



4th Row.—3 sl. sts. to center of shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center st. of next shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center st. of following shell continue around, join.

5th Row.—3 s.c., ch. 4 to form p., 3 s.c. 1 p., 3 s.c. around next ch. 7, repeat from * all







Now work always with a half strand. Take half of the first, 2 of the second, 2 of the 3rd, and left half of 4th, as shown in Fig. 1. Take half of first and half 4th and knot them, after weaving in and out, as shown in Fig. II.

Continue knotting 2nd and 5th and so on. The last row of knots is formed as shown in Fig. III.

Materials required: {ROYAL SOCIETY White CORDICHET No. 80, 4 balls. Crochet Hook, size 14 ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet, No. 8, 1 ball. Crochet Hook, size 11

To start this yoke begin at point A with 85 meshes and follow diagram until 13 rows are made. This is for back of yoke. At point B turn and continue with rows of 13 meshes until C is reached. When filet part is complete work around outside of yoke with 3 d.c. into one m., 2 d.c. into next m. Into each corner m. put 9 d.c., at angles finish 5 d.c. together.

At inside of yoke work all around with 3 d.c. into one m., 2 d.c. into next m. At angles finish 5 d.c. together. Continue all around and join with sl. st.

BEADING

Ch. 9, sk. 3, 1 d.tr.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.tr.c. and continue. At angles 1 d.tr.c., pull 3 times through 2 loops, sk. 3 sts., 1 d.tr.c. into angle, pull 3 times through 2 loops, sk. 3 sts., 1 d.tr.c., pull 3 times through 2 loops and then through the remaining loops on needle, continue all around. Join with sl. st. to 6th ch. from beginning.







For the beginner in Filet Crochet, it would be well to read the following directions carefully and practise with the working models shown before starting a piece of work.

Open mesh: 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch. to close mesh. This forms a perfect square. In making rows of open meshes the d.c. is always made into d.c. of previous row.

Closed mesh: 1 d.c. into d.c., 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c.

To make a number of open meshes like Working Model Fig. 1, which has 10 open meshes, ch. 30, add 1 ch., ch. 5 more to turn, sk. 8 chs., 1 d.c. into 9th ch. 4th Row.—To increase 2 closed meshes at beginning of row, ch. 8, sk. 3, 5 d.c. into 5 next chs., 7 d.c. into 7 following d.c., 4 open meshes, 6 d.c. into 6 following d.c. To increase 2 closed meshes at end of row proceed the same way as to increase 1 closed meshes at end of row proceed the same way as to increase 1 closed meshes at beginning of row, ch. 3, for each additional closed mesh. 2nd Row.—Ch. 3, 71 d.c. into sts., 5 d.c. into next st., 3 d.c. into next sts., 5 d.c. into following st. (this forms two corners) 71 d.c. 5 d.c. into next st., 3 d.c. into sts., 5 d.c. Join to first d.c. of row.

3rd Row.—Ch. 3, 73 d.c., 5 d.c. into next st., 7 d.c., 5 d.c. into next st. continue around. Join.

4th Row.—Ch. 3, 75 d.c., 5 d.c. into next st., 11 d.c., 5 d.c. into next st. continue around. Join.

5th Row.—Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into every st. all around taking up back rib. Join.

6th Row.—Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into every st. all around taking up back rib.

7th and 8th Row.—Same as 6th row.

9th Row.—Ch. 3, 1 bean st. (to make bean st., cotton around needle pull through next st., * cotton around needle pull through same st., repeat from * 3 times more, pull through all loops on needle) ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 bean st., ch. 1. sk. 1, 1 bean st., continue all around. Join.

10th Row.—1 s.c. into every st. all around. Join.

11th Row.—1 s.c., ch. 4, form p., sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 1 s.c., repeat all around.

Embroidered band begin with green 1182 working a row of back stitches directly under crochet bean stitches working across from one bean stitch to the next.

4th Row.—Pink 1201 work a row back stitches in first crochet row under the top band working back stitches same size as the upper row.

This fits a glass tray 9 inches long. When crochet is finished place on tray pulling up sides into shape. The draw string when tightened holds the crochet in place. If desired a little glue at sides makes it firmer.

Materials required: ROYAL SOCIETY Pink CORDICHET, No. 3015, size 70, 6 balls. Crochet Hook, size 13.

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Start at point A with 103 open meshes and follow diagram until point B is reached. Then continue for shoulder band until point C is reached. Now start at point D and continue until point E is reached, then work across front and finish the bands and center point.

At outside of filet yoke work 1 row of s.c., 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., 3 s.c. into following m., 2 s.c. into next m. Into corner ms., 9 s.c., at angles between straps and front only 1 s.c. into each of 2 m.

Make one other row of 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c. all around. The two outside straps and inside of sleeveband are finished same way. At inside of yoke:

1st Row.—3 s.c. into 1 m., 2 s.c. into next m. at angles, 1 s.c. into each of 2 m., continue around, join.

2nd Row.—Beading. 7 s.c., * turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into next st., turn, 13 s.c. around ch. 9, sk. 1, 13 s.c. into following sts., repeat from * around. Have one loop of ch. 9 at each angle, join.

3rd Row.—Ch. 11, 1 s.c. into center st. of first loop, ch. 6, 1 d.tr.c. into center between 2 loops, ch. 6, s.c. into center of next loop. At angles after s.c. into loop before angle is made, ch. 6, sk. 6 s.c. 1 d.tr.c. Without any chs. between 1 s.c. into center of loop at angle, 1 d.tr.c. into 7th st. before next loop

4th Row.—7 s.c. around each ch. 6 all around neck.

5th Row.—Edging.—7 s.c., turn, ch. 6, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 6, ch. 6, 7 s.c. into following sts.. repeat from * around.

SLEEVE-BAND Begin with 11 open meshes and make 96 rows or any length desired. Finish outside with beading and edging as on inside yoke,

Wind cotton 50 times around cardboard 4 inches long, cut, tie in center, tie again one-half inch from top, sew on.

ROYAL SOCIETY Crochet No. 1010, 4 balls. Crochet Hook, size 5.
Follow directions for scarf in making cushion, only adding 3 rows of meshes top and bottom as shown in illustration.

Place on stamped linen and cut linen away underneath. When pillow is made up trim corners with crocheted corner and tassel.

CORNER

Ch. 4, sk. 3, 4 d.c. into first ch., turn, ch. 3, 2 d.c. into each st., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next st., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into last st., turn, 3 s.c. into each of 4 spaces, turn, 5 s.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 5, 5 s.c., turn, ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 7, 5 s.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 5, finish off.

FOR BACK OF CORNER

Make one other piece the same way, only make plain row of s.c. for the last row.

Join the 2 pieces together with 1 s.c. into each row of s.c., 3 s.c. into first space, 3 s.c. around each of 2 d.c., 3 s.c. into point, continue for other side, turn, 1 s.c. into each st., 3 s.c. into point. TASSEL

Wind cotton 120 times around cardboard 6 inches long, cut, tie in center, tie again 1 inch from top.

Start on top of tassel. ch. 9, join to ring, 6 s.c. into ring, ch. 1, join into point of corner, ch. 1. 6 s.c. into ring, join and finish off.








