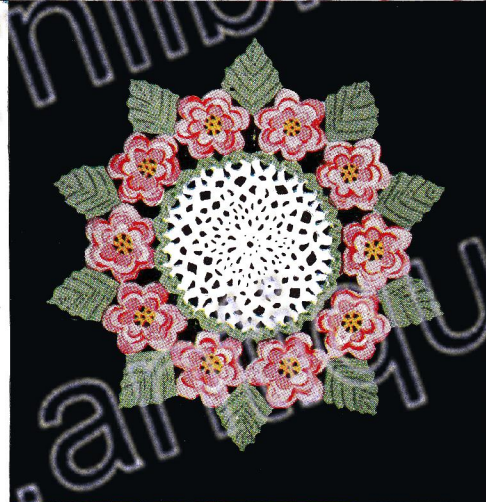
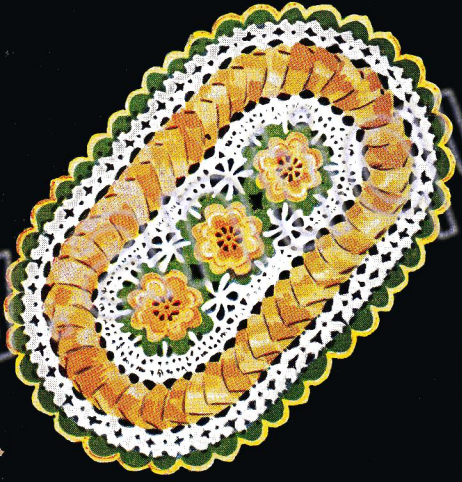

**ROSE:** With Yellow ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, \* ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch, cut thread. Attach Shaded Pinks in loop, 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c in same space, \* 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times, join.

**Next Row—\*** Ch 5, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* 5 times.

**Next Row—**Over each loop work 1 s c, 7 d c, 1 s c, join.

**Next Row—\*** Ch 7, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* all around.

**Next Row—**Over each loop work 1 s c, 2 d c, 5 tr c, 2 d c, 1 s c, join, cut thread. Work 9 more roses in same manner.

**CENTER:** With White ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 10 s c in ring, join.

**2nd Row—**Ch 3, 2 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, \* ch 3, cluster st in next s c (cluster st: 3 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), repeat from \* 8 times, ch 3, join.

**3rd Row—\*** Ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, s c in next cluster st, repeat from \* all around (20 loops).

**4th Row—**Sl st into loop, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ending row with ch 1, d c in same space as beginning (this brings thread in position for next row).

**5th Row—**Ch 3 (counts as part of 1st cluster st), cluster st in same space, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ending row with ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, join in 1st cluster st.

**6th Row—**Sl st into loop, \* ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around.

**7th Row—**Sl st into loop, ch 3 (counts as part of 1st cluster st), cluster st in same space, \* ch 5, 2 s c in next loop, ch 5, cluster st in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 5, 2 s c in next loop, ch 5, join.

**8th Row—**Sl st into loop, ch 1, 2 s c in same space, \* ch 7, 2 s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ending row with ch 3, tr c in 1st s c.

**9th Row—**Ch 3, cluster st in same space, ch 5, cluster st in same space, \* ch 1, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join, cut thread.

**10th Row—**Attach Green in the ch 1 between cluster sts, ch 4, cluster st in next ch 5 loop, ch 1, s c in center st of any petal of rose, \* ch 1, cluster st in same space on center, ch 4, s c in the ch 1 between next 2 cluster sts, ch 4, cluster st in next ch 5 loop, ch 1, s c in center st of next petal of same rose, ch 1, cluster st in same space on center, ch 4, s c in next ch 1 loop between next 2 cluster sts, ch 4, cluster st in next ch 5 loop, ch 1, join to center st of any petal of next rose, repeat from \* until all roses are joined ending row to correspond, join, cut thread.

**LEAF:** With Green ch 11, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts of ch, 3 s c in last st, working

on other side of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts.

**2nd Row—**Ch 2, turn, working through back loop of sts only, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c.

Repeat the 2nd row 5 times.

**Next Row—**Ch 1, turn, join to center st of 2nd free petal on right hand side of any rose (to join: drop loop from hook, insert in petal, pick up loop and pull through), skip 1 s c on leaf and working through back loop of sts only, 1 s c in each of the next 9 s c, join to center st of next free petal of same rose, s c in same space on leaf, join to center st of 1st free petal on left hand side of next rose, s c in same space on leaf, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, join to center st of next petal of same rose, ch 1, s c in next s c on leaf, cut thread. Work 9 more leaves joining between roses in same manner.

# Pansy Handkerchief #803

Illustrated on page 4

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATting CROCHET, Article 25.

1 ball Tinted Lavender and Yellow

1 ball Nile Green

1 Handkerchief

Steel crochet hook No. 13

**PANSY:** With Tinted Lavender and Yellow ch 9, join to form a ring, ch 3, 2 d c in ring, \* ch 6, 3 d c in ring, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 6, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row—**Sl st to next d c, \* 11 d c in next loop, s c in center d c of next d c group, repeat from \* 4 times, join.

**3rd Row—**Ch 1 and work 1 s c in each d c and 1 s c in each s c between petals, join.

**4th Row—\*** Ch 9, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* once, ch 1, turn, work 1 s c, 3 d c, 9 tr c, 3 d c, 1 s c over next ch 9 loop, sl st in sl st, 1 s c, 3 d c, 9 tr c, 3 d c, 1 s c over next ch 9 loop, sl st in same space with ch, ch 1, turn and work 1 s c in each st of the 2 large petals, cut thread. Work 1 more pansy in same manner.

**3rd Pansy—**Work 1st 3 rows same as 1st pansy.

**4th Row—\*** Ch 9, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* once, ch 1, turn and work 1 s c, 3 d c, 9 tr c, 3 d c, 1 s c over the ch 9 loop, sl st in sl st, 1 s c, 3 d c, 9 tr c, 3 d c, 1 s c over next ch 9 loop, sl st in same space with ch, ch 1, turn, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts, having the 2 large petals toward you, join to right hand side of 1st pansy at beginning of large petal, 1 s c in each remaining st of same large petal, 1 s c in each of the next 8 sts of next large petal, having the 2 large petals of 2nd pansy toward you, join to left hand side of 2nd pansy at beginning of large petal, 1 s c in each remaining st of same large petal, cut thread. Sew in position on corner of handkerchief as illustrated having the 2 large petals of end pansies extend over the handkerchief.

**Edge:** Attach Green at left hand side of corner and work a row of s c all around working 3 s c in each corner, turn.

**2nd Row—\*** Ch 5, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to corner having an even number of loops to corner, ch 5, s c in same space (corner), \* ch 5, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* around next 2 sides having an uneven number of loops on each side and working corners same as 1st corner, work 4th side same as 1st side, cut thread, turn.

Attach Tinted Lavender and Yellow in same space, ch 4, 4 d c cluster st in 1st loop (4 d c cluster st: 4 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), ch 3, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, 4 d c cluster st in next loop, ch 3, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, repeat from \* around to opposite side of flower, working 2 - 4 d c cluster sts with ch 5 between in each corner loop and ending row with ch 4, sl st in large petal of flower, cut thread.

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## Crocheted Edge for Plate #801

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON, Article 90, size 5**

**1 ball each White and Steel Blue  
1—7 inch plate**

**Steel crochet hook No. 5 or No. 6.**

Starting at inside edge of front of plate with White ch 174 about 20 inches, join to form a ring being careful not to twist ch, ch 6, skip 2 sts of ch, tr c in next st, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts of ch, tr c in next st, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join in 4th st of ch (58 meshes).

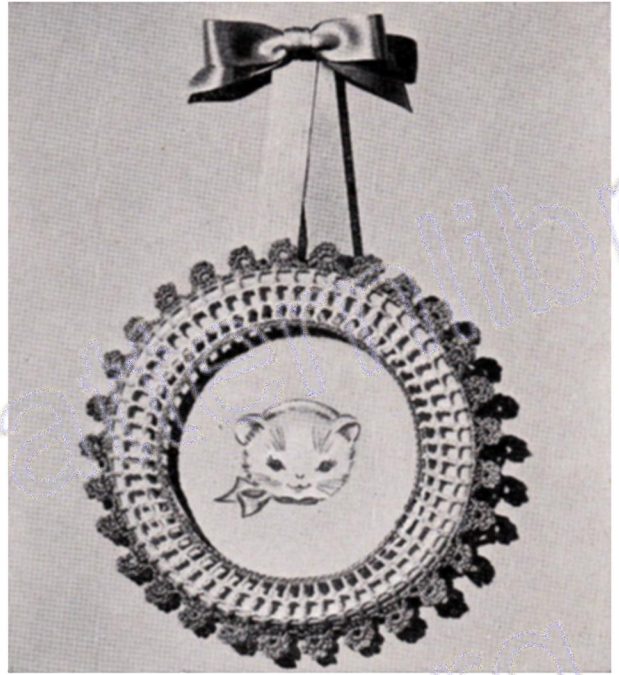
**2nd Row**—Ch 6, tr c in next tr c, \* ch 2, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join in 4th st of ch.

**3rd and 4th Rows**—Same as 2nd row.

**5th Row**—Ch 6, tr c in next tr c, \* ch 1, tr c in next tr c, ch 2, tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join. The last 2 rows go in back of plate.

**EDGE:** Attach Blue in any ch 2 mesh at top of 3rd row, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, ch 3, turn, skip 1 d c, s c in next st, ch 3, turn, s c over ch 3 loop just made, \* ch 3, s c in same space, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, 2 s c in next mesh of 3rd row, \*\* ch 2, 3 d c over next mesh, ch 3, turn, skip center d c, s c in next d c, ch 3, turn, s c over ch 3 loop just made, \* ch 3, s c in same space, repeat from \* twice, ch 2, 2 s c over next mesh at top of 3rd row, repeat from \*\* all around, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

Attach Blue in any ch 2 mesh of starting ch, 2 s c in same space, \* 2 s c over next mesh, repeat from \* all around, join, cut thread.



## Forget-Me-Not Handkerchief #802

Illustrated on page 4

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET, Article 25.**

**1 ball each Blue, Yellow and Nile Green.**

**1—Handkerchief**

**Steel crochet hook No. 13**

**FLOWER:** With Yellow, ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 10 s c in ring, join, cut Yellow.

Attach Blue, \* ch 4, 3 tr c in same space, ch 4, sl st in same space, 1 sl st in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from \* 4 times, join, cut thread. Work a 2nd flower joining it to 1st flower at center tip of any petal. Work a 3rd flower joining it to 2nd flower leaving 2 petals of 2nd flower free at lower edge. Lay the 3 flowers in front of you having the 2 petals at lower edge.

**4th Flower**—Work Yellow center. Attach Blue, ch 4, 1 tr c in same space, leaving 3 petals free at lower edge of left hand flower, join to 1st tr c at right hand side of next free petal, sl st in tr c just made, 2 tr c in same space of center, ch 4, sl st in same space, 1 sl st in each of the next 2 s c of center, ch 4, 3 tr c in same space, join to 3rd tr c, (left hand side) of free petal of center flower, sl st back into the tr c just made, ch 4, sl st in same space of center and complete other 3 petals same as other flowers. Work a 5th flower joining 1st petal to side of petal of previous flower, 2nd petal to right hand side of center flower and next petal to left hand side of 1st free petal of lower right hand flower as illustrated. Measure 1 inch on each of the 2 sides from corner of handkerchief and draw a line diagonally, turn under and baste. With Yellow, work 28 s c over the folded edge then work a row of s c around remainder of handkerchief working 3 s c in each corner, join, cut thread. Cut away extra material from underneath corner. To join flowers to corner attach Nile Green in same space, s c in next s c, holding the 3 flowers against corner, leave side petal of end flower free, sl st in center of next free petal of 1st flower, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, sl st in center of next petal of same flower, \* 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, sl st in center of 1st free petal of next flower, 1 s c in each of the next

5 s c, sl st in center of next petal of same flower, repeat from \* once, then work 1 s c in each s c around remainder of handkerchief, working 3 s c in center st at each of the 3 corners, join, cut thread.

Attach Blue at opposite side of flowers, \* ch 3, skip 2 s c, 3 d c in next s c, ch 3, sl st in top of last d c for picot, 2 d c in same space, ch 3, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, ch 5, sl st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 2, skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around to same place at opposite side of flowers, cut thread.

## Carnation #805

Illustrated on page 5

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "PURITAN" CROCHET COTTON, Article 40**

or

**"DE LUXE" CROCHET COTTON, Article 346**

**1 ball Kelly Green**

**2 balls Pink or color desired will make 5 flowers**

**Heavy flower Wire for Stems. Medium Wire for Leaves.**

**Steel crochet hook No. 5**

**Calyx:** With Green ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 10 s c in ring, join.

**2nd Row**—Ch 1 and work 2 s c in each s c, join (20 s c).

**3rd Row**—1 s c in each s c, join. Repeat the last row 5 times, cut thread.

**Next Row**—Attach Color, \* ch 9, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around (10 loops).

**Next Row**—Sl st into loop, ch 7 and work 29 d tr tr c (5 times over hook) in same space, \* 30 d tr tr c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, join in 7th st of ch.

**Next Row**—\* Ch 2, s c in next d tr tr c, repeat from \* all around, cut thread. If desired this last row may be worked with a contrasting color.

Fasten a knot in end of heavy wire and pull through calyx, fill calyx with cotton and sew together under the flower.

**LEAF:** With Green ch 50, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, working on other side of ch and over a 7 inch length of medium wire, leaving 2½ inches of wire free at lower edge, work 1 s c in each st, join, cut Green. Work 2 more leaves in same manner for each flower. Cover flower stem with a ½ inch strip of Green crepe paper and attach 1st leaf about 1½ inches from calyx and each of the next 2 leaves about 1 inch apart working down the stem.

Doll's clothes may be made with any of the AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY products listed below:

"GEM" CROCHET COTTON Article 35, size 30	} 1 ball Shaded Lt. Yellows or color desired	steel 4
Combined with		
"STAR" RAYON CROCHET Article 700	} 3 balls Buttercup or color desired	steel 4
or		
"DAWN" Med. Weight POMPADOUR Article W 31	} 3 balls Baby Green or color desired	plastic E same as size 1 or 2
¼ yd. Crinoline		
1 yd. narrow black velvet Ribbon		
1 bunch tiny Flowers		
1—7 Inch Doll		

If GEM and RAYON CROCHET COTTON are used, work with one strand of each throughout. If POMPADOUR is used work with single strand.

**DRESS:** Bodice, ch 38, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining st of ch, ch 3 to turn all rows.

**Next 2 Rows**—1 d c in each d c.

**4th Row**—1 d c in each of the next 5 d c, turn. Work 5 more rows even in d c, cut thread leaving a length. With wrong side of work toward you, skip 24 d c of 3rd row, attach thread in next st, ch 3 and work same as opposite side. Bring side section forward to 3rd row, leaving 6 sts free at center for neck edge and 3 sts free on both sides for armholes and sew.

**SKIRT:** With bodice facing downward and working on opposite side of starting ch, attach thread in 1st st, ch 5, d c in next st, \* ch 2, skip 1 st, d c in next st, repeat from \* across row (18 meshes, beading) ch 4, turn.

**2nd Row**—1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in next mesh, \* ch 1, d c in next d c, ch 1, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in next mesh, repeat from \* across row ending row with ch 1, skip 1 st of end loop, d c in next st, ch 4, turn.

**3rd Row**—\* Skip 1 loop, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in next ch 2 loop, ch 1, skip next ch 1 loop, shell in next d c, ch 1, repeat from \* across row ending row with skip 1 st of end loop, d c in next st, ch 4, turn.

**4th Row**—Shell in next shell, ch 1, d c in next ch 1 loop, ch 1, repeat from beginning across row ending row with skip 1 st of last loop, d c in next st, ch 4, turn.

**5th Row**—\* Shell in next shell, ch 1, skip next ch 1 loop, d c in next d c, ch 1, repeat from \* across row ending row with skip 1 st of last loop, d c in next st, ch 4, turn. Repeat last row 10 times, cut thread.

**SLEEVES:** With right side of work toward you, attach thread in back of armhole, ch 3 and work 31 d c around entire armhole, join, ch 3, turn.

**2nd Row**—1 d c in each d c, join, ch 3, turn.

**3rd Row**—1 d c in each d c, join, do not turn.

**4th Row**—Sl st in every other st, join, cut thread. Work other sleeve in same manner.

**BONNET:** Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 15 d c in ring, join, ch 3, turn.

**2nd Row**—1 d c in each d c, join, turn.

**3rd Row**—Ch 3, d c in same space, \* 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around ending row with d c in last d c, join, do not turn.

**4th Row**—Work in same manner as last row, join, ch 5, turn.

**5th Row**—Skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 1, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 11 times, ch 3, turn.

**6th Row**—1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in 1st mesh, \* 1 d c in next

mesh, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in next mesh, repeat from \* 5 time, d c in 3rd st of ch of last mesh, ch 3, turn.

**7th Row**—Shell in next ch 2 loop, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from beginning across row ending row with d c in 3rd st of ch, ch 3, turn.

**8th Row**—6 d c in next shell, skip the 2 d c of same shell, s c in next d c, repeat from beginning across row working last s c in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

**BASKET:** Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 11 d c in ring, join, ch 3, turn.

**2nd Row**—D c in same space, 2 d c in each remaining st, join, ch 3, turn.

**3rd Row**—1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, \* 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join, ch 3, turn.

**4th Row**—D c in same space, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, \* skip 1 d c, shell in next d c, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch.

**5th Row**—\* 6 d c in next shell, skip 2 d c of same shell, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around.

**Next Row—Handle,** ch 26, skip four 6 d c groups, sl st in next s c, \* ch 4, working along ch, skip 4 sts, sl st in next st, repeat from \* once, ch 5, skip 5 sts, sl st in next st, \* ch 4, skip 4 sts, sl st in next st, repeat from \* once, sl st in joining of previous row, cut thread.

**Finishing**—Place dress on doll and sew skirt and 4 rows of bodice together. Lace ribbon through beading and tie with bow. Cut 1 - 12 inch length of ribbon and lace through beading of bonnet. Place bonnet on doll's head and sew to hair. Tie ribbon as illustrated. Fill basket with flowers and slip center loop of handle on hand. Lace remainder of ribbon through beading at waist line and tie in bow.

**SAUCER:** With Green ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 3, 11 d c in ring, join.

**2nd Row**—\* Ch 3, s c in next d c, repeat from \* 11 times.

**3rd Row**—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 2 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, \* ch 3, cluster st in next loop (cluster st; 3 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join in 1st cluster st.

**4th Row**—Ch 1 and work 7 s c over each loop, join.

**5th Row**—\* Ch 4, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, ch 4, skip 3 s c, s c in space over next cluster st, repeat from \* all around (24 loops).

**6th Row**—Sl st into loop, ch 1, 3 s c in same loop, \* ch 1, 3 s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join in 1st s c, cut Green.

**7th Row**—Attach Shaded Yellows in center s c of any s c group, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, s c in center s c of next s c group, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in center s c of next s c group, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 3, s c in center s c of next s c group, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch.

**8th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, 10 tr c in center of next shell, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in center of next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 3, 10 tr c in center of next shell, ch 3, join.

**9th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, 1 tr c in each tr c with ch 1 between each tr c, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**10th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3 (count as part of 1st shell), shell in same space, \*\* ch 3, s c between 1st 2 tr c, \* ch 4, s c between next 2 tr c, repeat from \* 7 times, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**11th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \*\* ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 6 times, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**12th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \*\* ch 3, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in center of next shell, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**13th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, shell in next ch 2 loop, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, then work 5 loops across pineapple, ch 3, shell in next ch 2 loop, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**14th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \* ch 2, shell in next loop, ch 2, shell in next shell, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, work 4 loops across pineapple, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**15th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, shell in next shell, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, shell in next shell, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, work 3 loops across pineapple, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**16th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \* ch 4, cluster st in next s c, ch 4, shell in next shell, ch 4, cluster st in next s c, ch 4, shell in next shell, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, work 2 loops across pineapple, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**17th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \* ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, shell in next shell, repeat from \* once, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**18th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, shell in same space, \* ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 4, shell in shell, repeat from \* once, ch 3, s c in remaining loop of pineapple, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from 1st \* all around, ending row to correspond, join, cut thread.

**19th Row:** Attach Green in center of 1st shell, ch 3 (count as part of 1st cluster st), cluster st in same space, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, cluster st in next loop, ch 3, sl st in top of cluster st for picot, repeat from \* once, ch 4, s c in center of next shell, \* ch 4, cluster st in next loop, picot, ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* once, ch 4, cluster st in next shell, picot, cluster st in next shell, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join, cut thread.

**CUP:** Work 1st 7 rows same as saucer.

**8th Row**—Same as 8th row of saucer but having 8 tr c in every other shell instead of 10 tr c.

**9th Row**—Same as 9th row of saucer.

**10th Row**—Same as 10th row of saucer but having 6 — ch 4 loops across each pineapple.

**11th Row**—Same as 11th row of saucer but having 2 loops less across each pineapple.

**12th Row**—Same as last row but having 1 loop less across each pineapple.

**13th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \*\* ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in center of next shell, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**14th Row**—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \*\* ch 3, shell in next loop, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, \* ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from \* once, ch 3, skip 1 loop, shell in next loop, repeat from \*\* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**15th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 2, shell in next loop, ch 2, shell in next shell, ch 3, s c in 1st loop of pineapple, ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**16th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, shell in same space, \* ch 3, cluster st in next loop, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from \* once, ch 3, s c in remaining loop of pineapple, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join, cut thread. Attach Green and work edge same as on saucer.

**HANDLE:** With Green ch 35 rather tightly, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

**2nd Row**—1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, 3 d c in next s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c, cut thread leaving an end. Sew to side of cup as illustrated.

## DIRECTIONS FOR STARCHING

Dissolve  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup starch in  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of cold water. Boil about 1 cup of water, remove from flame, then slowly stir the starch mixture into boiling water stirring constantly. Place back on flame until it thickens. As soon as starch is cool enough to handle, dip cup and saucer and squeeze starch through them thoroughly. Wring out extra starch. The article should be wet with starch but there should be none in the spaces. Place saucer over a china saucer to curve slightly and cup over a small custard cup or tumbler and let dry.

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING CROCHET, Article 25**

**3 balls Shaded Pinks**

**2 balls Hunter Green**

**1 spool covered Wire. 1 bunch Yellow Stamens**

**Steel crochet hook No. 13.**

**PETAL:** With Shaded Pinks ch 2, 3 s c in 2nd st from hook, ch 1 to turn each row.

**2nd Row**—2 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c.

**Next 4 Rows**—1 s c in each s c.

**7th Row**—Increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row, then work 2 rows even. Repeat the last 3 rows once.

**13th Row**—Increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row then work 1 row even.

**15th Row**—Increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row then work 5 rows even (13 s c).

**21st Row**—Decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of row (to decrease: \* insert hook in next st, pull loop through, repeat from \* once, thread over and pull through all loops at one time).

**22nd Row**—Work even.

**23rd Row**—Skip 1 s c, s c in next s c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 s c, sl st in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 3 s c, s c in next s c, ch 1 and without cutting thread, work a row of s c down left hand side, around lower edge and up right hand side, do not work across top, cut thread. Work 4 more petals in same manner.

Using 4 Yellow Stamens, double in half and wrap a 6 inch length of thin wire around lower edge several times to hold in place, leave remainder of wire for stem. Place the 5 petals of flower around stamens laping 1 petal half way over the previous petal as illustrated.

Tie securely with thread wrapping thread around lower edge about 15 times about 1/4 inch from lower edge of petals.

**CALYX:** With Green ch 8, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 12 s c in ring, join.

**Next 2 Rows**—1 s c in each s c, do not join these or remainder of rows.

**4th Row**—Working in s c, increase in every other st (18 s c). Work 3 rows even.

**8th Row**—Increase in every 6th s c, then work 3 rows even.

**Next Row**—\* Ch 12, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in next st of ch, 1 s d c in each of the next 9 sts of ch (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), \* insert hook in next s c, pull loop through, repeat from \* twice, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, repeat from \* 6 times, join, cut thread.

Pull stem through center of calyx and place calyx in position.

Work 7 more flowers in same manner.

**LEAF:** Starting at lower edge with Green ch 4, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows.

**2nd Row**—1 s c in each s c. Repeat the 2nd row twice.

**5th Row**—Working in s c, increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row, then work 1 row even.

**7th Row**—Increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row, then work 2 rows even.

**10th Row**—Increase 1 s c at beginning and end of row.

**11th Row**—Work even. Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times (17 s c in last row).

**Next 4 Rows**—Work even.

**24th Row**—Decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of row.

**25th Row**—Work even. Repeat the last 2 rows twice.

**Next 4 Rows**—Decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of each row. Work 1 row even.

**Next Row**—Insert hook in 1st s c, pull loop through, \* insert hook in next s c, pull loop through, repeat from \* once, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, cut thread. Holding the Green covered spool wire around outside edge, attach Green at lower edge and work a row of s c around entire leaf working over the wire and leaving about 4 inches of wire free on each side at lower edge.

Work 2 more leaves in same manner.

Twist all wires together to form a corsage placing leaves as desired.

## Chrysanthemum #809

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DE LUXE" CROCHET COTTON, Article 346**

or

**"PURITAN" CROCHET COTTON, Article 40**

**2 balls Yellow or color desired**

**2 artificial or natural Leaves**

**1 corsage Pin.**

**Steel crochet hook No. 7**

**CENTER SECTION:** 1st Row—Ch 8, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 15 d c in ring, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row**—Ch 20, 1 s d c in 3rd st from hook (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), 1 s d c in each of the next 17 sts of ch (petal), s c under the post of 1st d c picking up entire post of st, \* ch 20, s d c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 17 sts of ch, s c under post of next d c picking up entire post of st, repeat from \* 14 times, join (16 petals).

**3rd Row**—\* Ch 20, s d c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 17 sts of ch, repeat from \* once (double petals), s c in front loop of 1st d c made, \* work a double petal, s c in front loop of next d c, repeat from \* 14 times, join (16 double petals).

**4th Row**—Same as last row but working an s c in back loop of each d c (16 double petals) cut thread.

**BACK SECTION:** Work 1st row same as center section.

**2nd Row**—Ch 3, d c in same space, \* 2 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join (32 d c).

**3rd Row**—Ch 3, d c in same space, 1 d c in next d c, \* 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join.

**4th Row**—Ch 22, 1 s d c in 3rd st from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 19 sts of ch, s c under post of 1st d c of 3rd row picking up entire post, \* ch 22 and work 20 s d c on ch, s c under post of next d c of 3rd row picking up entire post, repeat from \* 46 times, join.

**5th Row**—Work a double petal same length as previous row, s c in front loop of 1st d c of 3rd row, \* work a double petal same length as last petal, s c in front loop of next d c of 3rd row, repeat from \* all around, join, cut thread.

Place center section on inside of back section and sew securely.

Place 2 leaves in back of flower and sew securely in position. Sew corsage pin in position.

## Daisy Corsage #810

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "GEM" CROCHET COTTON, Article 35, size 30.**

or

**"STAR" CROCHET COTTON, Article 20 or 30, size 30**

**1 ball each White and Yellow**

**3 artificial Leaves**

**3—6 inch strips of Wire**

**Green Crepe Paper.**

**Steel crochet hook No. 12**

**DAISY:** With Yellow, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 17 d c in ring, join, cut thread.

**PETAL:** With White, ch 14, insert hook in any d c, pull loop through, ch 1, 1 s c in next st of ch, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 d c in each of the next 9 sts, 6 s d c in end st, working on opposite side of ch, 1 d c in each of the next 9 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s c in next st, sl st in same d c, cut thread. Work a petal in each remaining d c. Work 2 more daisies in same manner.

Cover each wire with 1/2 inch strip of Green crepe paper. Sew center back of daisy to one end of wire. Tie wires together and attach leaves. Cover tied section with crepe paper.

**1 additional ball Shaded Yellows is needed to make both mats.**

**Steel crochet hook No. 7.**

## SMALL MAT OR COVER

With Shaded Yellows ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, \* ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row**—Over each loop work 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c, join.

**3rd Row**—\* Ch 5, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* 7 times.

**4th Row**—Over each loop work 1 s c, 7 d c, 1 s c, join.

**5th Row**—\* Ch 6, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* all around, cut thread.

**6th Row**—Attach Green and work 1 s c, 1 d c, 7 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c over each loop, join, cut thread.

**2nd FLOWER:** Work 1st 5 rows same as 1st flower.

**Next Row**—Attach Green and work 1 s c, 1 d c, 4 tr c in same loop, join to center st of any Green petal of 1st flower (to join: slip loop off hook, insert in center st of petal of 1st flower, pick up loop and pull through), 3 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c in same space of 2nd flower, 1 s c, 1 d c, 4 tr c in next loop of 2nd flower, join to center st of next petal of 1st flower, 3 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c in same space of 2nd flower, finish row same as 1st flower. Work 3rd flower in same manner, joining to 2 center petals of 2nd flower leaving 2 petals free at top and lower edge between joinings, cut thread.

Attach White between the 3rd and 4th free petal of end flower, ch 7, \* s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, tr c between petals, ch 3, repeat from \* once, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, tr c between next 2 petals keeping last loop of tr c on hook, tr c in joining keeping last loop of tr c on hook, tr c between next 2 petals of next flower, keeping last loop of tr c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time (a tr c cluster), ch 3, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, tr c between petals, ch 3, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, work a tr c cluster between flowers, \* ch 3, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, tr c between petals, repeat from \* 4 times, ch 3, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, ch 3, tr c cluster between flowers, finish row to correspond joining last ch 3 in 4th st of ch.

**2nd Row**—Sl st into loop, ch 6, d c in same space, \* ch 1, 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c (shell) in next loop, repeat from \* 6 times, ch 1, 1 tr c, ch 3, 1 tr c in tr c cluster, skip the ch 3 loop, \* ch 1, shell in next loop, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 1, 1 tr c, ch 3, 1 tr c in next tr c cluster, skip the ch 3 loop, \* ch 1, shell in next loop, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 1, 1 tr c, ch 3, 1 tr c in next tr c cluster, skip the ch 3 loop, \* ch 1, shell in next loop, repeat from \* 7 times, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch.

**3rd Row**—Sl st into shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in next shell, repeat from \* all around, join.

**4th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, \* ch 7, s c in center of next shell, repeat from \* all around, cut White.

**5th Row**—Attach Shaded Yellows in any loop, ch 3, 5 d c, ch 3, 6 d c over same loop, \* 6 d c, ch 3, 6 d c over next loop, repeat from \* all around, join.

**6th Row**—Ch 3, 1 d c in each d c and 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c in each ch 3 loop, join.

**7th Row**—Ch 4, 1 tr c in each d c and 2 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in each ch 3 loop, join, cut thread.

**8th Row**—Attach White in ch 3 loop, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 1, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in next ch 3 loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join.

**9th Row**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 3 d c in same space, \* ch 1, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c (shell) in center of next shell, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join, cut thread.

**10th Row**—Attach Green in center of shell, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 2, 3 d c in same space, ch 1, s c in the ch 1 between shells, \* ch 1, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c in center of next shell, ch 1, s c in the ch 1 between shells, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join, cut thread.

**11th Row**—Attach Shaded Yellows in any s c, \* ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 3 d c of next shell, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in center of same shell, 1 s c in each of the next 3 d c of same shell, ch 1, s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around, join, cut thread.

The following directions are for a 7x12 oval rack cover:

**Casing:** With wrong side of work toward you, attach White between shells of 9th row, \* ch 7, s c in the ch 1 between next 2 shells, repeat from \* all around.

**Next Row**—Sl st to center of loop, \* ch 7, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around.

**Next Row**—Same as last row but having 5 chs in each loop, cut thread.

## LARGE MAT OR COVER

Work flowers for center same as small mat but working 4 flowers instead of 3 and joining in same manner.

Attach White and work in same manner as 1st row of small mat working over 3rd flower same as over 2nd flower and working a tr c cluster between 3rd and 4th flowers.

**2nd Row**—Same as 2nd row of small mat but working shells across 3rd flower same as across 2nd flower and working 1 tr c, ch 3, 1 tr c in the tr c cluster between the 3rd and 4th flowers.

**3rd Row**—Same as 3rd row of small mat.

**4th & 5th Rows**—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c (shell) in center of next shell, repeat from \* all around, join.

Repeat the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th rows of small mat.

**12th Row**—Same as last row, cut White.

**Next Row**—Attach Green and work same as 10th row of small mat.

**Next Row**—Attach Shaded Yellow and work same as 11th row of small mat.

The following directions are for a 10x15½ oval rack cover:

**CASING:** Work same as for small cover attaching thread in 10th row, but having 3 rows of 7 ch loops instead of 2 rows.

# Tea Cozy #811

**Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED, Article W 11 or W 41**

**3 ozs. Amber**

**1 oz. White**

**1 oz. Golf Green**

**Any assorted colors for Flowers.**

**1 teapot measuring about 20 inches in circumference and about 7 inches in height not including knob.**

**Plastic crochet hook No. 5 or G.**

With White ch 36 rather loosely, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch (35 s c), drop White.

**2nd Row**—Attach Amber, ch 1, turn, s c in 1st s c, \* cluster st in next s c (cluster st: 3 tr c in same space leaving last loop of each tr c on hook, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time), s c in next s c, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn.

**3rd Row**—1 s c in each s c and 1 s c in each cluster st (35 s c), drop Amber, turn. When changing color always complete last half of st with next color.

**4th Row**—Pick up White, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

**5th Row**—1 s c in each s c, drop White, turn.

# Corn Pot Holder #814

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED, Article W 11 or W 41  
 1 oz. each of White, Amber and Golf Green  
 1 pr. knitting needles No. 7  
 Bone crochet hook No. 4

Starting at lower edge with White cast on 56 sts and K 1 row. Join Amber.

**Next Row**—\* With White K 7, drop White, pick up Amber and K 7, repeat from \* across row crossing yarn firmly at back of work.

**Next Row**—\* With White K 7, pass White under needle

and with Amber K 7, repeat from \* across row.

Repeat these 2 rows alternating the colors until work measures 8 inches from the beginning, bind off leaving an end. Thread into needle and draw together inserting needle through every 7th st. Work other end in same manner. Sew sides together for 1 inch at top and lower end.

**LEAVES:** With Green ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 2, work \* 1 s d c in ring (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in ring, pull through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), ch 18, sl st in 18th st from hook, repeat from \* 5 times, join in 2nd st of ch, cut yarn.

Sew to top of holder as illustrated.

**RING:** With Green cover a bone ring with s c and attach to top of holder.

With Cream ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, \* ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from \* 5 times, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row**—\* Ch 4, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around (8 loops).

**3rd Row**—Sl st into loop, \* ch 7, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts of ch (s d c: thread over hook, insert in space, pull through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts of ch, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around.

**4th Row**—1 s c in each of the 5 sts on side of petal, 3 s c in point of petal, 5 s c down other side of petal, repeat from beginning all around, join, cut thread.

**5th Row**—Attach Green in point of petal, 3 s c in same space, \* 1 s d c in each of the next 2 s c, d c in next s c, thread over hook twice, insert hook in last s c on side of petal and work off 2 loops twice, thread over hook once, insert in 1st s c on side of next petal and work off all loops 2 at a time, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 s c, 3 s c in next s c (top of petal), repeat from \* all around in same manner, join.

**6th Row**—Ch 3, \* 3 d c in next s c, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from \* all around in same manner, join in 3rd st of ch, cut thread.

**7th Row**—Attach Cream in center st at point, ch 1 and work 3 s c in same space, \* 1 s c in each of the next 5 sts, ch 9, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 sts of ch, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts of ch, skip 1 st of previous row, 1 s c in each of the next 5 sts, 3 s c in next st, repeat from \* all around in same manner, join.

**8th Row**—Ch 1 and work 1 s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, \* skip 1 s c and work 7 s c up side of petal, 3 s c in point of petal, 7 s c down other side of petal, skip 1 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 11 s c, repeat from \* all around in same manner ending row with 1 s c in each of the last 4 s c, join, cut thread.

**9th Row**—Attach Green in center st at point of petal and work 3 s c in same space, \* s c in next s c, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 s c, d c in next s c, thread over hook twice, skip 2 s c, insert in next s c, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops twice, thread over hook once, insert in next s c, pull through and work off all loops 2 at a time, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, s d c in next s c, s c in next s c, s d c in next s c, d c in next s c, skip 2 s c, thread over hook twice, insert in next st, pull through and work off 2 loops twice, thread over hook once, insert in next s c, pull through and work off all loops 2 at a time, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c on side of next petal, 1 s d c in each of the next 3 s c, s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around in same manner, join.

**10th Row**—Ch 3 and work 3 d c in center st at top of each petal and 1 d c in each remaining st.

**11th Row**—Ch 3, \*\* 3 d c in next st (point), 1 d c in each of the next 10 sts, \* thread over hook, insert in next st,

pull through and work off 2 loops, repeat from \* once, thread over and work off all loops at one time (a decrease at base of scallop), 1 d c in each of the next 9 d c, repeat from \*\* all around in same manner, cut thread.

Work another section in same manner.

With Green sew the 2 sections together. With Green cover a bone ring with s c and sew to top of holder.

**ROSE:** Using a single strand of thread, with Shaded Pinks ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, \* ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

**Next Row**—Sl st into loop, 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c in same space, \* 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from \* 4 times, join.

**Next Row**—\* Ch 5, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* 5 times.

**Next Row**—Over each loop work 1 s c, 7 d c, 1 s c, join.

**Next Row**—\* Ch 7, sl st in back of work between next 2 petals, repeat from \* all around.

**Next Row**—Over each loop work 1 s c, 2 d c, 5 tr c, 2 d c, 1 s c, join, cut thread. Sew Rose to front of potholder as illustrated.

## Hosiery Hanger #817

Illustrated on page 13

**Materials Required:** AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" BLEND YARN, Article 75

1 skein each Lt. Green and Cerise will make 2 hangers.

6 plastic clip Clothespins

1 metal Hanger

Steel crochet hook No. 0

With Light Green, starting at top of hook work a row of s c around entire hanger having 128 s c across lower edge, cut yarn.

**2nd Row**—Attach Cerise, s c in same space, ch 2, sl st in top of s c for picot, \* 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, ch 2, sl st in top of last s c for picot, repeat from \* all around, cut yarn.

Attach Cerise between 4th and 5th picots at lower edge, \* ch 6, s c in top of 1 side of clothespin pulling loop through the hole of clothespin and also pulling loop up about 1/2 inch, ch 3, s c through hole at top of opposite side of same clothespin, ch 6, skip 4 picots of last row, sl st between last skipped picot and next picot, repeat from \* 5 times, cut yarn.

**FLOWER:** With Cerise ch 2, 6 s c in 2nd st from hook, join in 1st s c, ch 3, 2 tr c in same space, ch 3, sl st in same space, \* sl st in next s c, ch 3, 2 tr c in same space, ch 3, sl st in same space, repeat from \* 4 times, cut yarn. Work another flower in same manner.

**LEAVES:** \* With Green ch 12, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s d c in next st of ch (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time), 1 d c in each of the next 6 sts, 1 s d c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, do not cut yarn, repeat from \* 3 times, cut yarn. Sew on hanger as illustrated having 2 leaves on each side and the 2 flowers in the center.

## TERRY CLOTH LAUNDRY BAG # 815

With right side of loops of 1st row toward you and working around lower edge of bag, attach thread in picot above joining of two cloths, shell in center st of 1st loop, \* shell in center st of next loop, repeat from \* to opposite side, sl st in picot above joining, cut thread, do not turn.

**Next Row**—Attach thread in 1st tr c of 1st shell around lower edge, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in loop of same shell, \* skip 2 tr c, sl st in next tr c, ch 3, sl st in same space, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in loop of next shell, repeat from \* all around to opposite side ending row with sl st in last tr c of lower edge, cut thread.

Fold corners down as illustrated, attach thread at one end where cloths are joined and work a row of loops all around folded edge.

**2nd Row**—Sl st to center of loop and work a shell in center st of each loop, join.

**3rd Row**—Sl st to center of shell, \* ch 7, s c in loop

of next shell, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, tr c in last sl st.

**4th Row**—Ch 4, tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in tr c of previous row, \* shell in center st of next loop, repeat from \* all around, join. Repeat the 3rd and 4th rows once then repeat the 3rd row once.

**8th Row**—Working over hoop, \* ch 15, bring ch backward, s c in next loop, ch 15, bring ch forward, s c in next loop, repeat from \* all around in same manner ending row to correspond, join, cut thread.

**Handle - Beading:** Crochet a ch 25 inches or a little longer than length desired, s c in 2nd st from hook, \* ch 7, skip 7 sts of ch, d tr c (3 times over hook) in next st, repeat from \* until beading measures 23 inches, ch 7, skip 7 sts, s c in next st, cut off remainder of ch, do not turn.

**2nd Row**—Ch 4, \* shell in center st of next loop, repeat from \* to last loop, ch 4, s c in s c, working on other side of beading, ch 4, \* shell in center st of next shell, repeat from \* to last loop, ch 4, sl st in s c, do not turn.

**3rd Row**—4 s c in 1st loop, 1 s c in each of the next 2 tr c, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in loop of shell, \* skip 2 tr c, sl st in next tr c, ch 3, sl st in same space, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in loop of next shell, repeat from \* to last shell of 1st side, 1 s c in each of the next 2 tr c of same shell, 4 s c in next loop, s c in s c, 4 s c in next loop, 1 s c in each of the 1st 2 tr c of next shell, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in loop of same shell, continue all around in same manner ending row to correspond, join, cut thread. Lace ribbon through beading and sew to each end of hoop.

With White ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 4, \* 3 d c in ring, ch 1, repeat from \* twice, 2 d c in same space, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row**—Ch 1, \* 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in next ch 1 loop, 2 s c in each of the next 3 d c, repeat from \* all around, join in 1st s c.

**3rd Row**—Ch 3, 2 d c in loop, ch 4, 3 d c in same loop, \* ch 3, 3 d c, ch 4, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch.

**4th Row**—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, 3 d c, ch 4, 3 d c in next loop, ch 3, skip 2 d c, 3 d c in next d c, skip the ch 3 loop, 3 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch.

**5th Row**—Ch 3, 2 d c over same space, \* ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, 3 d c, ch 5, 3 d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, 3 d c between next two 3 d c groups, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch.

**6th Row**—Sl st to next d c, ch 7, \* skip next d c, d c in next d c, ch 4, d c in center d c of next d c group, ch 4, d c in next loop, ch 5, d c in same loop, ch 4, d c in center d c of next d c group, ch 4, d c in next d c, ch 4, d c in center d c of next d c group, ch 4, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**7th Row**—Ch 3, \* 4 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, repeat from \* twice, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, \* 4 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, repeat from \* once, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**8th Row**—Ch 7, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 4, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* once, ch 4, 1 d c,

ch 7, 1 d c in next loop, ch 4, skip 3 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 4, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 3 times, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**9th Row**—Ch 3, \* 4 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 3 times, 4 d c, ch 3, 4 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, \* 4 d c in next loop, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 3 times, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**10th Row**—Ch 7, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, \* ch 4, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* twice, ch 4, d c in next loop, ch 5, d c in same loop, \* ch 4, skip 4 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 5 times, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**11th Row**—Ch 7, d c in next d c, \* ch 4, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 4, 1 d c, ch 5, 1 d c in next loop, \* ch 4, d c in next d c, repeat from \* 6 times, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

**12th Row**—Ch 1 and work 5 s c in each ch 4 loop and 3 s c, ch 3, 3 s c in each corner loop, join, cut thread.

**13th Row**—Attach Red and work 1 s c in each s c and 3 s c in each corner loop, cut thread. Work another section in same manner.

**14th Row**—Place the 2 sections together having wrong sides facing each other. Attach White in 1st s c of 8th mesh from right hand corner, working through both sections, work a row of s c all around working 3 s c in corner st to last s c of 8th mesh before same corner (opening for plant), working on remaining back section only, continue in same manner, then work in same manner on remaining front section, join, turn.

**15th Row**—Working on back section, \* ch 5, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to corner st, ch 7, s c in same space, \* ch 5, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* 8 times, then working around lower section, \* ch 5, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* to next corner st, continue working in same manner around remaining lower section and front, working all corners same as 1st corner, join, cut thread.

**16th Row**—Attach Red in 1st loop of back section at opening, working around entire outside omitting front section, work 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in each ch 5 loop and 3 s c, ch 3, 3 s c in each corner loop, join in 1st s c.

**17th Row**—Sl st to next ch 3 loop, \* ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from \* to corner loop, ch 7, s c in same loop, continue working all around in same manner working all corners same as 1st corner.

**18th Row**—Work in same manner as 16th row, join, cut thread.

**Next Row**—Working in front section only, having wrong side of section toward you, attach Red at opening at right hand side, in each 5 ch loop work 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c and 3 s c, ch 3, 3 s c in corner loop, ending row with sl st in opening, turn.

**Next Row**—Work in same manner as 17th row, ending row with sl st in opening, turn.

**Next Row**—Work in same manner as 16th row, join, cut thread.

With Red cover a bone ring with s c and sew to holder as illustrated.

**6th Row**—Pick up Amber, ch 1, s c in 1st s c, \* cluster st in next s c, s c in next s c, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn. Repeat from 3rd row 4 times (6 cluster st rows).

**Next Row**—Cut White, continue with Amber, s c in 1st s c, \* skip the cluster st, s c in next s c, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn.

**Next 4 Rows**—1 s c in each s c, ch 1 to turn each row.

**Next Row**—Decrease in every other st (to decrease: \* insert hook in next st, pull loop through, repeat from \* once, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time), cut yarn.

Work another section in same manner. Sew sections together on each side leaving an opening for spout and handle.

**STEMS:** Cut Green 10 inches long for each stem.

**FLOWERS:** Cut Colors 5 inches long, double in half, then double in half again, then double in half a 3rd time. Using 1 stem, wrap around center and tie securely having both ends the same length.

Make 124 more flowers in same manner. Place through top of cozy and sew in position as illustrated.
