BODICE... With No. 10 hook make a chain 25 inches long (about 13 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: Sc in 9th ch from hook, dc in next ch, sc in next ch, * ch 4, skip 3 ch, sc in next ch, dc in next ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from * across until there are on row

across until there are on row

Cut off remaining chain. Ch 5, turn.

2nd row: * In next loop make sc, dc and sc, ch 4. Repeat from * across, ending with sc, dc and sc in last loop. Ch 5, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 1½ inches. Now work across half of back as follows: Ch 5, turn and work across until there are in all

Ch 5, turn and work over these loops only until piece measures 6 inches in all. Fasten off. For front, skip 1 loop, attach thread in next loop, ch 5, in next loop make sc, dc and sc, ch 4 and continue across until there are in all for front 22 loops 23 loops

Ch 5, turn and work over these loops only until piece measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches in

To Shape Neck: 1st row: Now work across 10 loops. Turn. 2nd row: Sl st to center of 1st loop, ch 4 and continue in pattern across. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: Work across to last loop, do not work in last loop. Turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows once more (6 loops remain). Work straight until piece measures 6 inches in all. Fasten off.

For other side of front, skip

1 loop 2 loops
attach thread in next loop and work remaining 10 loops to correspond. Fasten off.

For other half of back, skip 1 loop, attach thread in next loop, ch 5, in next loop make sc, dc and sc, ch 4 and work remaining 12 loops 13 loops to correspond with other half of back. Fasten off. Sew up shoulder seams.

SKIRT . . . Attach thread in 1st sp on opposite side of foundation chain on Bodice and with No. 6 hook work as follows: 1st row: Ch 3, dc in same place where thread was attached, * ch 4, in loop formed by ch-3 and dc make

3 dc (group made), sc in base of next dc, ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 4 and complete group as before, sc in same sp, ch 3, dc in same sp, ch 4 and complete group as before, sc in base of next dc, ch 3, dc in next sp. Repeat from * across. Ch 8, turn. 2nd row: * Dc in next ch-4 loop, ch 4 and complete group, sc in same ch-4 loop, ch 3. Repeat from * across. Ch 8, turn. Repeat 2nd row 2 more times. Hereafter work is done in rnds. Join last sc of each rnd with a sl st in the 5th st of the last ch-8 turning ch. Ch 8, turn. Work as for 2nd row, joining at center back as described, until piece measures from top 15" of shoulder Join and fasten off.

SLEEVES . . . Starting at lower edge (with No. 10 hook) ch 95 (to measure about 7½ inches). 1st and 2nd rows: Same as 1st and 2nd rows of Bodice (15 loops). Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: (In next loop make sc, dc and sc, ch 4) 4 times; (sc in next loop, ch 4, sc in same loop, ch 4) 7 times; in next loop make sc, dc and sc, complete row in pattern (22 loops). Ch 5, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 1 inch. Turn.

To Shape Top: 1st to 4th rows incl: Sl st to center of 1st loop, ch 4 and work in pattern across to last loop, do not work in last loop (14 loops remain). Work straight until piece measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches up center. Fasten off.

Attach thread at neck edge and work 2 rows of sc along neck edge, holding in to fit. Work a row of sc along back opening. On next row work 8 ch-4 buttonloops along right back. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonloops. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in, gathering extra fullness of sleeves across top 4 inches at each shoulder. Press through damp cloth. Tie ribbon around at waistline.

2nd row: Skip 1 st, * (insert hook in next st and pull loop through) twice; (thread over and draw through 2 loops) twice; ch 1. Repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Sc in base of ch-1, sc in sp before 1st single thread, * sc in sp following single thread, sc in sp before next single thread. Repeat from * across.

Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows alternately for pattern until piece measures $9\frac{1}{2}$ " 10" ending with 2nd row of pattern.

Next row: Dec across as follows: Sc in base of ch-1, * (skip 1 sp, sc in next sp) 3 times; sc in next sp. Repeat from * across. There are on row

Now work back and forth in rows of sc for $\frac{3}{4}$ inch for waistband. Next row: With wrong side facing, work as for 2nd row of pattern. Continue working in pattern until piece measures $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches from top of waistband, ending with an sc row. Following row: Work in pattern across 29 sts 31 sts Ch 1, turn.

Work over this set of sts only for Right Back for $1\frac{1}{4}$ " $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ending with 2nd row of pattern.

Next row: Work across to within last 12 sts. Ch 3, turn and work over the remaining 17 sts 19 sts for $3^{1}/4^{"}$ $3^{1}/2^{"}$ Fasten off.

Skip the next 13 sts on the last complete row, attach thread and work across the next 61 sts 65 sts Ch 1, turn.

Work over this set of sts only for Front for $1\frac{1}{4}$ " $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ending with a pattern row.

Next row: Work across
17 sts
19 sts
Ch 1, turn.

Work over this set of sts only for shoulder for $3\frac{1}{4}$ " $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fasten off.

Skip next 27 sts on Front and work over remaining sts for other shoulder to correspond.

Skip next 13 sts on last complete row, attach thread and work over the remaining sts for Left Back to correspond with Right Back.

RUFFLE... Chain 81 sts to measure $11\frac{1}{2}$ " $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: 2 dc in each sc across. Ch 3, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Dc in each dc across. Ch 3, turn. At end of 4th row ch 4, turn. 5th row: * Skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, ch 4. Repeat from * across. Ch 5, turn. 6th and 7th rows: Sc in 1st loop, * ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across. Ch 5, turn. Fasten off at end of 7th row.

Sew shoulder seams. Attach thread at lower edge of Right Back of skirt and work a row of sc (making 2 sc in each pattern row and 1 sc in each sc row) across to neck, along neck edge working in sps as for pattern, then along Left Back to correspond. Ch 1, turn. Place a pin on this sc row on Right Back 1/4 inch down from neck edge, place another pin at center of waistband and a pin half way between these 2 pins. Place another pin 21/4 inches up from lower edge of skirt and 4 pins evenly between this last pin and the one in the waistband. 2nd row: Sc in each sc (increasing at the outside corners of neck and decreasing at the inside corners of neck as necessary to keep work flat) across to 1st pin, ch 3, skip 3 sc for buttonhole, sc in each sc across to next pin. Continue making a buttonhole in this manner at each pin. Finish row with sc. Ch 1, turn. Work 2 more rows of sc. Fasten off. Sew ruffle half way between neck and armhole edge. Sew on buttons.

HAT Average headsize

Make a chain to measure about 17 inches (7 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across until there are 108 sc on row. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. Work 3 more rows of sc tightly. Ch 3, turn. Next row: Work as for 2nd row of Dress. Following row: Work as for 3rd row of Dress, increasing 1 st in every 6th sp across—to inc 1 st, make 2 sc in 1 sp. Repeat the last 2 rows once more. Next row: Work as for 2nd row of Dress. Following row: (Insert hook in next sp and draw loop through) twice, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (1 st decreased); dec 1 more st in same way, work sc in each sp across to within last 4 sps, dec 2 sts as before. Ch 3, turn. Continue working in pattern, decreasing 2 sts at both ends of each sc row until piece measures 4½ inches in all, ending with an sc row. Ch 3, turn.

To Make Ruffle: Work 2 dc in each sc across. Ch 3, turn. Next row: Dc in each dc across. Ch 4, turn. Now work as for 5th, 6th and 7th rows of Ruffle of Dress. Fasten off. Sew straight edges together at back of Hat. Work a row of sc along shaped edge at back of Hat.

Fasten off. Skip 8 shells for neck and work other shoulder to correspond.

RIGHT BACK... Make a chain about 10 inches long. 1st row: Work as for 1st row of Front until there are

Hereafter work is done in rnds: 1st rnd: Attach thread in ch-5 sp of next shell, ch 4, 12 tr in same sp, * ch 5, s.o.s., ch 5, 13 tr in ch-5 sp of next shell. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5. Join to 4th st of ch-4. 2nd rnd: Ch 5 (to count as tr and ch 1), tr in next tr; (ch 1, tr in next tr) 11 times; * ch 4, s.o.s., ch 4, tr in next tr; (ch 1, tr in next tr) 12 times. Repeat from * around; join to 4th st of ch-5 first made. 3rd rnd: Sl st in 1st ch-1 sp, sc in same sp; *(ch 3, sc in next ch-1 sp) 11 times; ch 4, s.o.s., ch 4, sc in next ch-1 sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 4, sc in 1st ch-3 loop. 4th rnd: * (Ch 3, sc in next loop) 10 times; ch 4, s.o.s., ch 4, sc in next ch-3 loop. Repeat from * around, ending as for previous rnd. 5th rnd: * (Ch 3, sc in next loop) 9 times; ch 4, in ch-2 sp of next shell make 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc; ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending as before.

6th rnd: * (Ch 3, sc in next loop)

8 times; ch 4, in next ch-2 sp make a shell; ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending as before. 7th rnd: * (Ch 3, sc in next loop) 7 times; ch 4, s.o.s.,

Repeat from * across, ending with

ch 5, sl st in 3rd st of turning ch at beginning of rnd (hereafter skirt is worked in rnds). 2nd rnd: Ch 3, * (2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) 3 times; ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, (dc in next dc, ch 2) 5 times; dc in next dc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, sc in last ch-5 sp, ch 2, sl st in top st of starting chain. 3rd rnd: Ch 5, * (skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2) twice; dc in next dc, ch 5, (dc in next dc, ch 2) 5 times; dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in center st of starting chain. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rnds alternately until Skirt measures

SLEEVES... Starting at bottom, make a chain to measure about 11 inches. Work in pattern as on Bodice, having on 1st row 36 sps 40 sps Cut off remaining chain. Continue working in pattern for 2 inches, ending with 3rd row of pattern.

To Shape Top: Sl st across 6 sts at beginning of next 12 rows 14 rows Fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams. Work a row of sc along Left Back opening; work 5 ch-5 loops evenly along Right Back opening. Work beading at neck as follows: Ch 5, * skip 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 2. Repeat from * around entire neck edge, dc in last st. Fasten off. Sew up sleeve seams and sew sleeves in, shirring extra fullness in top 3 inches at shoulder. Sew on buttons. Press through damp cloth. Run velvet ribbon through neck beading and through the row of sps at bottom of Bodice.



Ch 2, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Make sc, ch 2 and sc in each ch-2 loop across. Ch 2, turn. Fasten off after 3rd row. This completes one tuck. Skip 3 rows of sps, make another tuck across next row of sps. Continue working a row of tucks over every 4th row of sps across Bib. Work tucks on Left and Right Back of Bodice in same way. Starting on 2nd row of sps work tucks over each Side Piece, having last row of tucks on last row of sps. Starting on 29th row from bottom of Skirt, work tucks back and forth joining rnds with a sl st in 1st sc made. Repeat tucks to bottom of Skirt.

Sew Side Pieces to Bib. Work 2 rows of sc along Left Back to top of Skirt. Work 1 row of sc along Right Back, then on next row make 8 ch-7 buttonloops evenly spaced. Sew buttons on Left Back to correspond. Starting at center back run ribbon through row of sps at top of Skirt.

Continue working in pattern across Front, work in pattern over chain as on opposite side and continue in pattern across Back, ending with ch 5, sl st in top of starting cluster. Ch 1, turn. Repeat from * around (3rd pineapple rnd started). Continue in established pattern around until only 1 loop remains on pineapples of 2nd pineapple rnd.

Next rnd: S.o.s., * ch 4, sc in next loop, ch 4, s.o.s., ch 4, sc in next loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 10 times; ch 4, s.o.s. Repeat from * around. Join. This completes 2nd pineapple rnd. Continue working in this manner until 5 pineapple rnds have been completed, having 15 tr for pineapples of 4th and 5th pineapple rnds. Join. Next rnd: * S.o.s., ch 3, s.o.s., ch 4, sc in next loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 10 times, ch 4. Repeat from * around. Join. Now work pineapples individually as follows: 1st row: S.o.s., ch 4, sc in next loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 9 times; ch 4, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn. Continue in this manner, having one ch-3 loop less on each row until 1 loop remains at top of pineapple. Ch 5, turn. Next row: Make s.o.s., ch 4, sc in loop, ch 4, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn, make s.o.s. twice. Fasten off. Attach thread to 1st shell of next pineapple and complete the point in same manner. Continue thus until all points have been worked.

Work 2 rnds all around outer edges as follows: 1st rnd: Attach thread in ch-3 sp between shells (at base of points), sc in same place, * shell over each turning ch along both sides of point and in each of the 2 shells at tip of point, having ch-2 between shells;

sc in next ch-3 between shells (at base of points). Repeat from * around. Join. 2nd rnd: Sl st to center of next shell, ch 5, * sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, in sp of next shell make dc, p and dc—to make a p, ch 4 and sc in 4th ch from hook; ch 2. Repeat from * across point, ending with ch 2, dc in sp of last shell on this point, dc in sp of 1st shell on next point, ch 2, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, in sp of next shell make dc, p and dc and continue thus around. Cut a 13-inch length of ribbon and pass through shells at neck edge. Sew ends in place. Pass remaining ribbon through Beading and tie in Back.

7ips for Crocheters

IMPORTANT... Be sure to buy at one time sufficient material of the **same dye lot** to complete the article you wish to make, as it is impossible to avoid slight variations in shade in different dye lots.

GAUGE . . . Before starting your article, make a small sample of the stitch. If your working tension is too tight or too loose, use a finer or coarser hook, to obtain the correct gauge.

LAUNDERING... Launder garment in warm water, using a good neutral soap or soap flakes. Do not use bleaching solutions! Allow to dry. Shape gently to size and, if necessary, iron while slightly damp, on wrong side with a moderately warm—not hot—iron.
