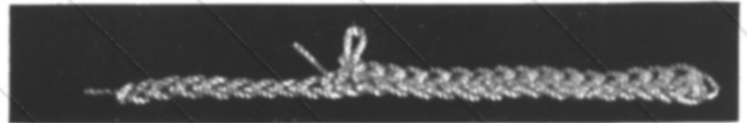
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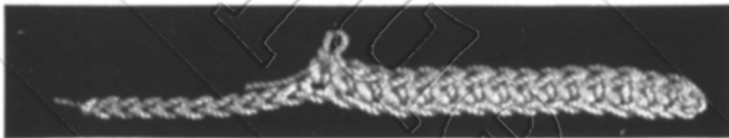
CHAIN STITCH

Make a loop on the crochet hook; thread over hook and draw through first loop; repeat until the desired length has been made.



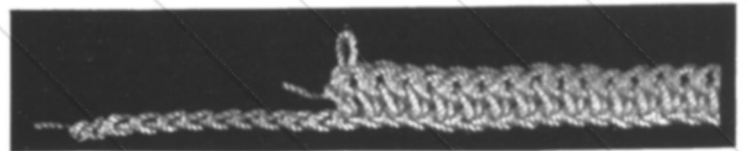
SLIP STITCH

Insert hook into chain stitch or stitch of previous row of crocheting; thread over hook and pull through stitch and loop on hook.



SINGLE CROCHET STITCH

Insert hook into chain stitch or stitch of previous row of crocheting; thread over hook; pull loop through stitch; thread over hook again and draw through the two loops on hook.



ONE-HALF DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH

Thread over hook and insert hook same as in single crochet; thread over hook; pull loop through stitch; thread over hook and pull through the three loops at one time.



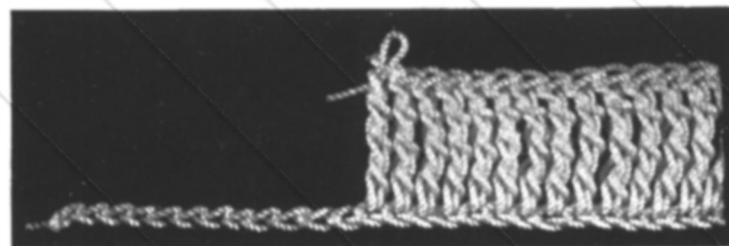
DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH

Thread over hook and insert hook same as in single crochet; thread over hook; pull loop through chain stitch; thread over hook and pull through first two loops; thread over hook and pull through the remaining two loops.



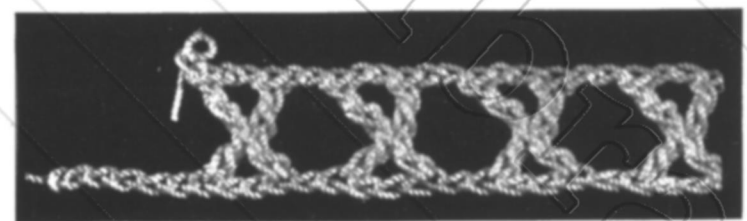
TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Made same as double crochet, winding thread over hook twice instead of once, working off two loops at a time as follows: Thread over the hook and through two loops; thread over and through next two loops; thread over and through last two loops.



DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Made same as treble, winding thread over needle three times, working off two loops at a time.



X. TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Complete a Y. treble; ch. 1; thread over hook; insert hook through two center threads of Y.; thread over hook and draw through two loops; thread over hook and draw through last two loops.



CLUSTER OF PICOTS

Make a chain of 3 picots; join them together by making a slip st. into first picot.



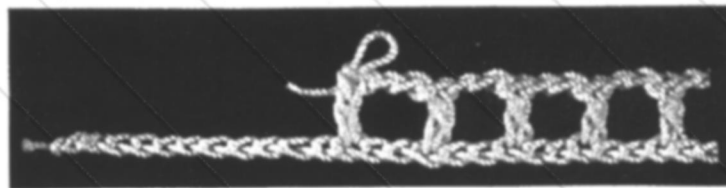
PICOT

Ch. 4; into fourth stitch from hook make a single crochet stitch; this forms a picot.



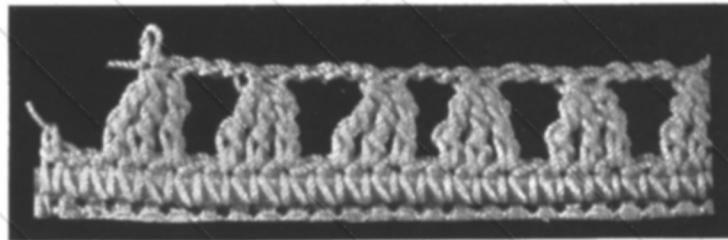
Y. TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Thread over hook twice; insert hook into chain or stitch of previous row; thread over the hook and draw through chain stitch; thread over hook and draw through two loops; thread over hook; skip one stitch of first row; hook through next stitch; thread over hook and through chain stitch; thread over and through two loops; thread over and through next two loops; thread over and through next two loops; ch. 3 and repeat in next stitch.



OPEN MESH

1 d.c.s. Ch. 2; skip 2 sts. 1 d.c.s. in next st., ch. 2; skip 2 and repeat.



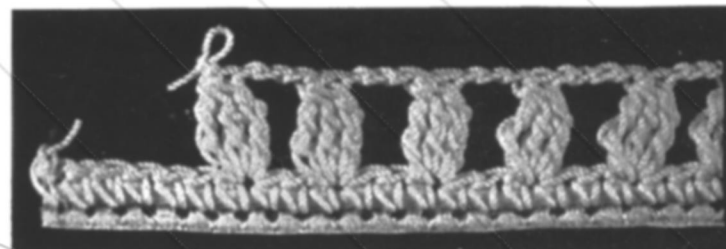
POINTED CLUSTER TREBLE

Made same as cluster treble, except that the three treble stitches are separate at bottom making one treble in each three stitches, then finish same as cluster treble.



DOUBLE CROCHET PICOT

Ch. 4; into fourth stitch from hook make a d.c.s.; this forms a double crochet picot.



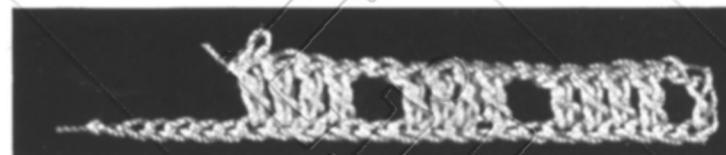
CLUSTER OF TREBLES

Is formed by making three treble stitches in same stitch, leaving last loop of each treble on crochet needle until third treble has been made, then thread over needle and draw through three remaining loops on the needle. This binds three trebles together at upper edge.



CHAIN OF PICOTS

Are formed by making a succession of three picots, without any stitches between.



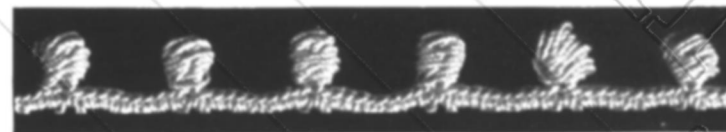
SOLID MESH

Four d.c.s. form a solid mesh. If a number of solid meshes are made in a row, make 4 d.c.s. for first solid mesh, 3 d.c.s. for each succeeding mesh. Ch. 3 for turning at end of a row, the 3 ch. forming the first stitch of the next row. When using finer thread than sample shown, mesh will be square.



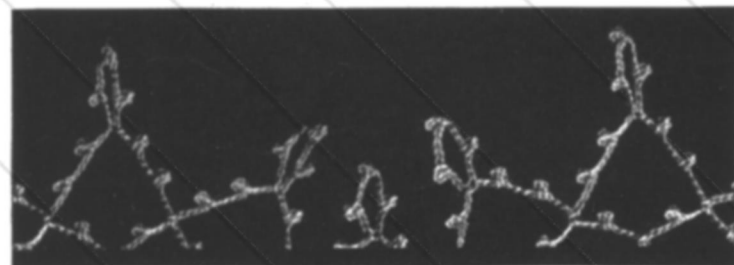
CROCHETING INTO HEMSTITCHING

When crocheting into hemstitched material, make 1 s.c.s. in one hole, 2 s.c.s. in next, alternating 1 s.c.s. in one, 2 s.c.s. in next, except when using very fine thread, then make two stitches in each hole, or when using very heavy thread, 1 st. in each hole.



CLONES KNOT

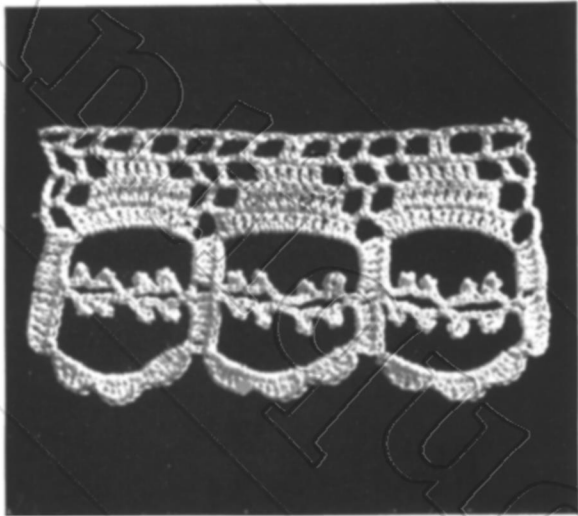
Make a ch. as directed, thread over, then pass hook downward under the ch. and catch up a loop, bring it forward and up and thread over again as if for a d.c. Continue to catch up loops from over and under the ch. the number of times specified. A knot of "16 loops" will have that many loops over hook. Draw thread through all loops on hook at once, thread over and draw through loop on hook, and finally, make a s.c. around ch. at base of knot, drawing tight. Make the knot evenly and rather loosely.



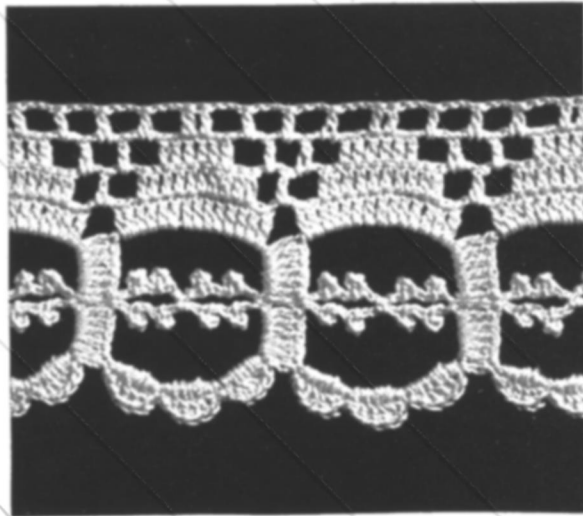
PICOT LOOP

This consists of a chain loop with one or more picots on it,

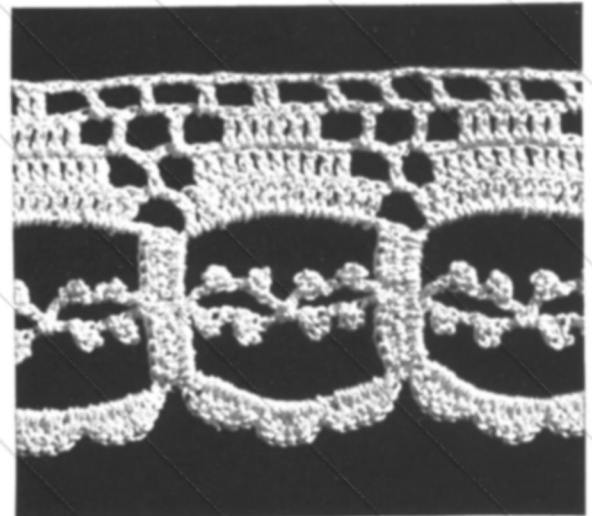

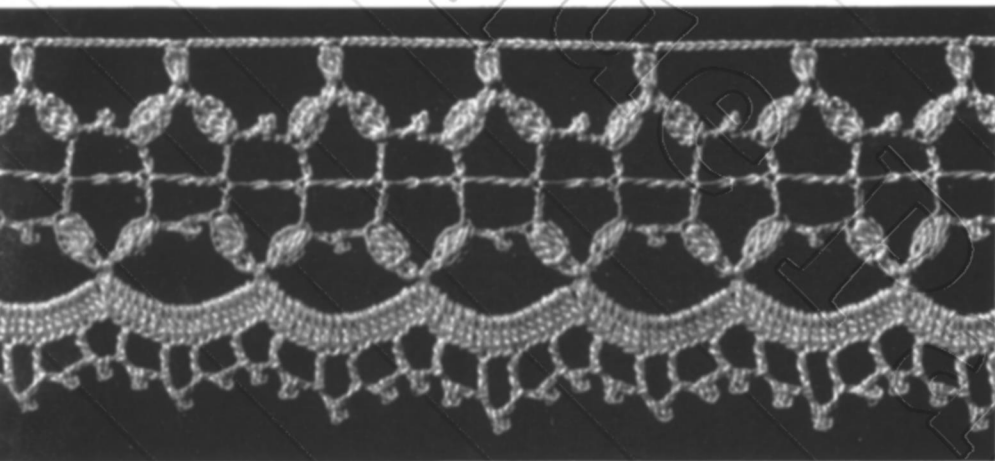

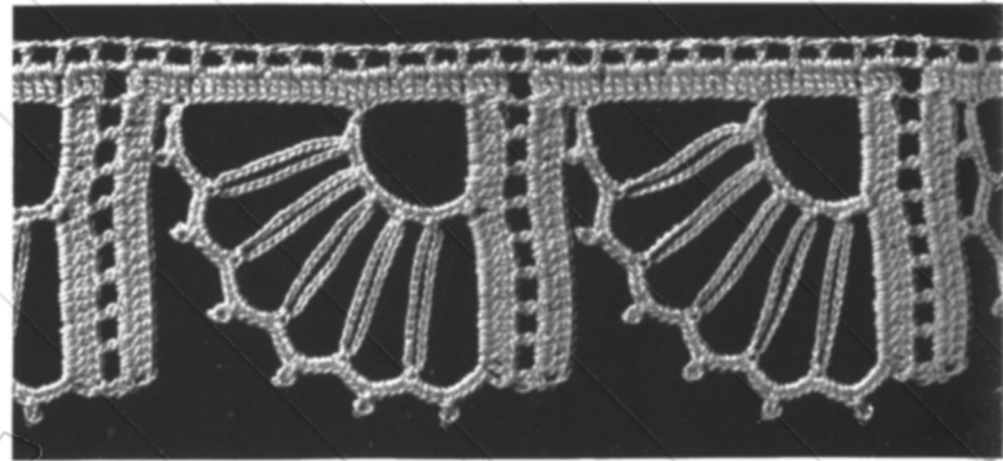

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Ch. 9, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, a 4-ch. p. in top of cluster, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 6, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 7, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, a p., ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 3, 1 tr. in first st. at start of lace, ch. 8, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, a p., ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 6, p., ch. 7, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, p., ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in last tr., * ch. 8, a cluster in 5th st. from hook, ch. 2, turn; 1 sl. st. in tip of 4th cluster from hook (in order made), ch. 2, sl. st. in top of last cluster, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of same cluster, ch. 6, p., ch. 7, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, p., ch. 4, 1 sl. st. at base of this cluster, ch. 3, 1 tr. in last tr. Repeat from * for required length.

Scallop Edge. Join to tip of first cluster at start of lace, (ch. 16, 1 s.c. in joining of next 2 clusters) repeated. Fasten off. **2nd Row.** Join to start of last row, ch. 3, (16 d.c. over 16-ch., then make 1 d.c. over same ch., 1 d.c. in next s.c. and 1 d.c. over next ch., working these last 3 d.c. into a cluster) repeated. Fasten off. **3rd Row.** Join to 3rd of first 16-d.c., ch. 3 in place of a d.c., (ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. 3 d.c., 1 d.c. in next, ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in next, ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. 3 d.c., 1 d.c. in next, ch. 5, p., ch. 1, sk. 5 sts., 1 d.c. in next) repeated. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to first cluster on top of lace, ch. 4, a 2 d.c. cluster in same st., (ch. 13, a 3 d.c. cluster in joining of next 2 clusters) repeated.



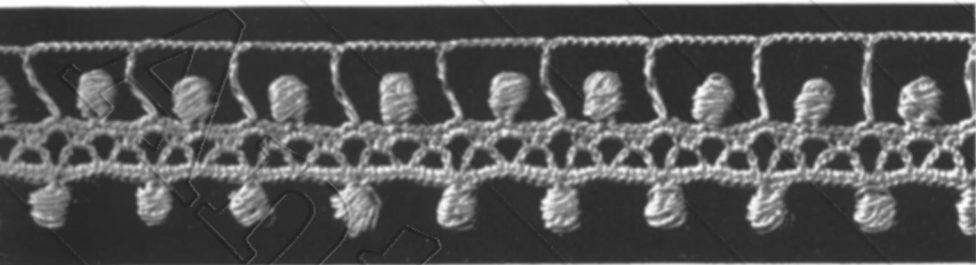
No. 2—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Heading Braid. Ch. 9, 1 d.c. in first st., ch. 5, turn; sk. last 2 sts. of 9-ch., 1 d.c. in next, (ch. 5, turn; sk. 2 sts. of previous 5-ch., 1 d.c. in next) repeated for required length, allowing 12 meshes for each fan motif of finished lace. **2nd Row.** Now working down side of braid, ch. 3, * (2 d.c. over next space, 1 d.c. in next st.) 9 times, ch. 23, 1 sl. st. in 10th d.c. from hook, ch. 1, 2 s.c. over ch., ch. 30, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., (3 s.c., ch. 30, 1 sl. st. in last s.c.) 4 times over ch. 2 s.c. over ch., 1 s.c. in 9th st. of ch. from last d.c. Ch. 22, turn; 1 s.c. in center of last 30-ch., loop, (ch. 7, 1 s.c. in next 30-ch. loop), 4 times, ch. 7, sk. 15 d.c., 1 sl. st. in next, ch. 1 turn; (4 s.c., a 5-ch. p., and 4 s.c.) over each 7-ch. and 1 s.c. in each s.c. between chs. (4 s.c., p., and 4 s.c.) over part of next 22-ch., ch. 3, 15 d.c. over balance of same 22-ch., 1 d.c. in next s.c., 8 d.c. over next 8-ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in last d.c. on heading row, 2 d.c. over next space of heading row, 1 d.c. in next st., slip hook out of loop, insert in top of 3-ch. at end of perpendicular row of d.c. on fan motif, catch loop and pull thru, ch. 2, sk. next space on heading row, 1 d.c. in next st., turn; (ch. 2, sk. 2 d.c. of perpendicular row of d.c. on fan motif, 1 d.c. in next) 8 times, 1 d.c. under 3-ch. at end of row, ch. 3, turn; (1 d.c. in next d.c., 2 d.c. over next 2-ch.) 8 times, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in next d.c., 2 d.c. over next space of heading row, 1 d.c. in next st., slip hook out of loop, insert in 3-ch. at end of row of d.c. just completed on fan motif, catch loop and pull thru. Repeat from *, and on all following motifs join as follows: In place of the first p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in 5th d.c. up straight side of previous fan motif, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in last s.c.



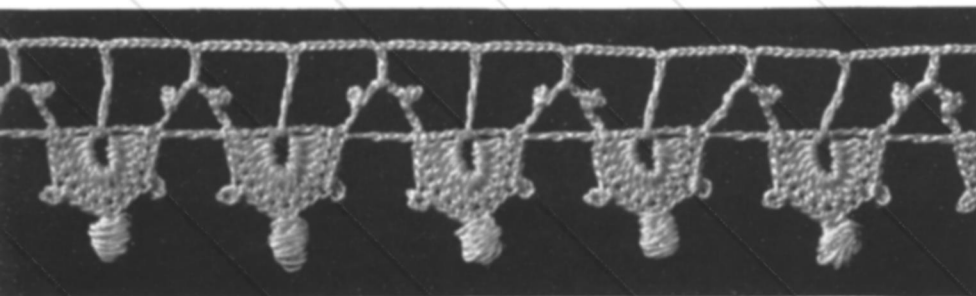
No. 3—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Clones Knot Edge. (Ch. 7, 1 d.c. in first st.) repeated for length required. **2nd Row.** Ch. 8, turn; 2 s.c. in last 6-ch. loop, (ch. 3, 2 s.c. in next loop) repeated. **3rd Row.** Ch. 1, turn; 1 s.c. in last 2 s.c., (2 s.c. over next 3-ch., ch. 4, a Clones knot of 16 loops over ch., 1 s.c. over same 3-ch. loop, 1 s.c. in next 2 s.c., 3 s.c. over next 3-ch., 1 s.c. in next 2 s.c.) repeated. **4th Row.** Ch. 17, turn; 1 tr. in center s.c. between last 2 knots, (ch. 9, 1 tr. between next 2 knots) repeated. Fasten off. Make another row of s.c. and knots on other edge of lace, putting 4 s.c. over each d.c. of first row and 1 s.c. between d.c., making the knots exactly opposite the tr. in 4th row.



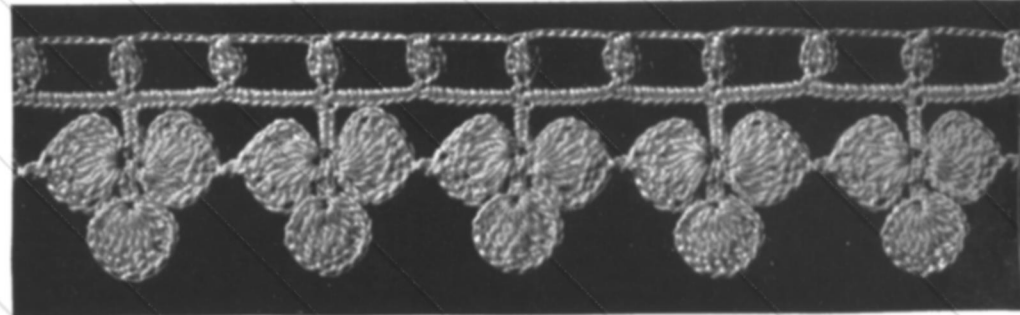

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Ch. 8, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 9, a 5-ch. p., ch. 3, 1 tr. in first st. of lace, * ch. 14, slip hook out of loop, insert in 4th st. of 14-ch. from beginning, catch loop and pull thru forming a loop, ch. 3, 13 d.c. in loop, 1 sl. st. in tr., ch. 1, turn; 1 s.c. in next 4 d.c., a 5-ch. p. in last s.c., 1 s.c. in same st. with last s.c., 1 s.c. in next 3 sts., ch. 4, a Clones knot of 18 loops over ch., 1 s.c. in same d.c. with last s.c., 1 s.c. in next 3 d.c., p., 1 s.c. in same st. with last s.c., 1 s.c. in next 3 d.c. and in top of 3-ch. at end of row, ch. 7, p., ch. 9, p., ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in last s.c. of scallop. Repeat from *. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to center of first p.-loop at start of lace, ch. 11, 1 tr. in center ring at base of next scallop, (ch. 8, 1 d.c. in center of next p.-loop, ch. 8, 1 tr. in center ring at base of next scallop) repeated.



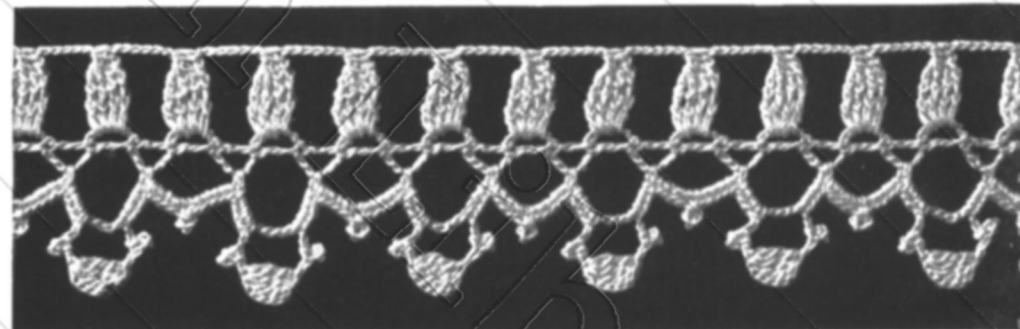
No. 5—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Shamrock Edge. (Ch. 12, a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. in same st.) repeated for required length, making the final cluster with 3 d.c. and omitting the 4-ch. following. **2nd Row.** Turn; (ch. 8, 1 s.c. in top of next cluster) repeated. **3rd Row.** Turn; * (8 s.c. over next 8-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c., ch. 10. In 6th st. of ch. from hook, make 3 tr., 3 d. tr. and 3 tr. Ch. 5 and 1 sl. st. in same st., ch. 8, and in 6th st. from hook make 3 tr., 3 d. tr. and 3 tr. Ch. 5 and 1 sl. st. in same st., ch. 2, 1 s.c. at base of first leaf, ch. 6, and in first st. of ch. make 3 tr., 3 d. tr. and 3 tr. Ch. 5, 1 sl. st. in same st., 4 s.c. over next 4-ch. to form a stem, 1 s.c. in same st. with last s.c. on heading row, 8 s.c. over next 8-ch. and 1 s.c. in next s.c. Repeat from *, and after the 2nd d. tr. of first leaf of each group, join as follows: ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in corresponding d. tr. of 3rd leaf of previous group, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in top of last d. tr. made. Complete group.



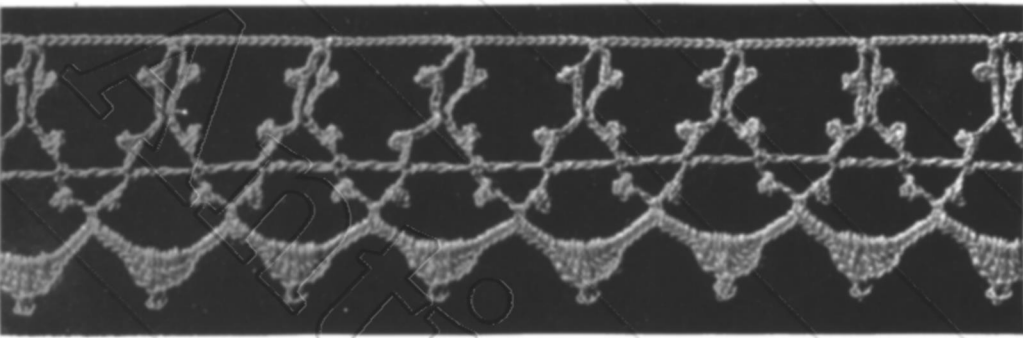
No. 6—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Ch. 7, 1 d.c. in first st., (ch. 7, turn; 1 d.c. in last d.c.) repeated for required length. Turn. **2nd Row.** Sl. st. to center of last 7-ch. loop, (ch. 9, 1 s.c. in next loop on same side of first row, ch. 12, 1 s.c. in next) repeated. **3rd Row.** Ch. 1, turn; * 4 s.c. over 12-ch., ch. 6, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 8, a 2 tr. cluster in 2nd st. of 8-ch., 1 tr. in same st., ch. 6, a 5-ch. p., ch. 2, 4 s.c. over last third of same 12-ch., (5 s.c., a 5-ch. p., 5 s.c. over next 9-ch. loop. Repeat from *. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to first 7-ch. loop on other side of first row, ch. 8, a 3 d. tr. cluster in same loop, (ch. 6, a 4 d. tr. cluster in next 7-ch. loop) repeated.



No. 7—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

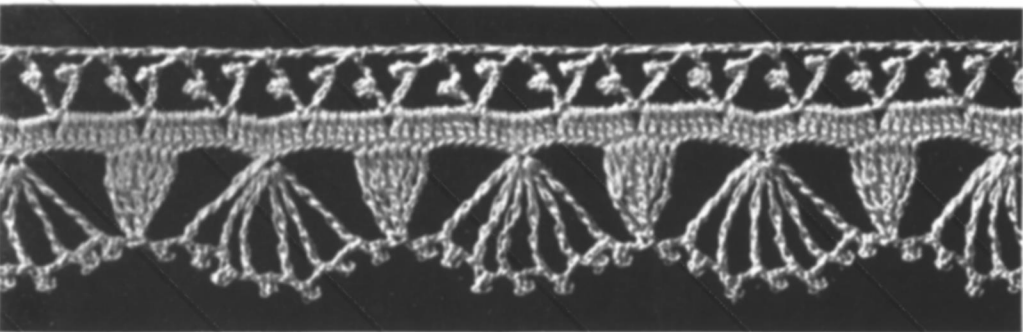
NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Ch. 7, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 8, a 5-ch. p., ch. 2, 1 tr. in first st. at start, * ch. 6, p., (ch. 10, p.) twice, ch. 3, sk. last 2 ps. and next 2 ch. beyond, 1 sl. st. in next ch., ch. 7, p., ch. 2, turn; 1 tr. in last tr., ch. 6, p., ch. 8, p., ch. 2, turn; 1 tr. in last tr. Repeat from * for required length. Fasten off.

Edge. With wrong side up, join to center of first p.-loop of last row, (ch. 14, 1 s.c. in next p.-loop) repeated.

2nd Row. Ch. 1, turn; (5 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 3 d.c., a 5-ch. p. in last d.c., 3 d.c., 1 h.d.c. and 5 s.c.) over each 14-ch. loop of last row. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to center of first p.-loop on other side of lace, (ch. 12, 1 s.c. in next loop) repeated.



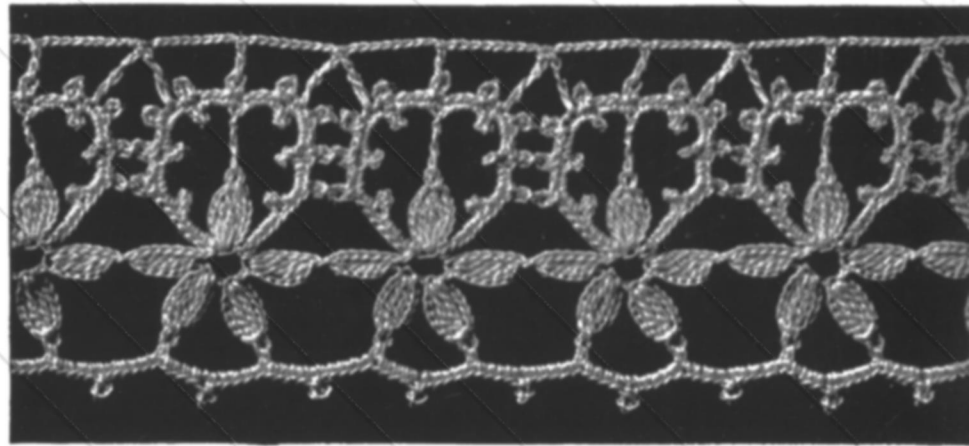
No. 8—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Braid. Ch. 15, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hoop to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 3, 1 tr. in first st. of 15-ch., ch. 7, a 5-ch. p., ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in 3rd st. previous to first p., (ch. 7, p., ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in top of next to last tr.) repeated for required length. **2nd Row.** Ch. 3, and working along side of lace, (7 d.c. over next tr., 1 d.c. at base of tr.) repeated. Fasten off. **3rd Row.** Return to start of last row and join to 4th d.c., ch. 8, * 1 d. tr. in next st. holding last 2 loops on hook, 1 tr. in next 2 sts. holding the last loop of each on hook, 1 d.c. in next 2 sts. holding the last loop of each on hook, making 6 loops on hook. (Thread over and draw thru 2 loops) twice, 1 tr. in next st. holding last loop on hook, (thread over and draw thru 2 loops) twice, 1 d. tr. in next st. holding last loop of d. tr. on hook, thread over and draw thru 2 loops, thread over and draw thru remaining 3 loops on hook. Ch. 5, 1 s.c. in first st. to make a 5-ch. p., ch. 1, sk. 8 d.c., 1 d. tr. in back loop of next, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d. tr. in same st.) 5 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 1, sk. 8 sts. and repeat from *.



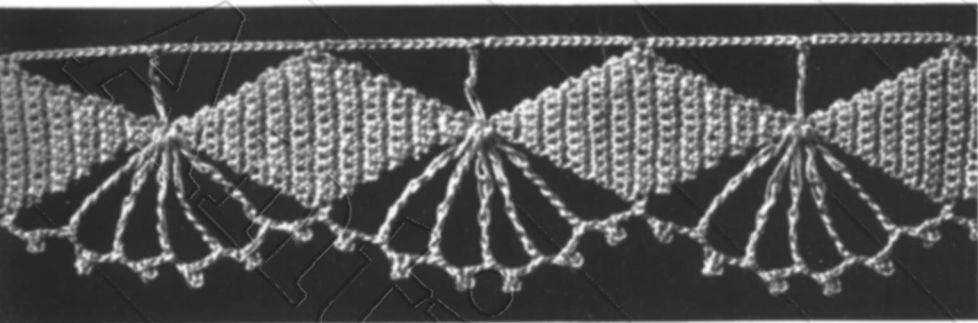
No. 9—EDGING

Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

(Ch. 8, a 2 tr. cluster in 2nd st.) twice, * a 4-ch. p. in top of last cluster, ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base of same cluster, ch. 8, a 2 tr. cluster in 2nd st., a p., ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, (ch. 8, a 2 tr. cluster in 2nd st.) 3 times. Repeat from *. End row with 3 petals in last flower. **2nd Row.** Ch. 8, a 2 tr. cluster in 2nd st., p., ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base, * ch. 8, a 3 tr. cluster in 2nd st., p., ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base, ch. 9, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in p. at tip of last cluster petal, (ch. 8, p.) 3 times, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. between last 2 petals, ch. 1, turn. Roll these last 2 p.-loops over so that the ps. all point in toward petal instead of around outside of circle. 4 s.c. over last 4-ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p., (3 s.c. over half of next ch., a 5-ch. p., 2 s.c. over balance of ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p., a p.) twice, * 3 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. in tr., a p., 3 s.c. over next ch., (1 s.c. in base of p., a p., 3 s.c. over half of next ch., a p., 2 s.c. over balance of ch.) twice, 1 s.c. at base of next p., 4 s.c. over next ch., 1 sl. st. at base of last petal, 1 sl. st. just before 5th petal from hook, ch. 6, 1 sl. st. between next 2 petals, ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base of next petal, ch. 8, a 3 tr. cluster in 2nd st., p., ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 9, p., (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 3, turn; 1 tr. in p. at tip of last cluster petal, (ch. 8, p.) 3 times, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. between last 2 petals, ch. 1, turn. Roll ps. over so they point in toward petal, 4 s.c. over last 4-ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p., 3 s.c. over half of next ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. back in last p. of previous circle, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in last s.c., 2 s.c. over balance of ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. back in next p. on previous circle, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in last s.c., (3 s.c., p., 2 s.c.) over next ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p., a p. Repeat from *. **Heading Row.** Join between 3rd and 4th ps. around outside of first circle, ch. 14, sk. 1 p., 1 d.c. in next p., (ch. 8, 1 tr. between next 2 ps. holding last 2 loops on hook, 1 tr. between next 2 ps. of next circle holding last 3 loops on hook, thread over and pull thru all loops on hook, ch. 8, sk. 1 p., 1 d.c. in next p.) repeated. Fasten off. **Edge.** Wrong side up. Join to p. of 2nd petal of first row, (ch. 9, 1 s.c. in next petal) repeated. Ch. 1, turn. **2nd Row.** Cover each 9-ch. with (5 s.c., a 5-ch. p., and 5 s.c.). Fasten off.



No. 10—EDGING

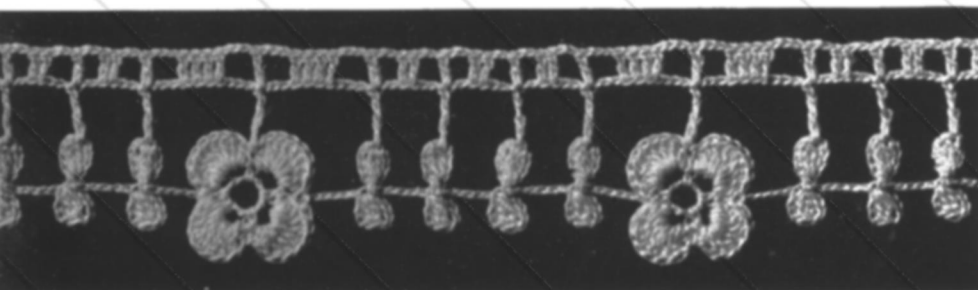
Crocheted with NUN'S BOILPROOF Cordonnet Special Crochet Cotton, size 50.

NUN'S Crochet Hook, No. 1140, size 14.

Illustration is actual size crocheted with above thread and needle.

Diamond Edge. Ch. 2, 1 s.c. in first st., * ch. 2, turn; sk. last ch. st., 1 s.c. in next st. and 1 s.c. in s.c. of last row, ch. 2, turn; sk. last st., 1 s.c. in next ch. st. and 1 s.c. in the 2 s.c. of last row. Continue, each row increasing 1 s.c.—until there are 13 s.c. in row. Ch. 1, turn; 1 s.c. in 13 s.c. of last row, ch. 1, turn; sk. last s.c., 1 s.c. in remaining 12 s.c., ch. 1, turn; sk. last s.c., 1 s.c. in remaining 11 s.c. Continue, dropping 1 s.c. in each row until there is only 1 s.c. in last row. Ch. 1, turn; 1 s.c. in 1 s.c. of last row. Repeat from * for required length.

Edge. Ch. 18, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 2, 1 long tr. (thread over 4 times) in first st. of ch., (ch. 6, a 5-ch. p., ch. 2, 1 long tr. in same st.) 3 times, ch. 6, p. ch. 2, 1 s.c. in side point of last diamond, * (ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 long tr. between diamonds) 5 times, ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 s.c. in side point of next diamond. Repeat from * and fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to end of first diamond, ch. 20, 1 s.c. in side point of same diamond, (ch. 14, 1 tr. between diamonds, ch. 14, 1 s.c. in side point of next diamond) repeated.

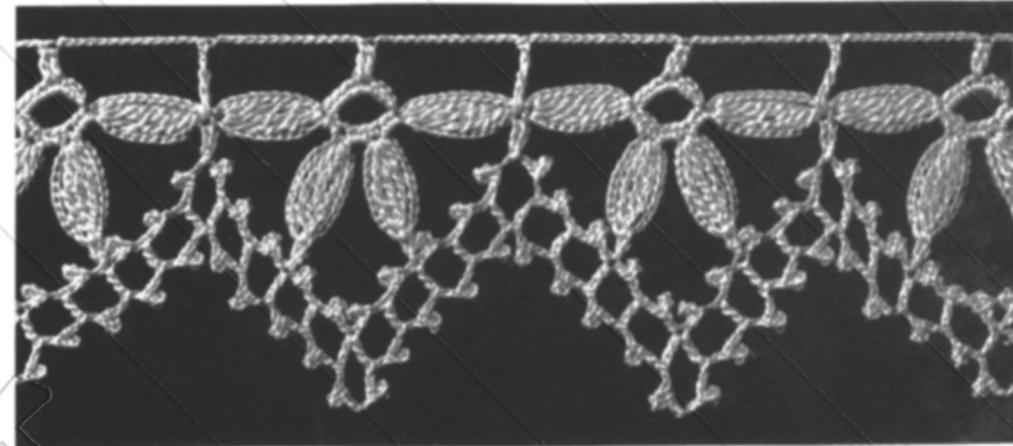

Flower and Leaf Edge. Ch. 9, form into a ring with sl. st., (ch. 6, 1 s.c. $\frac{1}{4}$ way around ring) 4 times, (1 h.d.c., 7 d.c., 1 h.d.c.) over each 6-ch. loops, 1 s.c. in each s.c. between loops, ending with a sl. st. in place of final s.c. * ch. 10, * * a 2 d.c. cluster in 5th st. from hook, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. in same ch. with d.c., ch. 5, a 2 d.c. cluster in first st. of ch., ch. 4, 1 sl. st. in same ch. with d.c., 1 sl. st. at base of first cluster. Now turn work around a little to left, keeping right side up and make a ch. st. across between clusters, ch. 9 and repeat from * * until you have 4 pairs of little leaves. Ch. 17, slip hook out of loop, insert in 9th ch. from hook, catch loop and pull thru, forming a ring, (ch. 6, 1 s.c. $\frac{1}{4}$ way around ring) 4 times. Pass thread under lace already made, keeping loop on hook on top. (1 h.d.c., 7 d.c. and 1 h.d.c. over next 6-ch. loop, 1 s.c. in

next s.c.) 3 times, 1 h.d.c., 7 d.c. and 1 h.d.c. over next loop, 1 sl. st. in next s.c. Now pass thread under lace already made, keeping loop on hook on top, (ch. 7. Let this lie across back of next petal, 1 sl. st. in back loop of next s.c. between petals) twice. Repeat from * for required length. **Heading Rows.** Join between 3rd and 4th petals of first flower, ch. 3 in place of a d.c. * ch. 10, 1 tr. in tip of next leaf, (ch. 6, 1 tr. in tip of next leaf) 3 times, ch. 10, 1 tr. between petals of next flower. Repeat from *. **2nd Row.** Join to 3rd st. of first ch. at start of last row, ch. 3 in place of a d.c., * ch. 3, sk. next 3 ch., 1 d.c. in next 4 ch., ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next tr., (ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. in next 2 ch., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in next tr.) 3 times, ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.c. in next 4 ch., ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next tr. Repeat from * to end of lace and fasten off.

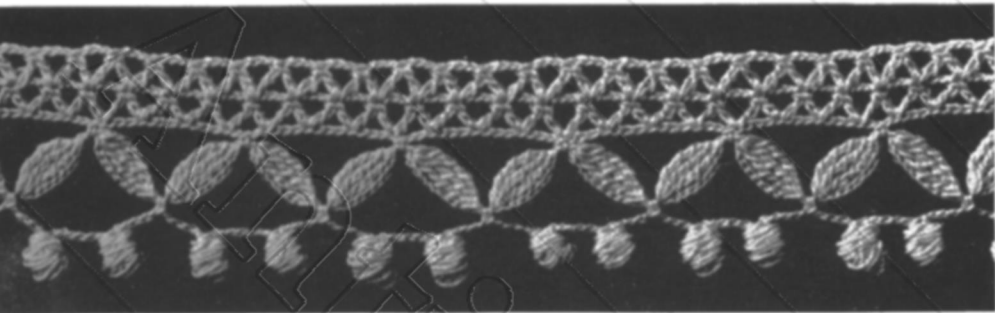

(Ch. 8, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p.) repeated for about twice required length. **2nd Row.** Ch. 9, p., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in center ch. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, * (ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in center ch. between next 2 ps.) 4 times, ch. 6, p., ch. 8, p., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in same st. with last d.c., (ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 d.c. in center st. between next 2 ps.) 4 times, sk. next 2 ps., 1 d.c. in center st. beyond. Repeat from *.

Fasten off. **3rd Row.** This is worked across first row, ch. 4, 1 sl. st. in center of 9-ch. at start of last row, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in first of 4-ch., * ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st. of this ch., ch. 13, a 3 d. tr. cluster in 3rd st., ch. 2, sk. 3 ps. of first row, 1 sl. st. at base of next d.c., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of cluster, ch. 10, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 13, a 3 d. tr. cluster in 3rd st., ch. 2, sk. 4 ps., 1 sl. st. at base of next d.c., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in cluster, ch. 10, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, ch. 13, a 3 d. tr. cluster in 3rd st., ch. 4, sk. next 3 ps., 1 sl. st. under center of next 3-ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in first st. of 4-ch. Repeat from * across lace.

4th Row. At finish of end flower, ch. 10, 1 sl. st. at base of last cluster, * (2 s.c. over next 2-ch. between clusters, 1 s.c. at base of next cluster) twice, 2 s.c. over next 2-ch., ch. 6, 1 sl. st. back in first s.c., 8 s.c. over 6-ch., 1 sl. st. in top of next cluster, ch. 10, 1 sl. st. at base of same cluster, 1 sl. st. in next st., ch. 10, 1 sl. st. at base of next cluster. Repeat from * and fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to start of last row, ch. 5 in place of a tr., (ch. 13 sk. next cluster, 1 d.c. in the following 4th and 5th s.c. worked into a cluster, ch. 13, 1 tr. between next 2 clusters) repeated.



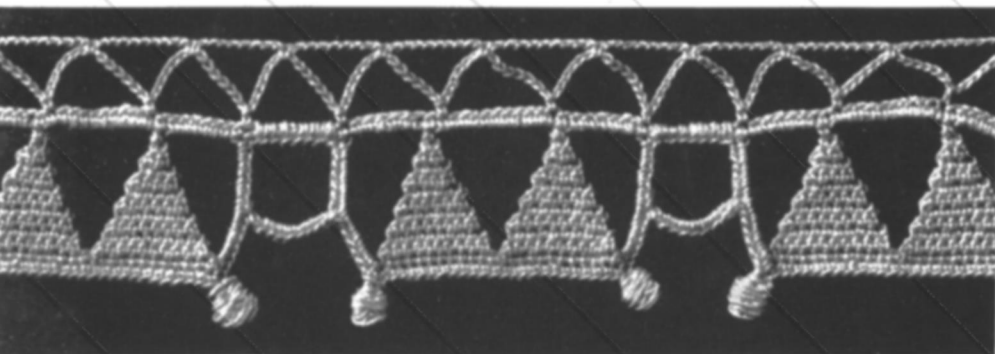

Fasten off. **3rd Row.** Join to start of last row, ch. 6, 1 d.c. in same st. holding last loop on hook, sk. 3 ch., 1 d.c. in next st. holding last 3 loops on hook, thread over and pull thru all loops on hook at once, * (ch. 3, 1 d.c. in same st. with last d.c., holding last loop on hook, sk. 3 sts., 1 d.c. in next holding last 3 loops on hook, thread over and pull thru all loops) repeated to end of lace. Fasten off. **4th Row.** Join to 3rd st. of ch. at start of last row, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in back loop of next double d.c. Repeat from * in last row. Fasten off. **Other Edge.** Join between first 2 clusters of first row, (ch. 8, a clones knot of 16 loops over ch., ch. 9, a knot, ch. 4, 1 s.c. between 2nd and 3rd clusters) repeated.

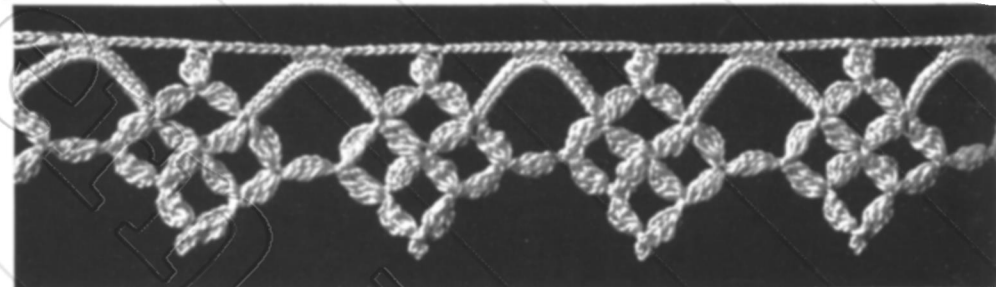

Triangle Edge. Ch. 25, sk. last st., 1 s.c. in next 12 sts., * ch. 1, turn; sk. last s.c., 1 s.c. in next 10 s.c., (ch. 1, turn; sk. last s.c., 1 s.c. in each remaining s.c.) repeated for 8 more rows. Last row will have 1 s.c. in it. Fasten off, leaving a 1 inch length of thread. Join again to next st. of original ch., and make 1 s.c. in each remaining 11 sts. of ch. Repeat from *, making another triangle. Repeat from start, making enough pairs of triangles for required length, allowing a 1/2 inch space between pairs. **2nd Row.** Join to starting end of first row of s.c. of first triangle, ch. 17, 1 s.c. in top point of same triangle, * ch. 11, 1 s.c. in top of next triangle,

ch. 6, 1 long tr. (thread over 4 times) in lower corner of same triangle at end of first row of s.c., ch. 8, 1 long tr. in lower right hand corner of another triangle pair, ch. 6, 1 s.c. in top of same triangle, and repeat from *. Fasten off. **3rd Row.** Join to 10 st. of 17-ch. at start of last row, * 6 s.c. over next 6-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c., 11 s.c. over next 11-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c., 6 s.c. over next 6-ch., 1 s.c. in next long tr., ch. 8, 1 s.c. in next long tr. Repeat from *. At end of row, continue on around bottom of lace for 4th row. 13 s.c. over next long tr., 1 s.c. in corner of triangle, * ch. 4, a Clones knot of 16 loops over ch., 1 s.c. in same st., 1 s.c. in each st. across base of both triangles to other corner, ch. 4, a Clones knot over ch., 1 s.c. in same corner st., 13 s.c. over next long tr., 8 s.c. over both 8-chs., 7 s.c. over half of next long tr., ch. 8, 1 sl. st. across in 7th s.c. over previous long tr., 9 s.c. over 8-ch., 1 sl. st. in last s.c. over long tr., 6 s.c. over balance of same long tr., 1 s.c. in corner of triangle and repeat from *. **Heading Rows.** Join to first s.c. at top of lace, * ch. 14, sk. 7 s.c., 1 s.c. in next, ch. 14, sk. 9 s.c., 1 s.c. in next, ch. 14, sk. 7 s.c., 1 s.c. in next, ch. 14, sk. 8 s.c., 1 s.c. in next s.c. Repeat from *. **2nd Row.** Ch. 14, turn; 1 s.c. in center of last loop on last row, * (ch. 9, 1 s.c. in next loop) twice, (ch. 8, 1 s.c. in next loop) twice. Repeat from *.



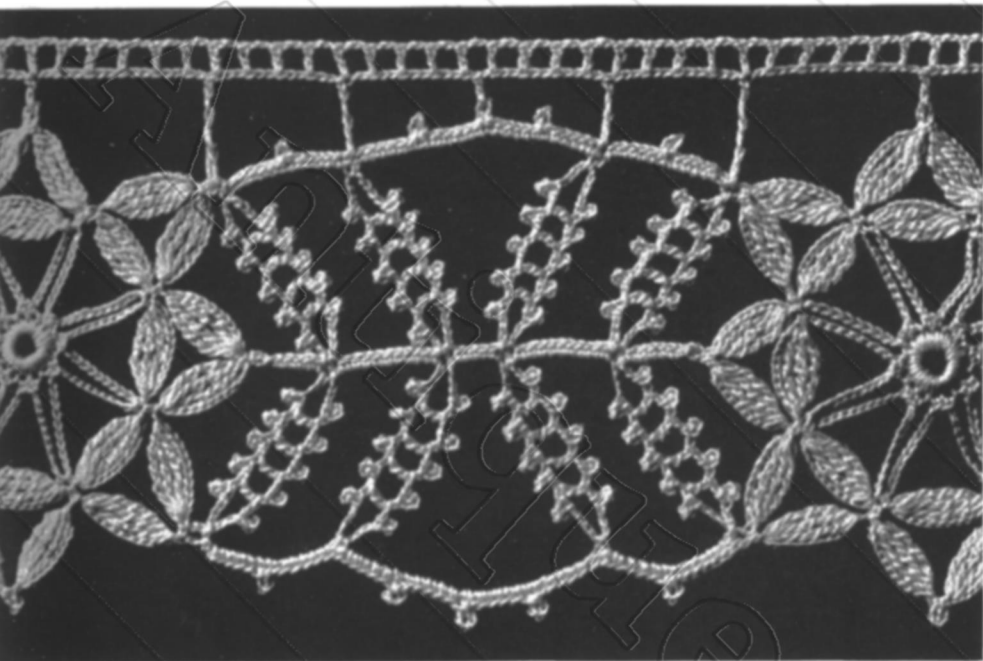

Repeat from * for required length. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join between 3rd and 4th clusters at start of lace, ch. 4, a 2 d.c. cluster in same place, (ch. 7, sk. 7 s.c. of next loop between squares, 1 s.c. in back loops of next 4 s.c., ch. 7, a 3 d.c. cluster between next 2 clusters of next square) repeated.

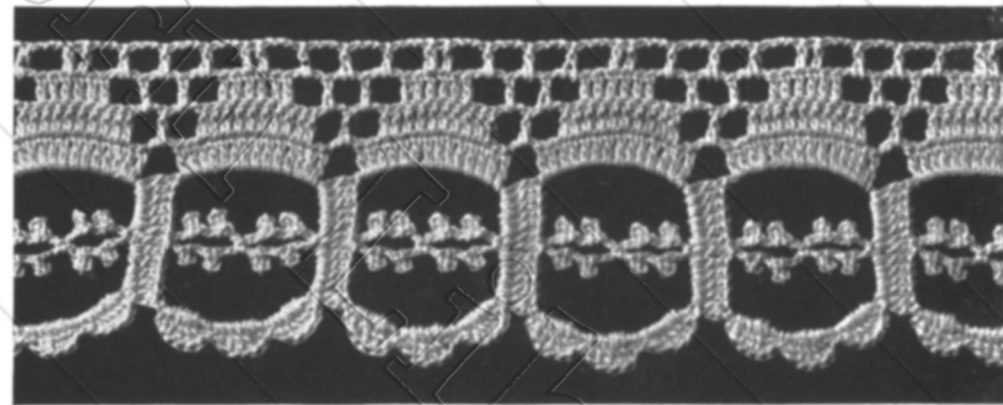

Fasten off. **2nd Row.** Join to center of 1 loop, (ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 1, 1 s.c. in next loop) repeated around. **3rd Row.** * Ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 6, 1 s.c. in first ch. for a p., ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 1, 1 s.c. between next 2 clusters of last row. Repeat from * 7 times. Fasten off. Make another motif. After completing the 6th point of last row on this motif, ch. 10, a 3-d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 15, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., (ch. 6, a 5-ch. p.) 4 times, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in p. tip of last completed point of motif, ch. 8, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. in 1-ch. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. in 1-ch. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 3, sk. next p. and 2 sts. of next ch., 1 sl. st. in next ch., ch. 18, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4 times, ch. 12, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 3, sk. next p. and 2 ch. sts., 1 sl. st. in next, ch. 12, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4 times, ch. 12, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 2, sk. next p. and 3 sts. of ch., 1 sl. st. in next, ch. 19, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4 times, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in p. tip of 1 point on first motif, ch. 7, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 2, sk. next p. and 3 sts. of ch., 1 sl. st. in next, ch. 5, 1 sl. st. in next p. point of first motif. Ch. 1, 6 s.c. over 5-ch., 1 s.c. at base of last p.-loop, ch. 7, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4 times, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in next p. point of first motif, ch. 8, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., 11 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p.-loop, ch. 7, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4 times, ch. 12, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., 4 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p.-loop, ch. 8, p., (ch. 6, p.) 4

times, ch. 12, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between 2nd and 3rd ps. from hook, (ch. 5, p., ch. 1, 1 d.c. between next 2 ps.) 3 times, ch. 5, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., 11 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. at base of next p.-loop. Now make another p-loop just like last one. 5 s.c. over next ch., 1 sl. st. under ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in top of last cluster on 2nd motif, ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 1, 1 s.c. between next 2 clusters of last row of motif, ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 2, turn; 1 s.c. in last p.-loop, * ch. 11, 1 s.c. in next p.-loop, ch. 24, 1 s.c. in next, ch. 11, 1 s.c. in next p. point of first motif where next p.-loop is fastened, ch. 1, turn; (6 s.c., a 5-ch. p., and 6 s.c.) over last 11-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c. (6 s.c., p., 6 s.c., p., 6 s.c., p., and 6 s.c.) over next 24-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c., (6 s.c., p., and 6 s.c.) over next 11-ch., 1 s.c. in next s.c., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of last cluster, ch. 10, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st., ch. 1, 1 s.c. between next 2 clusters of motif. Fasten off. Repeating from * make the same last 2 rows of two 11-ch. loops and one 24-ch. loop covered with s.c. and ps. on opposite side of lace, connecting p.-loops and motifs. Continue to make and join motifs in same way for required length. **Heading Rows.** Join to first motif in first p. point to right of center top point, ch. 8, in place of a d. tr., * ch. 16, 1 d.c. in center top p. point, ch. 16, 1 d. tr. in next p. point at end of row of s.c., ch. 12, sk. next p. and 6 s.c. beyond, 1 tr. in next s.c., ch. 12, sk. next p., 1 d.c. in next p., ch. 12, sk. next p. and 6 s.c., 1 tr. in next s.c., ch. 12, sk. next p. and 6 s.c., 1 d. tr. in next p. point of motif. Repeat from *. **2nd Row.** Ch. 5, turn; sk. 2 ch., 1 d.c. in next, (ch. 2, sk. 2 ch., 1 d.c. in next) repeated.

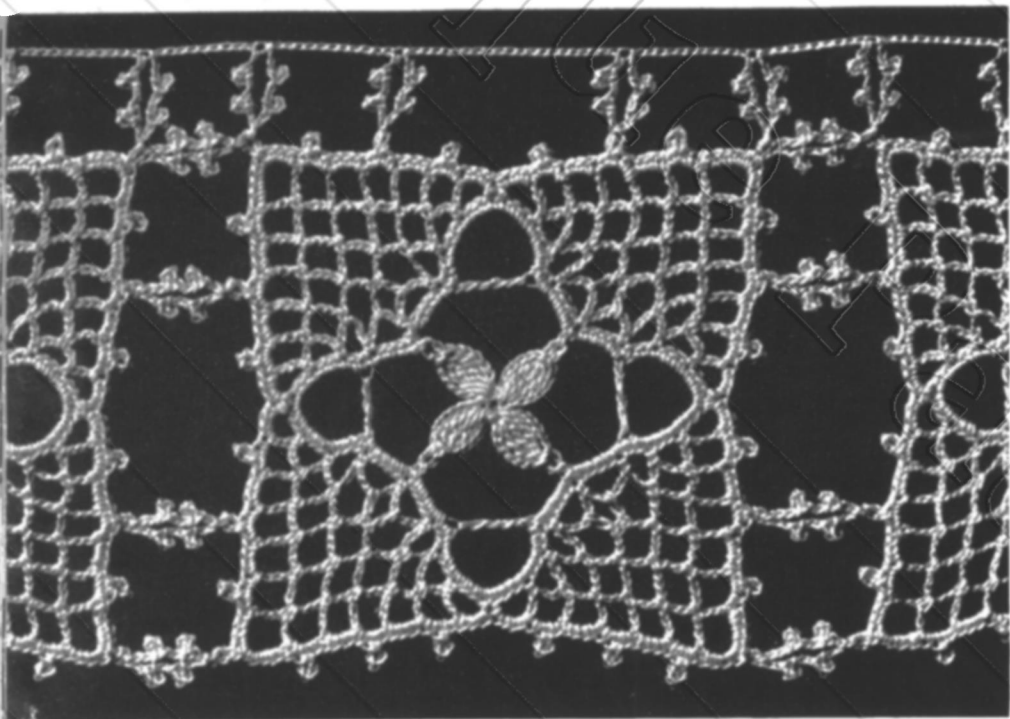

(ch. 6, 1 s.c. in 2 threads of 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch.p.) twice, (ch. 8, a 5-ch.p., ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 s.c. between 4th and 5th ps. from hook, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in last d.c., 1 d.c. in next 6 sts., * ch. 20, turn; 1 s.c. in top of p.-loops between 4th and 5th ps., ch. 20, 1 sl. st. in 1st d.c., ch. 1, turn; (1 h.d.c., 4 d.c. 1 h.d.c., and 1 s.c.) 3 times over last 20-ch., making instead of final s.c., a sl. st. in 5th st. of ch. from left end, ch. 3, 5 d.c. over balance of ch., 1 d.c. in next s.c., (ch. 6, p.) twice, (ch. 8, p., ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 s.c. between 4th and 5th ps. from hook, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in last d.c., 6 d.c. over next ch. Repeat from * for required length, omitting

the double p.-loops following the last row of d.c. at end of lace. **Top Rows.** Ch. 6, 14 d.c. over next ch., (ch. 3, 14 d.c. over next ch.) repeated, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in first st. at start of lace. **2nd Row.** Ch. 6, turn; 1 d.c. under last 3-ch., (ch. 3, sk. 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in next 10 d.c. ch. 3, 1 d.c. under next 3-ch.) repeated. **3rd Row.** Ch. 6, turn; 1 d.c. under last 3-ch. * ch. 3, sk. 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in next 6 d.c., (ch. 3, 1 d.c. under next 3-ch.) twice. Repeat from * to end of row. **4th Row.** Ch. 6, turn; 1 d.c. under last 3-ch., ch. 3, 1 d.c. under next 3-ch., * ch. 3, sk. 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in next 2 d.c., (ch. 3, 1 d.c. under next 3-ch.) 3 times. Repeat from * to end of lace and fasten off.

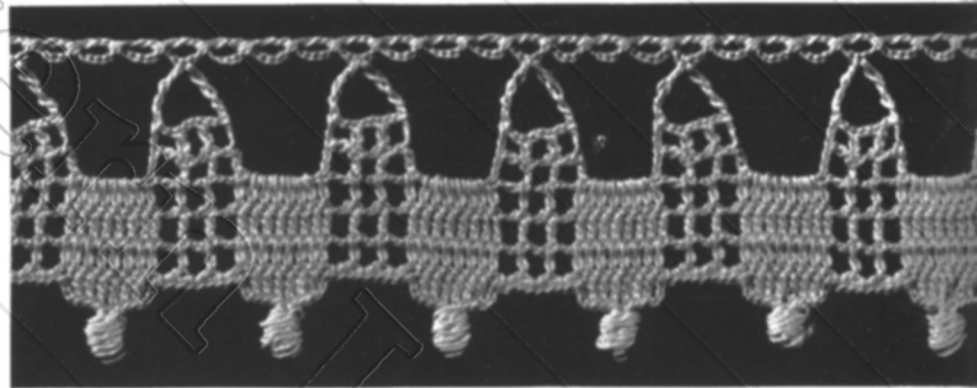

Edging of Lattice Squares. (Ch. 7, a 3 tr. cluster in first st., a 5-ch. p. in top of cluster, ch. 6, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster) 4 times, 1 sl. st. at base of first cluster. Fasten off. **2nd Row.** Join to p. tip of 1 cluster, (ch. 22, 1 tr. in 6th st. of ch. from beginning, ch. 5, 1 s.c. in p. of next cluster) 4 times. **3rd Row.** 5 s.c. over 5-chs., 16 s.c. over 16-chs., and 1 s.c. in each st. between chs. Fasten off. **4th Row.** Join to 9th or center s.c. of 16 s.c. on 1 loop, * (ch. 6, sk. 2 s.c., 1 s.c. in next) 3 times, ch. 6, 1 s.c. in s.c. between loops, ch. 6, sk. 4 s.c., 1 s.c. in next (ch. 6, sk. 2 s.c., 1 s.c. in next) twice, ch. 3, sk. 2 s.c., 1 d.c. in next. Turn; (ch. 6, 1 s.c. in next 6-ch. loop) twice, ch. 5, 1 d.c. in next 2 loops, ch. 5, 1 s.c. in next, ch. 6, 1 s.c. in next, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next. Turn; (ch. 6, 1 s.c. in next loop) 4 times, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next. Repeat this row for 4 more rows, each row 1 loop shorter. Fasten off, leaving a 1 inch length of thread, to be worked over later. Join to next s.c. following end of first row of loops on this corner and repeat from * for all 4 corners. Do not break thread after completing 4th corner, but continue with **5th Row.** Work 3 s.c. over half of corner space, (over next space on side of point make 2 s.c., a p., and 1 s.c., 3 s.c. over next space) 3 times. (3 s.c. over next space, and 2 s.c., a p., and 1 s.c. over next)

loop at corner of square make (4 s.c., p., and 4 s.c.). Repeat from * around square, working over the short lengths of thread left from each point. Fasten off. Make another square as far as the 3rd corner of last row. Make 4 s.c. over half of the 6-ch. loop at corner, then ch. 8, 1 s.c. in 5th st. of ch. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in p. at a corner of first square, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in 2nd st. of 8-ch. from last s.c., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of last s.c. Continue across side of square making this same p.-loop joining at 3rd, 6th and next corner ps., across to corresponding ps. on previous square. Make and join enough squares for required length. **Heading Row.** This is worked across one edge of lace from left to right. Ch. 7, a 5-ch. p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in corner p. at left end of lace, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in first st. at start of row, * ch. 18, p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. next p. to right on square, 1 sl. st. in next p. (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, sk. last 4 ps. and 1 st. of 18-ch., 1 sl. st. in next st., ch. 27, p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. 2 ps. on square, 1 sl. st. in next, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, sk. last 4 ps. and 1 ch. st. of 27-chs., 1 sl. st. in next st., ch. 18, p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, sk. 1 p., 1 sl. st. in corner p., (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, sk. last 4 ps., and 1 ch. st. of 18-ch., 1 sl. st. in next, ch. 16, p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in corner p. of next square, (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 2, sk. last 4 ps. and 1 ch. st. of 16-ch., 1 sl. st. in next. Repeat from *.

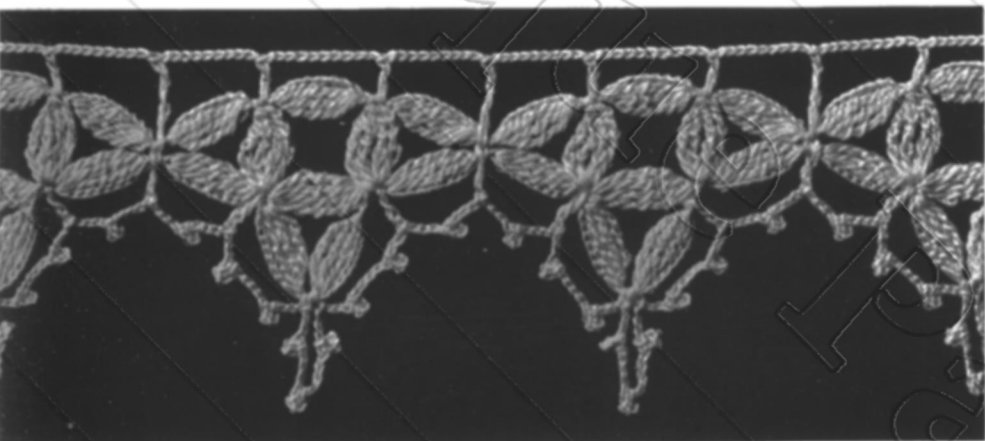

Repeat from * until 8 clusters are finished, then 1 d.c. over next ch. and a sl. st. in first 3-ch. Fasten off. Make another flower, joining 2 petals to 2 petals of first flower as follows: In place of the 5-ch. p. at tip of petal, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in tip of a petal of first flower, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of cluster just made. Continue making flowers, joining them into a zigzag row, as in illustration. **Top Picot-Mesh Sections.** This is made between every 3 flowers. Join to first flower in first free petal at right of joining with second flower, ch. 6, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., ch. 4, 1 d. tr. in joining with second flower, ch. 8, a 5-ch. p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next or middle petal of same flower, ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 d. tr. in joining of this flower with next one to left, ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next petal, ch. 8, p., ch. 11, p., ch. 4, turn; 1 d.c. in last d. tr., ch. 8, p., ch. 11, p., ch. 4, 1 d.c. in next d. tr., ch. 8, p., ch. 11, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in same petal at start of section. Fasten off. Repeat across top of lace, filling in all spaces. **Top Heading Row on Same Edge.** Join to top petal of first flower, ch. 19, 1 d.c. in center of next p.-loop, * (ch. 12, 1 d.c. in next p.-loop) twice, ch. 16, 1 d.c. in top petal of next flower, ch. 16, 1 d.c. in next p.-loop. Repeat from *. **Pointed Edge.** From end of last row in top petal of last flower, count around to left and join to third petal, ch. 8 in place of a d. tr., * ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next petal, ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 d. tr. in joining of flowers, ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next petal,

(ch. 8, p., ch. 11, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next petal) twice, ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 d. tr. in joining of flowers. Repeat from *. **2nd Row.** Join to 8th st. of ch. at start of last row, * (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 10, p., (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in 3rd st. following 2nd p., ch. 7, p., ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in next d. tr. of last row, (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 10, p., (ch. 8, p.) twice, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in 3rd st. following 2nd p., ch. 7, p., ch. 8, p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. in center of next p.-loop of last row. another square as far as the p. in center of scallop at 3rd corner, ch. 8, 1 s.c. in 5th st. from hook to form a 5-ch. p., (ch 6, a 5-ch. p.) twice, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in p. at a corner scallop of first square, (ch. 6, p.) 3 times, ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in 2nd st. of first 8-ch., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of last tr., 5 more tr. in same corner st., sk. 7 d.c., 5 tr. in next st., ch. 8, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in p. of next scallop along side of first square, ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. back in 2nd st. of 8-ch., ch. 2, 1 sl. st. in top of last tr., 5 more tr. in same st. Connect the next scallop in same way as the last, and then connect the corner scallop to corner of first square with the same long p.-loop as was used for first corner joining. Complete 4th side of square and fasten off. Continue joining squares for required length.

Heading Row. Join to top right hand corner of first square, ch. 6 in place of a tr. (ch. 11, 1 d.c. in p. of next scallop, ch. 10, 1 d.c. in p. of next scallop, ch. 11, 1 tr. in p. of corner scallop, ch. 12, 1 tr. in corner p. of next square) repeated. Fasten off.

Ch. 16, 1 d. tr. in first st., ch. 6, 1 tr. in same st., * ch. 3, turn; 9 d.c. over 6-ch., 1 d.c. in d. tr., 10 d.c. over half of next ch., ch. 3, turn; sk. last d.c., (1 d.c. in next 3 d.c., a 5-ch. p in top of last d.c., 1 d.c. in same st. with last d.c.) twice, 1 d.c. in next 3 d.c., 3 d.c. in next st., which is center d.c. of fan. 1 d.c. in next 4 d.c., (p., 1 d.c. in same st. with last d.c., 1 d.c. in next 3 d.c.) twice. Pull out loop on hook, pass ball thru and pull tight. Let thread lie across back of work to center of last row. Insert hook in 2nd of the 3 d.c. in center of fan, catch thread and pull thru and make 1 ch. st., pulled tight to hold thread. Ch. 15, 1 d. tr. in same center d.c. ch. 6, 1 tr. in same st. Repeat from * for required length. Following last fan, do not break thread. **Heading Rows.** Ch. 19, 1 d.c. in corner of next fan (ch. 16, 1 d.c. in corner of next) repeated. LAUNDERING ART NEEDLEWORK

Each embroidered piece should be handled separately.

Use **NUN'S SOAP** for **WOOLENS** and **EMBROIDERIES** to make a good suds in plenty of hot water. Do not rub. Squeeze and press gently. If article is badly soiled, use two or three changes of suds. Rinse article well in clear cold water until all soap has been removed. Press out surplus water with hands. Dry at once without sun, oven or radiator heat. Never allow wet embroidery to lie in a heap or be rolled or folded without another cloth between. It is harmful for em-

broidered surfaces to come in contact with unworked parts of the material while wet. When fairly dry, iron on wrong side with a moderately hot iron. An excessively hot iron should never be used on embroidered pieces on account of the danger of scorching the cloth. A scorched fabric may be restored to its original condition providing the threads have not been injured. Wet the scorched places and expose the material to the sun. Repeat until spots disappear.



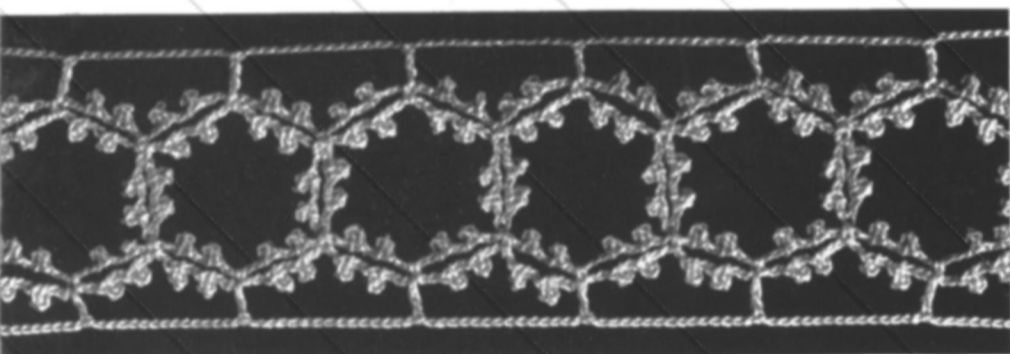

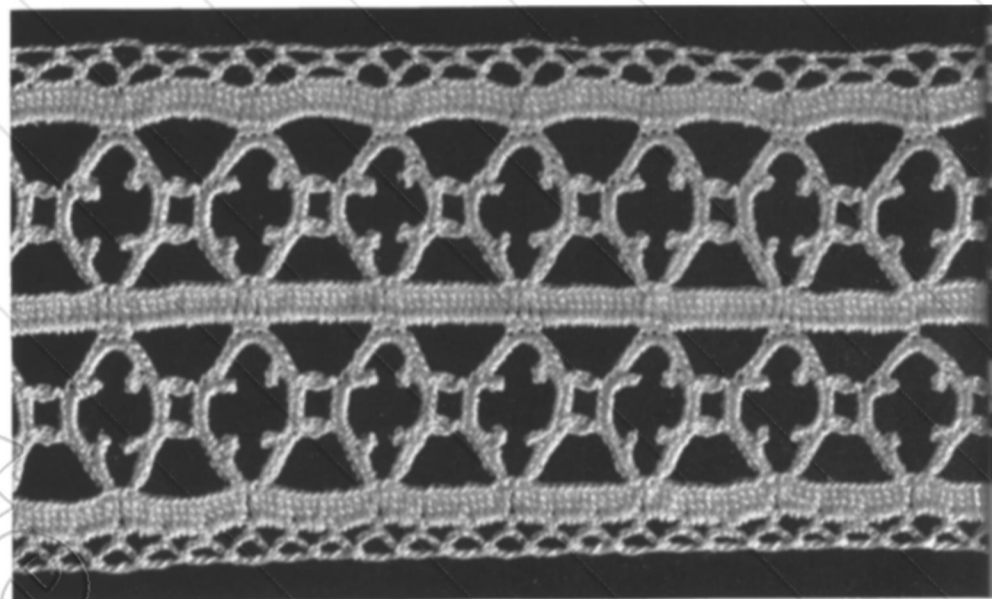

Repeat from start of row. Fasten off. **3rd Row.**

Repeat from *. **4th Row.** * (ch. 6, p.) twice, ch. 3, 1 s.c. between next 2nd and 3rd ps. of last row, ch. 7, p., ch. 6, p., ch. 2, 1 s.c. in same st. with sl. st. between loops of last row, working over the top of sl. st. Repeat from *. Fasten off. **Heading Row.** Join to s.c. between first 2 p.-loops of last row, ch. 3 in place of a d.c., (ch. 14, sk. next 4 ps., 1 d.c. in next s.c.) repeated. Fasten off. Repeat this row on other side of lace.

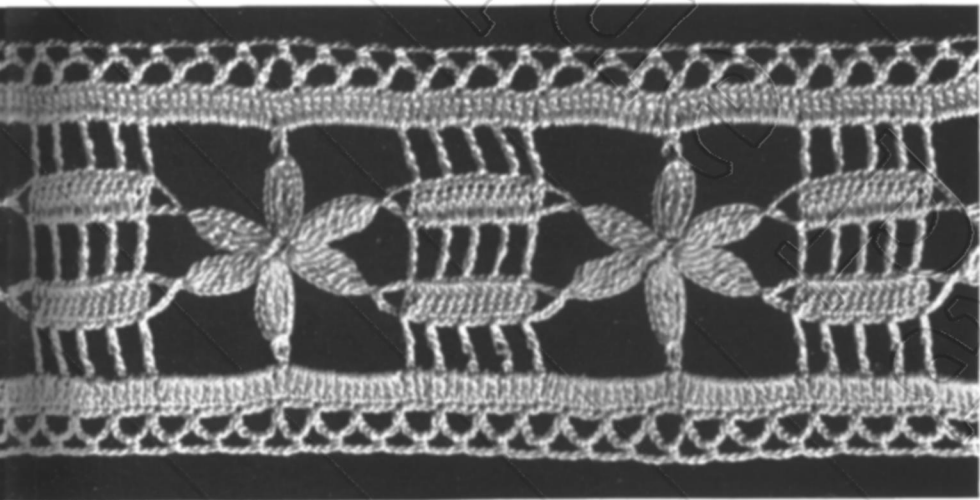

This makes a circle loop with the 4 ps. on inside of circle. Turn; 3 s.c. over last 3-ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., (2 s.c., a 5-ch. p. in last s.c., 4 s.c., p., 1 s.c.) over next ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 9 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 7 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 3 s.c. over next ch., sl. st. in top of last d.c., * (4 d.c. over next 3-ch. of 2nd row, 1 d.c. in next h.d.c.) 3 times, ch. 7, turn, p., ch. 10, p., ch. 12, p., ch. 10, p., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. back in 2nd from last d.c., turn; 3 s.c. over last 3-ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 2 s.c. over next ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in 6th s.c. up side of last circle loop, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., 4 s.c. over ch., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in 4th s.c. up side of last circle loop, ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in last s.c., 1 s.c. over ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 9 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 7 s.c. over next ch., 1 s.c. in base of next p., 3 s.c. over next ch., 1 sl. st. in top of last d.c. Repeat from *. Fasten off. **4th Row.** Join to center top of first circle loop, working 1 s.c. in 3 center s.c., (ch. 10, 1

s.c. in the 3 center s.c. at top of next circle loop) repeated. Fasten off. **5th Row.** Join to start of last row, ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next 2 s.c. Now make another row of d.c. and circle loops, repeating from * * in 3rd row; and between circle loops, make 12 d.c. over each 10-ch. of last row and 1 d.c. in next 3 s.c., then a circle loop. **6th Row.** Repeat 4th row. **7th Row.** Make 12 d.c. over each 10-ch. and 1 d.c. in 3 s.c. between chs. of last row. **8th Row.** Turn; sl. st. in 2nd of last 3 d.c., (ch. 6, sk. 4 d.c., 1 s.c. in next) repeated. **9th Row.** Ch. 6, turn; 1 h.d.c. in last loop of last row, (ch. 3, 1 h.d.c. in next loop) repeated.

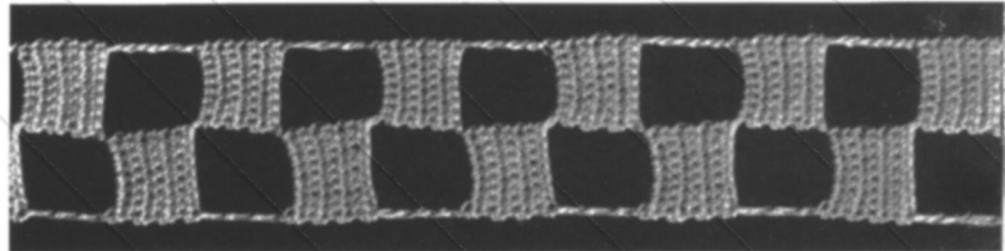

Repeat from beginning for required length, ending row with a flower with 2 petals in it. **2nd Row.** (Ch. 9, a 2 d. tr. cluster in first st., p., ch. 8, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster) 3 times. This makes 5 petals in this flower. 1 sl. st. at base of 2nd petal, ch. 9, a 3 d. tr. cluster in same st., * ch. 8, 1 d.c. in first st., 1 tr. in corner of next d.c.-group of last row, (ch. 2, sk. 2 sts. across same d.c.-group, 1 tr. in next st.) 4 times, ch. 4, turn; (2 d.c. over next 2-ch., 1 d.c. in next tr.) 3 times, 2 d.c. over next 2-ch., sk. 2 sts. of next 8-ch., 1 sl. st. in next st., ch. 1, turn; 1 s.c. in each of the last 11-d.c. and in top of 4-ch. at end, ch. 4, 1 d.c. in top of last tr., ch. 9, a 3 d. tr. cluster in first st. of ch., 1 sl. st. at base of next petal of last row, ch. 9, a 2 d. tr. cluster in first st., p., ch. 8, 1 sl. st. at base of cluster, 1 sl. st. at base of next petal of last row, ch. 9, a 3 d. tr. cluster in same st. 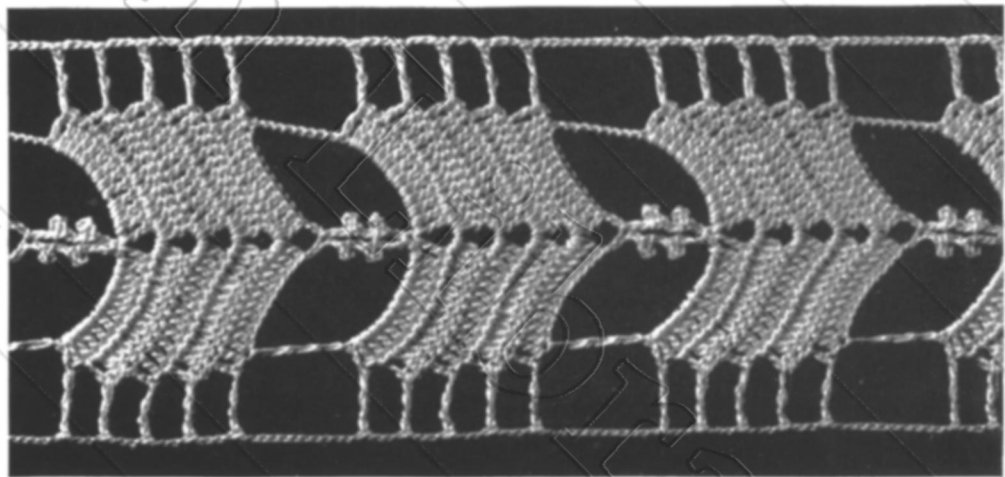

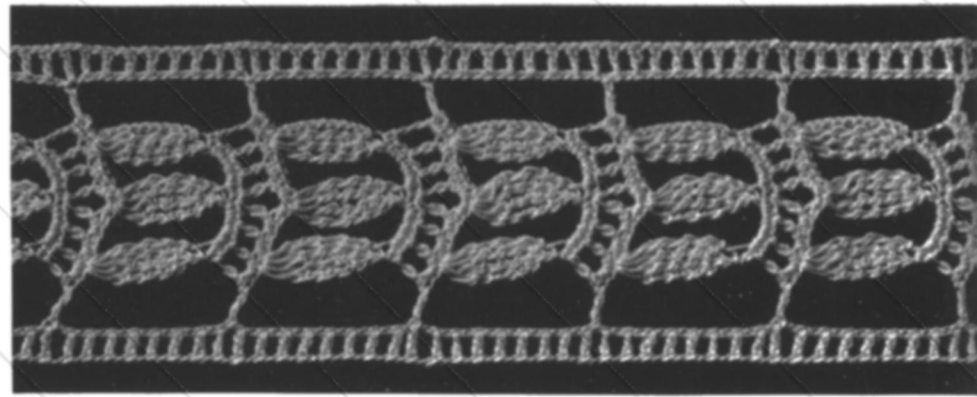

plete row with 11 d.c. **6th Row.** Ch. 1, turn; sk. last d.c., 1 sl. st. in next 2 d.c., ch. 21, 1 s.c. in center of p.-loop, ch. 11, sk. next 10 d.c., 1 d. tr. in next. **7th Row.** Ch. 3, turn; 11 d.c. over last 11-ch., (1 d.c., ch. 4, and 1 d.c.) in next s.c., 11 d.c. over next 11-ch., 1 d.c. in 9th st. of same ch. counting from left end. Repeat from * for required length. **Heading Row.** Without breaking thread at end of lace, ch. 9, 1 tr. in corner of next row of d.c. down side of lace, (ch. 3, 1 tr. in next corner) 3 times, ch. 11, 1 d.c. in corner of first row of d.c. of next group, (ch. 3, 1 d.c. in next corner) 4 times. 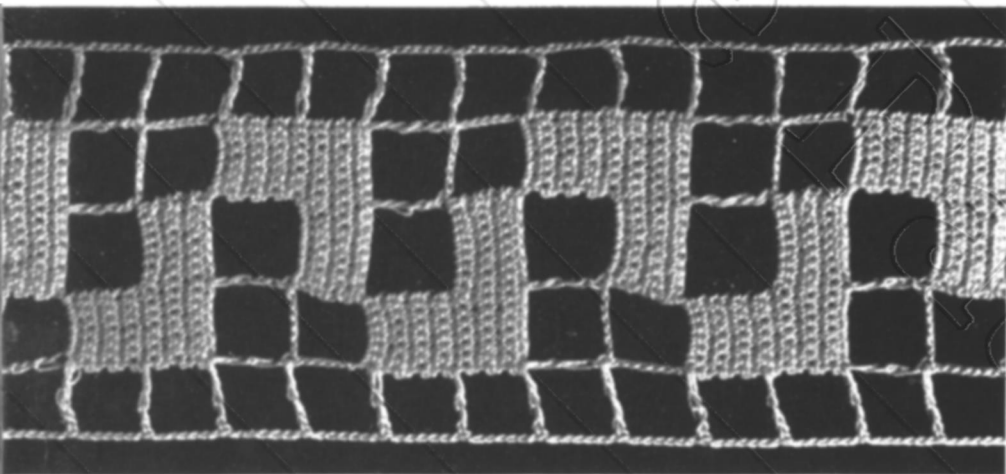
