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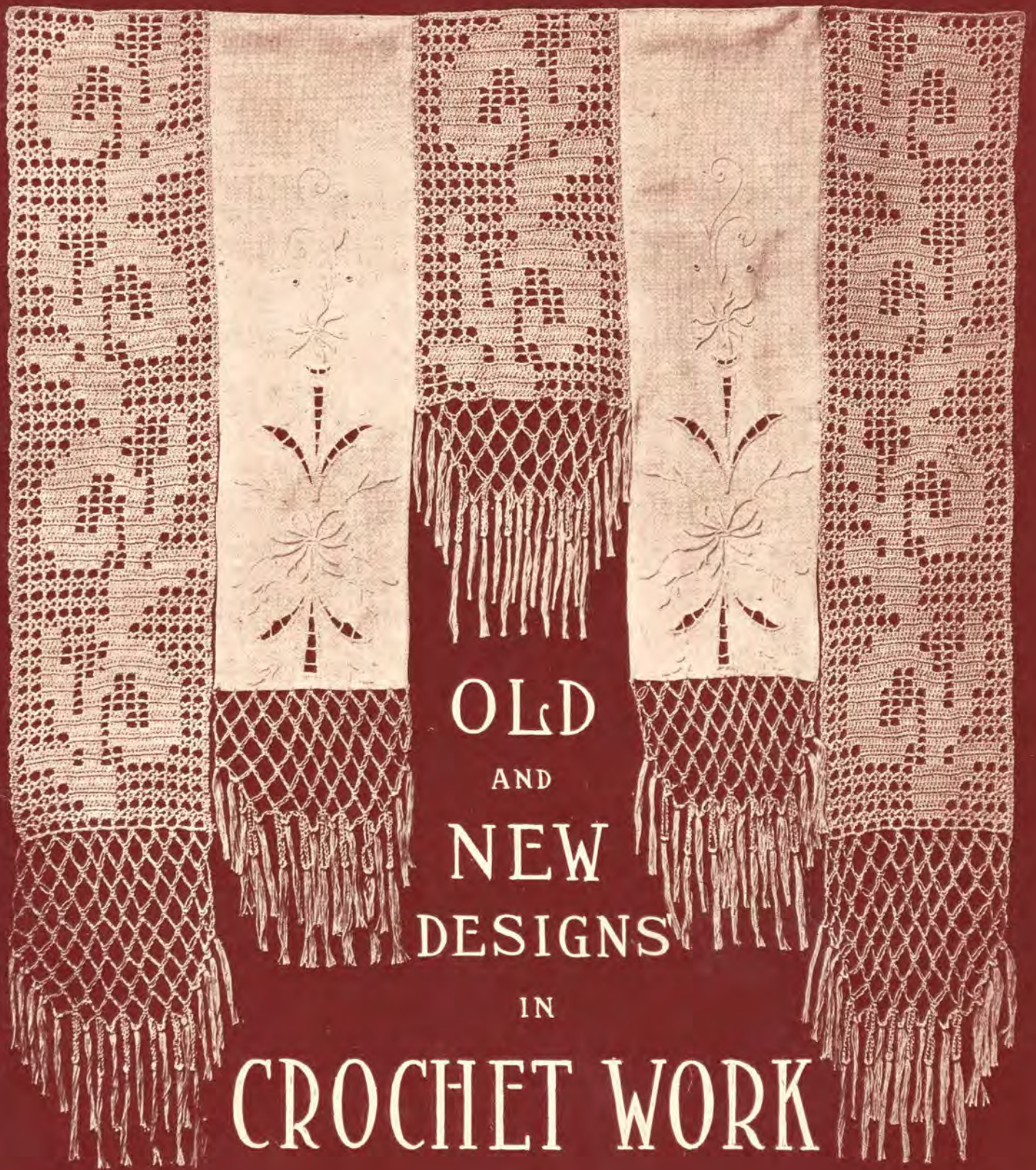

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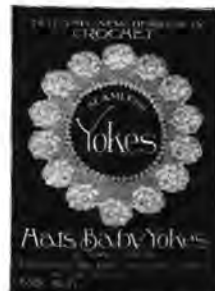

Chain



No. 326

To start the ch. tie a slip knot, insert hook, thread over hook, and draw through a loop. Repeat, drawing through as many loops as are required, each loop being called a ch. st.

Double Crochet



No. 327

Having a stitch on the needle, put the needle through the work and draw a stitch through, making two on the needle. Take up the thread again and draw it through both these sts.

Treble



No. 328

Having a stitch on the needle, take up thread once as if for a stitch, put the needle through the work and draw a stitch through, leaving three on the needle. Take up the thread and draw through two, then two remaining.

Half Treble

Having a stitch on the needle, take up thread once as if for a stitch, put the needle through the work and draw a stitch through, leaving three on the needle. Take up the thread and draw through three and chain off.

Double Treble



No. 330

Having st. on needle, take up 2 threads as for a st., put needle through work, draw stitch through, making 4 on needle. Take up thread, draw through 2, then 2, then 2 remaining.

Triple Treble



No. 331

Having st. on needle take up 3 threads as for a st., put needle through work, draw stitch through, making 5 on needle, take up thread, draw through 2, then 2, then 2, then 2 remaining.

**Slip Stitch**



No. 332

Pass hook through a stitch of the foundation and draw thread through that and the loop on the needle without putting thread over.

**Picot**



No. 333

Ch. four sts., insert hook in first ch. st. made on ch. throw thread over, and draw through ch. st. and loop on hook.

**Mesh**



No. 334

1 t., ch. 2, sk. 2 ch., 1 t. in next ch.

**Popcorn Stitch**



No. 335

1 t. in 8th ch. from needle, 5 t. in same st., take hook out, insert in top of 1st t. then 5 t., then thread over hook, draw through 2 loops, chain 1 to draw it in proper shape.

**Lacet**



Nos. 336-337

1st R. 1 dc. in 9 ch. from needle, ch. 2, sk. 2 st., 1 t. in next ch., 2 ch., sk. 2 st., 1 dc. in next st., 2 ch., sk. 2 t. in next, repeat.

**Space**

2nd. R. 8 ch., tn., sk. lacet, 1 t. in t., 5 ch., sk. 1 l., 1 t. in next t., repeat.

**Cluster**



No. 338

Thread over needle, take st. same as in t., draw out longer, draw thread through but 2 loops, \* 1 t. again drawing thread through 2 loops, repeat \* 5 loops on hook, then thread over, draw through 5 loops, then 1 ch. to draw cluster into proper shape.

**Cross Treble**



No. 339

Thread over needle twice, draw a lp. through ch., thread over needle, draw through 2 lp., thread over needle, sk. 3 ch., draw thread through ch. having 5 lp. on needle, ch. off 2 at a time.



Portiere Curtain No. 200

**No. 200**

This beautiful portiere, 2½x9 feet, should be made of Bulgarian Ecreu Linen, and to secure the very best effect, No. 10 Macrame Cord should be used for both the crochet and embroidery work. Each curtain requires 18 balls. Center Medallion of Insertion:

- 1st R. 15 t. under 6 ch.
- 2nd R. Ch. 4, 1 p., 1 t. in 2nd t., 1 p., 1 t. in next t., rp. ro.

- 4th R. Ch. 4, 1 t. in ea. st. ro.
- 5th R. 5 dc., ch. 10, join, 17 dc. under 10 ch., 5 dc. in next 5 dc., ch. 10, join, rp. 10 times.

- 4th and 5th R. Rp. 2nd row.
- 6th R. Ch. 5, 1 dc. in 1st t., ch. 5, rp.
- 7th R. \* Ch. 7, sk. 5 ch., 1 dc. in next dc., rp. 13 times, ch. 3, 1 dt. in next dc., tn.
- 8th R. Ch. 7, 1 dc. in next 7 ch., rp. until you have 3-7 ch., \* rp. \* to \*.

Fringe:

Cut 12 threads 18 in. long and knot as illustrated.

This curtain is made of bobbinet and square medallion same as No. 201, but this medallion is crocheted with Cream linen thread. This design is also used for door panels.

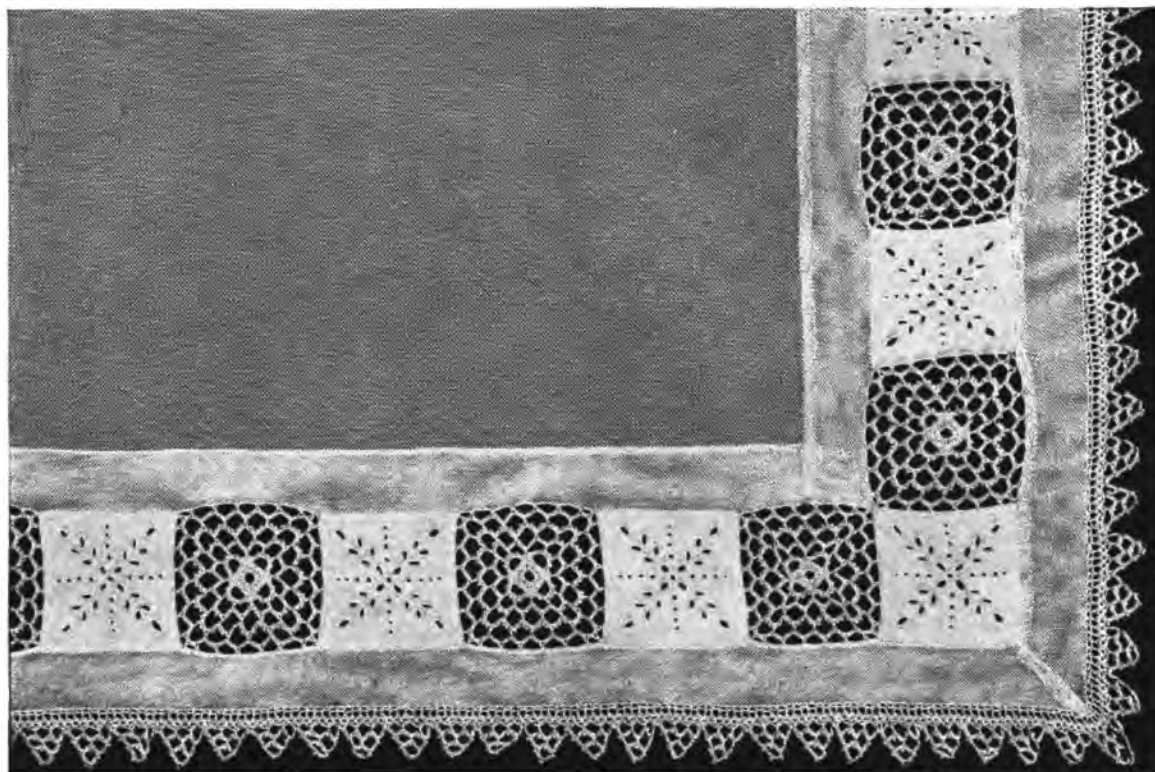

- 3rd R. Ch. 7, 1 dc. in center of 11 dc., ch. 7, rp.
- 4th R. 5 dc., 1 p., 5 dc. under ea. 7 ch.

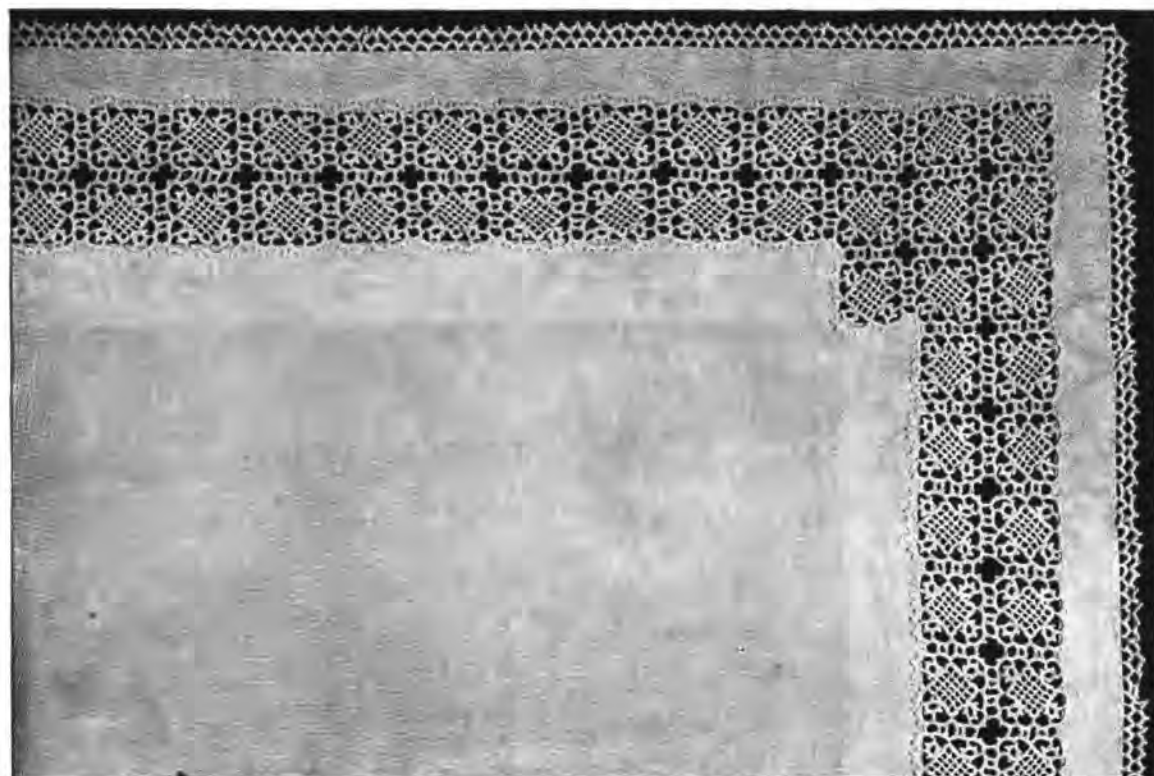
This charming curtain design is most effective when made up of ecru bobbinet. The crocheted and linen embroidered pieces are 5 inches square.

- Ch. 12 and join.
- 1st R. Ch. 4, 1 t., rp. 19 times under 12 ch.
- 2nd R. 2 dc. bet. ea. t.
- 3rd R. 3 dc. in 3 dc., ch. 10, sk. 5 dc., 5 dc. in next 5 dc., rp. 3 times, 2 dc. next to 3 dc. and join.
- 4th R. 3 dc. in 3 dc., 2 dc., 5 p., 2 dc. under 10 ch., rp. ro.
- 5th R. Ch. 10, 1 dc. in 2nd p., ch. 12, 1 dc. in 4th p., ch. 10, 1 dc. in center of 5 dc., rp. ro.
- 6th R. 5 dc., 1 p., 5 dc. under 10 ch., 5 dc., 2 p., 5 dc. under 12 ch., rp. ro.
- 7th R. Sl. st. to center p., ch. 10, 1 dc. in 1st p. of corner, ch. 12, 1 dc. in next corner p., ch. 10, 1 dc. in next p., rp. ro.

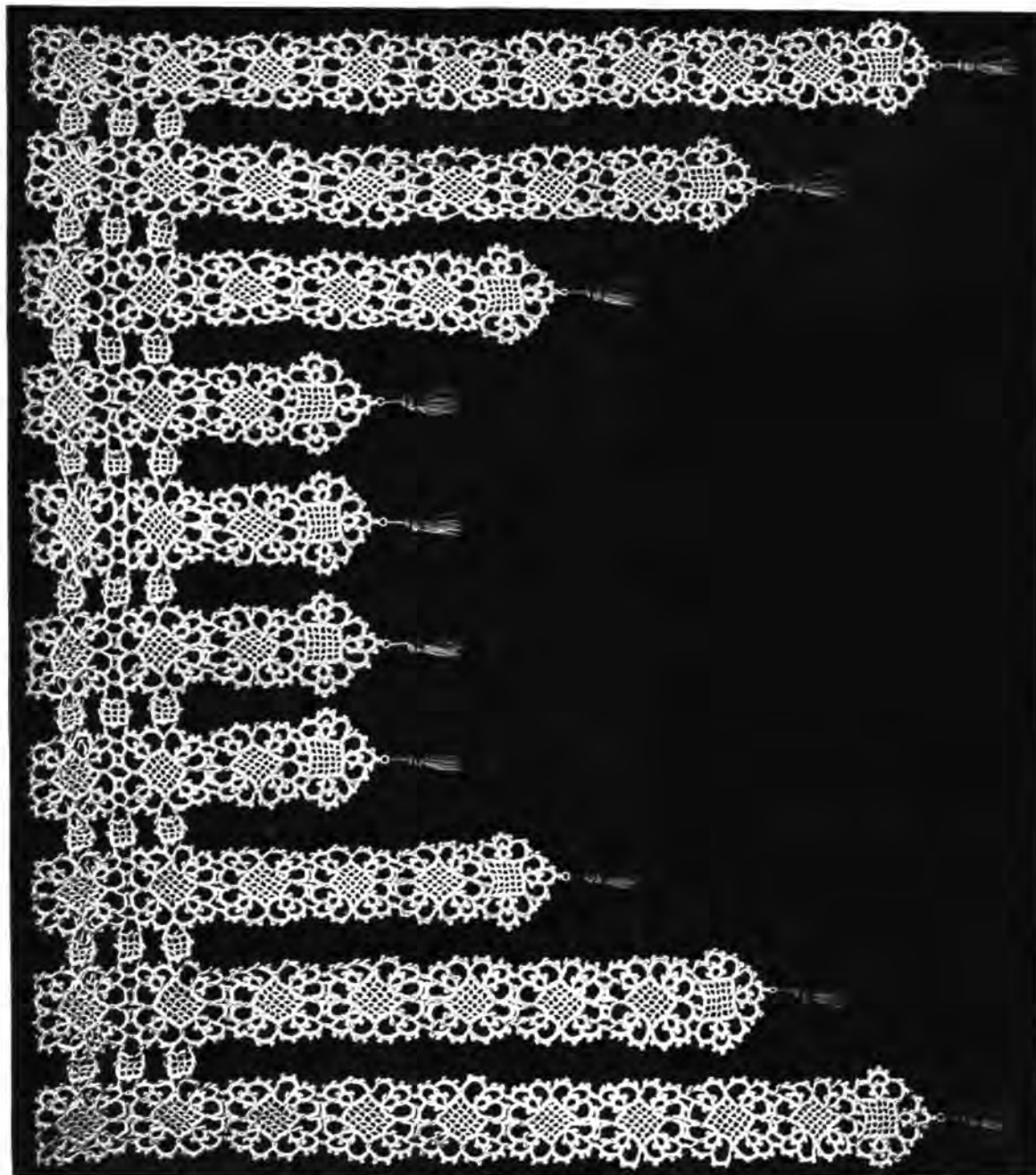

This design originated in Bohemia. Many beautiful things can be made as your fancy suggests with these squares as used in No. 201. The square measures 7 inches and is made of ecru Macrame. 24 balls will complete each portiere. Use needle No. 2.

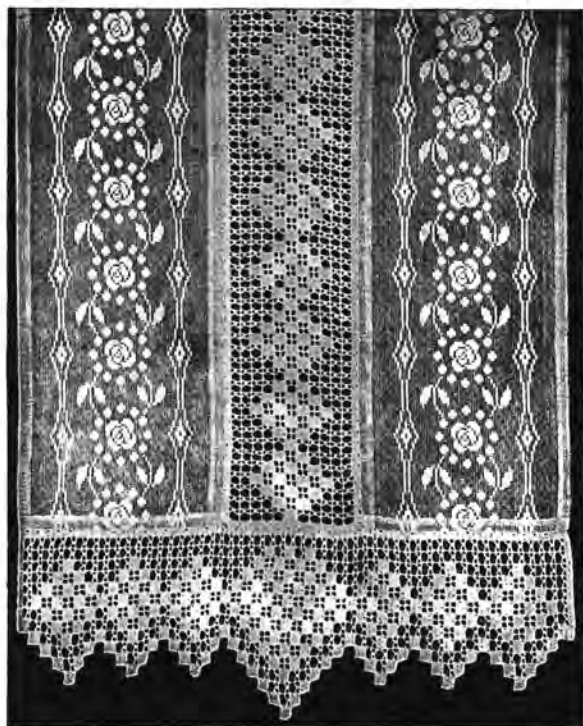

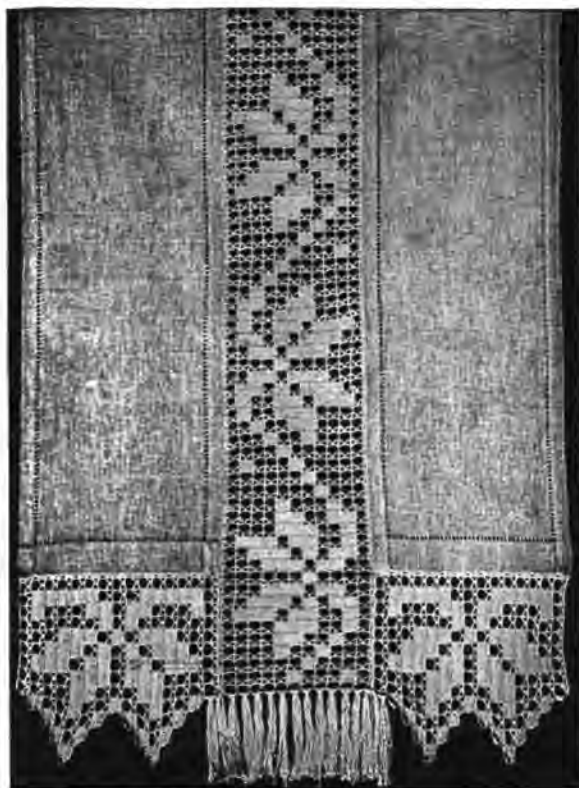

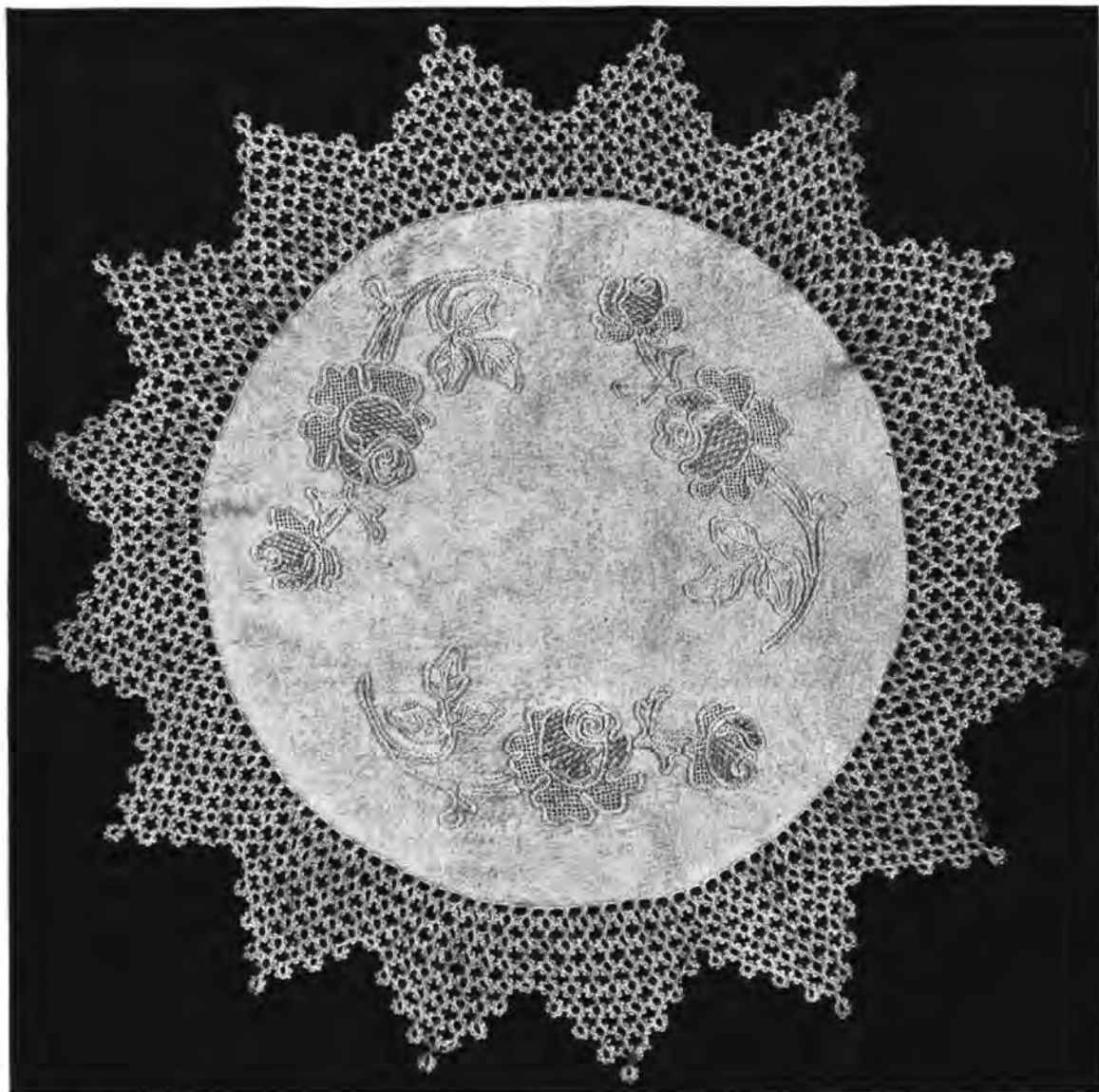

This center piece is 27 in. and made of ecru linen. The embroidery is worked in linen color and gold thread. The outlining is crochet, the center of the leaves is done in the German knot stitch.

**Directions for Outlining.**

2 ch. catch back in second ch., make 1 dc. 1 ch. catch back in third ch., make 1 dc. Repeat.

**Edging:**

Commence between 2 scallops.

1st R. Ch. 8, dc. in 4th ch. from needle to form 1st p., ch. 4, 1 dc. in 4th ch., ch. 4, 1 dc. in 4th ch. \* ch. 8, 1 dc. in 4th ch. from needle. 2—4 ch. p., rp. \* to \* once, ch. 8, 1 dc. in 4th ch. from needle 6, 4 ch., p. 2nd R. 4 dc. on last 4 ch., 3-4 ch. p., 4 dc. on next 4 ch., 3-4 ch. p., 4 dc., 3-4 ch. p., 4 dc. 3rd R. Do not turn the work. Ch. 12, 1 dc. in 4th ch. from needle, \* ch. 2, withdraw needle, insert in the middle of the 2nd p. of preceding row. Draw st. thru, ch. 2, 1 dc. in 1st ch., 1-4 ch. p., ch. 8, 1 dc. in 4th ch. from needle, \* rp. \* to \* 3 times, ch. 8, 1 dc. in 4th ch., 5 p., 4 dc. on last 4 ch., rp., adding to points, see illustration.

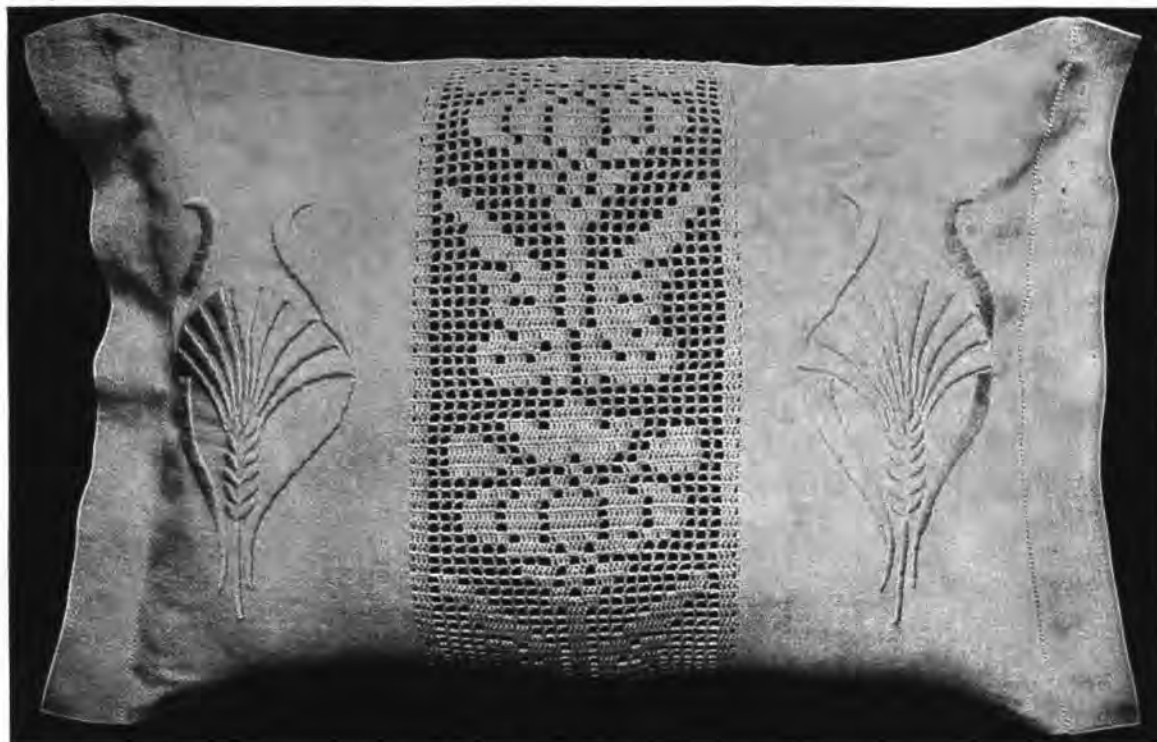
