CROCHET COTTON

2 - 250 Yd. Balls White

Small White Beads

4 Small Snaps

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 OR ANY SIZE
HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH
GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 8 sts = 1 inch

SKIRT: Ch 101, s c in 2nd st from hook,
d c in next ch, * s c in next ch, d c in
next ch, repeat from * across ch, ch 1
to turn all rows. **2nd ROW:** * S c in d c,
d c in s c, repeat from * across row.
Repeat the 2nd row for pattern. Work even
in pattern until skirt measures 6½ inches
from beg. **WAISTLINE DEC ROW:** * Insert
hook in next st, pull loop through, repeat
from * twice, thread over and pull through
all loops (2 sts dec), repeat from 1st *
across row (34 sts). **NEXT ROW:** Dec 6 sts
evenly spaced (28 sts). Work even for
1 inch. **NEXT ROW: SHAPE BUSTLINE:**
Work in pattern across 1st 9 sts, working
in pattern work 5 sts in each of the next
3 sts, 1 st in each of the next 4 sts, 5 sts
in each of the next 3 sts, work even across
remaining 9 sts. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work
even in pattern. **NEXT ROW:** Work across
1st 9 sts, dec 1 st in next 2 sts (to dec
1 st: * insert hook in next st, pull loop
through, repeat from * once, thread over
and pull through all loops), work even
across next 13 sts, dec 2 sts in next 4 sts,
work even across next 13 sts, dec 1 st in
next 2 sts, work even across remaining sts.
NEXT 2 ROWS: Work even in pattern, cut
thread. Sew back seam leaving 2¾ inches
free for back opening at top.

FINISHING: Attach thread at side of last
row of right side and work a row of s c



all around back opening to opposite
corner. Crochet a chain long enough
to go from center front around neck
to tie. Sew center of chain to center of
front bodice. Sew 2 beads in each st of
ch to within 8 sts of each end thus leaving
8 sts of ch free at ends for tying. Sew
snaps in position.

FLOWER: Make 21. Ch 4, join to form a
ring, * ch 3, sl st in ring, repeat from *
5 times. **NEXT ROUND:** * Sl st in next
ch 3 loop, 1 s c, 3 d c, 1 s c, sl st in
same loop, repeat from * 5 times (6 petals).
Sew 15 flowers around lower edge of skirt.
Sew 2 beads in center of each petal of
flower. Sew 6 flowers around waistline
sewing 2 beads in each petal.

CROCHETED BRIDAL CAPE

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
The Famous "PURITAN" MERCERIZED
CROCHET COTTON

2-250 Yd. Balls White

Steel Crochet Hook No. 5

1 Yd. ¼ inch White Satin Ribbon

⅓ Yd. Nylon Tulle

Ch 68, 1 d c in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, turn (65 d c).

2nd ROW: Ch 8, sl st in 4th ch from hook for picot, ch 1, skip 1 d c, 1 d c in next d c, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch for picot, ch 1, skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, repeat from * across row, turn (32 picots).

3rd ROW: Ch 7, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in 1st d c, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in same d c, repeat from * across row, working last 2 d c in 3rd ch (counts as 1 d c), turn (65 picots). **4th ROW:** Ch 8, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from * across row working last d c in 3rd ch, turn. Repeat 4th row 10 times, cut thread, turn. **15th ROW:**

SLEEVE SHAPING: Attach thread in 6th d c, ch 8, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from * 53 times, cut thread, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Attach thread in 2nd d c, ch 8, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from * across row to within last d c (2 picots dec in row), cut thread. Repeat the last row until one picot mesh remains.

SLEEVES: Pin 1st d c of 14th row to 6th d c of same row on each side. Sew seams from 14th to 6th row.

NECKEDGE: Attach thread to 1st st of 1st row, * skip 3 sts, 1 sl st in next st, repeat from * across row, cut thread. Attach thread in 5th picot row at armhole edge, ch 6, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, s c in next d c space, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, s c in next d c space, repeat from * 4 times, * ch 5, sl st in 4th ch, ch 1, skip ⅛ inch space, s c in next st, repeat from * across neckedge and complete armhole to correspond, cut thread.

FLOWERS: Ch 4, join to form a ring, * ch 4, holding last loop on hook 2 d c in 1st ch, thread over and pull through all loops on hook (cluster st), s c in ring, repeat from * 5 times, cut thread. Work 5 more flowers. Attach thread in space between petals, * ch 2, 1 sl st in space between petals of next flower, repeat from * once, cut thread. Make another cluster of flowers in same manner. Finish with beads same as dress.

BOUQUET: Cut 3 - 10 inch lengths ribbon, fold each length in half, draw each length through the center of flowers leaving about ¼ inch loop on right side. Attach to hand.

HEAD PIECE: Cut a circle of tulle 11 inches in diameter. Fold the tulle back 5 inches. Work running sts from 3 inches on one side to within 3 inches of other side, draw tightly. Tack a 3 flower cluster to tulle for bridal veil.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7 OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW

3 Small Snaps

1 Small Button

GAUGE: 11 sts = 1 inch (Blouse and skirt)

BLOUSE FRONT: With National Blue ch 28, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. **2nd ROW:** Working in front loop of st s c in next s c, * working in back loop of st, s c in next s c, working in front loop of st, s c in next s c, repeat from * across row (pattern). **3rd and 4th ROWS:** Repeat 2nd row. **5th ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg and end of row. (Note: to keep pattern uniform work as follows: if a st of previous row is worked in front loop of st work in front loop of same st in next row, if a st is worked in back loop of st work in back loop of st in next row). **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and end of row (to inc: insert hook in front (or back) loop of st, thread over, pull through, insert hook in back (or front) of same st, thread over, pull through all loops). **NEXT ROW:** Work even. Repeat last 2 rows twice. Place a marker in center st (16th st). **NEXT ROW:** Work to 6th st from center, inc 1 st in next st, then inc 1 st in next st, work 7 sts, then inc in corresponding manner on other side of center st. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st in 6th st and 1 st in 5th st from each side of center st. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Work to 9th st from center, dec 2 sts in next 4 sts, work across row dec 2 sts

in corresponding manner on other side of center st. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Work to within 8th st from center, dec 2 sts in next 4 sts, work across row dec 2 sts in corresponding manner on other side of center st. **NEXT ROW:** Work even, cut thread. **NEXT ROW:** Attach thread in 4th s c, 1 s c in each s c to within 4th s c at end of row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Dec 1 st at each end of each row. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Work 1st 3 s c, dec 1 st, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, work across row. **NEXT ROW:** Work across remaining 3 sts, cut thread (right shoulder). Work left shoulder in corresponding manner.

BACK: With National Blue ch 14, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch. **2nd, 3rd and 4th ROWS:** Work even. **5th ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, work across row. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg of row, work across row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. Repeat last 2 rows twice. Continue to work even until section measures same as front to armholes, cut thread. **NEXT ROW:** Attach thread in 4th st from side edge, work across. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Dec 1 st at end of the 1st row worked and dec 1 st at beg of the 2nd row worked. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Work 1st 3 s c, dec 1 st, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, work across row. **NEXT ROW:** Work across remaining 3 sts, cut thread. Work a 2nd section to correspond reversing all shapings.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder and side seams. **EDGE:** Work 1 row of s c around each armhole. Attach thread at lower edge of center back, work 1 row of s c all around edge, cut thread. Sew snaps in position on back opening.

1/3 Yd. 1/4 inch ribbon

2 Small Snaps

Steel Crochet Hook No. 7

ROSE: Ch 4, join to form a ring, * ch 4, sl st in ring, repeat from * 5 times. **2nd**

ROUND: 1 s c, 3 d c, 1 s c in each loop (petals). **3rd ROUND:** Ch 3, holding petal

Crocheted Squares for your Dolly

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

“DAWN” DE LUXE FINGERING YARN or

“DAWN” NYLON

1 skein White

Steel Crochet Hook No. 00 OR ANY SIZE
HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH
GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: Each motif measures 1¼ inches.

Sleeve Motif: ¾ inch.

MOTIF: Ch 4, join to form a ring, sl st in
ring, * ch 3, sl st in ring, repeat from * 7
times, do not join this or following rounds.
Place a marker at beg of each round. **2nd**

ROUND: * 3 s c in next loop, 1 s c in next
loop, repeat from * all around. **3rd ROUND:**
Working in back loop of sts only work 1 s c
in each s c working 3 s c in center s c at
each corner, sl st to corner st, cut yarn.
Work 15 motifs. Sew motifs tog in back loop
of sts, sewing 3 x 3 for back. Sew 1 x 3 for
each front.

SLEEVE MOTIF: Work 1 st 2 rounds same
as motif, sl st to corner st, cut yarn. Work
12 motifs. Sew 3 x 2 for each sleeve.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder, side and sleeve
seams leaving 1 motif free for armhole at
back and fronts. Sew sleeves in posit' on.

EDGE: Attach yarn in corner at lower edge
of right front and working in back loop of
sts, 3 s c in same space, work 1 s c in each
st all around to opposite corner, 3 s c in
corner, 1 s c in each st across lower edge,
join in 1st s c. **NEXT ROUND:** Work 1 s c
in each s c, join, cut yarn. Work a row of
s c around each sleeve edge.

Outdoor Dress-Ups

KNITTED HAT AND COAT

(at right)

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

"DAWN" MOHSPUN

1 skein White

1 Pr. Knitting Needles No. 1 OR ANY SIZE NEEDLES WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW

1 Small Pearl Button

GAUGE: 11 sts = 2 inches

COAT

Starting at lower edge cast on 58 sts. **1st ROW:** K across row. **2nd, 3rd and 4th ROWS:** **NOTE:** Always sl the 1st st at front edge throughout. P across each row. **NEXT 6 ROWS:** Work in stockinette st (K 1, P 1 row). **START SHAPING:** **1st DEC ROW:** K 17, sl 1 as if to K, K 1, p.s.s.o. (dec), K 20, K 2 tog (dec), K 17. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Continue in stockinette st (**NOTE:** Always work 3 even stockinette rows between each of the following dec rows; this will not be referred to again). **2nd DEC ROW:** K 16, dec 1 st, K 20, dec 1 st, K 16. **3rd DEC ROW:** K 16, dec 1 st, K 18, dec 1 st, K 16. **4th DEC ROW:** K 15, dec 1 st, K 18, dec 1 st, K 15. **5th DEC ROW:** K 15, dec 1 st, K 16, dec 1 st, K 15. **6th DEC ROW:** K 13, dec 1 st twice, K 14, dec 1 st twice, K 13. **7th DEC ROW:** K 12, dec 1 st twice, K 12, dec 1 st twice, K 12. **8th DEC ROW:** K 11, dec 1 st twice, K 10, dec 1 st twice, K 11. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even in stockinette st. **START BACK AND FRONT SEPARATION:** **NEXT ROW:** K 9, dec 1 st, turn. (**Right Front**). **NEXT 7 ROWS:** Work in stockinette st. **NEXT ROW:** K 2, bind off 1 st (for buttonhole), K remaining sts. **NEXT ROW:** P across, cast on 1 st over bound off st. **NEXT ROW:** **NECK SHAPING:** Bind off 4 sts, work across remaining sts. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at end of row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** **SHAPE SHOULDER:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Bind off remaining sts.

BACK: Attach yarn, dec 1 st, K 10, dec 1 st, turn. **NEXT 9 ROWS:** Work even in stockinette st. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** **SHAPE SHOULDERS:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of each row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Bind off 2 sts at beg of each row. Draw yarn through remaining sts.

LEFT FRONT: Attach yarn and work same as right front reversing the shaping and omitting the buttonhole.

SLEEVES: Cast on 12 sts. **1st 3 ROWS:** K across each row. **4th ROW:** P across row. Work in stockinette st for 10 rows. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. Work even until sleeve is desired length.

SHAPE CAP: **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Bind off 1 st at beg of each row. Bind off remaining sts.

COLLAR: Cast on 26 sts. **1st 5 ROWS:** K across each row. **6th ROW:** K 2, * K 2 tog, K 2, repeat from * across row. Bind off.

FINISHING: Sew sleeve and shoulder seams. Turn hem back along ridge of sleeves and lower edge of coat. Tack in position. Sew collar in position easing in any fullness. Work a row of slip sts along each front edge and around collar. Sew button in position.

HAT

Cast on 24 sts, K 3 rows. **NEXT ROW:** K across row inc 6 sts evenly spaced (30 sts). **NEXT 5 ROWS:** Work in stockinette st starting with a P row. **NEXT ROW:** * K 1, K 2 tog, repeat from * across row. **NEXT ROW:** P across row. **NEXT ROW:** K 2 tog across row, cut yarn leaving a length for sewing. Draw yarn through sts and fasten securely. Sew seam.

POMPON: Wind yarn 20 times over 1 inch cardboard. Slip off cardboard, tie at center, cut both ends and trim into shape. Attach to top of Hat.

The Mother of the Bride

SEQUIN 2 PIECE DRESS

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY

"DAWN" ORLON

1 ounce Baby Green

1 Pr. Knitting Needles No. 1 OR ANY SIZE
NEEDLES WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH
GAUGE BELOW

1 strand Crystal Iris 5 M/M cup sequin

3 small snaps

GAUGE: 8 sts = 1 inch

TO WORK WITH SEQUINS: Sequins are strung on a double strand of thread. Untie strand, place yarn through loop and pull strand of sequins onto yarn.

SKIRT: BACK: Cast on 27 sts, K 1 row.

START PATTERN: 1st ROW: K 2, * pull sequin close to st, K 1 pulling sequin through st, K 1, repeat from * across row ending last repeat with K 2. **2nd ROW:** P across row. **3rd ROW:** K 1, * K 1 pulling sequin through st, K 1, repeat from * across row. **4th ROW:** P across row. Repeat these 4 rows for pattern throughout. Continue in pattern until there are 25 sequin rows ending with sequin row. **NEXT ROW:** P across row dec 1 st at beg and end of row. Work 4 more sequin rows. **NEXT ROW:** P across row dec 1 st at beg and end of row. Work 4 more sequin rows. Discontinue sequins. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, P 3, * P 2 tog, P 2, repeat from * 3 times, P 2 tog. **NEXT ROW:** K across row. Bind off.

FRONT: Work same as back but start with 3rd pattern row.

Ripple Shift

illustrated on page 9

FINISHING: Sew side seams. Crochet a chain 10 inches long, cut yarn. Lace chain at waistline and draw tight.

SHELL

FRONT: Cast on 23 sts, K 1 row. Work in pattern same as front of skirt until there are 9 sequin rows ending with sequin row. **START ARMHOLE AND NECK SHAPING. NEXT 2 ROWS:** Bind off 2 sts at beg of row. **NEXT ROW:** Work across 9 sts, place remaining sts on st holder. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg and end of row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even in pattern. Repeat last 2 rows twice, 3 sts remain. Work even until there are 14 sequin rows from beg. Bind off. Attach yarn at center, bind off 1 st, then work other side to correspond.

LEFT BACK: Cast on 11 sts, work same as back of skirt. Work in pattern until there are 9 sequin rows ending with sequin row. **NEXT ROW: START ARMHOLE AND NECK SHAPING:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, work across remaining sts. **NEXT ROW:** Work even in pattern. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg and end of row. Repeat last 2 rows once. Work back and forth in pattern on these sts, always dec 1 st at neck edge on every P row until 3 sts remain, bind off. Work other side to correspond.

FINISHING: Sew side and shoulder seams. Sl st around armholes and front edges. Sew snaps in position at back.

Starting at lower edge ch 48, join in 1st st of ch taking care not to twist ch. **1st ROUND:** Ch 1, s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, * 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, skip 1 st of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from * 4 times, 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, join in 1st s c. **2nd ROUND:** Ch 1, turn, working in back loop of sts throughout skip 1 s c, * 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, skip 2 s c, repeat from * all around, join in 1st s c. Repeat last round 17 times (4 inches). **NEXT ROW:** Ch 1, turn, skip 1 s c, * dec 1 s c (to dec: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert in next st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, s c in next s c, dec 1 s c, skip 2 s c, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, join in 1st st. **NEXT 4 ROUNDS:** Ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, * 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c. **NEXT ROUND:** Ch 1, turn, skip 1 s c, * 2 s c in next s c, s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, skip next 2 s c, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, join in 1st s c. **NEXT 3**

HIS PLAIN SWEATER

Materials Required:

"DAWN" DE LUXE FINGERING YARN or
"DAWN" NYLON

1 skein Red or Scarlet

1 Pr. Aluminum Knitting Needles No. 3 OR
ANY SIZE NEEDLES WHICH WILL RESULT
IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 7 sts = 1 inch

BACK: Cast on 22 sts, work in K 1, P 1,
ribbing for 3 rows, then work in stockinette
st (K 1 row, P 1 row) until work measures
4 inches from beg. **SHAPE SHOULDERS:**
Bind off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. **COL-**
LAR: Work remaining sts in K 1, P 1 rib-
bing for 3 rows, bind off.

FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Cast on 14 sts. Work in K 1, P 1,
ribbing for 3 rows, then work in stockinette
until work measures 1 inch from beg. **NEXT**
ROW: Inc 1 st at beg and end of row.
Work even for 1 inch. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st
at beg and end of row. Work even until
sleeve measures 2¾ inches from beg.

SHAPE SLEEVES: Bind off 3 sts at beg of
next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at beg of each
row until 4 sts remain. Bind off remaining
sts 2 at a time.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder, side and sleeve
seams. Sew sleeves in position. Sew sides
of collar. Cut letter from felt and applique
in place.

BODICE: Ch 36, 1 d c in 4th st from hook
and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3 to
turn all rows. **2nd ROW:** Ch 3 (counts as
1st d c), 1 d c in each remaining st. **3rd**
ROW: Ch 3, 1 d c in each of next 6 sts,
3 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next
18 sts, 3 d c in next st, 1 d c in each re-
maining st, 38 sts. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work-
ing in d c work 3 d c in center st at both
inc points, 50 sts. **NEXT ROW:** Side Back
of bodice, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next
9 d c, ch 3, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Work even,
ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 s c in each of

and 7th ROWS: Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing,
drop White. **8th ROW:** Pick up Color, K
across row. **9th, 10th and 11th ROWS:** Work
in K 1, P 1, ribbing, drop Color. Repeat
from 4th row for stripe pattern until there
are 6 Color stripes, cut White. **SHAPE**
SHOULDERS: With Color bind off 7 (5) sts
at beg of next 2 rows. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work
in K 1, P 1 ribbing inc 1 st at each end of
each row, bind off.

FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: With Color cast on 14 (10)
sts. Work 3 rows in K 1, P 1 ribbing,
then work in stockinette st (K 1 row,
P 1 row) until work measures 1 inch
from beg. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and
end of row. Work even for 1 inch. **NEXT**
ROW: Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. Work
even until sleeve measures $2\frac{3}{4}$ ($2\frac{1}{2}$)
inches from beg. **SHAPE ARMHOLES:** Bind
off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec
1 st at beg of each row until 4 sts remain.
Bind off remaining sts 2 at a time.

FINISHING: Sew side seams leaving $1\frac{1}{2}$
inches open for armhole. Sew shoulder and
sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position. Sew
both sides of 3 rows of ribbing at neckedge,

HAT

Cast on 24 sts and work same as back
until there are 5 color stripes, cut yarn

COLLAR: NEXT 9 ROWS: Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing.

FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Cast on 16 sts. Work in pattern same as back until there are 4 cable rows.

NEXT ROW: Inc 1 st each side. Continue in pattern inc 1 st each side in row after the 6th and 7th cable rows. Work even for 1

more pattern (8 cable rows). **NEXT 2 ROWS:** **SHAPE CAP:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of each row, then dec 1 st each side every other row until 10 sts remain. Bind off remaining sts.

FINISHING: Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position.

TROUSERS

BOTH SUITS work as follows: Cast on 20 sts, work in stockinette st (P 1 row, K 1 row) for $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. Continue in stockinette st inc 1 st each side every inch twice, then $\frac{1}{2}$ inch once. Work even until section measures $4\frac{3}{4}$ inches from beg. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Bind off 2 sts at beg of each row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at each side. Work even until section measures $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches from 1st bind off ending with a K row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** K across each row. Bind off in P. Work another section in same manner.

FINISHING: Block both sections to measurements. Sew seams. Sew a strip of narrow ribbon on side of each trouser leg for tuxedo.

JACKET

Directions are given for Tuxedo. Changes for Business Suit are given in parentheses. **BACK:** Cast on 22 sts. Work in stockinette st for $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st each side. Continue in stockinette st for 1 inch. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st each side. Work even for $\frac{3}{4}$ inch. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** **SHAPE ARMHOLES.** Bind off 2 sts at beg of each row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st each side. Repeat last 2 rows twice. Work even until armholes measures 1 inch from 1st bind off. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** **SHAPE SHOULDERS:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of each row. Bind off remaining sts.

RIGHT FRONT: Cast on 8 sts, P across row. **2nd ROW:** K across row inc 1 st at beg of row. **3rd ROW:** P across row inc 1 st at end of row. Repeat last 2 rows until there are 14 sts on needles. Continue even in stockinette st until front measures $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches from beg. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at side edge. Work even until front measures $2\frac{1}{4}$ ($2\frac{3}{4}$) inches from beg. **NEXT ROW:** **START NECK SHAPING:** Dec 1 st at front edge, then every 7th (5th) row 4 times. Shape remainder of side edge and armholes same as back. Bind off shoulders same as back. Mark position for button (buttons) placing marker $1\frac{1}{2}$ (1) inches from lower edge for Tuxedo. For Business Suit mark position for 2 more buttons having top button below neck shaping and remaining button evenly spaced between buttons.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as Right Front reversing all shaping. Work to marker ending at front edge. **NEXT ROW:** Work 2 sts, bind off next st (buttonhole), work across remainder of row. In next row, cast on 2 sts over bound off sts. Work remainder of front same as right front reversing shaping and working 2 more buttonholes for business suit. **SLEEVES:** Cast on 12 sts. Work same as back until sleeve measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches from beg *. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st each side. Work even for $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Repeat from * once, then work even until sleeve

measures $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches from beg. **SHAPE CAP: NEXT 2 ROWS:** Bind off 2 sts at beg of each row, then dec 1 st each side every other row twice. Dec 1 st each side every row twice. Bind off remaining sts.

FINISHING: Block all sections to measurements. Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position. Sew button (buttons) in position.

COLLAR FOR TUXEDO: Cut a strip of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch ribbon to fit around front and back of neck (about 9 inches long). Fold length in half. Sew edges of ribbon to edges of front and back of neck of jacket tapering to points at each end as illustrated.

CUMMERBUND: Sew long edges of three 6 inch lengths of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch ribbon tog. Pleat at seams. Make a small hem on each end. Finish with snaps. **TIE:** Make a bow tie of narrow ribbon.

BUSINESS SUIT COLLAR: Cast on 1 st.

1st ROW: K 1, P 1 in st. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Starting with a K row work in stockinette st. **NEXT ROW:** Inc in 1st st, P across row. **NEXT 5 ROWS:** Work in stockinette st. **NEXT ROW:** Inc in 1st st, P across row (shaped side is outer edge). **NEXT 7 ROWS:** Work in stockinette st. **NEXT ROW:** Inc in 1st st, P across row. **NEXT ROW:** K across row. **NEXT ROW:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of row, P across remaining sts. **NEXT ROW:** K across, cast on 3 sts at end of row. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Work even in stockinette st. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at end of row. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row. **NEXT ROW:** Shape center back. Work across 2 sts, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Work across 2 sts. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work across 3 sts. Repeat last 4 rows once. **NEXT 6 ROWS:** Work even in stockinette st ending at outer edge. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at end of row. **NEXT ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg of row. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Bind off 3 sts at beg of row. **NEXT ROW:** Cast on 3 sts at end of row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg of row, then complete shaping same as opposite side. Steam. Sew in position.

SLEEVES: Ch 10 and work 9 s c across ch. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Work even. **5th ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Work even. Repeat last 5 rows once, then repeat 5th row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work even. **18th ROW:** Dec 2 sts at beg and end of row. **19th ROW:** Dec 1 st at beg and end of row, cut yarn. Sew shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position.

EDGE: Attach yarn at lower edge of right front * ch 1, sl st in next row, repeat from * all around jacket working into each st across back of neck and lower edge.

SKIRT: Ch 31, s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows. **NEXT 19 ROWS:** Work 1 s c in each s c. **21st ROW:** 1 s c in each of the next 5 sts, dec 1 st in next 2 sts, work even across row to within last 7 sts, dec 1 st in next 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the remaining 5 sts. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** 1 s c in each s c. Repeat last 3 rows twice, cut yarn. Sew back seam matching rows and leaving 1 inch open at top. Finish top with hook and eye or a snap fastener.

HAT: Ch 4, 11 d c in 1st st of ch (ch 3 at beg of row counts as 1st d c), join in 3rd st of ch, ch 1, turn. **2nd ROW:** Working in back loop of sts only work 2 s c in each d c (24 s c), do not join this or following rows, ch 1 to turn each row. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** 1 s c in each s c, cut yarn. Sew back seam.

CROCHETED SLACKS

illustrated on page 7

Work 1st 17 rows same as sleeve of jacket for 1 leg. **18th ROW:** Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. **NEXT 4 ROWS:** Work 1 s c in each s c, cut yarn. Work another leg section in same manner. **NEXT ROW:** Attach yarn in 1st s c of one section, working across both sections work 1 s c in each s c. **NEXT 5 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT ROW:** Dec 1 st at each hip (center st of each section). **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work even. Repeat last 3 rows once, cut yarn. Fold each leg section in half and sew leg seams. Sew back opening leaving 5 rows free at top. Sew snap or hook and eye at top.

Work 4 more roses in same manner joining each rose in last round as follows: ch 2, sl st in any loop of 1st rose, ch 1, sl st between petals of 2nd rose, ch 2, sl st in next loop of 1st rose, ch 1, sl st between next petals of 2nd rose, then complete round. Join 3rd, 4th, and 5th rose to each rose in same manner having 1 loop free between roses.

BODICE: Join thread in center loop of 1st rose, ch 3, 4 d c in same space, 3 d c in next loop, * 3 d c in next loop of next

SKIRT: With White ch 43, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows (right side). **2nd ROW:** Working loosely and in back loop of sts, sl st in each s c, drop White, pick up National Blue. When changing colors always complete last half of st with new color. **3rd ROW:** With National Blue working in front loop of sts, 2 s c in 1st st, 1 s c in each st to within last 2 sts, skip 1 st, 1 s c in last st. **4th ROW:** Working in back loops of sts sl st in each st, drop National Blue, pick up White. **5th ROW:** Working in front loop of sts 1 s c in each sl st. **6th ROW:** Working in back loop of sts 1 sl st in each st, drop White, pick up National Blue. Repeat from 3rd to 6th rows for pattern until section measures 9 inches ending with 2nd row of National Blue, cut thread.

WAISTBAND: Attach National Blue in 1st s c of 1st row, 1 s c in each stripe, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 s c in each s c dec evenly to 34 s c, ch 1, turn. **NEXT ROW:** 1 s c in each s c, ch 7, sl st at end of 1st s c row for button loop, cut thread.

POCKET: With National Blue ch 12, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch. Work in pattern same as Blouse for 1¼ inches, cut thread. Work 2.

FINISHING: Sew center back seam of skirt for 2½ inches. Sew pockets in position as illustrated. Sew button in place on waistband.

GAUGE: 17 sts = 3 inches

RIGHT FRONT: Working lengthwise with Brown ch 57, 1 s c in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, cut Brown, attach Antique Gold, ch 1 to turn all rows always working the ch 1 with color of next row. **2nd ROW:** Working in back loop of sts throughout work 1 s c in each st, cut Antique Gold. **3rd ROW:** Attach Brown, 1 s c in each s c, cut Brown. Repeat last 2 rows 3 times. **10th ROW:** With Antique Gold skip 10 s c for armhole, 1 s c in each remaining s c. **11th ROW:** With Brown 1 s c in each s c omitting armhole sts. Repeat last 2 rows once, then repeat Antique Gold row. **NEXT ROW:** With Brown ch 10, cut yarn, set ch aside. Work across row, pick up ch and work 10 s c across ch, cut Brown.

BACK: Working in pattern work 24 rows even, then shape armhole same as right front. Work left front to correspond to right front. Sew shoulder seams.

SLEEVES: Attach Brown at underarm and work 20 s c around armhole, join in 1st s c, ch 1, turn and join all rounds.

NEXT 4 ROUNDS: 1 s c in each s c. **NEXT**

ROUND: Dec 1 st at beg and end of round.

NEXT 3 ROUNDS: 1 s c in each s c. **NEXT**

ROUND: Dec 1 st at beg and end of round.

NEXT 10 ROUNDS: 1 s c in each s c.

NEXT ROUND: **CUFF:** Working in front loop

SHORTS: With wrong side of 1st row toward you and working along starting ch, attach thread in 1st st, 1 s c in each st, turn. **2nd ROW:** Ch 3, working in back loop of sts d c in same space, 1 d c in each of the next 15 s c, 2 d c in each of the next 2 s c, 1 s c in each of the next 15 s c, 2 d c in next s c, ch 3, turn. **3rd ROW:** Working in both loops and in d c inc 1 st at beg and end of row and 1 st in each of the 2 center sts. **4th ROW:** Work even in d c joining this and following rows, ch 3 to turn all rows. **5th ROW:** Repeat 3rd row. **6th ROW:** Work even in d c. **7th ROW:** Working in d c inc 1 st in each of the 1st and last 2 sts and in each of the 2 center sts, join, cut thread. Fold shorts in half and sew center sts tog to form leg opening.

SKIRT: Working in free loops of sts of 1st row of shorts attach thread in 1st st, ch 3, d c in same space, * 1 d c in each of the next 5 sts, 3 d c in next st, repeat from * 3 times, 1 d c in each of the next 8 sts, 3 d c in last st, ch 3, turn. **2nd ROW:** * 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, 3 d c in next d c (inc point), repeat from * across row ending with 1 d c in each of last 4 sts, ch 3, turn. **3rd ROW:** Working in d c work 1 d c in each st working 3 d c in center st of each inc point, join this and following rows, ch 3, to turn each row. **4th ROW:** Work even in d c. **5th ROW:** Work 1 d c in each d c and 3 d c in d c directly over center d c of inc point of previous row. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Work even. **NEXT 2 ROWS:** Working in d c work 3 d c in each inc point in each row. **NEXT ROW:** Work even, cut thread.

SLEEVES: Ch 18, 1 d c in 4th st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3 to turn all rows. **2nd ROW:** 1 d c in each d c. Repeat 2nd row 8 times, ch 1 to turn at end of last row. **NEXT ROW:** SHAPE CAP Sl st over next 2 d c, ch 3, dec in next 2

sts (to dec: keeping last loop of each st on hook 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 d c in each d c to within last 4 sts, dec in next 2 sts, ch 3, turn. **NEXT ROW:** Dec in next 2 sts, 1 d c in each d c to within last 2 sts, dec in next 2 sts, cut thread.

FINISHING: Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position. Finish back opening with hooks and eyes or small snap fasteners.

TRIM: Sew 3 rows of rick rack around edge of skirt alternating colors. Sew 1 row of Green around neck edge as illustrated.

TAM

Ch 4, join to form a ring, 12 s c in ring, join in 1st s c. **2nd ROUND:** Ch 3 (counts as 1st d c, d c in same space, 2 d c in each remaining s c, join each round. **3rd ROUND:** Ch 3, 2 d c in next d c, * d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from * all around, join. **4th ROUND:** Ch 3, d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, * 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from * all around, join. **5th and 6th ROUNDS:** Work even in d c. **7th ROUND:** Ch 3, dec in next 2 sts, * 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, dec in next 2 sts, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, join. **NEXT 2 ROUNDS:** Ch 1, 1 s c in each st in each round, join each round, cut thread at end of last round.

TRIM: Sew 3 rows of rick rack around tam as illustrated.
