, ch 2, (sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next dc, hdc in 3d dc to right of end of row on next circle) repeated to end. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st. Ch 3, turn, dc in each st. Fasten off. In Blue repeat circles and Row 1 of Top. Starch backs and press flat. Sew together across top with Blue circles laid between White circles.

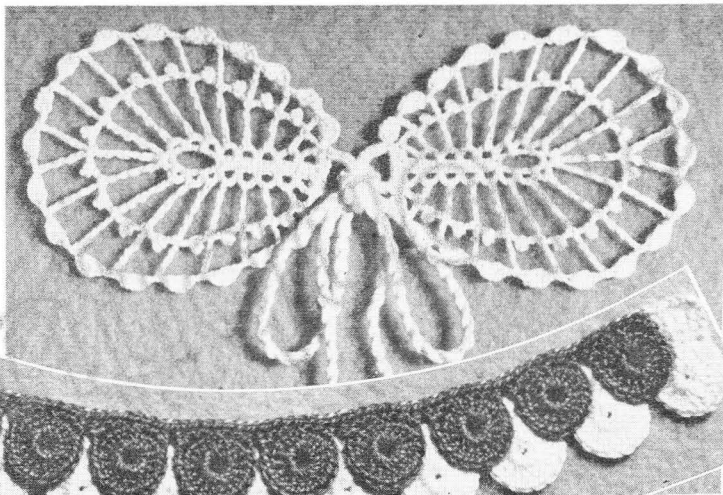

Ch 4, turn, dc in 2d st of 14-ch, (ch 1, dc in next 2d st) 5 times. ** Ch 20, remove hook, insert it back in 11th st (from hook end), catch loop and pull thru, ch 1, (sc, ch 5, 2 sc) in ring, ch 2, turn, sc in center dc of last row, ch 2, turn, (2 sc, ch 5, 2 sc) in ring, ch 2, turn, tr in 2d st of end 4-ch. Ch 1, turn, sc in tr, ch 2, 2 sc in ring, (ch 5, 2 sc in ring) 3 times, ch 2, sc in end ch-loop. Ch 11, turn, sc in 2d p, ch 5, tr in end sc. Ch 4, turn, sk tr, dc in next 2d st, (ch 1, dc in next 2d st) 5 times. Repeat from * to ** twice. Repeat from ** for desired length, ending with one repeat from * to **. **EDGE**—Ch 1, sc in end of last row, ch 8, sc in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 3, 3 sc in end of next 2d row. * (ch 5, p, ch 2, dc) twice in sc between next 2 sps, ch 5, p, ch 2, 3 sc in next narrow sp, ch 6, p, ch 2, dc in next 2d sp, ch 5, p, ch 3, 3 sc in next 2d sp. Repeat from * to end. Repeat on other side.

next, 2 sc in next) 8 times. Make 6 more rows with 1 more sc between widenings in each row (72 sc in final row). In Rows 8 and 9, put widenings between those in previous row. Sl st in next, ch 3, dc in 7 sc, (2 dc in next sc, dc in 8 sc) repeated around. Sl st in 3-ch. Ch 3 and in both loops, widen in every 5th st. In next row, widen in every 6th dc. (Ch 5, sc in next 4th dc) 27 times, ch 2, dc in next 4th dc. (Ch 5, sc in next loop) 28 times. Fasten off. **FLOWER**—In Sil-Tone and size 10 hook, * ch 9, tr in 9th st from hook, (ch 5, sc in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 1, tr) twice in same st with tr, ch 6, sl st in same st. Repeat from * 15 times. Roll up in 2 complete turns and tack. Make 2. Stretch and pin Brim right-side-down and wet with hot starch. Press thru cloth. Remove when dry, sew crown on top to loops on edge of Row 9, stuffing hard with cotton. Tie ribbon around crown. Tack flowers on bow.

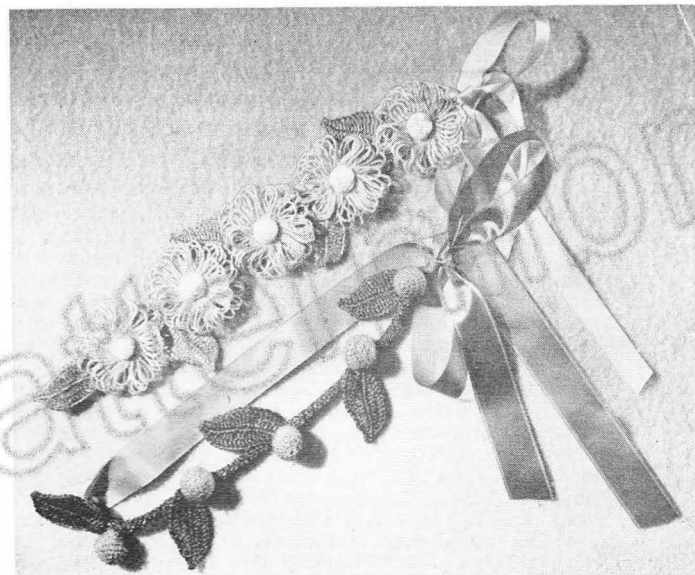
No. 40—2-pairs Curtain Tie Backs

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton size 5. Crochet hook size 5.

"A"—DAISY TIE BACKS—MATERIALS—1-ball each Orange and Mid Apple Green and 1/3-ball White (or other colors), for each pair. 3-yds. Ribbon 3/4" wide.

DAISY—FRILL—In Orange, ch 61, sk 1 st, 60 loop sts (see instructions) on ch. Fasten off. **BASE**—In Orange, ch 10 and join. Ch 1, 15 sc in ring. 2 sc in 1 loop of each sc. Cut 12" long. With this end and starting at last st, sew Frill to Base thru 1 loop of each st. When inside row on Base is reached, go thru each st on Base but thru every 2d st on Frill. **CENTER**—In White, ch 2, 7 sc in 1st st. (2 sc in 1 loop of next sc) 7 times. (1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) 7 times. Sc in 21 sc. (Sc in every 2d sc) 11 times. Stuff with cotton and close with sl sts. Sew in Daisy center. Make 10 flowers per pair. **LEAF**—In Green, ch 21, sk 1 st, * 1 sc, 1 hdc and 1 dc on ch, (tr in 3 sts, 2 tr in next) twice, (dc in 2 sts made into a Cluster) 3 times. 1 hdc and 1 sc on ch, * (sc, ch 3, sc) in end st. Repeat from * to * on other side of ch. Fasten off. Make 10. **BAND**—In Green, ch 10" long, 6 dc in 4th st, 1 dc in each st on both sides of ch, with 7 dc in other end. Join and fasten off. Make 2. Starch back of leaves and band and press flat. Sew 5 leaves and flowers on each band. Cut ribbon 21" and 33" long. Sew to ends.

"B"—CHERRY TIE BACKS—MATERIALS—1/4-ball each Scarlet and Shutter Green. 3-yds. ribbon. **CHERRY**—In Scarlet, ch 2, 7 sc in 1st st. In both loops, (2 sc in next sc) 7 times. (1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) 7 times. (Sc in 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 7 times. Sc in 56 sc (2 rows). (Sk 1 sc, sc in next 2 sc) repeated until a small opening is left,

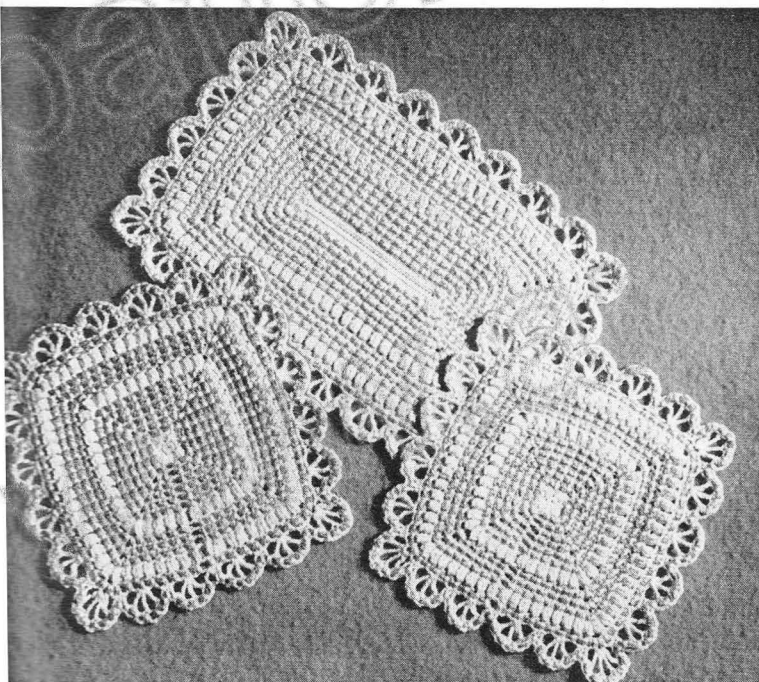


stuff with cotton and close with sl sts. Make 10 per pair. In Shutter Green, repeat leaves in "A" Tie Back. Make 10. **CORD**—In Green, ch 2, (2 sc, 1 hdc and 3 dc in 1st st, dc in back loops of these 6 sts around and around for 10". Close with 2 hdc, 2 sc and 2 sl sts. Fasten off. Make 2. Starch leaves. Sew 5 leaves and cherries on each cord. Cut ribbon 21" and 33" and sew to ends of cord.

No. 41—Hot Dish Mat Set

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton:—5-balls White size 5. Size 3:—1-ball each Nile Green and Dk. Lavender, and 2-balls Salmon Rose (or other colors). Crochet hook size 5.

SQUARE MAT—In White, ch 6, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, 8 sc in ring. In back loops, sl st in 1st sc, (1 hdc, 3 dc and 1 hdc in next sc, sc in next sc) 4 times, ch 2. **ROW 3**—Cut a cord of 8 strands Green 5-yds. long. Twist lightly. Hold



in front of 2-ch and make sc over cord into same st with last sc, * ch 2, (sc, ch 3, sc) over cord into next 3d (corner) st, ch 2, sc over cord into next 3d st. Repeat from * around. Drop cord at back, ch 2, sl st in 1st sc, ch 2. **ROW 4**—Bring up cord taut around in front of 2-ch and make sc over cord into same sc. Over cord, ch 2, sc in next sc, * ch 2, cord into same sc. Over cord, ch 2, sc in next sc, * ch 2, (sc, ch 3, sc) in corner sp, (ch 2, sc in next sc) 3 times. Repeat from * around, ending as in last row. **ROW 5**—Ch 2, bring cord in front, sc over cord in same sc, (ch 2, sc in next sc) twice, * ch 2, sc in next sp, (ch 2, sc in next sc) 5 times. Repeat from * around, ending as in Row 3. **ROW 6**—At corners, make (sc, ch 3, sc) in corner sc. **ROW 7**—Make corners as in Row 4. **ROW 8**—Make corners as in Row 5. Drop cord on back. **ROW 9**—Ch 3, 5 dc in same sc, remove hook, insert it back in ch st before dc, catch loop and pull thru (a popcorn st), (ch 3, a pc st in next sc) 4 times, ch 3, (a pc st, ch 4, a pc st) in corner sc. Complete row in same way, ch 2, sl st in 1st pc st. Draw up cord and make 2 rows over it with corners as in Row 4, and one row with Row 5 corners. Drop cord and make another pc st row. Bring up cord and make 1 row with Row 4 corners. Drop Cord. **EDGE**—Ch 1, * sc in next sp, (ch 3, tr) 3 times in next 2d sc, ch 3, sc in next 2d sp, sc in sc. Repeat from * around. At corners, ch 3, tr in corner sp, (ch 3, dtc) twice in same sp, ch 3, tr in same sp, ch 3, sc in next sp, sc in sc, sc in next sp. **ROW 2**—Bring up cord, * sc over it into next 3-ch sp, ch 2 sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in tr, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, sc in 2d sc between shells. Repeat from * around. At corners, sc in 1st sp, (ch 2, sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in dtr) twice, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, sc between shells. Tack cord ends on back. Make a 2d Mat with Lavender cord.

LARGE MAT—In White, ch 40, 2 sc in 2d st, sc in 37 sts, 3 sc in end st, 38 sc on other side of ch. In back loops, sl st in 1st sc. Ch 1, * (1 hdc, 3 dc and 1 hdc) in next sc, sc in 37 sc, (1 hdc, 3 dc and 1 hdc) in next sc. * 1 sc in next st. Repeat from * to *. Sl st in 1st ch. Cut a Salmon Rose cord 8-yds. long, ch 2, sc over cord in same st, * ch 2, (sc,

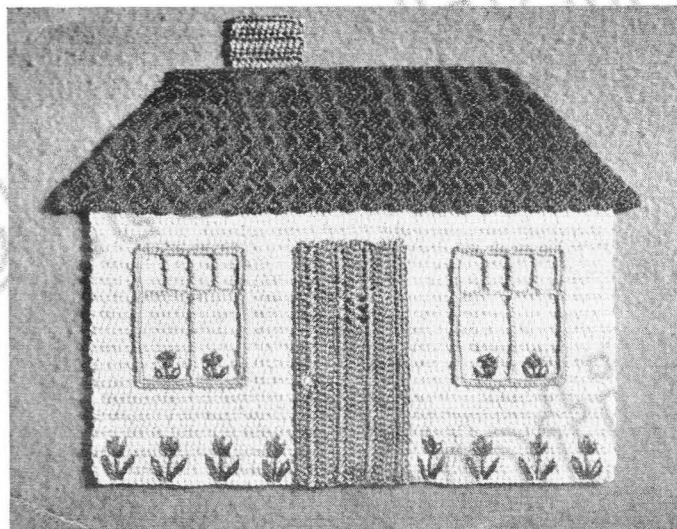
ch 3, sc) in next 3d st, (ch 2, sc in next 3d st) 13 times, ch 2, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next 3d st, ch 2, * sc in next 3d st. Repeat from * to *. Sl st in 1st sc. Continue as for Small Mat. Stretch and pin Mats right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

No. 42—High Chair Doily

MATERIALS—Lily Pearl Cotton, size 3:—4-balls Cream, 2-balls Emerald Green, and 1-ball each Golden Brown and Orange. 1-skein Lily Six Strand Floss in Red. Crochet hook size 3.

WALL—In Cream, ch 86, sk 2 sts, 84 hdc on ch. (Ch 2, turn, 84 hdc) repeated for 6¼". Fasten off. **ROOF**—In Green, ch 129, 3 dc in 5th st, sc in next 4th st, (ch 3, 3 dc in next st, sc in next 4th st) 24 times. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, turn, sc in 3-ch of last shell, (ch 3, 3 dc in same place, sc in 3-ch of next shell) repeated across (1 less shell than last row). Repeat 9 times. **ROW 12**—Ch 3, turn, sc in last shell, (hdc in 1st 2 dc of next shell, sc in next dc, sc in 3-ch) repeated across. Fasten off. Sew long side on top of Wall. **CHIMNEY**—In Brown, ch 13, sk 2 sts, 11 hdc on ch. (Ch 2, turn, 11 hdc) 4 times. Fasten off. Sew to top of roof 1¼" from left end. **DOOR**—In Brown, ch 42, sk 2 sts, 40 hdc on ch. (Ch 3, turn, dc in next 39 sts) twice. Ch 3, turn, dc in next 8 sts. (ch 1, turn, dc in next 2d st) 3 times, dc in next 25 sts. Ch 3, turn, 25 dc, (ch 1, dc in next dc) 3 times, 8 dc. (Ch 3, turn, 39 dc) twice. Ch 2, turn, 40 hdc. Turn over and sew on center of wall. Make an Orange French Knot door knob 2¾" from bottom. **WINDOW**—In Orange, ch 33, dtr in 18th st from hook, (ch 4, dtr in next 5th st) twice, ch 12, sl st in end st, ch 55, sl st in 5th st at other end. Ch 1, sc in next 7 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 19 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in 25 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in 19 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in 17 sts, sl st in 1st ch. Fasten off. Make 17-ch and tack from center dtr to bottom of window. Make 2 and sew on each side even with door top. In bottom of each half window, make a stem and 2 Lazy Daisy Stitch leaves in Green, with 4 Red French Knots. Across bottom of wall, make 4 Tulips on each side, Green leaves and stem, with 3 Red Lazy Daisy Stitch flower petals. Steam and press dry on back thru a cloth.

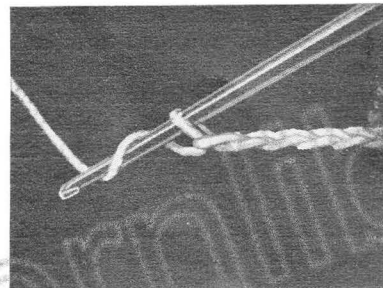
CHAIN STITCH (ch)—Make a loop on hook, * thread over hook, as illustrated, and draw thru loops already on hook. Repeat from * for desired length.

SLIP STITCH (sl st)—Insert hook in stitch, thread over hook and draw thru chain and loop on hook.

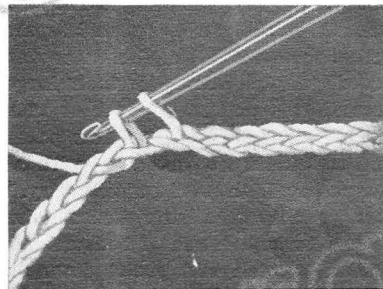
SINGLE CROCHET (sc)—Make a chain the desired length, insert hook in 2d chain from hook, or under both loops of a stitch on a row below, catch thread and pull thru, thread over and pull thru two loops on hook. Chain 1 to turn at end of row.

HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (hdc)—Make a chain desired length, turn,

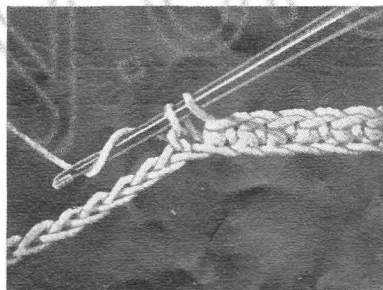
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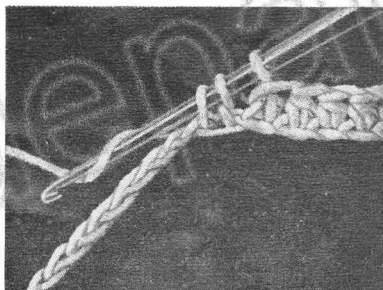

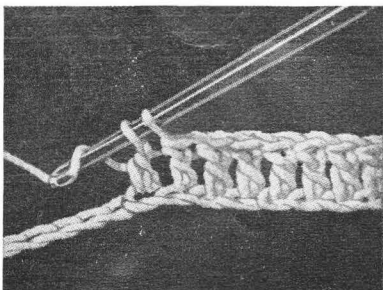

skip last 2 chain stitches, * thread over, insert hook in next stitch of chain, catch thread and pull thru, thread over and draw thru all 3 loops on hook at once. Repeat from * in each stitch on chain or in a stitch of preceding row. Chain 2 to begin a new row after turning work.

DOUBLE CROCHET (dc)—Make a chain desired length thread over insert hook in 4th chain from hook, catch thread and pull thru, (thread over and draw thru 2 loops) twice. * Thread over, insert hook in next stitch, catch thread and pull thru, (thread over and draw thru 2 loops) twice. Repeat from * to end of row. Ch 3 to turn.

BLOCKING DIRECTIONS

Bedspreads or other designs can be blocked after completion, or blocks can be pressed separately, then sewed together afterwards. For the latter method, cut a true cardboard pattern about an inch larger than block. Mark around this on tissue paper or muslin. Stretch and pin block right-side-down on this pattern on ironing board and steam thru a wet cloth with a hot iron, then press thru a dry cloth until perfectly dry. Where there are popcorn stitches or other raised stitches, pad ironing board with a turkish towel. If bedspread is blocked after completion, stretch and pin it down as a whole or in sections on a well padded flat surface. Be sure to pin out all picots, loops, scallops, etc., around outside edges. Steam and press in same way. When perfectly dry, remove pins.

Loop Stitch (lp st)—How To Make

Hold work between thumb and first finger, with thread passing over 1st and 2d fingers, lift 1st finger under thread, bend and bring finger forward and down under thread again, making a complete turn of thread around finger. Insert hook in next st, catch left-hand strand of thread above finger and pull thru, tightening thread loop around finger, thread over and pull thru 2 loops on hook for 1 sc to fasten loop st. Work tightly.

Crochet Stitches — Not Illustrated

TREBLE (tr)—Thread over twice and work off in twos as in dc.

DOUBLE TREBLE (dtr)—Thread over 3 times and work off in twos.

TRIPLE TREBLE (tr tr) Thread over 4 times and work off in twos.

LONG TREBLE (long tr)—Thread over specified number of times and work off in twos.

PICOT (p)—A Picot is made on a chain by working a sc in the specified st from hook, taking up 2 loops of ch st—the left-hand loop and the one back loop. A Picot is made following a sc, dc, tr, etc., by making the specified number of ch sts, then a sl st in side-top of st preceding chain.

PICOT-LOOP (p-loop)—This consists of a chain loop with one or more picots on it.

CLUSTER—This consists of 2 or more dc, tr, dtr, or tr tr gathered together at top into a tight group, as follows: Hold the last loop of each st on hook, then thread over and draw thru all loops on hook at once.

Stitches can be made thru either both loops of stitches of previous row or thru the back loops only. If not specified, take up both loops.

The term "fasten off" is used whenever the thread is to be cut 6 or 7 inches from the work, slipped thru the loop on hook, pulled tight, threaded to a sewing-needle and fastened securely on wrong side of work.

SKIP (sk).

After a piece of crochet is finished, stretch and pin it right-side-down on a padded ironing board and steam with a wet cloth and hot iron. Then press thru a dry cloth until thoroughly dry.

TO INCREASE IN CROCHET—Make 2 stitches in one. Always increase in 2nd stitch from edges.

TO DECREASE IN CROCHET—Before working off last loops, insert hook in next stitch and work off loops of both stitches together.

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
